HARRY ALEO PASSES AWAY

Owner Harry Aleo, 88, who campaigned champion sprinter Lost in the Fog, died Saturday at his home in San Francisco after a long battle with cancer. Longtime

companion Deannie Bartlett was at his side. Born and raised in San Francisco, Aleo was a talented third baseman and was signed to a minor league contract by the Brooklyn Dodgers, but an arm injury during spring training ended his baseball career. Drafted into the Army during World War II, Aleo was a veteran of the Battle of the

Bulge. After his discharge from the military, the California native went into real estate, and also opened an insurance brokerage. Aleo was introduced to horse racing by a former son-in-law, and purchased his first horses in 1979. Greg Gilchrist was his trainer from the first. "Just talk about his loyalty," Gilchrist told *Daily Racing Form.* "He stayed with me through bad times and good. We had our differences, but we walked away and went back to work." Gilchrist added, "It's left a big hole in my stomach. He was a big brother to me, a father to me." In addition to Lost in the Fog, Aleo campaigned GSWs Smokey Stover and Victorina. His Wild Promises captured the June 8 Yerba Buena S. at Golden Gate. Aleo is survived by daughters Carol, Terri and Valerie, and three grandchildren. Services are pending.

Bourbon Gets His Shot...

On the board in four of six starts at two, with a victory in the six-furlong Bull Page S., Not Bourbon opened his sophomore season with a second in the Apr. 12 Achievement H. He stretched out to seven furlongs for the Queenston, then handled a mile and an eighth in the Plate Trial. The third choice yesterday, he settled in fourth early before joining the leaders from the outside with a quarter mile left to run. The late Not Impossible (Ire) (Sadler's Wells--Ball Chairman, by Secretariat), the sire of Not Bourbon, was an unraced full brother to fellow Fipke homebred Perfect Soul (Ire), Canada's champion turf horse in 2003. Not Impossible had three crops. From 23 starters, he has 13 winners. Not Bourbon is his only stakes winner.

JULY TARGET FOR NATIVE John Mayne's

G1 Golden Jubilee S. hero Kingsgate Native (Ire) (Mujadil) will tackle the G1 Darley July Cup in his next start. Following his victory over War Artist (Aus) in Saturday's six-furlong highlight, the sophomore is on course to meet the runner-up again in Newmarket's July 11 contest. "He's come out of the race very well, with no problems," trainer John Best told PA Sport. "[Jockey] Seb [Sanders] said there was more to come, and the horse saw the six furlongs out very well. He's bred to get the trip and we were pretty sure he would see it out, but you never know until they do it on the track. His next race will almost certainly be the July Cup, and then the G1 Coolmore Nunthorpe S. [at York Aug. 22], which he won last year."

a two-year-old. I had a string of horses here (at Calder), so I actually wasn't able to able see any of his Triple Crown races in person. But he was a very laid-back horse, and I think that's

part of what made him a great horse--he was so calm and collected. Were you rooting for Big Brown this year? No, I really wasn't, just because of Affirmed. But, of the horses in recent years who had a chance, I thought he had the best chance. Recently, the ones he didn't win the Triple Crown ran into really nice horses--Empire Maker, Touch Gold, Victory Gallop, and I just didn't see anyone this year like that.

You played a lot of sports when you were younger and still work out a lot. Do you think that helped you be a better horse trainer? I think so, especially when I was young. I had a few wonderful coaches, and I applied a lot of what they taught me to training when I was 19, 20. Mostly in terms of discipline and being consistent. Consistency's a big thing. Some guys come out six days a week; not me. I'm here seven days a week, four times a day. I love coming out.

Favorite meal? I stay away from red meat; it's mostly chicken and fish for me. I eat a lot of pasta, too, just because I do work out a lot.

Hobbies outside of racing? I love going to the movies, just to relax and get away.

Favorite athlete? It's getting to be Tiger Woods. I just love his attitude and how aggressive he gets when he's going head to head. He's got a lot of class. I wish someone could to for horse racing what he's done for golf. I mean, even my wife was watching Monday (the U.S. Open playoff).

Favorite music? It varies. But I love the Bee Gees, Simon and Garfunkel, things like that. No heavy metal. I need something that's relaxing and helps me think clearly.


