Ran poorly first time out, but two of his next three were much better, and since he has speed and the rail, good enough to put him in the thick of this if he runs back to that level. But this gelding is by Dixie Union, whose runners so far haven't liked synthetic surfaces much (see Sire Profile). That makes him tough to use and, at the same time, tough to throw out.

- 2 Macho Again Macho Uno Mena 10-1
 Ran a big figure last time out, and a repeat would
 give him a big shot here. But his only effort over Poly
 was the worst of his life, and since he's also off a big
 jump to a new top, a bounce is likely.
- 3 Chitoz Forest Wildcat Douglas 8-1
 Ran well over this surface last year, but has deteriorated since on dirt and grass. If that was simply a function of surface, he'll run better now. But even if he does he would have to dramatically improve on that two-year-old figure to contend.
- 4 Rich Young Ruler Victory Gallop Pompell 30-1
 Ran a new top before being eased in his last, and it's tough to know what his condition is now. Since he's never run fast enough and never tried Poly, he's tough to like regardless.
- 5 Adriano A.P. Indy Prado 6-1
 Showed nice development and good figures on both
 Poly and grass at two, and ran a big one at Gulfstream
 on turf in January. In his last, he tried dirt and ran
 poorly, but we think he'll run much better now over the
 synthetic surface. Contender.
- Racecar Rhapsody Tale of the Cat Albarado 6-1
 Was left at the post in his debut and, if you adjust his number for the lengths he lost at the start, he gets a strong figure, equal to the ones he ran later that made him competitive in graded stakes. Though he's coming off a layoff, there are lots of plusses here. He's run well fresh, run well on Poly and adds blinkers, a strong move for McPeek (see Trainer Profile). This colt is a strong contender even without improvement from his juvenile figures, and McPeek shows positive trainer intent by running here instead of the Rushaway. Strong Contender.
- 7 Halo's King Halo's Image Castanon 50-1 Has never run fast enough to threaten here.

"STAR DABBLER is without a doubt one of the best looking stallions that you will find anywhere. He was a brilliant racehorse whose career was cut short by an unfortunate injury but



not before he had proven himself at the very top levels of competition. STAR DABBLER is by leading sire SAINT BALLADO and out of a half-sister to the dam of champion sprinter and promising sire SPEIGHTSTOWN. Although we got started a bit late with him last year, he still received a very good book of mares that are now producing his first foals. 10 El Aleman Point Given Mojica 99-1 Way too slow to compete with these.

11 Turf War Dixie Union Husbands 5-1

Is another by Dixie Union and, after four starts on Poly, improved dramatically when switched to dirt. His last, also on dirt, was better than it looked, but it's tough to like him going back to Poly. Down the line there should be a chance to bet this horse at a price on dirt.

12 Medjool Monarchos M Baze 8-1

Bottom Line: Racecar Rhapsody looks like the right one, with Duke of de Buqe, Adriano, and maybe Cannonball usable in exotics.




