It's not just about Curlin. The fairer sex was in action throughout the country yesterday as well, with a pair of former champions and a brace of 2007 Grade I winners

getting their pictures taken. Hystericalady (Distorted Humor) romped home in the GII Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill (see p4), just about 1 1/2 hours before her Breeders' Cup conqueror Ginger Punch (Awesome Again) mirrored that effort in Belmont's GI Ogden Phipps H. (p3). Unbridled

Belle (Broken Vow) made a facile return to the races in the GIII Obeah H. at Delaware Park (p6), and 2006 champion two-year-old filly **Dreaming of Anna** (Rahy) continued to shine on the turf with a front-running score in the GIII Mint Julep H. at Churchill.

PYRO FIRES BACK

Giving trainer Steve Asmussen the first leg of a lucrative stakes double at Churchill, **Pyro** (Pulpit) got back on track with a determined score in the GIII Northern Dancer S. "Hopefully, this is the first step to a very good second half of the year," Asmussen commented. **Cont. p5**

Curlin could only manage third in his first venture under the Twin Spires, the GI Kentucky Derby last May, but he turned the tables on Street Sense to take the GI Preakness S. two weeks later. He endured two more defeats--a second in the GI Belmont S. and third in the GI Haskell Invitational--before trumping all comers in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and GI Breeders' Cup Classic, thereby sealing Horse of the Year honors. Kept in training this season while his peers were embarking on their stud careers, the powerfully built colt kicked off with an easy handicap score at Nad al Sheba, then built off that to triumph in the world's richest race, the \$6-million G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 29.

The 128-pound heavyweight broke cleanly from the rail and saved ground in fourth as East Coast shipper Barcola set comfortable fractions of :25.01, :49.28 and 1:13.41. Jockey Robby Albarado began looking for a place to send the heavy favorite entering the far turn, but Sam P. (Cat Thief) kept him pinned inside. It didn't really matter, though. An inviting spot opened up as the field fanned out turning for home, and Curlin was soon in front. Albarado continued to hand ride the star to the wire; his former stablemate, Einstein, nipped Barcola for second. "He's showing that he is a superstar," Albarado offered. "He prevailed for the fans and I'm proud of him; he's an amazing horse--amazing athlete." The reinsman added, "He fulfilled a lot for me--taking me across the world and back. And I just look forward to the rest of the year and, hopefully, we can do it again for everyone." There's no word on what his next start might be, but Jess Jackson has mentioned that a tilt at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 5 isn't out of the question.

Ginger Punch, second by a neck in last year's Ogden Phipps, earned Eclipse Award honors after collecting trophies in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, GI Ruffian H. and GI Go for Wand H. The Florida-bred kicked off 2008 with a romp in the Sunshine Millions Distaff Jan. 26 at Gulfstream, but was brushed aside by the streaking Zenyatta and wound up third in the GI Apple Blossom H. Apr. 5 at Oaklawn. She bounced back to take the GII Louisville H. May 2 over a wet-fast Churchill strip despite jumping tracks in the stretch, and loomed a heavy favorite in this return to New York. After cruising along in third as Mistical Plan showed the way, the chestnut moved up to make a race of it approaching the stretch. She quickly took over and was hand-ridden to the wire. "They talked about retiring her last year, but I said, 'She's pretty sound. Why not keep her in training?'" said winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "She's not the prettiest filly in the world, but she's got a heart the size of an elephant and that's what counts." Never worse than third in as many Polytrack outings at Turfway this winter, Tizdejavu came up a half-length short when third in an all-weather allowance at Keeneland Apr. 12. His connections opted to try him on the grass in the GIII Crown Royal American Turf S. over this course May 2, and the Cooper/Ziebarth homebred pulled off the gamble at 21-1 in wire-to-wire fashion. Sent off as the second choice this time, the bay colt bowled along on the front end, setting fractions of :48.06 and 1:12.31. He skimmed dangerously close to the hedge turning for home, but that was the only anxious moment for jockey Garrett Gomez, who kept his mount busy in the final furlong. "This colt has nice, huge stride," said Gomez. Trainer Greg Fox was thrilled with his colt's effort. "I think his performance speaks for itself. We are going to enjoy this victory now [before committing to the next race]. He has plenty of options."

Hystericalady, heroine of the GI Humana Distaff H. last May, capped 2007 with a narrow loss to champion Ginger Punch in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Monmouth. Fourth to Intangaroo as the 1-5 chalk in the GI Santa Monica H. Feb. 2, the chestnut snapped back to form in the GIII Azeri BC H. at Oaklawn Mar. 9, but finished a head behind Intangaroo when third in her Humana Distaff defense May 3. With Garrett Gomez in the irons for the first time, the five-year-old sat in second through a half in :49.69. She took over shortly thereafter and began to open up in front of the stands. Gomez took a few peeks to see if there were any threats, but saw nothing and geared down the odds-on choice approaching the wire. "This is the first time I have ridden her and she is a nice, nice mare," said Gomez. "She gave me a little more kick than I was expecting."

Heroine of the 2006 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies on dirt under the Twin Spires, Dreaming of Anna regrouped on turf during the second half of 2007 with three stakes successes, including the GIII Pucker Up S., and finished up the year with a second in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. The chestnut began this season by sweeping Tampa's GIII Endeavour H. Feb. 16 and GIII Hillsborough H. Mar. 15, but ceded the early advantage to Bayou's Lassie in the GIII Distaff Turf Mile May 3 and settled for second. The odds-on homebred set out in front and never looked back, forging clear in the final furlong. "The [GI] Beverly D. [Aug. 9, Arlington Park] is one of the races we have targeted for her and after today, obviously she is headed in the right direction," said winning trainer Wayne Catalano. Runner-up to champion War Pass in the 2007 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and GI Champagne S., Pyro watched his star rise at Fair Grounds this winter. Eye-

catching scores in the GIII Risen Star S. Feb. 9 and the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 8 attracted the attention of Darley, which secured the colt's breeding rights. However, Pyro finished a desultory 10th over Polytrack in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 12 at Keeneland, and an eighth-

place effort in the GI Kentucky Derby three weeks later didn't do much to restore his luster. Away alertly in his first start back, the handsome dark bay was caught in a bit of traffic heading into the first turn, but settled into an easy rhythm in third as Texas Wildcatter (Monarchos) led from My Pal Charlie. He angled out approaching the stretch and rallied in tandem with Visionaire before assuming control in midstretch. "He was coming off two extremely disappointing efforts for a top-class horse," admitted winning trainer Steve Asmussen. "This was a quality field today, and he handled what was thrown at him. He was a lot sharper in the race and looked comfortable the whole time. Hopefully, we can map out a schedule that has some important races in it for three-year-olds for the year." Recapturetheglory (Cherokee Run), making his first start since finishing fifth in the Kentucky Derby, missed the break and lacked running room at the quarter pole before finishing fourth.

Pure Clan began her career on turf, taking an Ellis maiden and a Keeneland allowance, before making a very profitable move to the main track. The chestnut capped her unbeaten juvenile season with scores in Churchill's GIII Pocahontas S. and GII Golden Rod S., which caught the eye of IEAH Stables and Pegasus

Group. Her perfect record came to an end this spring at Oaklawn when she ran second and third, respectively, to the ill-fated Eight Belles in the Mar. 16 GIII Honeybee S. and Apr. 6 GII Fantasy S. In the GI Kentucky Oaks contested over a sloppy track May 2,

Pure Clan was caught four wide before settling for third, and the decision was made to put her back on the grass. With Julien Leparoux back in the irons here, the even-money chalk saved ground in third as the grey fillies Zee Zee and C J's Leelee alternated up front. Pure Clan angled out turning for home, put away the pacesetters and kicked clear smartly for a popular score. The Kentucky-based filly will almost certainly be getting on a plane for her next start. "I think I know where we will be spending the Fourth of July [at Hollywood Park 10-furlong GI American Oaks July 5] if we get an invitation," said winning trainer Bob Holthus. "She has trained well on the grass since the Kentucky Oaks, and her last work was just awesome. We felt all along that her action was better suited for the grass than the dirt." As for C J's Leelee, trainer Ken McPeek said, "She ran a great race. Robby [Albarado] did a great job. We've been beat two lengths to her twice--once on the dirt [in the Golden Rod] and now on the turf. They're classy fillies. We just hooked a tough one in Pure Clan."



The dark bay has moved forward off his last three starts, and won the Laz Barrera last time out in his best race to date. Young horses that improve gradually are less likely to bounce than ones that make a big jump, and Two Step Salsa hasn't done anything wrong yet. He tries two turns today, but his pedigree is at least distance neutral (see sire profile), so we expect him to at least pair his last. Since he also has speed and the rail, that makes him pretty tough.

Trevor's Clever Stephen Got Even

Was relatively slow as a two-year-old, but developed a lot this year, winning a stake last time out. He didn't run too fast that day either, and only won because he saved ground on both turns (1w1w, upper left). He's too slow to compete here.

3 15-1 Exuma **Ecton Park**

Got a late start, moved forward nicely in his third start, and basically reproduced that effort in his last. This guy isn't as fast as several others, but he's about 50/50 to run a new top, which could get him into the exotics.

Ez Dreamer In Excess (Ire) 8-1 Is heavily raced and very solid, and his sire, In Ex-

cess, gets early developers (see sire profile), so we don't expect too much more development. This colt is the same on grass and dirt, and the competition is easier on turf, so that's where his future lies.

Ecton Park

Shows another type of healthy Thoro-Graph pattern-he has run a new top in every other start, with bounces in between. His figure in the Arkansas Derby was the best anyone in this race has run, and while he might have bounced in the Preakness regardless, he also had a pretty rough trip (see trip comments). With four week's rest, there's every reason to believe this gelding will run his best now.

Monarchos 10-1 **Bingham**

Showed promise at Turf Paradise, and paired his top in a better-than-it-looked effort first time for Mullins. This gelding is very similar to Exuma, and also could get a piece of the exotics.

7 **Dixie Chatter** 5-2 **Dixie Union**

He won a Grade I last year, but only because the California juvenile division was so weak--his figures were just okay. His recent return was better than it looked, the best race of his life. There's nothing wrong with his pattern, and he could even be ready for a new top--but Dixie Chatter is slower than a couple of others here, carries high weight and drew outside, so we'll look elsewhere.

Wind's Legacy Millennium Wind

Was solid late last year, and ran a new top in his belated seasonal debut. It's tough to tell how much that effort took out of him and which way he'll go now, but the post doesn't help.

Bottom Line--It looks like the Affirmed will have a Latin flavor, with Two Step Salsa and Tres Borrachos fighting it out.
