Pure Clan (Pure Prize), perfect in three attempts on the grass, headlines today's GI American Oaks Invitational at Hollywood Park. Unbeaten in her first four

starts, she had the misfortune of running into the ill-fated Eight Belles twice at Oaklawn, in the GIII Honevbee S. Mar. 16 and GII Fantasy S. Apr. 6, and finished second and third, respectively. Regret S. at Churchill Downs. Pure Clan will mark the first Californian starter for veteran trainer Bob Holthus. "She's been very consistent and can go either way," Holthus said of his charge's ability to handle turf and dirt. "I don't think she has run on a turf course this firm before. She comes from off the pace, so I hope some others try to go for the lead. I expect to see her five or six lengths off the lead. We were fortunate with the draw to get the rail. Panza at the yard in England this winter, I spoke to the owner, we decided to target this race, and here we are," said trainer Jane Chapple-Hyam. The chestnut came up 3/4of-a-length short over yielding ground in the Epitome S. at Monmouth Oct. 26. Eighth in her seasonal opener, the seven-furlong G3 Fred Darling S., she comes here

off a pair of 10-panel efforts, finishing second to Michita in the Listed Height of Fashion S. May 21 at Goodwood and third last out in Newbury's Listed Ballymacoll Stud S. June 12. She'll have her desired firm footing this time. "I missed the [G1] Coronation S. at Royal Ascot to run in this race," Chapple-Hyam added. "She got a perfect trip [at Newbury], but the ground was too soft for her. She needed to get a run under her belt. I was not deterred because she is definitely better on firm turf, and I knew I would get firm turf here." Also shipping over is Carribean Sunset (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), put up to third in a tight finish in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas May 25 before filling the same spot in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 20; and Satan's Circus (Gone West), who took the Listed Prix Caravelle Apr. 25 prior to a fifth behind Zarkava (Ire) in the G1 Prix de Diane June 8.

With two good races under his belt since returning from the bench, Jayeff B Stables' Strike a Deal (Smart Strike) looks poised for a big run in today's GI United Nations S. at Monmouth. The bay lost a pair of tough photos last term in the GIII Colonial Turf Cup June 16 and the GII Virginia Derby July 21 before finishing third in the GIII Kent Breeders' Cup S. at Delaware Sept. 1. He was freshened following a sixth-place finish in the GII Kelso H. Sept. 29. A good second over a yielding Belmont turf course in the Volponi S. May 11, Strike a Deal most recently completed the superfecta in the GI Manhattan H. June 7. Trainer Bobby Frankel has a pair entered in Champs Elysees (GB) (Danehill) and Sudan (Ire) (Peintre Celebre), but will only send one as Ramon Dominguez is named to ride both. The former, who kicked off the year with a tally in Santa Anita's San Marcos S. Jan. 19, looks to rebound following a sixthplace finish as the 4-5 chalk in the GI Charles Whittingham Memorial H. Mar. 16, and most recently added a hard-fought tally in the GIII Hawthorne H. over this surface May 4. While trainer Bob Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*, "I think we're all running for second money," he added, "Zenyatta, if she brings her 'A' game,

she's tough to beat. If she doesn't bring her 'A' game, you have to be ready. On paper, we can't beat her, but funny things happen in racing. We're in a position to win, but we have to be lucky." Canadian Horse of the Year **Sealy Hill** shone on Woodbine's Polytrack before rounding out 2007 with a pair of tough beats on turf. Tenth in the GII Jenny Wiley S. on the Keeneland lawn Apr. 12, the Melnyk homebred finished a solid third in the GII Nassau S. on the grass at Woodbine last out May 31. She ships in to test this all-weather footing.

Khalid Abdullah's silks were carried to success in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. by Dancing Brave in 1986, and **Phoenix Tower** bids to provide a belated follow-up for Juddmonte in today's renewal. Still lightly raced, the four-year-old has been battle-hardened lately when winning the G3 Earl of Sefton S. at Newmarket Apr. 17 and finishing runner-up in both the G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury May 17 and G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 18. On the latter occasion, he was up against the new and vastly improved Duke of Marma-lade (Ire), and would be unlucky to find another of that caliber lurking at Sandown. "He came out of Ascot very well, is bouncing and Henry [Cecil] seems very pleased with him, so this looks a really interesting opportunity," Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe commented.

Grimthorpe added, "It's still very difficult to win a Group 1 race and any of these horses look like they have a nice chance." While this edition lacks a standout, the main proponents are at least in the right hands as seven of the nine hail from the stables of Cecil, Stoute, O'Brien and Godolphin. Between them, they have accounted for 15 renewals, with the latter three stables responsible for 12 of the last 15 winners. Stoute's Freemason Lodge rely on two "nearly" horses still searching for a Group 1 win to add to their tallies. Maraahel has seven group successes to his name, but is also that number in years now and has to improve on his latest, a non-threatening third behind Macarthur (GB) and Multidimensional in the June 21 G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot. Rob Roy adds a second string to Stoute's attack has a realistic chance if he manages to recapture the form of his G1 Champion S. second in 2006, his last try over this trip. Godolphin tallied with Halling in 1995 and 1996, Daylami (Ire) two years later and Refuse to Bend (Ire) in 2004, and could saddle both Campanologist and Literato (Fr). Frankie Dettori has chosen the former, who captured the G2 King Edward VII S. over 12 furlongs at Royal Ascot June 20. Last year's G1 Champion S. hero Literato needs ease in the ground in order to line up, and also requires an improvement on his sixth-place effort in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 18.

Jim Bolger saddled Park Express (Ire), now the dam of New Approach (Ire), to win this in 1986. He sends across Ezima, who comes off the back of a win in Leopardstown's Listed Saval Beg S. May 28. Like C "TDN Rising Star" C Folk Opera, she is burdened with a penalty, and that Godolphin runner will be attempting to build on her career-best success in the May 24 Listed Pinnacle S. at Haydock. "Folk Opera has been working well and I am happy with her," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "She always tries her hardest and deserves to take her chance in a group contest." Last year's fairytale story Turbo Linn bids for back-toback renewals, having won this in clear-cut fashion when it was staged at Newmarket. She should find this easier than Epsom's G1 Coronation Cup, in which she was seventh on her latest outing June 6. "We were very pleased with her at Epsom," conditioner Alan Swinbank told PA Sport. "Soldier of Fortune and Youmzain must be two of the best older horses in training, and she wasn't that far behind. We just hope that she is as good as she was last year. She has been working well, and she would have every chance." Last year's G2 Prix de Royallieu winner Anna Pavlova is still paying for those exploits and is heavily penalised in these events. She was a one place behind Turbo Linn at Epsom before finishing third in the G1 Pretty Polly S. over an inadequate 10 furlongs at The Curragh on Saturday.




