Neither post 20 nor history could stop him. Big Brown (Boundary) was 2-1 in the GI Kentucky Derby on the strength of just three sparkling wins, the fewest



any had sported since Regret in 1915. Despite a wide trip, he assumed command at the head of the lane and opened up impressively. "When he turned for home, we knew the game was over, and we were all going crazy," exalted winning trainer Rick trackphotographer.com Dutrow Jr. Eight Belles (Unbridled's Song) ran bravely to be a clear second,

but broke down in both forelegs while galloping out and was euthanized. Cont. p2

Susan Magnier's Henrythenavigator (Kingmambo) hadn't been out since finishing third to New Approach (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) in the G2 Futurity S. in August, but proved resolute in the final yards of yesterday's G1 2000

Guineas at Newmarket to hand that rival his first defeat. "The race worked well for me and he really answered the call," said winning rider Johnny Murtagh, who piloted Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) to victory in 2002. "He





#### PARK EXPRESS

David and Patricia Thompson's Cheveley Park Stud will be double-fisted in today's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Before the highly impressive G3 Nell Gwyn S. success of Infallible (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), they already had a major player in the unbeaten G2 May Hill S. winner Spacious (GB) (Nayef). "Jimmy [Fortune] was mightily impressed with Infallible and we really don't know much about her as no real buttons have been pushed," the Stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson said. "Spacious has strengthened up over the winter, has a lovely stride and covers plenty of ground, so she would probably favor top of the ground." Cont. p5-6





#### Kentucky Derby cont. Express Delivery...

Big Brown's connections were allotted the 16th selection during Wednesday's draw and boldly opted to take post 20. The unbeaten colt came away from his stands' side spot and brushed a bit with **Gayego** (Gilded Time) to his inside, but settled kindly for jockey Kent Desormeaux despite being in the five path. **Bob Black Jack** (Stormy Jack), equipped with blinkers for the first

time, made a beeline for the lead and showed the way through splits of :23.30 and :47.04 while being shadowed by **Cowboy Cal** (Giant's Causeway). Meanwhile, the GI Florida Derby winner raced alongside

the ill-fated filly before Desormeaux let out a notch approaching the far turn. The Hall of Fame rider received an instantaneous response and found clear sailing while five wide turning for home. He entered the stretch in complete command and further asserted his authority in the final furlong, giving his pilot a third Kentucky Derby trophy. "We were dreaming this would happen," Desormeaux said. "There were no distractions, no alterations in course; he just slid on over. He did it well within himself. He was truly in a gallop to the quarter pole, and he added power to his stride when I needed it. I didn't know if I had horse down the backside--he was off the bridle, just cruising along with his ears flopping, and I just left him alone 'til I needed him. When I needed him, I showed him the stick and

whoosh." Big Brown joins recent unbeaten Derby winners Barbaro (2006) and Smarty Jones (2004), while being the first to break from post 20 since Clyde Van Deusen in 1929. Big Brown, owned by IEAH Stable, Paul Pompa Jr., Gary Tolchin and Andrew Cohen, will put his unbeaten record on the line in the GI

Preakness S. May 17, but Dutrow may not exude as much enthusiasm in the second jewel of the Triple Crown as he did prior to the Derby. But it's early days yet. "This next race coming up is out of my hands," he said. "We're coming back in two weeks and I won't have a chance to train him. He looks like the best horse in his crop, but there will be new shooters...I don't think I'll feel as confident for the Preakness as I did for the Derby. I love training a horse for a race, but I can't do that now. My hands are tied."

#### Eight Belles Euthanized After Post-Race Injury...

Fox Hill Farms' Eight Belles raced in fifth in the early stages before moving forward on the far turn. She entered the stretch in second and, while never threatening the winner, came home a clear runner-up. However,

tragedy struck when the rangy grey filly was galloping out. "She had finished the race and was around the turn at the start of the back stretch, and right near one of the the outriders, as he was watching, he saw both front ankles collapse," reported Dr. Larry Bramlage. "It's obvious that she has condylar fractures on the left side, and the left front went through the skin and was contami-

nated. At least one of the sesamoids [in her right leg] was broken. I have never seen this happen, and there was nothing you could do." A \$375,000 KEESEP purchase, the daughter of Away (Dixieland Band) had rattled off four straight victories this season against her own sex, including the GIII Honeybee S. Mar. 16 and GII Fantasy S. Apr. 6 at Oaklawn. The \$400,000 runner-up purse took her posthumous career record to 10-5-3-1 and \$708,650. Fox Hill and trainer Larry Jones also finished second last year with Hard Spun.



## Kentucky Derby cont. 'Denis' Rides the Bo-Rail...

Hey, if it worked last year, why change? Jockey Calvin Borel gave 2007 hero Street Sense his patented rail-skimming ride and, after **Denis of Cork** (Harlan's Holiday) didn't get away very quickly from post 13, angled the blaze-faced bay over to the inside. He caboosed the field through the opening six furlongs before picking up the pace heading into the far turn. After weaving his way through some traffic, Denis of Cork went back to the rail and finished up well to claim third, 2 3/4 lengths ahead of **Tale of Ekati** (Tale of the Cat) in fourth. "He ran a huge race," said Borel. "We saved every inch of ground we could just to get there. I think he ran a huge race. The colt tried his heart out, and I can't take nothing away from him."

#### 'Colonel' Can't Get It Done...

The 9-2 second choice **Colonel John** (Tiznow), well behind early, looked to be making a menacing move on the far turn, but failed to sustain that bid and wound up sixth. "Turning for home we were in the right spot to come and get them, but you'll see in the replay that my horse took a funny step, switched leads and I could never get him going again from that point forward," reported rider Corey Nakatani.

While Henrythenavigator's success in the G2 Coventry S. came over six furlongs at Royal Ascot in June, the manner of that performance and his pedigree suggested a step up in trip would not pose a problem. Kept at six panels for The Curragh's G1 Phoenix S. in August, he succumbed to G1 1000 Guineas hopeful Saoirse Abu on heavy ground, and encountered similar conditions when failing to make a serious impact on New Approach in the G2 Futurity S. over a furlong further back there the following month. He was returning to a sound surface here, but stamina doubts remained, and they were due for a thorough examination as soon as Manning took favored New Approach to the lead from the outset.

Buried towards the rear at first, Henrythenavigator came through betwen rivals as the trailblazer set sail before the dip, and his acceleration got him alongside passing the eighth pole. With that rival showing his customary tenacity as his unbeaten record slipped away, the bay colt had to draw on his stamina reserves and there was just enough in the tank. "We were happy with him at home, but it was his first run and all of our horses have been improving a lot for it," trainer Aidan O'Brien said after greeting his fifth winner. "He was entitled to get tired at the end, and will improve. We thought the world of him last year and he was always exceptional--he was only three or four lengths off New Approach on heavy ground last summer, so on good ground we were very hopeful. Our worry was whether he was a sprinter, as he was showing so much speed, and he is obviously unique to have that natural speed and get a mile." Derbies appear out of the equation, according to O'Brien. "With that kind of speed, they would never go fast enough over a mile and a half to let him switch off the way he likes to," he added. "It would be wrong to go that route with him and he doesn't need to, so we'll look at the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas [at The Curragh May 24] next and then the G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 17]."

#### Same Approach...

Jim Bolger was taking defeat on the chin and is looking to the rematch in Kildare. "I'm happy with him. It would have been lovely to win, but he ran a fantastic race anyway. Everything went very well and they are two very good horses. The Irish Guineas will be next."

#### Gale Warning...

Following the news that Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's G3 Fred Darling S. heroine Muthabara may not make the gig following a late setback, this mile Classic takes on an even more open feel. That could encourage support for Laureldean Gale, who represents the Godolphin stable successful with Cape Verdi (Ire) in 1998 and Kazzia (Ger) four years later. Like the former, she was trained by Peter Chapple-Hyam at two and looked a leading Classic contender after finishing a halflength second to Proviso (GB), with Lady Deauville a further six lengths back in third in Deauville's G3 Prix du Calvados Aug. 18. Her first run in the royal blue proved an anti-climax when she paid for her antics in the preliminaries and flopped in eighth in Longchamp's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac Oct. 7. Connections are hoping to avoid a repeat today. "She boiled over before her last race at Longchamp and we've spent the winter trying to settle her down," Racing Manager Simon Crisford said. "We've done lots of paddock schooling at Nad Al Sheba, so we hope she'll be on her best behaviour. She does get herself wound up, but if she's calm in the preparade and when she's saddled, we've got a chance of seeing her at her best."

#### Here, Kitty Kitty...

While last year's G1 Fillies' Mile winner and winterbook favorite Listen (Ire) has been sidelined, the Coolmore operation still have two live chances in Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's G3 Park Express S. runner-up Savethisdanceforme and Diane Nagle and Magnier's G2 Rockfel S. winner Kitty Matcham. The latter had Royal Confidence back in third when annexing the G2 Rockfel S. on Champions' Day, and that seven-furlong contest was used by connections of the last two Guineas heroines Speciosa (Ire) and Finsceal Beo (Ire). "The two fillies are well and Savethisdanceforme has had the experience of a run this year," O'Brien said. "She is a big, rangy filly, while Kitty Matcham is very much like her dad. She is lovelybalanced, compact, strong and tough, and has the attitude that the 'Rock' had."

#### Lucky Jim...

Jim Bolger has a couple of livewires to chase a second consecutive success following the record-setting exploits of Finsceal Beo 12 months ago. Saoirse Abu has already tasted success at this level on two occasions when winning The Curragh's prestigious Phoenix S. and Moyglare Stud S. last summer, while Lush Lashes (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) captured the Goffs Fillies Million at that venue on her debut Sept. 15. While neither set the world alight when third in the Apr. 6 G3 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial and seventh in the G3 Park Express S., respectively, they will be better tuned for this prize.



# Be part of Cologne Race Club's 111 Years Jubilee Race Meeting in 2008

The Cologne Race Club in Germany will be celebrating its 111th year anniversary in 2008. For this special reason, the race meeting on **September 28** with the Group I Preis von Europa and the Group II Grosse Europa-Meile will be extended to a further eight races with a total purse of **111.000 Euro** for each race. The races are the following:

Listed race for 2-y-o fillies over	1500 m
Listed race for 2-y-o horses over	1600 m
Listed race for 3-y-o+ horses over	1300 m
Listed race for 3-y-o+ fillies and mares over	1600 m
Race of Handicap Class II standard for 3-y-o+ horses over	1600 m
Race of Handicap Class II standard for 3-y-o+ horses over	2200 m
Race of Handicap Class III standard for 3-y-o+ horses over	1600 m
Race of Handicap Class III standard for 3-y-o+ horses over	2200 m

The total purse of 111.000 Euro per race will be divided up in the following way: 60.000 – 25.000 – 12.000 – 7.100 – 3.200 – 3.200

- Closing date for the eight races: Tuesday, May 6th. The entry at that point is valid for any race.
- The selection of a race for the horse entered has to made by the trainer at the regular closing date on September 16th with dual entries still being possible at that date. This is also the time when the scales and weights are determined.
- A late entry is not possible. The entry fee on the closing date May 6th is 1.600,

  – Euros with 800,

  – Euros being deducted at that date and the second rate of again 800,

  – being due on June 3rd.
- 4. There will be a further fee of 1.600,- Euros due on declaration day.
- 5. Foreign runners are also eligible for the handicap races, their rating abroad will be conveyed to the German GAG system. A handicap of class II will be equivalent to a rating between 67 and 90, a handicap of class III will be equivalent to a rating between 56 and 70 according to the British handicap scale.
- 6. In the case of a necessary qualifying in accordance with paragraph no. 434 of the Rules Of Racing (declaration of runners exceeding the highest number allowed) the horses taken out of the race will be provided with substitute races. The purse for these substitute races which will only be held with a minimum of 8 runners is dependant on the number of actual runners and will amount to at least 30.000.— Euros.

A close fourth to English Channel in the 2006 renewal of this contest, the dark brown horse captured the GII Mervin Muniz Jr. Memorial H. at Fair Grounds last spring before finishing seventh--beaten three lengths--in the 2007 running of this affair. He lost his rider avoiding a fallen rival in the GII Dixie S. on the Preakness undercard last May and was sidelined the remainder of the year. Einstein returned a winner in an optional claimer on the Gulfstream lawn Jan. 11 before finishing sixth on the main track in the GI Donn H. Feb. 2. He bounced back to land the GI Gulfstream Park Turf S. three weeks later and chased home Kip Deville to be second in his latest, the GI Maker's Mark Mile Apr. 11 at Keeneland. The crowd's choice here, Einstein settled into an easy rhythm in third as Thorn Song (Unbridled's Song) showed the way in the early stages. Jockey Robby Albarado popped the question on the far turn and the six-year-old responded by gaining command at the head of the lane. Out of Control looked as though he might have Einstein's measure, but the other Brazilian-bred lost momentum when switching leads, and couldn't reel in the winner. "This year he's just double game," Albarado commented. "He does things easily. He's willing and able out there. He wants to be close to the pace and get them that way rather than coming in the back door. He's giving himself a better chance to do well." When asked about the next start for the son of 1985 Kentucky Derby hero Spend a Buck, trainer Helen Pitts said. "We'll just see how he comes out of it. The [GI] Arlington Million [Aug. 9] would be an ultimate goal, but I think he needs a break now." 
#### On to New York for Proud Spell?

CHELOKEE TO UNDERGO SURGERY Four-yearold Chelokee (Cherokee Run), who was injured during Friday's GIII Alysheba S. at Churchill, was resting comfortably at Lexington's Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital Saturday morning. The colt is scheduled to undergo surgery next week, but Dr. Larry Bramlage, the on-call veterinarian for the American Association of Equine Practitioners said his chances of recovery are just 50-50. "He tore the ligaments in the bottom of his [right front] ankle," Bramlage explained. "The bones that went up the side of the leg that they thought [were fractured] were actually sesamoid bones pulled five centimeters out of place. They're dislocated. Amazingly...they didn't go through the skin. Almost all the support [structure] went, but he was able to stay up. It's incredible that he didn't do more damage than he did." Despite the severity of the injury, Bramlage said that Chelokee had an excellent attitude yesterday. "We actually had to put a traffic cone in his stall because he needed something to play with," the veterinarian remarked. "He was trying to pull his IV line out of the ceiling." As for when exactly the surgery will take place, Bramlage said, "We don't know that until after I see the soft tissue early in the week."




