

FIRST DEFENCE BATTLES TO JAIPUR WIN

In search of a first graded stakes victory to add to an illustrious pedigree, First Defence (Unbridled's Song) had to dig deep to get the job done in yesterday's GIII

mile left to negotiate, the even-money choice found his advantage dwindling approaching the wire, but had enough left in the tank to eke out a head victory over Salute the Count. "I'm not sure if that family really likes it on soft turf," said trainer Bobby Frankel. "[Jockey] Javier [Castellano] said he bobbled a few times; hopefully, that's why he was stopping. He made an easy lead, but maybe it wasn't as easy as I thought. Watching him on the turn, it looked like he was going to gallop. At the end, I was looking for the wire." Winner of the 1 1/16-mile Long Branch BC S. at Monmouth last season, the colt finished a bang-up second to Hard Spun in the GI King's Bishop S. at the Spa before ending the season with a seventh in the GI Vosburgh last September. 

Final fields were drawn up yesterday for the opener to Royal Ascot 2008, with the curtain-raising G1 Queen Anne S. attracting 11 headed by the Alain de Royer-Dupre-trained duo of Sageburg (Ire) (Johannesburg) and Darjina (Fr) (Zamindar). Aidan O'Brien starts the meeting off with a trio headed by Coolmore and Frank Tagg's Haradasun (Aus) (Fusaichi Pegasus), who provides the first taste of the ever-strong Antipodean presence. Twice a winner at the highest level in his native country, the five-year-old has built up a considerable reputation and this will be his first encounter with a fast summer surface since coming under the revered auspices of the Ballydoyle conditioner. "I think that he is very, very good, and on his day in Australia he had a terrific, unbelievable turn of foot, which very few horses possess and he was almost unbeatable," Tagg told PA Sport. "He is pretty exceptional and, hopefully, he can show the racing public at Ascot his true form." cont. p2

Three of the last five renewals of the King's Stand S., which is now a Group 1, have gone Down Under, and the latest edition has attracted the big Australian names once more. In addition to Haradasun, stalwart Takeover Target (Aus) (Celtic Swing {GB}) is back for owner/ trainer Joe Janiak. The nine-year-old is joined by archrival Magnus (Aus) (Flying Spur {Aus}), who is set to run his last race for the Peter Moody team. Magnus was a place ahead of the veteran 12 months ago when third to Miss Andretti (Aus) in the five-furlong contest and his trainer is wiser to the challenge ahead this time. "He is in great shape and has traveled well," Moody said. "He ran a tremendous race in the King's Stand last year, but I think he came a little bit underprepared, as I wasn't sure how he would cope with the traveling and what training to do with him. This time round, we're targeting one race and he's come here a much fitter horse, so hopefully he can go out with a bang."

In the G1 St James's Palace S., O'Brien provides the first day's hottest favorite in Susan Magnier's Henrythenavigator (Kingmambo), who bids to follow in the illustrious footsteps of the stable's Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) by adding this prize to the G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas titles. While only seven will take on the likely odds-on favorite tomorrow, they include the Wertheimer brothers' G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) hero Falco (Pivotal {GB}) and Khalid Abdullah's G3 Craven S. winner Twice Over (GB) (Observatory). Clerk of the Course Chris Stickels is expecting near-perfect starting conditions for the fiveday extravaganza. "The forecast has been hit-and-miss and, although we could get showers during the week, we've had lovely drying days and it is getting quicker," he explained. "We aim to start on good-to-firm ground and, if we don't get any rain today, we'll be putting some water on the straight course to maintain it."



Having landed a career best in last September's G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, Quijano embarked on a roundthe-world trip which yielded a third in the GI Canadian International at Woodbine the following month and a second in the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December. Opening up this campaign with a fifth in the Mar. 6 G3 Dubai City of Gold at Nad Al Sheba, the chestnut homebred improved one spot in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at the same track before dropping to fifth in the Apr. 27 G1 QEII Cup back at Sha Tin last time. He was settled fourth behind the clear leader Gimmy from the outset of this European return. Eating into that rival's advantage once moving into second rounding the home turn, he loomed upsides Gimmy at the eighth pole and was driven out from there to assert superiority for a second top-level score. Trainer Peter Schiergen and jockey Andrasch Starke enjoyed a banner day at Milan yesterday. The pair combined to lift both of Europe's afternoon highlights with Quijano in this event and with Goose Bay (Ger) (Groom Dancer) in the G2 Oaks d'Italia. Stepping up from a maiden score at Frankfurt last July, Goose Bay opened her stakes account in the Aug. 5 Listed Oppenheim-Rennen at Cologne next time and hit the board in a hot renewal of the G3 Maurice Lacroix-Trophy at Baden-Baden Aug. 31. She dropped to fourth in a competitive edition of the Oct. 21 G3 Preis der Winterkonigin in her season closer back at the Iffezheim track and returned this term to run second in the Listed Henkel Trial at Dusseldorf last time. Keeping the leaders within range for most of this Classic, she was sent to the front with 500 meters remaining and maintained a relentless gallop inside the final guarter mile to go clear of the toiling pack. The victory, a personal best for Goose Bay, also ensured a banner day for trainer Peter Schiergen and jockey Andrash Starke following the earlier victory of Quijano (Ger) in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano. 

I purchased my first horse, a yearling colt, when I was 34 at the Washington Horse Breeders Sale in Spokane, Washington. I raced him at Longacres in Seattle.
- What did you do before you got into horse racing? I was, and still am, a real estate developer, in the Kent, Washington area. I built homes, but primarily focused on commercial development--small industrial parks, shopping centers, etc. I now live in Kentucky, but find that having to look at piece of property and imagine what should be on there translates very well into the breeding and racing of horses--it takes a dreamer to see and believe in what is possible, but has not yet come to be.

How many mares do you own? I presently own 14 mares.

- Do you still have Shocking Sport, dam of Misty Ocean? No. I sold her at Keeneland (January in 2006, for \$12,000), but I do have a half-sister named Staffette.
- Why did you pick Stormy Atlantic for her? Being that she was a multiple stakes producer, I was hoping for a filly out of Shocking Sport, and thought that the Seattle Slew in the bottom of Stormy Atlantic would fit well with the Lyphard in the mare and produce a good sized foal. Coincidentally, Stormy Atlantic's son, Stormello, also has Lyphard in the bottom of his pedigree.
- What do you remember about Misty Ocean as a foal? I remember that I was disappointed because she was a small foal, but she was very flashy, a pretty filly.

When selecting broodmares, do you generally stress

pedigree over race record? Yes, but I believe the stallion must have both unless you are breeding to a proven stallion, and then race record in not an issue. For example, Stormy Atlantic is a far better stallion than he was a racehorse.

Personality wise, who's been your favorite horse to be

- **around?** Easy. Montagnet, a Group 2 winner that I bred myself. He was a true frontrunner. He was absolutely fearless. He gave those of us privileged to be around him the feeling that he was invincible.
- How's Lil E. Tee doing? He is alive and doing well on our farm in Woodford County. His first two mares of the season were in foal on one cover, his desire to breed and fertility are great, and he looks like you could throw on the tack and ride him tomorrow. He has 19 stakes winners. It doesn't get any better than looking our office window and seeing a Kentucky Derby winner in the paddock.
- Describe your average day at Old Frankfort Stud. Well, at this point in my life I kind of run things like Hugh Hefner-talk on the phone in the early morning with my personnel that has been with me for a long time, and then time the horses as they train from my bedroom window--in my bathrobe! I love farming, and it's easy to put in a full day's work every day. I feel very blessed to live the life that I live.
- If you could change one thing about racing, what would it be? I would like to see the industry go to one license for all the racetracks. When you race horses in several states, keeping up with the licensing is a constant nuisance.
- If you are having friends over for dinner, what would the menu be? Now that is my wife's department, but if I were to choose the menu, it would be Cornish game hens stuffed with wild rice, with southern-style green beans, Caesar salad and bread

pudding with bourbon sauce (Woodford Reserve, of course!).

- What are your hobbies outside of racing? With a wife and 10 kids, I don't need any other hobbies.
- **Favorite vacation spot?** It's difficult to find any place more beautiful than home, but I would love to go to Ocean Shores in Washington and dig razor clams with the family.
- Favorite sports team? Favorite Athlete? I must admit that I am most definitely a fan of the Kentucky Wildcats. And my favorite athlete? Secretariat, of course.
- Favorite music? I like the standards from the forties. My favorite song is My Old Kentucky Home. Always brings a tear to my eye
- Last good book you've read? I am currently reading The Venetian Betrayal, by Steve Berry.

During the 'Stars of Texas Day,' held on Saturday July 12, Clarence and Dorothy Scharbauer Jr., L. William and Corine Heiligbrodt and Dixie Dot Com will be inducted into the Lone Star Park Hall of Fame. "We are extremely pleased to welcome our newest members to the Lone Star Park Hall of Fame," said Lone Star Park President and General Manager Drew Shubeck. "During the first 12 years of Lone Star Park's existence, they have significantly distinguished themselves at both Lone Star Park and in Texas horse racing." The Scharbauers left their mark on both the Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse industries, most notably campaigning Thoroughbred Hall of Famer and 1987 Horse of the Year Alysheba. In addition, they have been responsible for five Quarter Horse champions, and the Scharbauer family also owned 1959 Kentucky Derby hero Tomy Lee. The Heiligbrodts also got their start in the Quarter Horse industry, campaigning three-time world champion Meradas Little Sue before moving over to the Thoroughbred game in 1988. The Heiligbrodt's have won 11 juvenile stakes, 80 stakes winners (alone or in partnership) and 35 graded stakes winners, at Lone Star from 1999 through 2007. As a six-year-old in 2001 Dixie Dot Com (Dixie Brass), campaigned by Don and Carole Cahiken & Bart and Ronelle Heller, became the only horse in Texas history to sweep the GIII Texas Mile and GIII Lone Star H., his sole starts at the Grand Prairie oval. 
