

#### PROVISO NEARS RETURN

Khalid Abdullah's **Proviso (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) is set to make her sophomore bow in the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp Apr. 27. Last year's G3 Prix du Calvados winner and G1 Fillies' Mile runner-up will use the race as a prep for the G1 Prix de Diane (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 8. "Proviso is in great nick and coming along really well," the owner's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said of the TDN Rising Star" yesterday. "[Trainer] Andre [Fabre] is pleased with her and said she is really coming to herself. I think she'll go to the Prix Vanteaux and then we'll make a decision on her, but her main aim is the Prix de Diane."

#### Over to Him...

Khalid Abdullah's colors were carried to victory here by the great Dancing Brave in 1986 and, with the Sir Michael Stoute-trained Confront (GB) being rerouted to Saturday's G3 Greenham S. at Newbury, it is up to Twice Over (GB) (Observatory) to fly the flag in tomorrow's G3 Craven S. Unbeaten in two starts here in an October maiden and conditions event the following month, the homebred from the family of Passage of Time (GB) hails from Henry Cecil's stable. Having collected this prestigious trial with Lyphard's Wish (Fr) in 1979, Warren Place had to wait until 1994 to follow up with King's Theatre (Ire) and has not been represented since Painted Room was fifth seven years ago. "He's in good form and has pleased Henry," Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said yesterday. "He won nicely both times and is fairly unexposed. He's been going very well recently and everything he has done in his galloping has been straightforward. We are looking towards the Derby, but he's by a miler in Observatory, so the question is whether he'll stay a mile and a half. If he shows he's good enough here, we'll look at the 2000 Guineas."

# Triple Threats

#### Tomcito Drills at Keeneland...

In his final preparatory move in advance of Saturday's GII Coolmore Lexington S., Tomcito (Street Cry {Ire}) worked three furlongs out of the gate in :34.60 Tuesday morning at Keeneland. With rider Manfreddy Guzman, the two-time Peruvian Group 1 winner galloped out a half mile in :46.80, "He had worked out of the gate before his Grade 1 win at a mile and a guarter in Peru," said trainer Dante Zanelli. "He was close to the pace that day [Oct. 20] and won by [9 3/4 lengths]." With \$151,292 in earnings, the bay would need to hit the board Saturday to have a chance to get into the Derby lineup. "I think even if he finishes third [purse of \$32,500], I will be all right," added Zanelli. "I am not worried. I think I have the horse to beat. He is getting better and better and he was not even blowing [after the workl."



### ☆ TATTS BREEZE UP ☆

#### Pros and Con...

Rio de la Plata was sold from Con Marnane's Bansha House Stables, and the Co. Tipperary consignor--which has 23 catalogued this year--was flat out with viewers yesterday afternoon. "We've been very busy, although I'd hope to be, having sold two Group 1 winners at last year's sale. It's good to see the same old faces here" said Marnane, who felt that the turf in the later stages of the breeze was not suitable for all horses.

"It was very disappointing that the ground cut up later on and the American-bred horses just could not let themselves down on it," said Marnane. "I'd also be against letting people standing on the right hand side as they galloped, because it baulked the two-year-olds. When they see the people there, they were inclined to stop. Everyone should stand on the left, it's not fair on the consignors or buyers."

Marnane's team includes Lot  $\underline{97}$ , Benedicte (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), a half-brother to G1 Middle Park S. winner Amadeus Wolf (GB) (Mozart {Ire}), who cost 210,000gns as a yearling; Lot  $\underline{52}$ , an Arch colt who moved well; and Lot  $\underline{37}$ , a son of Cozzene, who strode out impressively.

Willie Browne's Mocklershill Stables was another with an eye-catching draft. Among them was Lot <u>189</u>, a Mr. Greeley filly; and Lot <u>160</u>, a Giant's Causeway colt who cost \$260,000 as a yearling.

Kip Elser's South Carolina-based Kirkwood Stables looks set for a good sale with several of his shining on the gallops. Standouts included Lot 34, named Madame Guillotine (Proud Citizen), who should show a good advance on her \$35,000 yearling cost; Lot 54, an Action this Day 3/4-brother to dual Group 1-winning sprinter Les Arcs (Arch); Lot 151, a Toccet filly; and Lot 168, a son of Mr. Greeley.


Locally based Emma O'Gorman also appears to have a strong team. These include Lot  $\underline{50}$ , a Danehill Dancer (Ire) colt, and the following Lot  $\underline{51}$ , an Irish-bred son of Indian Ridge (Ire).

Among the other smart workers was Lot <u>172</u>, a Danehill Dancer (Ire) colt consigned from Mark Dwyer's Oaks Farm Stables; Lot <u>184</u>, a son of Stroll offered by Jamie Railton; and Lot <u>135</u>, an Invincible Spirit (Ire) colt consigned from Norman Williamson's Oak Tree Farm.

"I think we saw some smart two-year-olds this morning," said Tattersalls Marketing Director Jimmy George yesterday. "The breeze was extremely well attended and things went very smoothly."



#### **SENSE OF JOY INJURED**

Khalid Abdullah's G3 Prestige S. winner **Sense of Joy (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) will miss the G1 1000 Guineas, it was announced yesterday. Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe broke the news of the John Gosden-trained **"TDN Rising Star" .** "She has sustained a soft tissue injury which will rule her out of the 1000 Guineas," he told the *Racing Post*. "Further investigations as to the extent of the injury are now being made."

#### WEATHER WATCH FOR NAHOODH

Trainer Mick Channon will be hoping that Newbury's ground does not turn soft as he prepares Jaber Abdullah's Nahoodh (Ire) (Clodovil {Ire}) for Saturday's G3 Fred Darling S. Last year's G2 Lowther S. winner will use the Dubai Duty Free-sponsored prep as a stepping stone to the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4. "Soft ground is a worry and most of my horses want top of the ground," he said. "She's a filly you need to understand, like a lot of Clodovils. Much will depend on what happens in the next few days, but I'm very keen to run her this week. She's very hairy in her coat, but when you give them a run it invariably flies off them."

#### **GREENHAM FOR CONFRONT**

Khalid Abdullah's **Confront (GB)** (Nayef) will drop back to seven furlongs for Saturday's G3 Greenham S., connections announced yesterday. Successful over a mile in an Ascot conditions event in October, the Sir Michael Stoute-trained homebred has pleased in his recent homework and will look to book his ticket to the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 3. "Physically, he's done exceptionally well and, although it's taken a while to hit his stride this year, the last three or four times I've watched him he seems to be getting there," the owner's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe commented. "He's from the family of Reams of Verse, so it's a Classic family."

#### **TOBA OFFERS SUPPORT TO THG:**

Thoroughbred Horseman's Group gained strong endorsement from the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association (TOBA) in its efforts to promote simulcasting through all account wagering companies and other outlets offering a fair contribution of revenue to horsemen and racetracks. "The Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association is in complete support of the goals of the THG to require fair pricing for advance deposit wagering companies," TOBA Chairman Bill Casner said after a meeting last week between THG leaders and the TOBA Board of Trustees. "The shift in wagering from on track to ADW has created the phenomena of 'handle up, purses down.' It is only reasonable to ask ADW companies that have no investment in bricks and mortar or horseflesh to pay their fair share to purses. Racetrack companies that own ADWs are obviously conflicted by the current pricing model. Racetrack ADWs can retain more revenue from an account wager and pay less to purse accounts than when the same bet is made at their track. This loophole must be closed. A more equitable pricing model will help to ensure the future of our industry." 


