#### **SETTING SAIL**

Team Valor's Sailor's Cap (Distant View) catapulted to the lead in the stretch after making a strong fourwide move on the turn for home to annex yesterday's GIII Colonial Turf Cup S. by 6 3/4 lengths over Nistle's

Crunch (Van Nistelrooy) in a driving rain storm. The bay was settled in fifth for most of the way beneath GI Belmont S.-winning jockey Alan Garcia as Kentucky Bear (Mr. Greeley) set an uncontested pace. Garcia asked his charge to quicken on the turn for home and Sailor's Cap delivered, running away to post a dominating victory. "He settled Adam Coglianese in nicely down the backside and

once he made that move it was like, 'Oh, my God!' he just circled those horses," trainer Jimmy Toner told Daily Racing From. "He loves that kind of ground, and he's just an improving horse." Sailor's Cap, a maiden winner over the Aqueduct turf last November, finished eighth behind Adriano (A.P. Indy) in a Gulfstream allowance Jan. 11. Freshened following that effort, he resurfaced to add a Keeneland allowance by three lengths Apr. 6 and entered the Colonial Turf Cup following a good second to Tizdejavu in the GIII American Turf S. at Churchill May 2.

#### **GOING NATIVE**

After a juvenile campaign highlighted by success in the G1 Nunthorpe S., Kingsgate Native (Ire) (Mujadil) proved he was no one-hit wonder when springing a 33-1 shock under Seb Sanders in vesterday's G1 Golden Jubilee S. John Mayne's imposing colt, who will stand at Cheveley Park Stud at the end of his career, failed to make any impact in Tuesday's G1 King's Stand S., but showed marked improvement here to overhaul War Artist (Aus) (Orpen) and score by 1 1/4 lengths. "I thought 33-1 was a crazy price for a Nunthorpe winner beforehand," trainer John Best commented. "He ran with the choke out earlier in the week and had only had one canter since, so he's done well to come back so quickly." Cont. p2

#### SALUTE THE GENERAL

Capping a golden week at the Royal meeting for Ballydoyle, Macarthur (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) got up in the dying strides to deny Multidimensional (Ire) (Danehill) by a neck in yesterday's G2 Hardwicke S. Having produced a career-best when third to Soldier of Fortune (Ire) in Epsom's G1 Coronation Cup 15 days ago, Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's four-year-old had to knuckle down to pass Multidimensional and justify 11-8 favoritism, but proved equal to the task under a red-hot Johnny Murtagh. "This is what we strive for and it means everything--when we achieve this sort of standard, everybody's very happy," Tabor said. Cont. p3

Kingsgate Native is all about sheer class and professionalism, which is exemplified in his race record alone. Tearing up all the rule books last year, his enterprising connections came straight to this meeting for a baptism of fire in the Listed Windsor Castle S., and he went within a head of justifying their boldness when second. He filled the same spot when a neck behind the subsequent G1 Cheveley Park S. runner-up Fleeting Spirit (Ire) in the G3 Molecomb S. at Goodwood the following month, and he chose the elaborate stage of York's Nunthorpe to break his maiden in August. As an already physically mature juvenile, he was receiving 24 pounds from the runner-up Desert Lord (GB) due to the weightfor-age scale applied in that contest, and an air of scepticism surrounded the true merit of that performance. He silenced some of the doubts with another second--in receipt of 17 pounds from Benbaun (Ire)--in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in October, but even his trainer had expressed concern that as a three-year-old without that advantage, he might struggle. After only beating three home in Tuesday's feature sprint, he had questions to answer, but did so in decisive fashion here on his first try at six furlongs. Keen early tracking the 4-1 favorite Takeover Target (Aus) (Celtic Swing {GB}) and War Artist on the stands side, the bay launched his challenge approaching the final furlong. As the latter edged past the tiring Australian raider, it was Kingsgate Native who proved strongest, and he ground his way to the front in the final 150 yards. "He was a bit keen early, so it took me a while to get him in a rhythm and settle him, but once he was he carried me very easily to the two," the winning jockey said.

#### The War is Lost, but Not the Battle...

War Artist's Australian connections were not downcast afterwards. "He has run very well, and Kerrin [McEvoy] gave him a great ride and tracked the right horse in Takeover Target," trainer James Eustace commented. "He followed him through and it nearly paid off. But full credit to John Best for winning with a three-year-old. We will go to the G1 July Cup [at Newmarket July 11] next, and then give serious thought to the Global Sprint Challenge." Gerry Galligan's Sir Gerry (Carson City), who made up late ground to finish third, is also set to contest the Darley-sponsored July Cup alongside Takeover Target, who Joe Janiak reported may have been jarred up by the fast surface when running in the King's Stand on the opening day. Hughie Morrison also pointed to ground conditions for the flop of Sakhee's Secret (GB) (Sakhee), who trailed in last. "He was never going on the ground," Morrison explained. As a full brother to the brilliant 2005 G1 Epsom Derby hero Motivator (GB), Macarthur had a lot to recommend him before he set foot on a racecourse. When he finally emerged at Navan at the end of the following October, he was straight into the winning groove. The bay was well-supported for the Derby the next spring, and took the classic Ballydoyle route of Leopardstown's G3 Ballysax S. and G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial, but failed to break through when third in both contests.

Missing Epsom due to a minor setback, he returned to finish third again in York's G2 Great Voltigeur S. in August before finishing sixth, beaten just over two lengths, despite a troubled trip in Doncaster's G1 St Leger the following month. He was allowed an easy time on desperate ground on his four-year-old bow when down the field in The Curragh's Apr. 13 Listed Alleged S., but stepped up on a faster surface to win the G3 Ormonde S. by four lengths at Chester May 9. Macarthur almost gave Soldier of Fortune the slip at Epsom last time and only surrendered to that rival and Youmzain (Ire) in the final furlong, confirming his progressive profile. Restrained in fourth early off this generous tempo, he was angled out for his rally before the final turn as Ted Durcan sent Multidimensional into the clear. Gathering in that rival with every stride, he was pushed to the limit as the eventual runner-up maintained a relentless gallop, but proved marginally the stronger in the final drive. "I thought he did very well to quicken up, and Johnny was very good on him," Aidan O'Brien commented. "He was very well after Epsom, but his last two runs have been close enough, so we might give him a little rest now."

#### HAT'S OFF!

At the end of a vintage week, a Royal winner was required to put the icing on the cake and so it proved as the Queen's homebred colt Free Agent (GB) (Dr Fong) registered a 2 1/4-length success in the Listed Chesham S. Highly impressive when winning on debut at Leicester June 2, the bay struggled for early pace, but finished off strong to defeat the other 7-2 joint-favorite Seaway (GB) (Dr Fong) and rouse the crowds. "The Queen loves her breeding and, as he passed the post, she just said, 'I've done it!'," said her Racing Manager John Warren.

Few of the Queen's runners score on debut, so when Free Agent got off the mark at the first attempt with a fluent five-length success at Leicester, the excitement was mounting ahead of this vital staging post. Failing to follow the script early on, the bay languished in rear and appeared tapped for speed, and was struggling by halfway.

However, he picked up when Richard Hughes got urgent soon after, and found the gaps through to lead passing the eighth pole before drawing away for his owner/breeder's 20th success at the meeting. "This is big," his rider said. "To ride one a winner here for the Queen is special. Me and Richard [Hannon] were worried about the ground, but cantering to post I knew we would be okay as he floated down. I jumped okay, but got squeezed out after a furlong and a half, and then was behind. In the last furlong, I needed him to stick his head out, and although he was getting tired, he did so." He is the first Royal winner at this meeting since Blueprint (Ire) in the 1999 Duke of Edinburgh S. "This was the objective, but Richard did remind the Queen that he is in the Derby, so we'll see how he gets on and take it one step at a time," Warren added.

#### Royal Meeting Ends on a High...

Officials at Ascot celebrated a record crowd for the final day of the five-day meeting. With a figure of 70,675 in attendance yesterday, the meeting total stood at 287,876, which represented an increase on last year's 275,090. "To break the 70,000 mark for today's crowd is tremendous news, and it is remarkable how popular the final day of Royal Ascot has become," the track's Chief Executive Charles Barnett said. "Needless to say, this is a record final-day crowd, which is remarkable as the fifth day only came into play in 2002." At the close of play, there were no surprises in the leading trainer and jockey titles, and Aidan O'Brien paid tribute to Johnny Murtagh following their six successes throughout the week highlighted by four Group Ones, including a third Gold Cup triumph for Yeats (Ire). Murtagh added, "As you can see from my reaction this week, I am really enjoying my job, and I'm working with brilliant people. I thought it might be a good week coming here, but you never believe it unless it happens and the winners just kept rolling in."

Tiz West, second to Behindatthebar in a seven-furlong Cushion Track maiden Feb. 2, missed by a halflength when third in his first route attempt over that surface Mar. 1 at Santa Anita. He graduated in frontrunning fashion when switched to the grass Mar. 24 and promptly added the La Puente S. Apr. 12. After jumping shadows in the GIII Will Rogers S. May 17 over this course, the bay finished fourth by two lengths, and was consequently equipped with a shadow roll this time. The homebred raced in third early as Will Rogers winner Polonius (Broken Vow) led, then made an eyecatching move while three wide on the far turn. Ez Dreamer came up on his outside and looked to be going the better of the two, but Tiz West dug in gamely on the rail and put his nose down at the right time. A claim of foul by the runner-up for interference on the backstretch was disallowed. Diamond A acquired his dam--a full sister to Horse of the Year Tiznow, et al--for \$625,000 at KEENOV in 2002.

Boundless, with "Snapper" Garrison aboard, won the \$49,500 race, which was witnessed by a crowd of 48,000. Garrison and three other riders were each fined \$250 for bad conduct at the start.

Reversing the trend of low-drawn winners at this meeting, Big Timer defied the widest stall of 28 to capture this prestigious prize. Formerly trained by lan Semple, the flashy chestnut burst onto the scene at two with a clear-cut win in York's G3 Acomb S. before trailing home 10th in Belmont's GI Champagne S. Off the board in all three starts last year, he found his form again during this year's Dubai Spring Carnival and was runner-up to Mutamarres (GB) in the Feb. 28 Listed Al Quoz Sprint. Second to the smart Utmost Respect (GB) in a conditions event at Thirsk on his European return and first start for his new trainer Linda Perratt Apr. 19, he was unplaced in the May 14 G2 Duke of York S. before finishing a half-length second to Major Cadeaux (GB) in the G3 John of Gaunt S. at Haydock last time May 31. Tracking the strong fractions against the far rail in third early, he traveled easily under Tom Eaves before grabbing the lead at the furlong pole. Chased by King's Apostle from there, he had enough in reserve to hold on from that rival and eventual second-place finisher Beaver Patrol, who had shaken loose from the stands-side group. "He was a good two-year-old and a lot of people wrote him off," Eaves commented. "Like a lot of horses, he lost his way a bit, but the owner and yard have been very patient with him and he was good today. I was happy enough with the draw, but my great worry was the pace, as his best form had been over seven, and it all worked out well." For his owner Gordon McDowall, the result represented the climax of a journey of highs and lows with his talented runner. "We took him to Belmont because he was a Street Cry and the pedigree was right, but the ground there was bottomless so it was a wasted journey," he explained. "He had problems behind the saddle at three, but we stuck by him, as we knew he was a good horse."

All the talk and money was for Mad Rush, but it was Sugar Ray who delivered the knock-out blow to foil the gamble in this competitive contest. Off the track until October, he was third at Leicester and, after more time on the shelf, took a handicap at Bath Apr. 22.
