THE FEW, THE PROUD...THE MOTHER GOOSE

Only three fillies are willing to challenge **Proud Spell** (Proud Citizen) in today's GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont Park, but you can't blame horsemen for looking for alternate routes. The only time the Brereton Jones homebred has finished worse than second was a third-place finish in the GI Ashland S., her only synthetic track try, and she comes into the race off a dominating five-length victory in the May 2 GI Kentucky Oaks. "She's just been ultra-consistent ever since we got

her," trainer Larry Jones said. "In her training, she always found a way to keep up, and she'd win every work by a head or a neck. In her races, whenever [jockey Gabriel Saez] sets her down, she gets to work." Will she have her work cut out for her? The toughest competition is likely to be **"TDN Rising Star" Music Note** (A.P. Indy). The Godolphin colorbearer broke her maiden by 7 1/4 lengths at Aqueduct in November, then came back after more than six months on the sidelines to take a Belmont allowance by seven under a hand ride. She stretches out off that one-mile test for her stakes debut. Bred by Gainsborough Farm, she is a half to French Classic winner Musical Chimes; her second dam is champion It's In the Air.

NEW APPROACH'S IRISH DERBY BID IN DOUBT

G1 Epsom Derby hero **New Approach** (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), ante-post favorite for tomorrow's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby, may not get the chance to complete the Derby double. Trainer Jim Bolger yesterday revealed the colt may be suffering from a foot ailment. "New Approach is not 100 percent comfortable in his box," Bolger told *PA Sport*. "We do not as yet know the extent of the problem. It appears it may be a foot bruise and we will know more [Saturday] evening." **Cont. p2**

HEATSEEKER OUT OF GOLD CUP

Heatseeker (Ire) (Giant's Causeway), who was the 7-5 favorite for today's GI Hollywood Gold Cup, has been scratched due to a problem with his left front ankle. The winner of the GI Santa Anita H. and GI Californian S. this year, the five-year-old was the 123-pound highweight for the 1 1/4-mile race. "I am sorry about it, especially with all the exposure we've gotten, but unfortunately we can't run a horse with a filled ankle and some heat in it," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said. "I don't believe it's serious, but we're not going to take a chance with so many more big races this year." Hollendorfer reported that X-rays were negative, and Heatseeker is expected to be back in action later this season.

Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby

TARTAN ARMY

While the last Scottish invasion of Ireland happened in 1315, County Kildare will witness a raid of a different kind as **Tartan Bearer (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}) does battle in tomorrow's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby. Despite having raced only four times, the chestnut has already established a reputation for toughness and resilience and, after losing out by a half-length to **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the June 7 G1 Epsom Derby, Ballymacoll's homebred is smarting for revenge. Like recent winners Ribocco, El Gran Senor, Law Society and St Jovite, he will bid to go one better over the Curragh's hallowed soil and provide Sir Michael Stoute with a fourth renewal, which would also be his first since Shahrastani in 1986. Peter Reynolds, manager of Ballymacoll Stud, believes the colt can find the necessary improvement to turn the tables on his Epsom conqueror. "We were absolutely delighted with Tartan Bearer at Epsom--he ran a wonderful race," Reynolds commented. "He didn't have that much experience and is learning all the time, so hopefully he will improve on that on Sunday. I can't see any reason why we wouldn't have a wonderful opportunity of winning, as The Curragh is a level, galloping track which should suit our horse very well, and the ground should be perfect. It's a long time since we won the Irish Derby with Troy (GB) in 1979 and we deserve another chance." **Cont. pxx**

Aidan O'Brien has sent out five winners since 1997 and supplies a quintet this time. Like his previous heroes Galileo (Ire), High Chaparral (Ire), Dylan Thomas (Ire) and Soldier of Fortune (Ire), **Washington Irving, Alessandro Volta, Frozen Fire and Bashkirov** all arrive off of runs in the Epsom Classic. While Washington Irving was a place ahead of Alessandro Volta when fifth three weeks ago, jockey John Murtagh has opted to partner the latter as he bids for a third edition since the turn of the century. "I have decided to ride Alessandro Volta, as I thought he ran very well to finish sixth in the Derby and I think the Curragh track will suit him better than Epsom did," he told the *Racing Post*. The decision leaves last year's winning jockey Seamus Heffernan to ride the G2 Dante S. runner-up Frozen Fire, who needs to rebound off a disappointing showing when only 11th in the Derby; and lands Colm O'Donoghue on Washington Irving. The only withdrawal yesterday was Khalid Abdullah's **Doctor Fremantle**, who will wait for the July 14 G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp. Following heavy rainfall on Thursday, the ground is expected to be on the easy side of good for the start of the three-day meeting today. "We had 15 millimetres of rain yesterday and the ground has changed to good-to-yielding," Curragh Manager Paul Hensey explained yesterday. "I think as it soaks in, it will be lovely ground for Sunday. There is a very competitive field there, with the first three at Epsom."

THE STARS COME OUT IN ARGENTINA

The best of Argentinian racing line up this afternoon for the annual Carreras de las Estrellas program at Hipodromo Palermo. The country's version of the Breeders' Cup World Championships, the program features six Group 1 events, highlighted by the G1 Gran Premio Estrellas Classic, which carries purse money of approximately \$236,000 and features **Fairy Magic (Arg)** (Southern Halo). The four-year-old looks to defend his title against 11 rivals in the 2000-meter test, including **Teamgeist (Arg)** (Mutakddim), runner-up in last year's G1 Estrellas Distaff; and **Visa Parade (Arg)** (Parade Marshal), who was a winner once in four American starts last year for trainer John Sadler. Should he succeed, Fairy Magic would be the first horse to win dual Classics since El Compinche (Arg) accomplished the feat in 1996 and 1998. The other Group 1 events are the Estrellas Distaff; the Estrellas Juvenile and Juvenile Fillies; the Estrellas Sprint; and the Estrellas Junior Sprint. In addition, the card will also witness the inaugural running of the Clasico Estrellas Mile.

The Queen of Coolcullen is accustomed to a heavy workload, having taken part in three Classics in the space of three weeks last May and completing the G1 English-Irish 1000 Guineas double in the process. Winless since that latter contest, the "living legend" has given her connections encouragement since her comeback fifth in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai Duty Free and pushed Duke of Marmalade (Ire) to 1 1/4 lengths in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at this track May 25 before her Royal outing. Her trainer Jim Bolger collected this with Alexander Goldrun (Ire) in 2005 and 2006, and the chief threat appears to be **Promising Lead**. Runner-up by a head to Satwa Queen (Fr) in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp in October, she returned with an impressive success in York's G3 Middleton S. last time May 15. Three-year-olds usually hold the key to this and Dermot Weld puts forward the promoted G1 Irish 1000 Guineas second **Mad About You**, who bids to emulate Moyglare and Weld's 1992 victress Market Booster and Dance Design (Ire), who collected this when run as a Group 2 in 1996 and 1997. The owner-breeder's Racing Manager Stan Cosgrove told *PA Sport*, "She ran a really good race in the Guineas and the ground would have been plenty fast enough for her. We've had a bit of rain recently, so it should be much more in her favour this time. I think she'll run well--she's got a big chance."

Not surprisingly he bounced, and the question is, what happens now? On the plus side, this horse has the rail, gets in light and adds blinkers--a good category for Frankel (*see trainer profile*). The negatives are that the big jump figures to knock him out for a while, and even a return to his top would only make him a borderline contender. Note that Frankel is one of a group of California trainers whose win percentages are down this year (*see "last 90 days"*).

3 Heatseeker (Ire) — SCRATCHED

4 Tiago Pleasant Tap 3-1

Has been extremely solid, other than the stinker in the slop at Monmouth. He has paired his top or run a new top in every start for 13 months. He earned exactly the same figure for his last two, though his Californian effort looks much worse than the one at Oaklawn due to spotting weight. He's likely to run his race again, but he's also spotting weight again.

5 Racketeer Awesome Again 8-1

Ran the best race of his life when second in a very strong allowance at Belmont last time out. A repeat would make him a borderline contender here, but he has a history of reacting badly to big efforts, and leaving Frankel's barn can't be seen as a plus.

6 Student Council Kingmambo 9-2

Was bought on our recommendation last summer and sent west, where he immediately won the GI Pacific Classic before taking the GI Hawthorne Gold Cup. He tailed off over the winter but came back around in his last, and here's the thing--when this horse is in form, he just cranks out his race every time, and with six weeks rest, there's no reason to think he won't now. Most importantly, he gets weight worth almost 1 Thoro-Graph point from Tiago, which puts him right in this, and is why we are running here.

7 Go Between Point Given 5-2

Has gotten better with age. His best improving a couple of points at four, and again at five. He's also become extremely consistent, but at a level just short of top stakes horses. On his very best he would be a contender here, but Bill Mott has indicated he might not be ready to throw his best, so he's tough to take as one of the favorites.

8 McCann's Mojave Memo (Chi) 12-1

Ran a 0 last time, and saving ground as lone speed, a repeat would put him right in this. But he's run that fast three times before, and bounced each time. It's hard to see him pairing up now as an eight-year-old.

9 Big Booster Accelerator 8-1

Has gotten better with age, although some of that may be attributed to joining the Mike Mitchell barn (*note: Mitchell is one whose win percentage has not gone down, see profile*). This gelding is a marathon specialist, but he's only run fast enough to compete here once in his life, and that was not recently.

10 Spice Route (GB) King's Best 15-1

Didn't run fast enough in Europe to make a dent here, and his pedigree doesn't exactly scream dirt. If he sticks around he could contend in turf stakes a cut below the top.

Bottom Line – This figures to be a two-horse race, with Tiago and Student Council fighting it out in what could be a close finish in the Gold Cup.

Following the 2006 GI Breeders’ Cup Turf hero’s sixth in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 6, Paul Reddam’s five-year-old may see out the remainder of his campaign in the States. “He goes back in the next fortnight for the Man o’War,” his conditioner said. “He travels really well and it’s the perfect opportunity for him. Plans are flexible, but possibly he will stay there then until the Breeders Cup Turf. He’s very well and he didn’t really handle Epsom, but he’s training extremely well since then. What keeps him most interested is to hop on a plane and have a change of scene.”

TUESDAY BREEZE POSSIBLE FOR BIG BROWN Trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. said yesterday that GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. hero **Big Brown** (Boundary) would resume galloping this morning and hinted that the colt could turn in an official breeze as early as this coming Tuesday morning. “I think I’m going to start galloping him tomorrow,” said Dutrow, adding that the IEAH and Paul Pompa Jr. runner has been jogging for a few weeks. “I think we’re going to put the shoes back on Monday. We’ll gallop him for few days until Monday and maybe Tuesday start breezing him, I’m not sure. But he’s ready. He’s put his belly back on, he’s as happy as he could be. Now I can train him the way we want to. Now he got his little break, jogging every day, so, he’s ready to roll.” The conditoner reiterated his plans to run Big Brown in the GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park Aug. 3, and added that he would like to come back in the GI Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 23. “I hope that Big Brown runs there,” said Dutrow. “In a perfect world, I would want to see him win the Haskell and win the Travers--in a perfect world. Especially my world, it’s not perfect.”

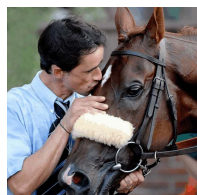

"This was one of the best drafts we have ever taken to a weanling sale and we got the desired result," Coolmore Australia General Manager Michael Kirwan said.
