Rahy's RACER FOREVER Wins Criterion S. (G3) at Newmarket (p. 12)

## A NERVOUS APPROACH TO THE DERBY

If he survives a late scare and if given the green light to race, Princess Haya of Jordan's **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) will be reaching for a further slice of history in today's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The Curragh. The first juvenile champion to go on to glory in the G1 Epsom Derby since the International Classifications began in 1977, the chestnut will be looking to join the pantheon of great dual Derby win-

ners which includes the likes of Nijinsky II, Grundy (Ire), The Minstrel, Troy (GB), Shergar (Ire), Generous (Ire), Sinndar (Ire), Galileo (Ire) and High Chaparral (Ire) since 1970. Only Henrythenavigator, rated by Aidan O'Brien the best miler he has

trained, stopped the Jim Bolger-trained star from adding the G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas to his enviable tally. Despite pulling hard for much of the first part of the June 7 Epsom Derby and encountering traffic after Tattenham Corner, New Approach still managed to find extra to deny Tartan Bearer (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}) in a pulsating finale. He is facing a battle against the clock after some heat was found in his foot Friday. Bolger told PA Sport, "There is less heat in the foot, and we are treating it." Dermot Weld finally conquered this prize in 1996 with the outsider Zagreb and followed up with Grey Swallow (Ire) four years ago. While a win for Bertam Firestone's Winchester (Theatrical {Ire}) would be a major upset after his disappointing effort when down the field in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot nine days ago, in Casual Conquest (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}) Weld has a main player. Promoted to favoritism for the Derby after his six-length defeat of Washington Irving (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial S. at Leopardstown May 11, Moyglare Stud's homebred was 4 1/2 lengths adrift of New Approach and Tartan Bearer when third in the Blue Riband. His conditioner is hoping the gap will close with that experience under his belt. "He's a lovely big horse and a good one who is still very immature, and he handled Epsom," Weld said. "[He] came out of the race sound. He is a balanced horse for his size and Epsom is a very fair track nowadays, so we have no excuses, and I'd be hopeful of a big run." The conditioner added, "He's similar to Grey Swallow, in that he's a stayer with speed, so he compares favorably." Cont. p2

## MAST-IVE UPSET IN GOLD CUP

When Heatseeker (Ire) was declared from Saturday's GI Hollywood Gold Cup H., it certainly opened up the race, and it was **Mast Track** (Mizzen Mast) who took full advantage. Owned, bred and trained by Bobby



Frankel, the four-yearold colt, adding blinkers and reknowned speed rider Tyler Baze for the first time, broke alertly from the inside stall, got his opening six panels in 1:12 4/5 and outsprinted favored **Go Between** (Point Given) to take the centerpiece of the spring/summer meet-

ing in Inglewood. "After Heatseeker scratched it was anybody's race I guess," said assistant trainer Humberto Ascanio. "Bobby [Frankel] told me this morning to make sure this horse was put onto the lead. When they went the first quarter in 24:48 I had a good feeling, then they went three-quarters and I thought 'man, that's it'. This feels great. He's a nice horse; he's always been a nice horse." #### Irish Derby cont.

Recent British-trained winners include Old Vic (GB) and Generous (Ire), but no horse has shipped over successfully since Commander in Chief (GB) completed the Epsom-Curragh double in 1993. Michael O'Flynn's Centennial came off a win in the Apr. 26 G3 Sandown Classic Trial to finish fourth behind Tartan Bearer and Frozen Fire in the G2 Dante S. at York last time May 15. The other raider from the far side of the Irish Sea is Patrick Cooper and Partners' Curtain Call, whose trainer Luca Cumani saddled dual Derby winner in Kahyasi (Ire) in 1988. While he disappointed when finding little at the business end of the Epsom Classic last time, the bay colt showed last year that rain-softened ground at this venue is up his alley with an emphatic success in the G2 Beresford S. "He had been running over seven furlongs, which was a bit short for him, before he went up to a mile in the Beresford, when he improved," rider Fran Berry told PA Sport. "He always rode like a horse who would be good over a mile and a half as a three-year-old."

A \$600,000 Keeneland September yearling, Frost Giant was a dual Group 3 winner in Ireland for Aidan O'Brien before being repatriated. Winless in his first four U.S. appearances, the chestnut took a nine-furlong test over the main track Feb. 11. Fourth as the favorite in the GIII Skip Away H. Mar. 15, he was the beaten chalk when eighth in a Churchill turf allowance Apr. 30 and was last seen finishing runner-up in a similar event on the Monmouth Park lawn May 29. Frost Giant jumped well and seized the initiative, but had some surprising company in the form of Naughty New Yorker (Quiet American). The latter began to fade after six furlongs, and it was Solar Flare who delivered a fresh challenge and held the call at the quarter pole. But Frost Giant, beneath jockey Rudy Rodriguez, was going the better of the two on the inside as the winning post loomed and scored narrowly. # Stakes Results cont. TAKING THE LEAD

Khalid Abdullah's Promising Lead (GB) (Danehill) marked herself as one of Europe's leading distaffers when getting the better of Mad About You (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) to capture yesterday's G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh. Always traveling easily in second under Ryan Moore, the homebred took over at the quarter pole and gradually asserted from her sole threat to score by 1 1/4 lengths as the 2-1 crowd's choice. "She is from the fantastic family of Hasili (Ire) and she has now won a Group 1, which is everything the breeder longs for," the owner/breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe commented. Finsceal Beo (Ire) (Mr. Greeley) gave way to finish last.

Promising Lead was a slow starter in the right hands, and Sir Michael Stoute gradually built her into the toplevel performer she was bred to be. Second in York's Listed Michael Seely Memorial Fillies' S. last May, she was still a work in progress when only fourth in the Listed Hoppings S. at Newcastle the following month but the penny dropped with a first stakes score in Salisbury's Listed Upavon Fillies' S. in August. Pitched straight into the highest level on her next start, she went within a head of upsetting Satwa Queen (Fr) in the G1 Prix de l'Opera on Longchamp's Arc day, and returned to record a facile success in the May 15 G3 Middleton S, at York on her latest start, Promising Lead settled at the head of the peloton as Ice Queen (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) was sent into isolation by Seamus Heffernan, and was still in cruise control when usurping that rival with a quarter-mile remaining. Despite the presence of Mad About You from there, the bay may have been idling on the run to the line, but she was never in danger of losing out. "She got nosed out at Longchamp, but has come back and done it nicely today, and Ryan has produced her just right," Grimthorpe added. "I will have to speak to Prince Khalid and see what he wants to do, but I would think her program will be fairly straightforward. It will probably be the G1 Nassau S. [at Goodwood Aug. 2] and G1 Yorkshire Oaks [at York Aug. 21], and then see after that." Dermot Weld revealed that the runner-up will return to this venue to tackle the July 13 G1 Darley Irish Oaks. The 5-2 second favorite Finsceal Beo, who was eased when fading out of contention in the final furlong, was reported to have been clinically abnormal afterwards.

Music Note overcame a significant stumble at the start, and GI Kentucky Oaks winner Proud Spell to register what can be considered only a mild upset in this prestigious event. Fourth as the 20-1 second-longest chance in her Oct. 14 debut at Belmont, the bay stretched to Aqueduct's one-turn mile Nov. 1 and was ridden out to a 7 1/4-length victory, earning the mantle of **O** "TDN Rising Star" **O**. Rested off that effort, she made her first start in Godolphin blue in her latest and showed few signs of rust, defeating the well-regarded Charming by seven in a one-mile allowance at Big Sandy May 22. Both Proud Spell, making her first start since her win in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 2, and Music Note stumbled badly at the start, allowing Never Retreat to lead through soft fractions of :48.66 for the half and 1:13.09 for three-quarters. Gabriel Saez asked Proud Spell for just enough speed to hold the rail and had the opportunity to go through an opening at the fence at the quarter pole, but his overly patient approach backfired badly. The divisional leader was pinched back to last in upper stretch, about the same time that Music Note was making her move while in the clear and on the outside. The latter assumed command with 3/16ths to run and pulled away to score handily. Proud Spell grabbed the bit and rerallied, but drifted out despite a right-handed whip from Saez, and came across Never Retreat. Though it did not seem to have an impact on the final placings, the stewards ruled otherwise and Proud Spell was demoted from second to third. "I had a beautiful trip, even though she stumbled at the start," commented winning rider Javier Castellano. "I tried to position myself; I did not want to be on the lead. It was a pretty tight trip. I wanted to be in position to just push the button. She galloped out good, and I don't think she will have a problem going farther." With that in mind, Music Note could resurface in the GI Alabama S. over 10 furlongs Aug. 16. Larry Jones, trainer of Proud Spell, took the defeat in stride. "From the beginning, it looked like it wasn't going to be our day. When we needed somewhere to go, we had nowhere to go. And when it was time to go, we weren't going."

Neatly tucked away in midfield, Royal Oath looked loaded for bear leaving the far turn. 

#### Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud cont.

While all the focus was on Getaway ahead of the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 6, it was Soldier of Fortune who emerged from that showdown with a reputation enhanced. The pair met for the first time in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in October, when Andre Fabre's improver had Ballydoyle's challenger a half-length behind in fourth, and it appeared on his seasonal return in the G2 Jockey Club S. that Getaway might have widened the gulf. Highly impressive when 3 3/4 lengths too strong for Sixties Icon (GB) in that May 4 Newmarket contest, Baron Georg von Ullmann's homebred was subsequently fifth at Epsom. That effort can only be marked down as disappointing, and he needs to rebound to provide his trainer with a sixth renewal. "He didn't really handle Epsom, but he might just be a bit below those sort of horses," Fabre told Racing Post. "The second, Youmzain, is a very good horse, as well as Soldier of Fortune, and you have to accept he just wasn't good enough. It's always the most difficult thing to accept." Soldier of Fortune, who captured the G1 Irish Derby by nine lengths on this weekend 12 months ago, also needs to confirm Epsom form with Youmzain, who was a head runner-up to Dylan Thomas (Ire) in the Arc last year. Only fifth behind Mountain High (Ire) in this race 12 months ago, the habitual bridesmaid tries again. "Youmzain put up a very good performance at Epsom--he's such a consistent, hardy horse and doesn't seem to know how to run a bad race," the owner's Racing Manager Bruce Raymond told PA Sport. "He comes out of his races very well because he's so tough, and he took Epsom in his stride." Last year's GI Man o'War S. and G1 Hong Kong Vase hero Doctor Dino holds Zambezi Sun and Getaway's stable companion Not Just Swing on the form of his success in the June 1 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly, and adds an extra dimension to one of the strongest runnings in recent memory. "I wasn't at all confident before the race at Saint-Cloud," trainer Richard Gibson said. "It was his first run back in a long time, but he's got so much energy and a lot of guts and did it well. We respect the other runners who are Group 1 winners, and Soldier of Fortune was very impressive winning the Coronation Cup. With the form of Aidan O'Brien, he definitely looks the horse to beat."

# HOLLYWOOD TO RACE THROUGH SUMMER

OF 2009 Speaking at Friday's meeting of the California Horse Racing Board, Hollywood President Jack Liebau revealed that the track will race through the summer of 2009, and likely until the end of that year. According to Daily Racing Form, Liebau said, "We expect to be allocated our 2009 historic dates. We have committed that we will run the spring/summer meeting, no question, and the fall meeting if we don't give six months' notice to the contrary." It is possible the Inglewood oval will operate into 2010 as well. Purchased by the Bay Meadows Land Company from Churchill Downs Inc. for \$257.5 million in September of 2005, Hollywood is slated to be closed for redevelopment. The Bay Meadows Land Company has already announced that Bay Meadows will cease to operate after the San Mateo County Fair meet in August.

**DECLAN'S MOON RETIRED Declan's Moon** (Malibu Moon--Vee Vee Star, by Norquestor), the champion juvenile of 2004, has been retired, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Now six, the Maryland-bred gelding has won

GIII Hollywood Prevue S. at two, Declan's Moon also captured the GII Santa Catalina S. in his lone start at three. The bay was sidelined by knee surgery after that victory, and his career was plagued by setbacks thereafter. "He never came back the same after surgery," trainer Ron Ellis told *DRF*. "It was too bad, because we saw the real horse in his first few races and after that it wasn't the same." Ellis added that breathing problems had been an issue in his most recent races. "He can't get his air," he said. "It was only under severe stress that it happened. We tried everything and it's something that can't be fixed." Purchased by Jay Em Ess Stable for \$125,000 as a FTMSEP yearling, Declan's Moon retires with a record of 18-6-2-2 and earnings of \$705,647.

#### **ADW Dispute Threatens Ellis Park Signal:**

With Kentucky horsemen still unable to reach an agreement regarding the revenue split with advance deposit wagering companies, it is unlikely that Ellis Park's signal will be distributed to the ADW companies when the meet opens Friday. The ongoing dispute over the issue prevented the distribution of the signal from several tracks this spring, including Calder and Churchill Downs, and also now threatens the Del Mar signal. An agreement that made the signals from all California tracks available to all ADW companies expires just before the Del Mar meet opens July 16. California track officials will meet with representatives of the ADW companies July 7 to try and work out the details of a new plan. The Thoroughbred Horsemen's Group, which represents, among others, horsemen in Florida, Kentucky and California in ADW negotiations, has asked for open access to the signals for all ADW companies.


