GRAND OLD DUKE

Aidan O'Brien secured back-to-back renewals of the G1 Prix Ganay for Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor as Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill) battled to a game success in the Longchamp feature yesterday. Twelve months after Dylan Thomas (Ire) enjoyed the first of O'Brien's two conquests on the Bois de Boulogne, the colt who earned a 'nearly' tag during 2007 finally broke through at the top level under a positive ride from Johnny Murtagh. Committed at the guarter pole, the 4-1 second favorite had to dig in to repel the late threat of Saddex (GB) (Sadler's Wells), but responded to every call to record a half-length verdict. "He's a brave horse who deserved that after placing so many times at this level," O'Brien said. Cont. p2

AMERICAN SWEEP AT SHA TIN


A pair of American-bred runners captured two prestigious races Sunday afternoon at Sha Tin in Hong Kong. First, the local hero Good Ba Ba (Lear Fan) notched his fourth consecutive Group 1 event and stamped himself

as one of the favorites for Horse of the Year honors with a powerful victory in the G1 Champions Mile, His jockey, Olivier Doleuze, was effusive in praise of his mount, "It's hard to explain the feeling you get on the back of this horse," he said. "I've been lucky enough to ride some very good horses in my ca-

reer, but this one is something special. Winning today I felt that I was going into the history books; he's now surely the Horse of the Year." With the win, Good Ba Ba gets an automatic berth in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. One race later, Archipenko (Kingmambo) swooped to take the G1 Audemars Piguet QEII Cup. It was the first Group 1 tally for the four-year-old, who only joined trainer Mike de Kock's yard in December. "I know it might sound crazy after winning a Group 1 race, but I think he is still improving and he can go and win another one," de Kock said. "We'll be thinking about him in terms of Royal Ascot, but I'm not sure what race we will target there yet." Sha Tin Results, p2-3

Duke of Marmalade Takes Prix Ganay (cont. from p1)

Entering the G1 Prix Ganay, Duke of Marmalade boasted a sole win in a Curragh maiden in June 2006, but that failed to tell the whole story. Injured following his runner-up placing in the G2 Vintage S. at Good-

wood, he was a creditable fourth in both the G1 English and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas last May before finishing second in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot. Fourth after a refresher in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York in August, he ran Dylan Thomas to 1 1/2 lengths when second in Leopardstown's G1 Irish Champion S. before another honorable effort when third in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. back at Ascot the following

month. Ridden prominently on this comeback, the bay was allowed to find his own rhythm as Spirit One (Fr) (Anabaa Blue {GB}) was sent into a clear lead by halfway. Rolling by that rival with a quarter mile remaining, his main threat, Saddex, was steadily turned back as Murtagh resorted to mainly hand riding in the final 50 yards. "He has a wide range of possibilities open to him now, but the first one is obviously the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup [at The Curragh May 25]," O'Brien added. Zambezi Sun (GB) (Dansili {GB}), sent off the 2-1 favorite, traveled strongly stalking Duke of Marmalade but found disappointingly little when asked to quicken in the stretch. The winner's second dam, Lassie Lady, is a half to Broodmare of the Year Weekend Surprise, dam of A.P. Indy and Summer Squall. It is also the family of GI Kentucky Derby hopeful Court Vision. Archipenko opened 2007 with a win in the G2 Derby Trial S. at Leopardstown, but finished off the board in his next four outings. The bay colt turned it around when taking the Feb. 21 G2 Al Fahidi Fort at Nad Al Sheba, and he was coming off a third in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai Duty Free S. Rated in fifth through the opening exchanges here, he was revved up as they hit the straight and uncorked a strong late run that carried him to a decisive success. "He came out of the gates very well and then came back into my hands and settled nicely," jockey Kevin Shea said. "He's the kind of horse that prefers to have some daylight, so I was happier having no horse outside me. When I pulled him out in the straight, I gave him two cracks and he dropped down well and I knew it was going to take something special to beat us." Good Ba Ba made it five in a row and took his fourth in Group 1 company with this impressive victory. The six-year-old capped off 2007 with a win in the Dec. 9 Hong Kong Mile, then added the Jan. 20 Stewards' Cup and the Mar. 16 Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup. At the back of the pack early yesterday, the favorite shot to the front when asked and proved much the best. "We've always tried to keep something in the tank with this horse and not do too much with him," trainer Andreas Schutz said. "He's best when he's fresh, and I think he's getting better and better. Halfway down the stretch he was still on the bridle and I was worried that he'd get there too soon, but then in a couple of strides he was two lengths clear, and it was all over." As for the future, Schutz said, "We'll not make any hasty decisions...however, I think we are odds on to stay in Hong Kong, and a big price against us going to the Yasuda Kinen or the Breeders' Cup." While all the focus was on Proviso, it was Belle Allure who led home a shock exacta in this trial for the G1 Prix de Diane at Chantilly June 8. Off the mark at Deauville in August, the chestnut had failed to shine in better grade when fourth in the G3 Prix d'Aumale at Chantilly in September and ninth in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac here on Arc day. Switched off in rear early as Proviso made the running, she swung wide in the straight and swept by that rival and Wait and See with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before putting her seal on the contest in a matter of strides. "That wasn't such a surprise to me, as she needs to come from behind in a truly run race," trainer Rupert Pritchard-Gordon commented. "She had a slow pace in the d'Aumale, and when we tried to use her inside post position in the Marcel Boussac, we found out not to put her in the race too early. She needs time between her races, so ideally we'll wait for the Prix de Diane now." Stephane Pasquier reported that Proviso failed to pick up in the straight and may have been unsuited to making the running. Click for the Racing Post chart.

Juddmonte homebred Coastal Path continues to impress as a potential top-league staver and was not hard pressed to maintain his perfect tally on this fouryear-old bow. Returning to the scene of his biggest successes in the G3 Prix de Lutece in September and G2 Prix Chaudenay the following month, the bay traveled easily in mid-division while kept wide throughout the early stages. Making his move along the 'false straight,' he gathered in Orion Star passing the eighth pole before asserting for a comfortable score. "It's nice to see him keep his unbeaten record and he loves this good ground," the owner-breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said. "We think he's a horse for the [June 19] G1 Ascot Gold Cup, and he may have one more run beforehand in probably the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier [at this track May 18]." GI Santa Anita Derby winner Colonel John (Tiznow) proved he has no problem with conventional dirt, turning in a sparkling five-furlong work at Churchill Downs yesterday in :57.80. The move was the best of 62 at the distance for the colt, who has raced and trained

almost exclusively on synthetic tracks. "I'm happy with the way he did it," trainer Eoin Harty said. "He did it within himself and that's what I liked. That track was fast today; maybe faster than it should be. But everyone else was working fast, so that's R Palmer part of my thinking. And [exercise rider Karine Lhuillier] wasn't

pushing on him." Harty is not concerned about how Colonel John will handle the surface change. "Dirt is not an issue," the conditioner asserted. "I thought he handled it well today.

He trained on dirt as a two-year-old and he handled it well then. I've been confident in him in that regard all along." Clockers caught the WinStar Farm homebred in fractions of :12, :23.20, :34.60 and :46. He galloped out in 1:11.20. The second-fastest five-furlong move was turned in by the speedy filly and Derby contender Eight Belles (Unbridled's Song) (:58.20) and the third fastest was recorded by GI Kentucky Oaks hopeful Proud Spell (Proud Citizen) (:58.40). Colonel John had been expected to work Monday, but the drill was moved up in the face of forecasted heavy rains Sunday night in Louisville.

Motion Happy With Adriano's Work

Trainer Graham Motion's Adriano (A.P. Indy) had his final serious work for Saturday's Kentucky Derby, going five furlongs in company at Churchill yesterday in 1:00.80. Regular exercise rider Xavier Azipuru was aboard for the work, accomplished through fractions of :12.20, :24.40 and :36.60. Adriano galloped out six furlongs in 1:14.40. "Xavier worked him all winter on dirt and turf," Motion said after the drill. "He said he worked as good or better than he's worked all year. I caught him in :24 or maybe a little bit better for the last quarter, and I was pleased with that. I wanted to see him finish up like that."

"Court Vision went well," Mott said after training hours. "He worked good and cooled out very quickly. He only took one deep breath and everything's looking pretty good." Mott was also pleased with his other Derby hopeful. "Z Humor is doing equally well," the trainer said. "He had a good work this morning, finished up well and looked smooth doing it. Anytime you have a horse on the improve, anything can happen."



CHRB Making Racing/Training Contingency Plans:

The California Horse Racing Board heard from industry representatives about possible contingency plans being developed for stabling, training and racing in California should Bay Meadows and Hollywood Park cease to operate. During Thursday's board meeting, CHRB Chairman Richard Shapiro called for the organization to become active in creating contingencies. Shapiro added he would be scheduling a meeting of the Strategic Planning Committee within three weeks. Southern California racing is threatened by the possible development of Hollywood Park and track president Jack Liebau is unable to commit to racing at the Inglewood oval beyond this year. Among ideas put forward by industry leaders at the meeting should Hollywood Park close is the expansion of Fairplex for year-round stabling and training. Other stabling options include the expanded use of Del Mar and San Luis Rey Downs. In Northern California, threatened by the expected closing of Bay Meadows, the Pleasanton fairgrounds may be expanded to accomodate year-round stabling, training and additional racing dates. Golden Gate Fields is also likely to offer expanded racing.

COX TAKES TOPPER AT CLASSIC SALE Vin Cox, who maintains he achieved value-for-money purchasing eight yearlings at an average A\$294,375 at the Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, struck again at the Inglis Classic Sale, securing the first session sale-topper on Sunday afternoon. The Sydney-based bloodstock agent went to A\$90,000 for a colt by Beautiful Crown, offered as Lot 110 by Emirates Park Stud. Cox echoed the views of many when he said, "It is a good solid sale for the right horse, but...the pedigree rarely matched the individual. [That] is pretty good money for a Beautiful Crown, who stood last year at A\$15,000, but the money is there for the right horse and [this colt] is an example. He is a lovely, big, strong colt and I have had a lot of luck with Beautiful Crown." The Chief's Crown stallion stands at Alanbridge, a farm soon to be rebranded Patinack. Cox had previously purchased the stakes-placed Beautiful Crown filly Chaud Roche (Aus), who has earned almost A\$200,000, as well as SP Cigar Royale (Aus) and sophomore Weekend in Paris (Aus), who was fourth in the Listed Gimcrack S. at two. Despite activity by a wide range of local and interstate trainers, as well as buyers from Hong Kong, New Zealand, South Africa and Singapore, the average for the first session was A\$29,273, compared with A\$43,926 last year. A total of 88 horses changed hands for A\$2,576,000, with two horses being knocked down to online bidders. The sale continues from 11 a.m. Monday, with a third session starting at the same time Tuesday.
