## WAR PASS UPSET IN TAMPA BAY DERBY

Yesterday's GIII Tampa Bay Derby was supposed to be a mere formality for Eclipse Award winner **War Pass** (Cherokee Run), another pit stop on the road to Lousiville. But the champ's race was over two strides out of the gate and Eric Fein's **Big Truck** (Hook and Ladder) proved the beneficiary, sitting a perfect trip



from behind the leading group before rallying into the stretch and outfinishing Dogwood Stable's **Atoned** (Repent) for a neck victory. Trainer Barclay Tagg has been down the Derby trail before with another New York-bred, Funny Cide. But the conditioner admits to having no delu-

sions of grandeur, despite saddling the colt who finished runner-up in Tampa's main local prep, the Sam F. Davis S. Feb. 16. "I told [Coa] to ride for second," Tagg said following the victory. "I told him if something happens to War Pass, if you ride for second he'll win the race. He felt the same way, and it kind of worked out that way. I mean, you just never know. Theoretically, you're not going to beat War Pass going a mile and a sixteenth here." ## The Makings of an Upset...

War Pass had never trailed at any call in his previous five career appearances, but that all changed as the gates sprung. Restless in the stalls, War Pass was bumped shortly after the start by Gentleman James (Yankee Gentleman) to his inside and Make Me Zach (First Tour), then found himself in the unusual position of being between those two longshots as the field raced into the clubhouse turn. Clearly uncomfortable with his position, jockey Cornelio Velasquez did his best to extricate his colt and was able to secure a stalking position, but was caught out five paths off the rail with only Atoned to his outside. In the meantime, Big Truck was tucked neatly away towards the inside and, about the same time War Pass was getting a lefthanded reminder from Velasquez, he eased out four wide to launch his bid in earnest. Atoned had first run and made the lead while still deep at the guarter pole and set sail for the wire, but Big Truck drew alongside at the sixteenth pole and went on to the narrow victory. War Pass, 1-20 throughout the wagering, dropped out tamely and was not persevered with for the final 3/16 of a mile. "He wasn't himself today," commented disappointed owner Robert LaPenta. "As soon as the gate opened, he didn't jump out like he normally does. He had some fever this week and we thought he'd be OK, but obviously it wasn't his day." LaPenta said a decision on a start in the GI Wood Memorial Apr. 5 would be made over the coming days.

## CAN HE STAY? BOY, CAN HE EVER

While the local divisional heavies such as El Gato Malo and Colonel John bide their time and await the Gl Santa Anita Derby in three weeks' time, a trio of top California sprinters had a little something to prove yesterday as they tried two turns for the first time in the Gll San Felipe S. In the end, it was Gl Del Mar Futurity hero **Georgie Boy** (Tribal Rule) who had the best finishing kick, switching out for the stretch drive to run down San Pedro S. winner **Gayego** (Gilded Time) by a narrow margin. **Bob Black Jack** (Stormy Jack), who set a world record of 1:06 3/5 in winning the Sunshine Millions Dash Jan. 26, was a solid third, well clear of Indian Sun (Indian Charlie) in fourth.

#### Consistent Form at Two...

Georgie Boy broke his maiden, appropriately enough, in Del Mar's Graduation S. for California-breds July 25, then was a game runner-up to Salute the Sarge in the GII Best Pal S. Aug. 12. Despite that solid form, he was 5-1 in the Futurity and turned the tables on his Best Pal conqueror by a half-length. Put away for the year following that effort, the dark bay showed an impressive turn of foot to win the seven-furlong GII San Vicente S. Feb. 10, defeating GI CashCall Futurity hero Into Mischief and Massive Drama by 3 1/4 lengths.

#### A Professional Two-Turn Debut...

With Michael Baze in the saddle, replacing the injured Rafael Bejarano, Georgie Boy settled kindly in third as Bob Black Jack cut out anything but sprint-like fractions while tracked by Gayego. The front-runner still held a narrow advantage after six furlongs in a pedestrian 1:13.02, and Georgie Boy was temporarily short of room in upper stretch. But, switched out past the eighth pole, he rallied stoutly to score, despite never jumping off his right lead. "He's matured dramatically since the last time I rode him [in his first start June 16]," Baze commented. "Around the far turn I just had to wait, wait, wait and at the top of the lane, I was able to swing out and say 'Goodbye'. He really impressed me more after we hit the wire. I had a harder time pulling him up than I did during the race." The winner goes next in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 5 or the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 12.







A total of 13 youngsters went under the hammer Saturday, having been removed from the main body of the Sale Dec. 8 due to the equine influenza outbreak in Australia. Hip 11, a son of the outstanding Redoute's Choice (Aus), was produced by Let's Get Even (Thunder Gulch), a half-sister to the dam of GISW Stephen Got Even and GSW Indy Glory. She has already produced G3 Norman Robinson S. winner Get Square (Aus) to the cover of Redoute's Choice. The co-sales topper, a A\$275,000 purchase out of last year's Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, was knocked down to the bid of Peter Law Kin Sang. The final horse through the ring equalled the top bid. Hip 13 is by Encosta de Lago (Aus), sire of Hong Kong's best horse and world champion turf sprinter Sacred Kingdom (Aus). A A\$420,000 purchase out of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, the bay is the first foal from Lane's End (Aus) (End Sweep), a half-sister to MGSW and G1SP Chong Tong (Aus). He was purchased by Cheng Keung Fai. "This year, we invested more money in stronger pedigrees, and their preparation for racing careers here has gone very well," commented Bill Nader, executive director of racing for the Hong Kong Jockey Club. "They all breezed well last week and presented beautifully in the ring. It was clear that each of these horses have the right temperament for Hong Kong, and that's very important." Gross receipts for the 13 horses offered were HK\$57.4 million (\$7,363,695) for an average of HK\$4,415,385 (\$566,438) and a median of HK\$4.5 million (\$577,293).
