(Boundary) galloped to an easy victory in Saturday's GI Preakness S. at Pimlico, and trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. is already thinking about that blanket of white carnations awaiting him in three weeks. "It doesn't look like he got down on his belly today, so he should have enough left to get the job done," Dutrow said during the NBC telecast. Kent Desormeaux took a look in the rearview mirror as he

raced down the lane, saw nothing there, and gathered the reins to leave something in the tank for the June 7 GI Belmont S. The colt will be retired to stud at Three Chimneys at the end of the year (see story, p2).



After blowing out a quarter in:25.20 on an empty track yesterday morning, he was sent off the 1-5 chalk at Pimlico.
Kent Desormeaux had his hands full as he rated the powerful colt just off the early leaders, then angled him off the rail as they raced down

the backstretch. The big bay eased up alongside **Gayego** (Gilded Time) and **Riley Tucker** (Harlan's Holiday) on the turn, switched leads when they straightened for home and took off. His rider had him in hand for the final sixteenth of a mile. 

Rick Dutrow Jr. continued. "It might work out that I blow him out the same as I did [yesterday] morning, but he'll just get one breeze." Co-owner Paul Pompa Jr. is confident that the budding superstar will be up to

the pressure. "He doesn't even work up a sweat," Pompa said during an HRTV interview. "He doesn't turn a hair." But how will his connections handle the three weeks til the Belmont S.? "It's been emotionally draining so far, but we're excited," he admitted. "We have a lot of people behind us. He's become the people's horse, and we're just riding the wave."

Big Brown to Three Chimneys...

IEAH Stables, Paul Pompa Jr., Gary Tolchin and Andrew Cohen's unbeaten dual Classic winner Big Brown (Boundary--Mien, by Nureyev) will head to stud at Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky, upon the completion of his racing career, it was announced prior to his dominating win in the Preakness. Financial terms haven't been disclosed. "Three Chimneys is thrilled to have the privilege to stand a horse of Big Brown's caliber," said Robert Clay, owner of Three Chimneys Farm. "Having won every race he's won with such ease, I don't think we've actually seen what he's truly capable of." Bred in Kentucky by Monticule, IEAH Stables acquired a majority interest in Big Brown following his impressive Saratoga debut last September. "We have entertained a variety of flattering offers but felt Three Chimneys was the best choice for us," said Michael lavarone, co-president of IEAH. "We were determined to participate in his breeding career and the Three Chimneys deal has given us this opportunity. We are very excited to partner with the likes of Three Chimneys and will be afforded the opportunity to stand this brilliant colt alongside the likes of Smarty Jones and Dynaformer in the breeding capital of the world." Big Brown was purchased by Eddie Woods for \$60,000 as a FTKOCT yearling, then by Hidden Brook, agent for Pompa, for \$190,000 as a KEEAPR juvenile.

The runner-up in the 2007 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, Creachadoir earned a well-deserved break after running sixth in the G1 St James's Palace S. in June. Sold to Godolphin before his win in the Oct. 6 G3 Joel S. at Newmarket, he ran a commendable fourth in the Oct. 20 G1 Champion S. at the Rowley Mile track and closed 2007 with a second in the Dec. 9 G1 Hong Kong Mile. Lining up for this off an eighth in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai Duty Free, he broke best, but settled in the wake of leader Rob Roy (Lear Fan) as the entire field drifted towards the stands' side rail. Angled off the fence to challenge at the quarter-mile marker, he seized the lead soon after and was ridden out late to comfortably hold the closing pack. "He's a tremendously strong character and is up for a fight, which is what separates the good ones from the average ones," said Frankie Dettori.

Cowgirls Don't Cry was three-for-five as a juvenile, including a stakes victory at Ellis Park, but was sidelined for more than 18 months after earning that black type. The chestnut filly finally resurfaced in an optional claimer going six furlongs at Aqueduct Feb. 14, winning by an impressive 5 3/4 lengths, but she was eased when trying her luck at nine panels in the Mar. 29 GIII Next Move H. Let go at 14-1 in the seven-furlong GII Bed o'Roses H. at the Big A Apr. 19, the four-year-old improved to be third; she was overlooked at 10-1 this time. Jockey Mike Luzzi sent Cowgirls Don't Cry right to the front, where she carved out a half in :47.67 and six furlongs in 1:12.55. Favored Rite Moment looked poised to take command as they came out of the turn, but she was floated wide and lost ground. The crowd's choice went after the leader once she was straightened away, but Cowgirls Don't Cry had left her behind and went on to win handily despite some awkward strides in the final furlong. Off the board in his first three starts, Pays To Dream was turned into a turf horse last spring and reeled off three straight wins against fellow New York-breds. The bay remained competitive when moved into open company, taking the Glow S. at Saratoga and running third in the Sept. 2 GIII Saranac S. at the Spa and the Oct. 6 GII Jamaica H., but he stumbled and lost his rider in the Oct. 24 Rutgers S. at Monmouth. Four-for-six last year, Roshani earned her first stakes victory in the GIII Taylor Made Matchmaker S. at Monmouth in August, but disappeared after finishing third in the Sept. 28 GIII Violet S. at the Meadowlands. The dark bay proved ready to run after a five-month layoff, capturing an optional claimer on the turf at Santa Anita Mar. 9. She had a short lead at midstretch in her latest, the Apr. 12 GII Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland, but weakened late and had to settle for fourth, just a half-length behind winner Rutherienne. The crowd's choice to raise her strike rate over the .500 mark, Roshani shadowed the pace as they slogged along through a half in :50.28. The five-year-old drove between horses to take over after six panels in 1:15.09, edged clear at the eighth pole and held on despite drifting out to deny the late surge of Lady Digby. Jeremy Rose, aboard the runner-up, lodged an objection alleging interference during the stretch drive, but the claim was disallowed. "Down the stretch, I wanted to feel somebody right next to me, because she got to the lead and started completely looking at the crowd and started to slow down," said jockey John Velazquez. He was overmatched when trying the all-weather in the Apr. 5 GI Santa Anita Derby, but Polonius rebounded from that experience with a determined score here. I knew he had handled it before and I had no question in my mind that he would handle it again today. I do believe if they had gone around again, they still wouldn't have got him." 




