Regarding his charge's weight assignment, the conditioner added, "It's quite substantial to be giving 10 to 15 pounds to this quality of older horses. How much is enough? Weight matters, and how much

matters. Everything has a point where it's not worth it." Curlin has made one previous start at Churchill Downs, crossing the wire third in last year's GI Kentucky Derby.

#### VERMEILLE CONFIRMED FOR ZARKAVA

Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre yesterday ended speculation as to where His Highness the Aga Khan's unbeaten Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) will run next when committing to the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp. Despite initial reluctance to tackle the 1 1/2-mile contest before her ultimate goal of the Oct. 5 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, connections of the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and G1 Prix de Diane have opted for the Sept. 14 race instead of Deauville's G3 Prix de la Nonette over 10 furlongs Aug. 24. "I think going for the Prix de la Nonette would not be a good decision, because there have been many times at the end of the Deauville meeting when the ground has not been very good," her conditioner said.

#### YEATS HEADS CUP LIST

Susan Magnier and Diane Nagle's Yeats (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) yesterday headed a field of 15 stayers remaining in Thursday's G1 Ascot Gold Cup. Successful in 2006 and 2007, the homebred seven-year-old may be joined by stable companions Septimus (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and Honolulu (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the 2 1/2-mile feature, which could also include Khalid Abdullah's unbeaten four-year-old Coastal Path (GB) (Halling) from the Andre Fabre barn. Mountgrange Stud's G2 Yorkshire Cup winner Geordieland (Fr) (Johann Quatz (Fr)) and Rennstall Gestut Hachtsee's G1 Prix du Cadran scorer Le Miracle (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}), second and third 12 months ago, respectively, look set for a return, while Godolphin have left in the G1 St Leger fourth Regal Flush (GB) (Sakhee) and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe third Sagara (Sadler's Wells). Rookie trainer Simon Callaghan is hoping that Edward Kirtland's Finalmente (GB) (Kahyasi {Ire}), winner of the G2 Henry II S. May 29, can improve on his fourth to Yeats (Ire) last year. "Everything is going to plan and we'll head for the Gold Cup with Mick Kinane set to ride," Callaghan told PA Sport yesterday. "Obviously we are very hopeful, although, as ever, it'll be an extremely competitive race with the French horse and Yeats in there. They will both be tough nuts to crack, but we feel our horse has progressed from his win at Sandown and I think he's getting better."

#### Rain Hits Ascot...

Ascot's Clerk of the Course Chris Stickels was yesterday counting the cost of heavy rainfall at the Berkshire venue. "We were expecting five to six millimetres of rain, but got 11 overnight and the going is good, with good-to-soft places," he explained. "I'd be happy with that at the moment as it removes the necessity to water at this time. Ideally, we look to produce a mixture of good and good-to-firm going."



NYCOTB TAKEN OVER BY NY STATE New York State Governor David Paterson announced vesterday that the state is assuming control of New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation. The deal came just two days ahead of a shutdown of all OTBs threatened by New York City Mayor Michael Bloomberg. Encompassing some 60 locations throughout the city's five boroughs, NYCOTB handles just over \$1 billion in wagers on an annual basis. The agreement in place calls for the state to take over NYCOTB over the next 90 days, and a board to be filled by Paterson appointees is to be created. The takeout on all bets will increase by one percent. Other financial details were not disclosed, though Paterson assured the operation will become profitable through structural changes. Bloomberg had indicated that he would shut down the OTBs June 15, citing the company's inability to operate in the black. Under a proposed plan by the Mayor which, among other things called for a change in the way NYCOTB shared revenues with other entities, the New York Racing Association stood to lose \$13 million. The deal which was struck yesterday could ultimately lead to a consolidation of other OTBs throughout New York state. The new entity, which is likely to be called Empire State Off-Track Betting Corp., will see its headquarters shifted from Midtown Manhattan to a location at Aqueduct Race Track. The Governor also used the opportunity to announce Senator John Sabini, a Democrat from Queens, as his choice to become the chairman of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board, a nomination which requires the approval of the Senate.

Also in May, MAHR rescued Dr. Hector (Texas Glitter), Choice Request (Valid Request), Fast Movin Fini (Fini Cassette), Pops Dark Secret (Mesopotamia), Skip'n True (Is It True) and Socies Girl (Rock Point).

#### Steroid Rule Adopted by Steeplechase Association:

A rule banning the use of all androgenic and anabolic steroids has been adopted by the National Steeplechase Association, effective Sept. 1. Four therapeutic medications--stanozolol (Winstrol), boldenone (Equipoise), nandrolone (Durabolin) and testosterone will be allowed at trace levels. "It's really unavoidable at this stage; with all that is going on in the world of Thoroughbred racing, we just felt the need to follow suit and be proactive," said NSA's Director of Racing Bill Gallo. "The rules are based on the Mid-Atlantic guidelines and when they made the move we felt it was the right thing to do and follow them. We actually use the same testing lab as Delaware Park and we typically follow their lead, so this made a lot of sense."


