ASMUSSEN CHARGE TESTS POSITIVE

Leading trainer Steve Asmussen's **Timber Trick** (Forestry) has tested positive for local anesthetic Lidocaine following a maiden win at Lone Star May 10, according

to a report in *Daily Racing Form*. The Texas Racing Commission has assigned Asmussen a July 18 date for a stewards' hearing. Lidocaine, a Class 2 drug, is prohibited on race day. Most jurisdictions enforce a six-month suspension for the infraction. The 42-year-old conditioner was suspended for six months between July 2006 to January 2007 when

another one of his horses tested positive for the Class 2 anesthetic Mepivacaine. Trainer Rick Dutrow Jr., who appealed a 15-day suspension in Kentucky for Clenbuterol, will be holding a press conference outside of Barn 10 at Aqueduct at 10 a.m. today.

Levine Monmouth Stable Tested by N.J. Officials...

Trainer Bruce Levine, who was winning at a 48-percent clip at the Monmouth meeting through Wednesday, had blood samples drawn from his 40-plus stable at the request of the New Jersey Racing Commission Tuesday, according to published reports. "It was a action that we deploy as part of our out-of-competition testing program," Frank Zanzuccki, the executive director of the commission, told *DRF*. "Sometimes it is random, sometimes it is based on prior information. In this case, it was random."




TCA Board Approves \$1.5 Million in Grants:

The Board of Directors for the Thoroughbred Charities of America (TCA) has approved grants totaling \$1,592,225 in 2008 to non-profit organizations in the areas of rescue, research, backstretch, education and therapeutic riding. "Since horse slaughter has been greatly reduced during the past few years there has been an increase in unwanted horses, putting a severe financial burden on the horse rescue groups who receive much of their support from TCA," said Herb Moelis, president of TCA. The TCA raises funds from year-to-year primarily through its Annual Stallion Season and Art Auction, scheduled for Dec. 5 at Keeneland Race Course and facilitated by auctioneers from Fasig-Tipton. Now in its 19th year, the TCA has raised over \$15 million, will 96 cents of every dollar going to charity. Liz Harris, the executive director of TCA, expressed her appreciation. "Nearly every stallion farm donates seasons to the TCA auction, purchased by other supporters, creating the funds so desperately needed by the very charities handling the industry's ex-racehorses, backstretch, research and other vital non-profits," she commented.

MORE THAN READY FILLY TOPS INGLIS

A More Than Ready filly produced by the regally related Danehill mare Milanova (Aus) highlighted a strong opening day of selling at the Inglis Australian Weanling and Breeding Stock Sale in Sydney, Australia. The filly, selling during the first of two sessions of the Select Weanling portion of the sale, was knocked down for A\$625,000 to Colm Santry Bloodstock, who secured her on behalf of Coolmore. She was offered as part of a reduction by Tyreel Thoroughbred Stud.

The nine-year-old Milanova, a Group 3 winner, is from a family that Coolmore has enjoyed great success with. Being a daughter of the Secretariat mare L'On Vite, she is thus a full-sister to Coolmore's champion dual Group 1 winner Holy Roman Emperor (Ire). It is also the family of Coolmore stallion Encosta de Lago (Aus), who will be crowned Australia's champion sire this season. Milanova's third dam is Canadian Horse of the Year Fanfreluche.

"This is one of the best pedigrees in the world and, obviously, the filly has great residual value," Santry said afterwards. "We're looking forward to getting Holy Roman Emperor back for his second season this year after receiving outstanding reports about his first foals, and it's wonderful to be able to buy another member of this great family."

The filly was one of two weanlings sold as part of the Tyreel Stud reduction. The other, a Tale of the Cat filly from G2 Sandown Guineas winner Moon Dragon (Aus) (Danehill), sold for A\$180,000 to Lockyer Thoroughbreds.

Coolmore's young Danehill sire Oratorio (Ire) provided the second-highest lot of the day when a bay filly from the Scenic (Ire) mare Rainscene (Aus) was knocked down to Anton Koolman for A\$300,000, topping the New Sire Showcase.

In all, 120 weanlings sold for just short of A\$4 million. The session average of A\$32,872 represented a strong increase of 29 percent on last year's overall select weanling sale result.

"This was a very pleasing start to this sale, which is in a new format for the first time this year," William Inglis Managing Director Mark Webster said. "Competition was very strong on the top lots and, overall, it was a very strong start and this is borne out in the overall average."

The select weanling sale continues this morning at 11 a.m., followed by a general session later in the day. A single session of breeding stock will be held Sunday. For complete results, visit www.inglis.com.au.

ONE CONFIRMED CASE OF STRANGLES A case of the equine disease strangles in one racehorse near Pukekohe was confirmed on Tuesday, New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR) was informed yesterday. The horse is isolated and is being treated. Controls have reportedly been put in place to prevent any potential spread of the disease. The confirmed horse was transported from a stable in the Taranaki region on June 17 with one other horse. The other horse on the float is also stabled near Pukekohe and is isolated. Test results are not known yet. NZTR, on the advice of veterinary experts, yesterday diverted two horse floats containing 18 horses from six trainers' stables to the Hawkes Bay A&P Showground, where they will be isolated. They were to be inspected on arrival by vets at the Hawkes Bay A&P Showground as a precautionary measure. The vets will decide whether or not the horses will be able to race at the Hawke's Bay meeting at Hastings.
