### STOKING THE FIRE

In a dramatic finish to the G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby, it was Frozen Fire (Ger) (Montjeu {Ire}) who emerged victorious to provide Aidan O'Brien and

Seamus Heffernan with consecutive renewals of The Curragh Classic. As with Soldier of Fortune (Ire) 12 months ago, it was the stable jockey's rejected mount who bounced back from an unplaced effort in the G1 Epsom Derby to cause a 16-1 upset. Johnny Murtagh had looked to

have the contest won on Alessandro Volta (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}), but that rival swerved across Tartan Bearer (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}) with a furlong remaining, and it was left to Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's second string to attack widest of all. Frozen Fire swept to a two-length success from the closing Casual Conquest (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}). "I think Alessandro Volta got stage fright when he turned into the straight, and he wouldn't have seen a crowd like that in front of him before," said trainer Aidan O'Brien, adding, "Frozen Fire was second in the [G2] Dante S., but got trapped back in the Derby, and [jockey] Mick Kinane said afterwards he was very happy with him and that he was a very good horse." ### INGLIS BROODMARE SETS SO HEM RECORD


The eight-year-old mare Milanova (Aus) (Danehill--L'On Vite, by Secretariat) was expected to be the highlight at Sunday's session of the Inglis Australian Breeding Stock Sale in Newmarket, and she didn't disappoint.

The subject of heavy competition from several breeding operations, the bay was finally hammered down to Coolmore Australia for a Southern Hemisphere record A\$5 million. She eclipsed the previous mark of A\$3.4 million, set by the Milanova & Encosta de Lago Filly broodmare prospect Virage de Fortune (Aus) (Anabaa)

at last year's Inglis Australian Easter Broodmare Sale. In foal to Encosta de Lago (Aus), Milanova was part of the 12-horse Tyreel Thoroughbred Stud reduction. A Group 3 winner and runner-up in the G1 Australasian Oaks, she is a full sister to champion Holy Roman Emperor (Ire); her second dam is Fanfreluche (Northern Dancer). "Genuine good horses like her that come on the market always attract genuine money," Coolmore Australia's General Manager Michael Kirwan said. "She's got a world-class pedigree, and Coolmore has enjoyed a lot of success with the family, with not only Holy Roman Emperor, but Encosta De Lago, who will be champion sire this year." #### Irish Derby cont.

Stepping up from a debut win at Gowran Park last August, **Frozen Fire** was pitched straight into the Oct. 27 G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster and fin-

ished a well-beaten eighth behind Ibn Khaldun. He matured over the winter, returning to run a promising second to Tartan Bearer in the May 15 G2 Dante S. at York, but failed to handle the rollercoaster undulations when 11th in the G1 Epsom Derby last time June 7. Settled in rear for most of this second domestic outing, he came under pressure soon after turning for home. Galvanized by Seamus Heffernan's urgings, he was steered to the outside, away from the trouble which

was unfolding in the center of the track, and swooped wide and late to claim glory. "This is down to a lot of people and it's been a privilege to have been involved in it," admitted Aidan O'Brien. "Seamus has worked very hard and is a great judge of a horse. Nobody deserves it more than him and I couldn't be happier. All we wanted was a strong, even gallop, and this is great for everyone involved, as there are so many people in the team who make this happen. The Curragh is probably the greatest track in the world, as it is very fair and really tests a horse over a mile and a half. It's a very special race."

### New Approach Forced to Scratch...

Princess Haya of Jordan's **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) was not 100 percent yesterday and was taken out of the Irish Derby. "He's still not sound and the problem may not be in his foot," trainer Jim Bolger said, adding that the G1 Epsom Derby hero was off in his near hind leg. "We're going to take scans [Monday], but he wasn't sound enough to go racing, so he won't be confirmed for the G1 Eclipse S. [at Sandown July 5]."

### Not Curtains for Call...

Newmarket-based trainer Luca Cumani was philosophical in defeat after **Curtain Call (Fr)** (Sadler's Wells) suffered interference, which compromised his Derby aspirations for a second time. "He was in full flow and lost momentum when he was hampered by Alessandro Volta," Cumani reflected. "It was difficult to recover after that, but I don't think he would have won even without the interference and I'm happy with the way he has run. He showed he belongs to this class, his race in the English Derby was all wrong, and he was much more competitive than he was at Epsom." With regard to future targets, Cumani continued, "We have no immediate plans. If he recovers well and quickly, he could go to France for the G1 Grand Prix de Paris [at Longchamp July 14], but we'll see."

### We Did Start the Fire...

Frozen Fire was foaled and raised at Michael Andree's Gestut Romerhof near Cologne. The best horse raced by his breeders, Jurgen and Wolfgang Hoyer, was the globetrotting World Series and G1 Singapore International Cup winner Epalo (Ger). They bought Frozen Fire's dam Flamingo Sea, winner of a maiden at Leipzig, in foal to Acatenango (Ger) which seemed a good idea as she is a Woodman half-sister to the German Oaks heroine Flamingo Road, who was also by Acatenango. The resulting foal was the average handicapper Feuersturm (Ger). Frozen Fire was sold as a yearling at Goffs February Sale in 2006 where, as the only Montjeu in the sale, he realised €250,000. Flamingo Sea herself has been through the ring twice since the birth of her best offspring, both times at Tattersalls' December Sale. She was knocked down to Scuderia Blueberry for 36,000gns in 2005 and was purchased by Horse France for 135,000gns one year later. Frozen Fire's 2006 half-sister (by Tiger Hill {Ire}) sold to Francesca Turri for €42,000 at last September's Select Yearling Sale at Milan.

Youmzain has played second fiddle on most of the major occasions he has been involved in, but it was his day in the Parisian sun yesterday. Sent off at 57-10 on the back of a fast-finishing runner-up effort behind Soldier of Fortune in Epsom's June 6 G1 Coronation Cup, Jaber Abdullah's five-year-old readily reversed those placings after gaining first run. He had captured a top-level prize in Cologne's G1 Preis von Europa in 2006, but missed out on all tries in this league the following term. On the board in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh and in Ascot 's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. in July, Youmzain was beaten a head when runner-up to arch-rival Dylan Thomas (Ire) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October. He was fifth on his seasonal bow in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad Al Sheba, and his johnny-comelately style saw him run out of real estate in the Coronation Cup. A change of tactics were employed here.

Settled closer to the front alongside Soldier of Fortune off the generous fractions carved out by the rabbits, he was full of run when launched between rivals at the top of the stretch. Quickening past the Ballydoyle challenger passing the quarter pole, the bay was always in control despite the game efforts of the runner-up as they pulled clear of the remainder. Trainer Mick Channon remarked, "He worked brilliantly last week; I really thought he had a great chance today and, indeed, he won very well." Looking ahead, he added, "It has always been the plan to go for the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. [July 26], so we will stick with that. 

Treat Gently found only Gagnoa (Ire) too good in her first try at Longchamp last September, and duly obliged with a win when returning to the Bois de Boulogne track for her sophomore bow May 15. She lined up for this coming back from a second in the June 1 G3 Prix de Royaumont at Chantilly, completing a banner weekend for Juddmonte distaffers by prevailing in a tight call. ### RAILWAY S.-G2 result cont.


Aidan O'Brien had won this race nine times since King of Kings (Ire) opened the scoring in 1997, and Mastercraftsman battled past Alhaban to make it 10 for Ballydoyle here. Having already beaten Intense Focus on debut over this track and trip May 5, the chestnut was on the shelf while that rival went on to finish runner-up in Royal Ascot's G2 Coventry S. Settled in rear by Johnny Murtagh as Declan McDonogh forced the pace against the stands rail on Alhaban, he was angled wide for his challenge and needed driving to join the long-time leader and Intense Focus approaching the furlong marker. Getting to the front with 150 yards remaining, Mastercraftsman answered every call to prevail as Alhaban dug in gamely. "He's a lovely big, long-striding horse who learned a lot from his first run and would have learned more today," his trainer said. "He looks like a horse who will get a lot more than six [furlongs] and will appreciate the step up to seven for his next run. All the big races are open to him and, hopefully, he'll progress." It was the longest two shots on the board who came home one-two in Saturday night's Cornhusker H., which had drawn a competitive field that included Grade II winners Zanjero (Cherokee Run) and Delightful Kiss (Kissin Kris). Eventual winner Wayzata Bay stumbled at the break, but recovered to sit in third off sensible early fractions. Moving three wide on the far turn, he collared the pacesetter and edged away under jockey Israel Ocampo. It was easily the biggest career win for Wayzata Bay, who ran fifth in last year's edition. The locally based six-year-old had finished runnerup in his last two starts, the Bosselman/Gus Fonner S. at Fonner Park Apr. 26 and the Jim Rasmussen Memorial S. here May 31. The 6-5 favorite Zanjero failed to make an impact, racing in mid-pack before closing a bit to be fourth. Fairbanks (Giant's Causeway), who would have been one of the favorites, scratched.
