BIG BROWN GALLOPS WITH NEW WIRES

Triple Crown hopeful **Big Brown** (Boundary) galloped at Belmont Park Saturday morning after having a new set of stainless steel wires applied to his left front hoof.

According to IEAH Stables Co-President Michael lavarone, the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. hero will have an acrylic and fiberglass patch placed on his hoof Monday and will work Tuesday. "We have time and we want to keep the patch off as long as possible to let the crack heal naturally," lavarone commented. Ian Mc-Kinlay is pleased with Big Brown's progress. "The little spot up top just keeps getting harder and harder," McKinlay said. "By Monday it should be in fabulous shape. There's no

sense in taking any chances. The only thing that can go wrong is rushing. If we don't rush it, we're good." Confirmed to line up against Big Brown in the June 7 GI Belmont S. are Anak Nakal (Victory Gallop), Casino Drive (Mineshaft), Denis of Cork (Harlan's Holiday), Icabad Crane (Jump Start), Macho Again (Macho Uno), Tale of Ekati (Tale of the Cat) and Tomcito (Street Cry {Ire}). Ready's Echo (More Than Ready) and Da' Tara (Tiznow) are listed as possibles.

THE LEADING 'LADY

She was pinched back at the start, but it didn't matter. Unbeaten **TDN Rising Star Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) picked off her rivals on the far turn

after trailing in fifth through a half mile in :48.19 and accelerated away smartly from Santa Teresita (Lemon Drop Kid) to take the GII Milady H. by 2 1/2 lengths at Hollywood Park yesterday. "Amazing, all I can say is just amazing," jockey Mike Smith said. "I'm telling you...I'm beside myself, I





don't even know what to say. There's no word in my vocabulary to describe her. She was squeezed at the start and I just didn't want her to fall. I knew if she stayed up she was going to be tough to beat. On the turn I just wanted to get her running because she's so big. She just galloped, man." Cont. p6



A ROCK AND A HARD PLACE

Jean-Claude Rouget's quest for that elusive first Classic winner continues, and it is up to High Rock (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) to end the voodoo for the Pau stable in today's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly. For jockey Christophe-Patrice Lemaire, a retainer with Rouget meant surrendering the ride on his darling Natagora (Fr) (Divine Light {Jpn}), but he could hardly have a better sweetener in Robert Bousquet's impressive G3 Prix la Force winner. Rather than the six-length winning margin, it was the manner of his success in that Apr. 13 Longchamp prep which caused a stir, having pulled hard for the majority of the race before opening up with a potent surge. Lemaire is brimming with confidence, but has the grey filly at the back of his mind. Cont. p2-3.

"His last race was very good," Lemaire told *PA Sport*. "He was fresh and showed a very good turn of foot and won brilliantly. I think he will come to the race in very good form. He is full of ability, and we expect him to


run a very good race. Of course, Natagora will be a big danger and she has the best form in the race. I think the trip won't be a problem for her, but the only

Andre Fabre has captured this prize only once, but with arguably the best winner in recent times in Peintre Celebre 11 years ago. He has a strong team of three this time, headed by Sean Mulryan, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's G1 Criterium International scorer Thewayyouare (Kingmambo). His other contenders are Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Democrate (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}) and Wertheimer et Frere's Prospect Wells (Fr) (Sadler's Wells). Both Democrate and Prospect Wells were breaking their maidens in their respective trials, and the former holds Mme. Daniel

Smooth Air made his 11th-place finish in the GI Kentucky Derby a distant memory with a smart tally here. The bay splashed his way home to a one-length victory in the GII Hutcheson S. Jan. 5, then placed third in his route debut in the Sam F. Davis S. Feb. 16. He completed the exacta behind Big Brown in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 29, but could only finish within 21 lengths of the Triple Crown hopeful last time on the first Saturday in May. With regular rider Manoel Cruz in the irons this time, Smooth Jazz stayed close to the pacesetting Celtic Meal (Formal Dinner) through fractions of :22.52 and :46.34. Floated wide at the top of the stretch after Cherokee Artist gained the lead, Smooth Air took over from that one in the lane and won going away. Heatseeker just keeps on rolling since joining the Jerry Hollendorfer barn. He closed out 2007 with a 30-1 upset victory in the GIII Native Diver H. Dec. 8, then finished third in the GII San Pasqual H. Jan. 12. The handsome chestnut finished second, beaten a head to Well Armed in the GII San Antonio H. Feb. 9 and followed with a career high, getting the job done in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 1. Shipped to Arkansas for the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 5, he came up a head short when second to Tiago, but had no problem turning the tables on that foe here. Breaking from the one hole, Heatseeker fought it out with Surf Cat from the git-go, rattling off fractions of :24.72, :48.15 and 1:11.68. Given his cue on the turn for home, Heatseeker exploded down the lane and left little doubt about the outcome, lowering his own track record. "I wanted to come from behind, but nobody wanted to go to the lead," jockey Rafael Bejarano said. "My horse broke really sharp and he got comfortable real fast. We were going really slow early and he was able to take advantage of the slow pace. I thought I had Surf Cat measured because I had a lot of gas left when we got to the turn. He was really running. It was like he re-broke at the eighth pole."

Zenyatta obtained **O "TDN Rising Star" O** status following a breathtaking Hollywood maiden win on Thanksgiving and continues to amaze. She stretched to two turns without a blink, adding an allowance at the Inglewood, California racetrack Dec. 15. Making her stakes bow in the Jan. 13 GII El Encino S. at Santa Anita, the Moss colorbearer rallied to a 1 3/4-length tally. Freshened following that victory, Zenyatta proved she can handle the dirt as well, posting her most impressive win in the GI Apple Blossom H. Apr. 5. The dark bay made it look like another walk in the park at Hollywood in yesterday's Milady. "She's special," trainer John Shirreffs said. "She was lucky because she got really squeezed coming out of the gate and Mike [Smith] was saying he just closed his eyes and hoped she didn't clip heels. She picked up her feet and got over it alright. She's breaking better and is a little lighter on her feet." Shirreffs said Zenyatta will target the GI Vanity H. at Hollywood July 5.




