#### Big Brown Exits Preakness in Good Order...

Unfazed by his facile victory in the GI Preakness S., **Big Brown** (Boundary) was on the muscle as he walked the Pimlico shedrow yesterday morning, and trainer

Rick Dutrow Jr. was feeling good about his chances in the June 7 GI Belmont S. "If he comes out of it good, trains good, I don't see a problem," said Dutrow. "It looks like he's ready." The conditioner did not see the distance of the final jewel in the Triple Crown as an obstacle. "He's not an aggressive-type horse where he wants to run off with the jock early on," he continued. "He'll do whatever Kent [Desormeaux] wants him to do at the time. He just falls

into the race. That's going to help him get a mile and a half." Big Brown becomes the fourth horse to exit the GI Kentucky Derby and the Preakness with his perfect record intact. The other three were Majestic Prince, second to Arts and Letters in the 1969 Belmont; Seattle Slew, who completed the sweep in 1977; and Smarty Jones, who got caught in the final yards of the 2004 "Test of the Champion" by Birdstone. "Everybody wants to see something great," Dutrow said. "Maybe we're going to see that. That'd be a lot of fun. Everybody's going to find out where he belongs. If he wins his next race, he's going to be up there with any good horse that's ever run. When everybody's talking about him, he'd be in the same breath as Secretariat, Affirmed, all those good ones." *Cont. p2*

#### **SAGE TIME**

The Longchamp crowd expected trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre to be triumphant in yesterday's G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp, but the identity of his winner was something of a surprise. Victory was considered more likely for 4-5 favorite Darjina (Fr) (Zamindar), but 11-1 chance Sageburg (Ire) (Johannesburg) collared that stable star inside the final furlong to score by 2 1/2 lengths at the Bois de Boulogne track. "He had come on a lot for his last run and we had done plenty of schooling with him because he has a tendency to be nervous," the trainer explained. *Cont. p2* 



#### On to the Belmont?

Icabad Crane (Jump Start), third in the Preakness at 22-1, could take on Big Brown once again in the \$1-million Belmont. "I think it's definitely a possibility," trainer Graham Motion said. "Obviously, we want to see how he is, but I think [jockey Jeremy Rose] feels that the distance is not an issue with him. I think with a cleaner trip [Saturday], there was a good shot that we would have been a good second. With that in mind, we might pursue it." Motion was pleased with the way his charge came out of the race. "He seems absolutely fine, no problems," he said. "His eyes are a little swollen just from getting a lot of dirt in his face, but he seems well and quite perky, really." Motion added, "Because he's so laid-back about everything, [racing] doesn't seem to knock him out quite like it might another horse. He just takes it in his stride. He obviously ran hard and he's tired, but he seems fine." Trainer Dallas Stewart has not yet decided where Preakness runner-up Macho Again (Macho Uno) will go next. "We really haven't given it a hard thought yet," Stewart said. "We've got three weeks to think about it. You've got to make sure everything is right with the horse and the horse is doing good. And our horse ran back in three weeks [after his win in the Derby Trial]. We'll get him back on the track and see how he does."

#### Overnight Ratings...


NBC's coverage of the Preakness earned a 5.1 national rating and a 12 share in the overnights, down 6 percent from last year. The prerace programming received a 3.5 rating and a 9 share, off 15 percent from 2007, while the broadcast of the race (5:45-6:45 p.m.) produced a 6.2 rating and 14 share, down just three percent from a year ago. The 133rd running of the race drew a crowd of 112,222, fifth-largest in Preakness history. It was the eighth consecutive year the on-site attendance exceeded 100,000.

#### Sageburg Takes Prix d'Ispahan (cont. from p1)

Trained by Andre Fabre at the start of his career, Sageburg (Ire) (Johannesburg) didn't see a racecourse until June in his sophomore season, but made up for lost time by taking a nine-furlong conditions event at Chantilly on debut and a similar event at this track the following month. The grey stepped into listed company with a facile victory in the Prix Ridgway at Deauville in July, but could manage only fourth in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp in September. He returned for the G2 Prix Dollar in October, but endured a troubled trip and ran fifth, although he was subsequently promoted to fourth following a stewards' enquiry. Making his debut for Alain de Royer-Dupre in the Apr. 27 G1 Prix Ganay, he finished a creditable third, and benefitted from a drop in trip to register a personal best in this. Settled in third as Turfrose (Ger) (Big Shuffle) set honest early fractions, Sageburg was asked to stretch once straightening for home. He took over from Darjina (Fr) (Zamindar) while under a drive 150 yards from the wire and was allowed to coast home late. A trip to the Royal meeting might now be in the cards, according to de Royer-Dupre. "When the time came to make entries for Royal Ascot, I was not quite sure what his best trip would be, so I only put him in the [June 18 G1] Prince of Wales's S., but we will see in time what our plans will be," he said. Of the runner-up he added, "I gave [Darjina] a long break after Dubai and, as she is very lazy at home, she might have needed the race. Looking at her in the paddock beforehand, it looked like she was carrying a bit too much condition. I think we ought to keep her at a mile, so there is a good possibility she will go to Royal Ascot for the [June 17 G1] Queen Anne S." Belle et Celebre ran fourth in a debutantes event at this track last October and improved to finish second behind Albisola (Montjeu {Ire}) in her season closer at Fontainebleau the following month. She came back to run second at Saint-Cloud Apr. 22, and benefitted from an enterprising ride by Christophe Lemaire to break her maiden in this stakes bow. The win initiated an afternoon Group 1 double for trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre, and also completed a banner weekend for breeders Gilles and Aliette Forien after this filly's half-brother Appel Au Maitre (Fr) secured victory in Saturday evening's Listed Walter Nilsens Minnelop at Ovrevoll in Norway. Sent to the front after an early dawdle, Belle et Celebre maintained control until pushed along when pressed in early stretch.

It looked like she might be overcome by the closing pack, but she would not be denied and rallied bravely under a drive to hold on. "I wasn't certain to run her earlier in the week because she was still a maiden, but the owner was keen to go and it proved the right choice," admitted de Royer-Dupre. "I asked Christophe Lemaire to observe how she behaved on the way to post and judge if she was relaxed enough to go on the lead. He did a superb job and, quite often here, when you get first run you can last to the line. If she comes out of this well, she will return in the G1 Prix de Diane [at Chantilly June 8]." Saddex fulfilled the promise of a one-time fourth in the G1 Deutsches Derby by lifting the G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne in his four-year-old debut and followed up with a victory in the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly last June. He claimed a personal best in the Aug. 12 G1 Rheinland-Pokal at Cologne next time and emerged with credit by finishing sixth in the Oct. 7 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. His exotic campaign closed with an 11th in the Nov. 25 G1 Japan Cup and he came back this term to finish second in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp Apr. 27. Unaffected by one false start here, Saddex was reserved off the pace in seventh soon after the break and was urged closer at the top of the long straight. He set his sights on Pressing when moving into second with 400 meters to run and kept on strongly under a drive to oust that rival in the shades of the post. Successful in a newcomers' event at Clairefontaine last July, Coastal Path doubled up at Deauville the following month before bagging the G3 Prix du Lutece in his first visit to this track in September. Two Step Salsa debuted with a 3/4-length victory over Santa Anita's Cushion track Jan. 20 and added an allowance win over that oval second-time out Mar. 7. Switched to Hollywood's turf course, the dark bay colt was a solid second in the Apr. 25 Harry Henson S. last

time out. Two Step Salsa jumped out to the early lead and opened a clear advantage through a quarter in :22.60 and a half in :44.66. He was challenged on the turn by Salute the Sarge (Forest Wildcat) and Dixie Chatter, but asserted control in upper stretch as those two rivals faltered and skipped clear an easy winner as Afleet Ruler closed well for second. For winning rider Martin Pedroza, the only

Salsa came at the start. "Coming out of the gate, if you watch the head-on, I clipped heels with the two-horse [Rapidity (GB) (Mind Games {GB})], his left leg with my right leg," Pedroza explained. "He kind of sat down for a minute and I had to ask him to get going. Once I got to the front, he was just galloping, just cruising. When I saw that horse come to me, I just chirped to him and he was gone." Salute the Sarge tired to fifth. "That was the game plan, to let him break and let [Two Step Salsa] go and see if we could run him down," explained Michael Baze, aboard the beaten favorite. "That horse just kept going along and I think it just broke my horse's heart. My horse was sitting real comfortable, but when they asked the winner, he just re-broke. When a horse takes off in front of you, it's hard to build up your confidence and keep hanging on." 
