# **CURLIN EARNS A REST**

**Curlin** (Smart Strike) returned from his impressive win in Saturday's G1 Dubai World Cup in fine shape and has now earned a vacation. Trainer Steve Asmussen reported yesterday that the imposing chestnut was full of energy Sunday and will ship to New York Apr. 2 to clear quarantine at Belmont Park. The four-year-old is expected to ship to Keeneland Apr. 6. "From there,



we'll plan a course for the second half of the year," Asmussen said. "It will be decided collectively and based on what's in the best interest of the horse and his legacy." **Sun Classique** (Aus) (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}) will head to Hong Kong after her win in Saturday's G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. "She's absolutely fine," trainer Mike

Curlin Horsephotos DeKock said yesterday. "We will

probably go the Irridescence (SAf) route and take her to Sha Tin for the [Apr. 27 G1] Queen Elizabeth II Cup. She'll then spend the summer in the UK, with the rest of my string from Dubai, and we'll think about Royal Ascot, although that might be a big ask as we won't have much time. There are other races like the G1 Nassau S. and G2 Sun Chariot S. to consider, so we don't have to rush her." Also likely for the Queen Elizabeth is G1 Dubai Duty Free winner Jay Peg (SAf) (Camden Park). DeKock's Honour Devil (Arg) (Honour and Glory) won the G2 UAE Derby and could be headed to America. Trainer Rick Dutrow, Jr.'s two winners from the World Cup card also exited their races in fine shape and are scheduled to ship to New York Apr. 2. "We haven't thought of any long-range plans," said Dutrow assistant Michelle Nevin of G1 Golden Shaheen winner Benny the Bull (Lucky Lionel) and G2 Godolphin Mile winner Diamond Stripes (Notebook). "It's going to take [Dutrow] a couple of days to just calm down from all the excitement. He was just so happy."

# FINE WEEKEND FOR FUJI KISEKI

A day after his Australian-bred daughter Sun Classique (Aus) upset the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, the Sunday Silence stallion Fuji Kiseki (Jpn) was represented by a Group 1 exacta in Japan when Fine Grain (Jpn) (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}) captured yesterday's G1 Takamatsunomi Kinen at Chukyo. The in-form Fine Grain, rated in mid-pack, hooked up with Kinshasa No Kiseki (Jpn) (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}) as both horses mounted their rallies in the stretch. After a fierce duel in the final 100 meters, Fine Grain managed one final surge to take it at the wire. It was Fine Grain's first Group 1 victory and his third victory from three starts this term. Defending champion Suzuka Phoenix (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) stumbled at the break and was near the back of the pack early, but closed well to collect show honors. # DERBY HOPEFULS WORK AT CHURCHILL

A trio of Kentucky Derby hopefuls worked under the Twin Spires yesterday. Trainer David Carroll sent out Denis of Cork (Harlan's Holiday) and Blackberry Road (Gone West). Unbeaten Denis of Cork, aiming for the Apr. 5 GII Illinois Derby, went five furlongs in :59.40. It was the third fastest of 15 at the distance at Churchill Downs yesterday. "He's been on edge now for a little while and we just wanted him to go out there and stretch his legs this morning, and he did it beautifully," said Carroll. "We're very happy with him and now, hopefully, he'll run big in Illinois. We need to run big there." Julien Leparoux will ride Denis of Cork for the first time in the Illinois Derby. Blackberry Road, coming off a fourth-place effort in the GII Louisiana Derby, worked five furlongs in 1:01.60 ahead of his expected start in the Apr. 12 GII Arkansas Derby. "The Louisana Derby was a very hard race on him," Carroll said. "He was in the race from the get-go and got beat a length and a half for second. Pyro was definitely the best horse that day, but that's not our style of racing. The Arkansas Derby will be a full field and the draw will be a factor, but we feel it'll be a true-run race, a fast-run race." Also working yesterday at Churchill, My Pal Charlie (Indian Charlie) blitzed five furlongs in a bullet :58.20. The AI Stall, Jr. trainee, second in the Louisiana Derby, is also pointing towards the Arkansas Derby. "This was his major work two weeks out and he hadn't done anything in 22 days from the Louisiana Derby," said Stall. "He had a little breeze at the Fair Grounds, but this was his major work. He cooled out like he'd galloped and that's the most important thing."

Wood Workers...

Giant Moon (Giant's Causeway), looking to rebound from his first loss when a lackluster ninth in the Mar. 8 GIII Gotham S., breezed five furlongs in 1:01.09 at Belmont Park yesterday. "The horse won four in a row on dry tracks, and then he loses in the slop in the Gotham," said trainer Richard Schosberg. "So, we're not going to make rocket science out of this. We're just going to stay away from sloppy tracks." Giant Moon is expected to make his next start in Saturday's GI Wood Memorial S. "He's trained really well since the Gotham, but he really had to since he didn't even get a good workout in the Gotham," Schosberg explained. "He's all set for the Wood Memorial. Now, we need the weather to cooperate." Jorge Chavez will replace Ramon Dominguez aboard Giant Moon in the Wood. Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out two Wood nominees to work yesterday at Belmont Park. Gotham runner-up Texas Wildcatter (Monarchos) went a half mile in :49.92 and stablemate Spurrior (Dixieland Band) went five furlongs in a bullet 1:00.03.






