Adriano to Kentucky Derby...

Adriano (A.P. Indy), winner of the GII Lane's End S. at Turfway, is likely to make his next start in the May 3 Kentucky Derby after an impressive work at Churchill Sunday, according to trainer Graham Motion. "I'm pretty sure we're going to go for it after this, I don't know why we wouldn't," said Motion. In company with stablemate--stakes winner Longley--the chestnut, with Edgar Prado in the saddle, breezed a half mile in :50 flat over a fast track. "He went nice," said Prado. "He started nice and easy and he finished good. When I called on him, he was there. He galloped out really well and it seemed like he handled it very well." The colt recorded internal splits of :13, :25.40 and :37.80 before galloping out in 1:03.40. "He seemed to handle it fine," said Motion. "I don't think the time was real flashy, but to be honest, I really wasn't asking him to do that. [The track] was kind of cuppy. I'm guessing they didn't put a lot of water on it because of the rain, so it just looked like it was a little loose." The move was the 29th fastest of 42 at the distance, "Believe me, I want to win the Derby as much as anybody else does, but I don't think it's engraved in my mind that I've got to get there," Motion said. "I think when we analyze it and we talk with [owner Donald Adam] and with Edgar [Prado], I think it is the right thing to do at this point." Prado, who also rides GI Wood Memorial winner Tale of Ekati and Monba, victorious in Saturday's GI Blue Grass S., would need to make a decision within the next 24 hours whether he would stay with the Courtlandt homebred in the Derby. "He's got to make up his mind, and I don't want to miss out on getting somebody else," explained Motion. Prado added, "Hopefully, everything will work out well. We hope [Adriano] will come out of the work beautiful and we'll play it from there. We just hope we make the right choice."

Gayego Heads to Churchill Monday...

Gayego (Gilded Time), winner of Saturday's GII Arkansas Derby, will be flown to Louisville Monday morning to prepare for the Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs May 3. On the flight from Hot Springs to Lousiville, the dark bay will be accompanied by Z Fortune (Siphon {Brz}) and Tres Borrachos (Ecton Park), second and third-place finishers in the nine-furlong event. "[Gayego]'s doing well," Martin Morales, assistant trainer to Paulo Lobo, said vesterday. "He's ready for the next one."







High Rock set the seal on an afternoon of Classic trials with arguably the best performance of all with a mighty display in this French Derby prep. A first-up third at Deauville last August, he broke through in a Saint-Cloud maiden the following month and entered winter quarters with the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club on the agenda after a victory in the G3 Prix de Conde at this track in October. Jockey Christophe Lemaire earned his corn through the early fractions of this as High Rock fought for his head in keen fashion while positioned third behind a stop-start pace. Allowed an inch of rein rounding the home turn, he seized the initiative at the top of the stretch and powered ever clear in near-effortless fashion to secure a second pattern win by daylight. "The horse was keen today because he was very fresh as I hadn't given him too much preparatory work for this first run of the year," explained trainer Jean-Claude Rouget. "He has class and talent and proved it once again today. I'm sure his best trip will be at around a mile-and-a-quarter so we can now think about the Prix du Jockey-Club [at Chantilly June 1]."

Derby Plans for Blue Grass Finishers...

Monba (Maria's Mon) and Cowboy Cal (Giant's Causeway), first and second, respectively, in Saturday's GI Blue Grass S. at Keeneland, will remain in Lexington for the time being, according to trainer Todd Pletcher. "We're not in any huge rush," said Pletcher in regard to shipping the colts to Churchill Downs. "We'll see how they do here the next few days, and map out a plan." Kentucky Bear (Mr. Greeley), third in the Blue Grass, was full of energy and "bouncing off the walls," said Reade Baker's assistant Cassie Garcia Sunday morning. The colt will be sent to Churchill to prepare for the Derby, even though he may not have enough graded stakes earnings to make it into the Classic. Also heading to Louisville is beaten favortite Pyro (Pulpit), who ran 10th. "He is doing great," said Steve Asmussen's assistant Scott Blasi, Fifth-place finisher Visionaire (Grand Slam) will remain at Keeneland until about a week before the Derby and will have his final major work over the Churchill strip. A decision has yet to be made whether 11th-place Big Truck (Hook and Ladder) will make the trip to Churchill. "It's decision time," said Joe Rosalez, assistant to Barclay Tagg. "He came back fine, cooled out great, ate up his feed tub. He's a classy little horse." Making his way up North, Miner's Claim (Mineshaft), a troubled sixth, will be sent to Woodbine in Toronto and be aimed for a sophomore campaign this summer, possibly the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park or the GI Travers S. at Saratoga.




