BIG BROWN BATTLING OUARTER CRACK


Rick Dutrow Jr. reported yesterday that GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness winner Big Brown (Boundary)

has developed a "slight" quarter crack on the inside of his front left hoof, but the trainer remains confident the colt will be ready to run in the June 7 GI Belmont S. Dutrow said he first noticed the problem Friday. "We didn't know until Saturday that it was a quarter crack," Dutrow said. "It scares us this happened, but this has nothing to do with his ability to finish what he started. He's going to be OK." Big Brown is

being treated by hoof specialist Ian McKinlay. "This is a very, very minor crack," McKinlay said. "We will put a set of wires in and patch it up." The three-year-old has been walking the shedrow twice a day and is expected to return to the track Thursday. "I am sure he will be 100 percent," Dutrow said. "If we get to breeze him Tuesday of Belmont week, or even Wednesday, we can live with that. Monday would be great, as long as lan can get it done the right way." But IEAH Stables' principal Michael lavarone, interviewed by TVG yesterday, assured, "If anything goes the wrong way, we won't take any chances."

Heaven Can't Wait...

Halfway to Heaven is the fourth foal from Trevor Stewart's stellar sprinter Cassandra Go, but proved she stayed seven panels when runner-up on debut at

Leopardstown at the end of October. She went one better over the same track and trip six days later. Returning to finish a head second to Carribean Sunset in the Apr. 6 G3 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial S., the gunmetal grey tackled the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches May 11 and, while no match for the brilliant Zarkava (Ire), was a creditable third. Always traveling well in a stalking third behind the yard's rabbits

yesterday, Halfway to Heaven moved up to take over before the quarter pole, where she was immediately challenged by Mad About You. She was briefly headed by that rival inside the final furlong, but saw her off in the final 50 yards and held on as Tuscan Evening and Carribean Sunset closed four abreast. Aidan O'Brien was ebullient. "She ran a great race in France, where she led into the straight before dropping back into fifth and then staying on to be third, so we thought the stiff mile here would suit her better," O'Brien said. He added that the filly is among the Ballydoyle entries for the June 6 G1 Epsom Oaks, but is unlikely to target that Classic. "Halfway to Heaven wants a strong-run mile, and I'm not sure she would get much further, so we'll have a look at the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 20]," he remarked. It was Tuscan Evening who got closest at the line, but she was judged to have interfered with Carribean Sunset, and was demoted to fourth. Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed Al Maktoum's new acquisition Nahoodh (Ire) (Clodovil {Ire}), sent off the 3-1 favorite, never made an impact and trailed in seventh. Transferred to Rick Dutrow Jr. after finishing off the board in her last two starts of 2007, Looky Yonder returned after a seven-month layoff to be third in a Gulfstream allowance Jan. 9. The dark bay beat an allowance field handily Feb. 27, but looked awkward during the early strides of the Apr. 9 GII Vinery Madison S. at Keeneland and faded to 10th. She bounced back with a victory in an optional claimer over a sloppy Belmont strip May 9, and was 9-1 facing GISW Dream Rush here. Looky Yonder trailed the field after a slight stumble at the start and was well back as odds-on Dream Rush cut out a half in :45.22 on a clear lead. The early fractions took something out of the favorite, however, and jockey Garrett Gomez was relentless in pursuit, sending Looky Yonder up the inside in the final yards to post the upset. 

This contest has been used by Coolmore as a vital stepping stone in recent years for the chief older horses among their brigade, and Duke of Marmalade duly followed where Montjeu (Ire), Black Sam Bellamy (Ire), Powerscourt (GB) and Hurricane Run (Ire) had led with an ultimately comfortable success. Injured during his juvenile season, the bay was brought back for a fruitful but frustrating sophomore campaign, where his consistency was not rewarded with big-race triumph. Instead he played second fiddle to stable companions Excellent Art (GB) and Dylan Thomas (Ire) in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot in June and Leopardstown's G1 Irish Champion S. in September, respectively. When he lined up for Longchamp's G1 Prix Ganay Apr. 27, the sole win on his resume remained in a maiden at this venue, but he overcame soft ground and the top-class pair Saddex (GB) and Sageburg (Ire)--both have subsequently won Group 1 races--to turn the corner there. Aidan O'Brien revealed afterwards that some work by the vets during the winter had made the difference, and any lingering problems would have been exposed both by this fast surface and the formidable presence of Finsceal Beo. It was the latter who posed the biggest threat when he had usurped the aggressively ridden Red Rock Canyon passing the quarter pole, but, after receiving some cracks with the whip, was only handridden in the closing stages to suppress her threat. "He only gives what he has to and is solid, tough and consistent," O'Brien commented. "He is special and wants an even pace, which he got, and we'll go for the G1 Prince of Wales's S. Unaware that GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness winner Big Brown was temporarily sidelined by yet another quarter crack, GII Peter Pan S. winner **Casino Drive** (Mineshaft) stretched his legs over the Belmont Park main track yesterday morning.

"He cantered six furlongs this morning, and he looked very good," said Nobutaka Tada, the racing manager for owner Hidetoshi Yamamoto. "He seems to be doing very well right now. He's a very quiet, professional and happy horse. He knows what he supposed to do. He seems to like it here at Belmont. He has settled in very well since he arrived and he knows what it's all about."

Tada said that media attention has not yet become a distraction.

"It seems like there are a few more people coming around the barn to see him, horsemen and visitors," he remarked. "As for people from Japan, I would expect they will come in the week of the Belmont, because the Japanese Derby is this upcoming Sunday. It's still pretty quiet at the moment."

The chestnut will have a workout this week.

"We are planning to breeze him on Wednesday, maybe five furlongs or longer, depending on how fast we go," Tada said. "He is a really good horse, so we are going to just do some light breezing."

'Henry' Derby Debate Continues...

Susan Magnier's **Henrythenavigator** (Kingmambo) was reported to have come out of Saturday's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas with no problems, and his connections are pondering a tilt at the June 7 G1 Epsom Derby. Following his second defeat of New Approach (Ire) in Saturday's Curragh Classic, the homebred is under serious consideration for the mile-and-a-half Blue Riband. "He came out of the race fine very well and we're very happy with him," Aidan O'Brien said yesterday, before John Magnier explained that the decision would be made after discussions with all the key figures. "Ultimately, it'll be John Halley, Aidan, Johnny Murtagh and all the lads who'll get together and decide," Magnier told PA Sport. "They'll give me their opinions, and we'll see after that. I don't decide, but if you ask me what I'd like to do I'd say that Epsom is where everything is decided. When the horse was bred, he was bred to go there--he's by Kingmambo and out of a Sadler's Wells mare. We've taken horses to Epsom before who shouldn't have gone there and they've run well, but we've also taken horses there who we thought would run well, and they haven't."

'Approach' Fine after Second Eclipse...

Princess Haya of Jordan's New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) was given a clean bill of health by trainer Jim Bolger following his runner-up effort in Saturday's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh. Having followed home Henrythenavigator as he had done in the May 3 G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, the chestnut will now be stepped up in trip. "He was out this morning for a hack canter; he was fresh and well and was moving well," Bolger told PA Sport. "We got away with it yesterday, but I wouldn't risk him on that ground again. I'm not sure how much it's affected my happiness, but it's not the sort of ground we should have had on Guineas Day. If we don't get good ground for the [June 29] G1 Irish Derby then he won't be turning up." The Curragh's Manager Paul Hensey reacted to the issue of the firm going which was prevalent over the Guineas weekend. "It was a difficult one and, in hindsight, we could have put more water on on Tuesday," Hensey explained. "We did water throughout the week, but we didn't get the rain the rest of the country got, and what killed us was the bright and dry weather yesterday. When the wind blows here, it has a hairdryer effect, and no amount of watering is going to keep that at bay. It was very quick everywhere on Saturday."

Ran well in group races in Argentina, but while we don't make figures for Argentina, we have to believe none of his efforts there would were better than his only race in this country. That still leaves him needing to improve a lot here.

3 Divine Park Chester House 5-2

Is five-for-seven lifetime, and had excuses in the two losses--he tried shipping to California in the dead of winter for one, and broke through the gate before the other. His race two back was big, and his last even bigger--maybe too big. If he can do it again, he's a likely winner, but he may have finally hit a level that causes a bounce, especially with less than four weeks rest.

4 Z Humor Distorted Humor 8-1

Gets weight here as a three-year-old running against older, but he would need to be getting around 30 pounds from the highweights to become relevant.

5 First Defence Unbridled's Song 5-1

Presumably has soundness issues, since he's a fouryear-old with only eight lifetime starts, but when he makes it to the gate, he runs his race. In his second start this season he could be ready to take it to a new level, but he starts out slower than some of these, and we note that Frankel has not been doing as well as usual recently.

6 Kiss the Kid Lemon Drop Kid 15-1

Has improved with age and is very versatile, handling grass, slop and fast tracks well. On his best, he could pick up a check here, but he hasn't previously run well off layoffs, and this may just be a tune up for longer races.

7 Council Member Seattle Slew 30-1 Has an ouchy pattern, and has never run fast enough to contend with these.

8 Commentator Distorted Humor 6-5

Has the classic sheet of the unsound horse: lots of blank space on the page, and his best races coming off layoffs. In his good ones, he's as fast as any horse in training, and he's fresh now. But he's also seven years old, and has only been able to fire his best shot once a year for the last three years. Since he already threw his best in January, it's tough to know if he's still sound enough to do it again this year.

Premium Wine Prime Timber 8-1

Got good over the summer last year, and broke through last time with the best race of his life. Obviously, he could bounce, but with a very healthy overall pattern and only two points of development since August, he may still be within himself. With seven weeks rest, we think there is a good chance he will pair that last one up, which puts him in this, at a price.

Bottom Line: The Race Shape shows us that Commenator and First Defence should be well clear of the others early, creating gaps for the others to drop into with the long run to the turn. Commentator and Divine Park are the best horses here, but neither is a sure thing to run his race. Premium Wine looks like the value, and we'll protect by playing him under the other two in exotics.
