## CURLIN TAKES TO THE TURF

In his first step on the road to a possible tilt at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, Stonestreet and Midnight

Cry Stable's **Curlin** (Smart Strike) negotiated seven furlongs--around the 'dogs'--over Churchill Downs' Matt Winn Turf Course Tuesday. Partnered by regular rider Robby Albarado, the four-year-old covered the distance in 1:31.20. The handsome chestnut, who was

accompanied by Hawaii Calls, recorded a final quarter in :24.20 and an eighth in :12.20, while galloping out a mile in 1:45.60. Curlin, who started about one length behind his stablemate, finished on even terms with the four-year-old. "We are very excited to work him, he's a tremendous athlete," said trainer Steve Asmussen. "We were very pleased with how he looked. The main thing is that Robby loved how he felt." Reflecting on the colt's first turf workout, Asmussen added, "He was blowing off his move, but seven-eighths in 1:31 and change around the dogs here is a very good move. I thought he galloped out exceptional, as always. One thing that I really liked about it is when he went to the turf course and jogged off, he kept his presence about him--there was no worry. He was very confident and relaxed behind [Hawaii Calls]. He paced himself well and didn't get too aggressive, like he was unsure about what he was supposed to do."

## CALL APPEAL PLACED

Connections of **Curtain Call (Fr)** (Sadler's Wells) have appealed against the decision of The Curragh stewards not to promote the colt from fifth after suffering interference in Sunday's G1 Irish Derby. Hampered by the errant Alessandro Volta (GB) as that rival veered left across his path inside the final furlong, the Luca Cumani-trained colt finished two lengths behind the fourth-placed Tartan Bearer (Ire), who was subsequently handed third upon the former's disqualification. Syndicate Manager Patrick Cooper told *Racing Post*, "We are appealing, as we feel our horse should have been placed in front of Alessandro Volta at the stewards' inquiry. Our horse was badly hindered, and we believe it cost him the 2 1/2-length difference there was between him and Alessandro Volta at the finish. He is in good order after the race and, luckily, has no cuts or bruises. He put up a solid performance, but I would have been more delighted if he hadn't been interfered with."

## APPROACH ON BOX REST

Princess Haya of Jordan's **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) faces a short spell on the sidelines, according to trainer Jim Bolger. In a statement, the Coolcullen conditioner reported that x-rays carried out on the G1 Epsom Derby hero came back negative. "Veterinary examination has revealed soreness on the solar surface of New Approach's left hind limb," Bolger said in his statement. "X-rays of the limb revealed no abnormality, and pelvic ultra-sonography revealed no abnormality. However, there is soreness in the gluteal muscle area, and he will be box-rested until he is fully sound, when following further ultrasonography, he will begin walking exercise."

## DOING A LITTLE JIGG ON CANADA DAY

Jim Dandy Stable's **Jiggs Coz** (Cozzene) came from off the pace to score an emphatic victory in Tuesday's GIII Dominion Day H. at Woodbine. Sent off the 3-1 second choice in the short four-horse field, the grey took control soon after the start, carved out pedestrian early fractions of :24.76, :50.07, 1:14.50 and 1:39.16 for a mile and was well within himself to post a 2 3/4-length victory over **True Metropolitan** (Proud and True). "We thought [True Metropolitan] was going to go to the lead, but [Jiggs Coz] showed speed nice and easy," explained winning trainer Sid Attard. "When I saw the :50 [half-mile mark], I was very happy." *cont. p2*

Winner of the Display S. at two, Jiggs Coz added the seven-furlong Queenston S. and the nine-panel Plate Trial S.--both against Canadian-bred rivals-- at three.

Favored in the Queens Plate S., the Ontario bred had to settle for third. "He came up with some problems,"

offered Attard. "I'm not making excuses. We were very disappointed we didn't win the Plate, but what are you

going to do? I wish he was as good in the Plate as he was today." Out for the rest of the season following a

runner-up finish in the Prince of Wales S. last July, Jiggs Coz returned with a ninth on the grass in the GIII

Conaught Cup May 25. "We talked to [rider] David [Clark] and he said this horse prefers Polytrack to the

grass," said Attard. The colt has never finished off the board in five career starts on the synthetic surface.

**Sterwins** (Runaway Groom) was forced to scratch yesterday morning. "He came out of his stall this morning

and he jogged sore," said the colt's trainer Malcolm Pierce. "He was okay yesterday and I'm sure he'll be

okay in a few days, but we weren't going to take any chances. Obviously, it's disappointing, but we want to

An easy winner in his latest start in the GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs June 14, the reigning Horse of the Year may make his next start in either the 11-furlong GI Man 'o War S. or the 10-furlong GIII Arlington H., both scheduled for July 12. "The perfect plan for us--for me, for Curlin and everybody associated with him--is to first establish his level of quality on the turf with his next race and not get ahead of ourselves," said Steve Asmussen. "We have to see if he can compete at the same level--a nice work is not a graded stake." Looking down the road to a start in France, Asmussen said, "If he can compete at his level on the turf and we get the race we expect, we will map out how to win the Arc with him. I think getting him over there immediately and getting him used to going right [handed] would be the biggest obstacle that we will face." As for the first step, Asmussen added, "I think we establish that he's as good a horse on the turf as he is on the dirt, then we get him over there and get him him relaxed, comfortable and doing right."

**O'BRIEN TO RELY ON NELSON FOR ECLIPSE**  
 Aidan O'Brien is likely to have a sole challenger in Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Mount Nelson (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) in Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown. Despite the presence of **King of Rome (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Plan** (Storm Cat) among the entries at the five-day stage, the Ballydoyle conditioner told *Racing Post* that the G1 Queen Anne S. fifth was the only intended runner. "We are looking at running only Mount Nelson in the Eclipse and Johnny Murtagh will ride him," O'Brien told the trade daily. "King of Rome will probably go to Hamburg for the G1 Deutsches Derby on Sunday. Plan ran well when fourth at The Curragh on Sunday, and this weekend might come a bit too soon for him." Clerk of the Course Andrew Cooper is hoping that the current good-to-firm description remains for Saturday's race. "The forecast is a little bit of mixed bag, and I don't think we can be too confident about the volume of rain we will see over the next few days," Cooper explained. "The track is good-to-firm, good in places [Tuesday] and we'd like to keep it like that for the meeting." As for the line-up for the 10-furlong contest, he added, "It lacks a Derby horse and a star, but it is a very busy time in the fixture list with lots of competitive races of this sort. In terms of older horses, if you take out Duke of Marmalade, the best around are there, so it will be a competitive and fascinating race."

Ahead of the Kieran McLaughlin trainee that day was Ventura, who jogged on the main track under exercise rider Augustine Lara Tuesday morning. Trained by Bobby Frankel, the four-year-old also won the GII Madison S. at Keeneland earlier this spring.

The family also breeds and races in Florida and Argentina. Laubali, by Mr. Prospector, is a half-brother to successful sire Honour and Glory from the family of Ogygian and Fappiano.

Fortanyo scored a redeeming victory following three consecutive defeats in Peru's top race for older horses on dirt. Piloted by leading rider Carlos Trujillo, he surged past champion Morena in the stretch to power his way home comfortably. The win capped a Group 1 weekend for the connections, and it was a very proud and sentimental moment for prominent Peruvian international breeder Jaime Rizo Patron Remy, who also owns and trains the colt. James Nealon, representative for U.S. Ambassador Peter Michael McKinley, presented owner Jaime Rizo Patron Remy with the winner's trophy. The winner's sire Farallon P. (Fappiano), is a half-brother to GISW Swept Overboard (End Sweep), was named Peru's Stallion of the Year last seson.

**SALE TIME**

July is here (where did the time go?), and that means it's less than two weeks before Fasig-Tipton Kentucky kicks off the yearling sale season in Lexington, beginning 10 a.m. Monday, July 14. In light of the definitive decline in first-half North American and European sales combined, plus the general economic downturn, consignors will no doubt be approaching the sale season from a guarded viewpoint. True, the average for the 6,147 horses sold in the first half of the year was up by 7 percent over the corresponding sales from last year (see the *Weekly Sales Ticker*); but 1,000 fewer horses were sold. The buyers were willing to pay a little more, but for fewer horses; in other words, they were being more selective. That trend is likely to continue.

One bright spot is that Fasig July is a pinhookers' sale, and European pinhookers had a terrific two-year-old sale season, especially with American bred. With the dollar continuing to flounder, even more against the Euro than sterling, European buyers should be back in force. They will be slowed down to the extent their seed money has been coming from players in the Irish property market; that is taking a battering, from what we were told last weekend when we were over for the Irish Derby. But to the extent they are not dependent on Irish property money, European pinhookers and other European buyers are likely to be among your best customers this year.

Fasig's New Sire Showcase, featuring yearlings by sires with their first and second crops constitutes 57 percent of the sale, including all of Monday. Probably two-thirds of those are from their sires' first crops (we'll preview them next week), but there are around 100 yearlings catalogued by sires with their second crops of yearlings, meaning their first crops are now two-year-olds. As everybody knows, this is an especially sensitive period for young sires, particularly in July. Many of them have barely had time to get off the ground, and all the buzz is about this year's crop of young sires. It's great for those sires which are off to a fast start, but those who aren't are eligible to get a little bit lost in the shuffle. But the sire you'd really like to have a yearling by right now is **Dixie Union**, who has gone to the top of the two-year-old sires list after two fillies by him won stakes over the weekend: Garden District in the GIII Debutante at Churchill Downs last Saturday, and Bold Union, winner of Belmont's Astoria S. on Sunday. This happens to be his fifth crop of two year olds, but the consignors of the six yearlings by him at Fasig will surely find the phrase 'timing is everything' working in their favor right now. *cont. p7*

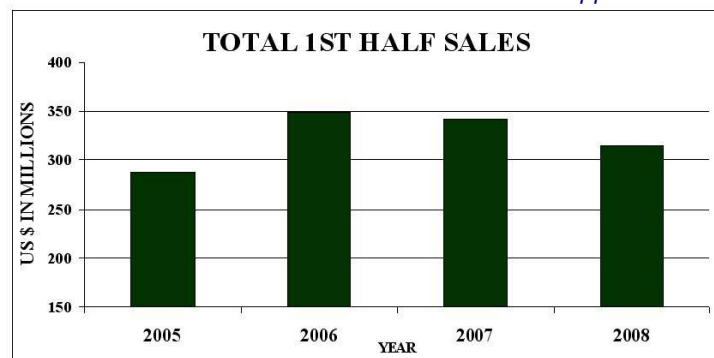

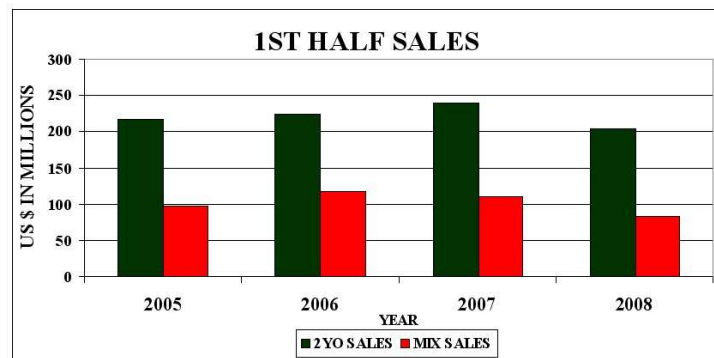

"It's easy to see from these graphs that first-half calendar year North American and European sales peaked in 2006-2007 in gross sales, but also in number catalogued and sold. Almost 1,400 fewer horses (11%) were catalogued in these sales than in 2007, with over 1,000 fewer sold (14%). The gross (\$314.2-million) was down 8% from 2007, and down 10% from its 2006 peak (\$349.1-million). The strongest sectors this year have been two-year-olds sold in Europe and at OBS."

But I digress. Three-figure foal crops seem to help these days, so it's no surprise three of the top four freshman sires by progeny earnings right now (*table p8*) have over 100 two-year-olds in their first crops; the exception is **Roar of the Tiger** (Storm Cat), a Hartley/De Renzo (Walmac South) Florida stallion who, like the successful New York sire **Freud**, is a stakes-placed full brother to North America's number three sire, Giant's Causeway. From 61 named foals, according to information provided to us by *The Jockey Club Information Systems*, Roar of the Tiger has had 19 runners and five winners--one of only three first-crop sires to have sired five winners so far. He is currently in second place on the North American freshman sire table, splitting two Ashford (Coolmore) stallions with over 130 named foals each: leader **Lion Heart** (Tale of the Cat), with seven winners, including a minor stakes winner; and **Chapel Royal** (Montbrook), who has five winners, and 24 starters. **Medaglia D' Oro** (El Prado), with more than 120 named foals, is one of two freshman sires with four winners so far; the other is **Omega Code** (Elusive Quality). He, like Roar of the Tiger, is a Florida stallion; Omega Code has one entered at Fasig, Roar of the Tiger none. No doubt these will be selling at OBS next month. The three Kentucky triple-figure foal stallions--Lion Heart, Chapel Royal, and Medaglia D' Oro--have five, 10, and six, respectively, catalogued at Fasig.

Numbers aside, I've always fancied Medaglia D' Oro. He's a good-looking horse, and ran first or second 13 times in Grade I or Grade II races. He was a two-turn horse and didn't win at two himself, so if he's showing up prominently on freshman sire lists, it's a bonus.

There are about 60 yearlings catalogued at Fasig by sires with their first three-year-olds, so this is their third crop of yearlings. Airdrie has been introducing their mid-range first-year sires at Fasig July for over 20 years, so it's a pretty sure bet that the 14 yearlings by their sophomore sires--Harlan's Holiday (Harlan), with nine catalogued and Proud Citizen (Gone West) with five--will be well received. The crop's number three sire by cumulative progeny earnings, Ashford's Van Nistlerooy (Storm Cat) has four catalogued. There are 10 by Posse (Silver Deputy), top Freshman Sire of last year, but who has dropped to fourth on the cumulative list by virtue of a slow first half of '08. So now's the time to buy; he's maybe had a few who haven't trained on, but the speed was there, that's for certain. Adena Springs' **Macho Uno** (Holy Bull) has five catalogued, though sadly their Florida-based dual GI Santa Anita H. winner **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again) has none. Another Florida sire who has had a very good '08, Repent (Louis Quatorze), has five yearlings catalogued. Those two are three-four on the '08 sophomore sire earnings list (*bloodhorse.com*), trailing only Harlan's Holiday and Proud Citizen.

"We were delighted on Sunday, as he was getting a reputation and people were starting to call him names. He's always been genuine and has done nothing wrong all his life, but he's just bumped into some very good horses like Rail Link (GB) and Dylan Thomas."

**Doctor Dino (Fr)** (Muhtathir {GB}) will likely sidestep the King George, according to trainer Richard Gibson. Last year's GI Man o' War S. and G1 Hong Kong Vase winner finished third behind Youmzain (Ire) at Saint-Cloud. "He came out of the race well and is in good shape, but we give full marks to Youmzain," Gibson told *PA Sport*. "We had raced against him before and we'd beaten him before, but he was very impressive at the weekend. We have no immediate plans, and we said we'd wait for 10 days or so after the race and see where we are, but I would describe the King George as doubtful. With a horse like Doctor Dino there are so many options abroad, especially in the autumn, so we're in no rush to make a plan."


