BIG DEAL

Unbeaten **Big Brown** (Boundary) will go postward as a heavy favorite in today's GI Preakness S. at Pimlico. A sparkling and authoritative winner of the GI Kentucky Derby two weeks ago, the big bay still has to cover the 1 3/16 miles faster than his 11 rivals in order to keep his date with destiny. He'll break from midfield this

time, as opposed to his outside-post scores in the Kentucky and Florida Derbies. "It's all about the break for us," said trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. "If he breaks clean, things will be right there for him. If he wants the lead or wants to sit off it, whatever." Dutrow added, "I think that it's our

race to lose. I think that he is the best horse in the race and I think if he breaks with the field, he'll win the

race." Only one Churchill rival has turned up to face the Derby winner, and that is **Gayego** (Gilded Time), the GI Arkansas Derby hero who wound up 17th after encountering traffic problems early. The dark bay will be equipped with blinkers this time.

"They're very light blinkers-- they're just to see if he pays attention a little bit more," said trainer Paolo Lobo. "I have been thinking since January about putting blinkers on him. He was doing well and running well, so I didn't want to change for the Kentucky Derby. But now he's going to run with blinkers." Cont. p2

The lightly raced **Kentucky Bear** (Mr. Greeley) missed drawing into the Run for the Roses due to insufficient earnings, but he's been at Pimlico for more than a week in preparation for the Preakness. A sharp maiden winner at Gulfstream ([video](#)), the chestnut was a troubled seventh in the GII Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 24, but rebounded with a good third in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland Apr. 12. Trainer Reade Baker likes his colt's chances. "From the Blue Grass, he's really developed and put on

weight," said Baker. "There's no grass to graze on in Florida, and once he got to the grass at Keeneland and Churchill the horse has been doing phenomenal."

Behindatthebar Scratched...

Behindatthebar (Forest Wildcat) was scratched yesterday morning after sustaining a foot bruise. "The way he went this morning, he was a little bit off on his left front," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "It appears that he's got a foot bruise in the inside corner of his left front hoof. It's unfortunate timing." The GII Coolmore Lexington S. victor shouldn't miss too much time. "I would expect that it could possibly be resolved by the beginning of next week," Pletcher added. "Sometimes foot abscesses or bruises can be tricky, but hopefully that won't be the case and it will be quickly resolved."

Geordieland had gained a reputation as a loveable
rogue, despite his creditable record, due to his squan-
dering of seemingly winnable opportunities. After being
second to Yeats (Ire) in both the 2006 G2 Goodwood
Cup and last year's G1 Ascot Gold Cup, the grey disap-
pointed when fifth in the 2007 Goodwood marathon,
and followed that with another runner-up placing in the
G2 Doncaster Cup in September. Time was called on
his season when he managed to get turned over at 1-4
in a conditions event at Pontefract the following month,
but the freshener worked wonders as he produced one
of his finest efforts here to claim the prize his ability
warranted. Switched off in customary fashion in rear as
Royal and Regal led through moderate fractions, he had
gifted that rival an apparently safe cushion inside the
final quarter, but rewarded Shane Kelly's impeccable
timing to snatch victory in the final stride. "If anything, I
probably got there a bit too soon, but for a stayer he's
got plenty of speed and gets into his races extremely
easily," Kelly said.

Aidan O'Brien, who unleashed an invigorated Hawk Wing in this race five years ago, saddles a formidable duo in **Haradasun** and Derrick Smith, Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's **Astronomer Royal**. The latter failed to build on his half-length defeat of Creachadoir in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains last May and a third in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot the following month, but has had a long break since his no-show in Keeneland's GI Shadwell Turf Mile in October.

Haradasun, who is owned by a syndicate including Frank Tagg and Coolmore, rattled up a brace of Group 1 wins at Randwick last year and continued to hold his own at that level, finishing third in the G1 Cox Plate at Moonee Valley in October. Disappointing when down the field in the G1 Mackinnon S. at Flemington the following month, he comes here off the back of some impressive homework. Cheveley Park Stud have enjoyed five successes here and rely on the gelding **Cesare**, who could hardly have been more impressive when taking the Listed Paradise S. at Ascot last time Apr. 30. Successful in the G2 Summer Mile S. there last July, he is up to this standard, but has to prove he is more than just an Ascot specialist. Peter Chapple-Hyam saddles a trio in John Fretwell's Listed Doncaster Mile winner **Medicine Path**, Ziad Galadari's G3 Phoenix Sprint S. scorer **Al Qasi** and Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's G2 Lennox S. winner **Tariq**. The latter, who tries this level again after a latest fifth in the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp on Arc weekend, has pleased his trainer in his preparation. "I am very happy with Tariq--he has been working very nicely," Chapple-Hyam commented. "He is in good form and I think he will get a mile--the trip should suit him. He handles all ground, so there are no worries there."

FLORIDA OUTLETS GET PREAKNESS SIGNAL

An agreement was reached late Thursday which will allow the signal from Pimlico Race Course to be distributed to patrons at Calder Race Course in Miami, as well as other inter-track wagering (ITW) facilities in the state, for the Friday and Saturday programs. In response to the ongoing dispute between the Florida horsemen and Calder, the Maryland Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association (MTHA) has not allowed the export of the signal from the Maryland Jockey Club to Florida since the beginning of the Calder meet in late April. But an agreement regarding the two Pimlico cards was reached when Churchill Downs Inc., parent company of Calder, agreed to escrow all revenue from the two days. "While this agreement doesn't solve the overall horsemen's disputes, and only allows the Maryland signal to Calder and the Florida ITWs for two days, we believe it is important to our Calder customers and the racing fans throughout Florida to be able to wager on the Preakness and the entire Pimlico cards on Friday and Saturday," said Steve Sexton, executive vice president of CDI. "Fortunately, this agreement comes in time to notify our Florida customers that they can wager on and enjoy these important races. We look forward to an enthusiastic crowd at Calder for two great days of racing." Alan Foreman, general counsel for the MTHA, explained the rationale behind the decision to release the signal. "This is one of the biggest weekends of racing year after year and we just wanted to find away to get the races to our fans in Florida," Foreman said. "Hopefully this will spur further discussions between the parties and the problem can be solved."

Rasmussen Poll Indicates Majority Oppose Racing Ban:

According to a survey conducted by the Rasmussen Reports, an electronic publishing firm specializing in public opinion polls, and Fox Television Stations Inc., just 10 percent of U.S. adults believe horse racing should be banned. The poll was conducted following the May 3 GI Kentucky Derby. Seventeen percent oppose a ban, and 17 percent are undecided. Fourteen percent of the women polled, but just seven percent of the men, thought the sport should be abolished. Broken down by political parties, 85 percent of Republicans, but only 66 percent of Democrats, were against a ban. The results of the poll were released by the National Thoroughbred Racing Association.

North American Catalogues to Denote Foreign Earnings:

Beginning next month, North American sales catalogues will present foreign earnings in native currency, followed by a total earnings line converted to U.S. dollars, the North American members of the Society of International Thoroughbred Auctioneers announced Friday. The change, which will take effect with the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's June Sale of Two-Year-Olds and Horses of Racing Age, applies to earnings from countries assigned "Part I" status in the International Catalogue Standards book for time periods that The Jockey Club Information Systems has detailed start-by-start information. "Reporting earnings in native currency from these Part I countries and providing total earnings in U.S. dollars will give buyers and consignors a more detailed assessment of a Thoroughbred's accomplishments, given the global appeal of the domestic auction market and the significant difference in value between the U.S. dollar and many foreign currencies," SITA Chairman Norman Casse said. Part I countries for which TJCIS has detailed start-by-start information are Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, France, Germany, Great Britain, Ireland, Italy, Japan and the United Arab Emirates.

Dogwood Dominion Award Noms Being Accepted:

Nominations for the 2008 Dogwood Dominion Award are now being accepted. In its 16th year, the award honors an individual who has had a positive effect on the Thoroughbred racing or breeding community in which he or she works. It was created in 1993 by Dogwood President Cot Campbell, who named it for the stable's MSW and British champion sire Dominion. The deadline for nominations is June 23.
