Henrythenavigator was obvious 🗘 "TDN Rising first time of asking at Gowran Park in May and made the necessary step forward to take the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot the following month. While deep ground at this venue provided excuses when he was subsequently runner-up in the G1 Phoenix S. in August and third to New Approach in the G2 Futurity S. in September, he nonetheless entered the May 3 G1 2000 Guineas with a question mark against his level of ability. That was quickly dispelled with an impressive turn of acceleration to cut down last year's champion and, while he needed a measure of courage to finish the task there, his raw speed was enough to settle the rematch in no uncertain terms. Always traveling easily in third as New Approach adopted his customary front-running tactics, he was in front in a matter of strides when switched out and had no difficulties throughout the final 150 yards. "Johnny [Murtagh] is naturally confident, but this week he said that he would win without coming off the bridle and how right he was," O'Brien added. "He is very relaxed and has a change of gear, so all the options are open to him. He is still in the [June 7] G1 Epsom Derby and everyone knows what a special race that is, but the boss and Sue will make that decision." Jim Bolger, trainer of the runner-up, was disappointed that the race was staged on ground which was changed officially to firm before racing. He told PA Sport, "I think it is unfair that we didn't have proper Guineas ground. There was no need to have firm ground, and he was leaning left all the time. He will come back here for the [June 29] G1 Irish Derby if the ground is good."

Imagine (Ire) provided Aidan O'Brien with the first of his two editions seven years ago, and her third foal is here to bid for a repeat of history. Like that luminary, Diane Nagle and Susan Magnier's **Kitty Matcham (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) boasts group-winning form at two and has even upstaged her at this point by going one better and winning the G2 Rockfel S. at Newmarket in October. Her return at that track saw her finish an encouraging ninth in the 1000 Guineas, the form of which has already been boosted by the success of also-ran Lush Lashes (GB) in York's G3 Musidora S.

In smashing the existing track record by over a second, Fleeting Spirit set some of her own headlines on a day of high-class sport. At the top of the tree at two over five and six furlongs, she showed blinding speed to win the G3 Molecomb S. at Goodwood in July and Doncaster's G2 Flying Childers S. in September either side of a third placing in the G2 Lowther S. at York in August. Only the subsequent G1 1000 Guineas heroine Natagora (Fr) could stop her in the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket in October and she had reportedly made further progress during her winter vacation. Despite breaking awkwardly from the stalls, the bay was ridden with confidence off the fast early fractions. When the button was pushed, there was nothing that could match her burst up the centre of the track which succumbed the warring duo Borderlescott and Desert Lord against the far rail. Slow pace? No problem. Mauralakana was her usual unhurried self as Herboriste tried to take it all the way, but when Kent Desormeaux pressed the button at the top of the stretch, the neatly made bay accelerated smartly past her rival to win by daylight as the favorite. Astronomer Royal, who had Creachadoir (Ire) and Excellent Art (GB) behind when winning the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp last May, proved that was no fluke when third in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot the following month. But from there he was fourth in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly in July, seventh in the G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp in September and sixth in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland in October, and connections decided on a return to sprinting after his disappointing effort when trailing in Newbury's G1 Lockinge S. seven days previously. Racing behind the early speed under Colm O'Donoghue, the bay was switched wide as the action unfolded inside the final guarter and reeled in Abraham Lincoln in the waning strides. "He has a lot of natural speed and sprinting is what he wants to do," Aidan O'Brien commented. "He won a French Guineas, but it was all speed that he did it with, and the pace of sprinting will really suit him. Kept mainly to sprints last term, Grecian Dancer was third in the G3 Phoenix Sprint S. here in August and started off her latest campaign with a first stakes success in Deauville's Listed Prix Miss Satamixa Jan. 3. Subsequently off the board in both the Apr. 13 G3 Gladness S. and May 5 G3 Athasi S. at this track, the mare signed off in style with a dramatically improved performance here. Held up towards the rear early, the bay arrived pulling double out wide and, when she swept to the front at the furlong marker, the contest was settled. "She did it well and I am totally stunned, as she worked quite average last week," trainer Charles O'Brien explained. "We decided to give her one more go, but I might just pull the plug now." BOARD RECLASSIFIES STEROIDS; TOUGHENS

PENALTIES In an effort to eliminate the race-day use of anabolic steroids in race horses in the state, the California Horse Racing Board acted Tuesday to reclassify the medications and stiffen penalties for violations. Testing will begin July 1. "This is an easy one," said CHRB Chairman Richard B. Shapiro. "Anabolic steroids have no place in competition sports, including horse racing. Period! End!" To satisfy the 45-day public notice requirement, the new classifications will be posted immediately, and there will be a public hearing at Del Mar July 17. A larger regulatory package of penalties and classification changes, which has been making its way through the regulatory process, is expected to be enacted in time for the Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita Park Oct. 24-25. The Board previously had banned all steroid use, with the exception of very low levels of boldenone, stanozolol, nandrolone and testoserone. Under the new classifications, a positive for any of these substances would result in disgualification, purse redistribution and a minimum 30-day suspension for a first offense. Additional measures adopted by the CHRB to protect the integrity of racing have included:

- Increasingly extensive pre-race examinations of all horses entered to run.
- Increased scrutiny of horses as they make their way to the gate.
- Improved racing surfaces.
- State-of-the-art drug testing at the Board's primary laboratory.
- A necrospy program that generates information used to prevent catastrophic injuries to horses.

Shapiro indicated that the effort to ensure the welfare of horses and riders would continue. "In the future, we'll be looking at inbreeding and some of the other possible contributors we might consider as adding to the frailty of racehorses today," he added. LEAR'S PRINCESS INJURED West Point Thoroughbreds' Lear's Princess (Lear Fan), who defeated champion Rags to Riches in the GI Gazelle S. last year, has suffered an ankle injury and will be sidelined. Tenth as the favorite in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, the bay filly is winless in three starts this season, including a third-place finish to Ginger Punch in the GII Louisville S. May 2. "She came out of her race at Churchill with some heat and inflammation in her left ankle, so we're sending her to Dr. [William] Baker at the Woodford Veterinary Clinic," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin told *Daily Racing Form*, adding that he hopes the filly will return in "30, 60, or 180 days." Also a stakes winner on the turf, Lear's Princess has a record of 10-4-3-1 and earnings of \$491,870. HORSEMEN COUNTERSUE CDI The Kentucky division of the Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association (KHBPA) upped the ante in their ongoing dispute with Churchill Downs Inc. (CDI) over accountwagering revenues, filing a suit against CDI in federal court Friday. Filed in response to the legal action taken by CDI against the horsemen, the KHBPA's suit claims that Churchill is in violation of their current contract, and that the stand-off is costing millions of dollars in purses. KHBPA has also asked the court to reverse the 20-percent purse cut that was enacted by CDI May 14. According to Daily Racing Form, the Kentucky horsemen are insisting that bets placed through Churchill's ADW platform TwinSpires.com result in the same percentage of money deposited in the purse account as the bets placed on track. Due to the dispute, ADW companies have not been able to take wagers on Churchill races since the meet opened Apr. 26.


