# MINT LANE WIRES DWYER

Sent off at the crowd's heavy 3-5 choice, Pinebloom Stable's **Mint Lane** (Maria's Mon) put forth a workmanlike effort to secure his first graded event in Sunday's GII Dwyer S. at Belmont Park. The Jimmy Jerkens

trainee, who was 5 3/4 lengths adrift of Casino Drive in the May 10 GII Peter Pan S. over the Belmont strip, entered the Dwyer off a strong win in the Postponed S. June 13. Breaking from post three under Eibar Coa, Mint Lane was soon in front and set sensible fractions

as **Ready's Image** (More Than Ready) pressed from the outside. Mint Lane shrugged off that tiring foe nearing the quarter pole and, though softened up a bit, none of his rivals was able to mount a serious threat down the lane and he won comfortably. # THE 'GENUINE' ARTICLE IN LOCUST GROVE

The four-year-old filly **Genuine Devotion (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) found the wire in time to notch her

fourth straight victory in Sunday's GIII Locust Grove S. on the sod at Churchill Downs. Owned by James Barry, she ended 2007 with a tally in the Xtra Heat H. sprinting on Belmont's lawn in October, then returned to win the Upper Noosh S. over that course May 17. On the engine in the Locust Grove, Genuine Devotion opened a clear lead in the stretch and dug in as Brownie Points (Forest Wildcat) came flying. # **DERBY GLORY FOR KAMSIN**

Stall Blankenese's Kamsin (Ger) (Samum {Ger}) led most of the way in the driving rain to capture yesterday's G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg. In leading home his stable companion Ostland (Ger) (Lando {Ger}) by three lengths, the 13-2 shot emulated his sire, who was successful in the millennium year, and provided trainer Peter Schiergen with a third renewal. It was the second Derby win in three years for his sire, and for owner and breeder Gestut Karlshof, also responsible for Schiaparelli (Ger). Cont. p2

Mint Lane has quietly emerged as a rock-solid performer in the three-year-old division this year, now having won four of seven in 2008, with a pair of runner-up efforts to his credit. He romped in an Aque-

duct maiden in January, again in an allowance race in late March, then ran Icabad Crane to a head when second in the Apr. 19 Federico Tesio S. at Pimlico. He was no threat to Casino Drive in

the Peter Pan, but rebounded with a facile victory in the Postponed. Though he didn't face any of the divisional leaders in the Dwyer, Mint Lane could see them soon enough, according to trainer Jimmy Jerkens. "We will definitely consider the [GI] Travers S. [Aug. 23]. He galloped out real good, so maybe he can go a mile and a quarter. By today's standards, he is running a little more often than the average horse. He's stayed fit since his last race, held his flesh well, so we ran him. We'll take him to Saratoga. The [July 27, GII] Jim Dandy S. comes up a little quick. You don't want to over-race him and take all the fun out of it for him." On his father Allen running second with 33-1 Tizbig, Jerkens added, "You can never count him out." Jockey Eibar Coa said he thought his mount did well to withstand the early pressure. "The way he won last time, I didn't think they were going to let him do the same thing," said Coa. "So, they were going to go after him. He's been just good enough to hold that speed and keep going." Kamsin, who opened his account at Krefeld Mar. 16 before taking the G3 Albert Von Metzler-Rennen at Frankfurt May 4, was only fourth in the G3 Bavarian Classic at Munich last time June 8. Relishing the return to rain-softened conditions here, the bay benefitted from the same type of enterprising ride exercised by Andrasch Starke on two of his previous five Derby winners Samum and Schiaparelli. In a positive frame of mind from the outset, he accepted a lead from Ostland before moving his mount into the lead turning out of the home straight for the first time. Dictating the fractions from there, Kamsin kicked decisively on the final turn and never looked likely to relinquish his advantage as he ploughed a lone path in the centre of the track. Schiergen was delighted with his one-two afterwards and said, "That was an excellent race for us. We did not really want to go to the lead, but the pace was so slow they almost moved at a trot. The jockeys really made the most of it; I have to compliment them on their riding. I can only say that Kamsin's running at Munich had to be wrong and the colt was not himself that day. The rain today also helped and once again, the jockeys did a masterful job." Starke added, "I kept a low profile on Kamsin, as I did not want to be the favourite in the race. She cleared that level at Belmont Sept. 15, then added the Xtra Heat S. and, in her seasonal bow, the Upper Noosh S. Stretching beyond six panels for the first time in this--and making her first start away from New York--Genuine Devotion set pressured fractions of :23 4/5 and :47 2/5 as Bayou's Lassie kept her honest. Genuine Devotion put away that determined foe in upper stretch, opened a clear lead, then held off Brownie Points. "This is my first race ever at Churchill Downs," said winning rider Alan Garcia, who added, "My filly was very comfortable today and I had a lot of horse. At the quarter pole, I asked her and she was running. She began to pick it up and I looked back, and nobody was coming. She got the job done." Goldikova was successful in both juvenile starts at Chantilly last year and warmed up for this campaign with a second to Azabara (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) in an Apr. 3 one-mile conditions event at Longchamp. Gaining immediate revenge on that rival, she found only Zarkava (Ire) too good in the May 11 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches back at that Paris venue, but had stamina limitations exposed when chasing home that wonder filly in another Classic, the G1 Prix de Diane, on her return to Chantilly last time June 8, where she still managed a creditable third. Settled second in the wake of her rabbit Pas Seule (Fr) (Iron Mask) through the early fractions of this, she quickened clear passing the two pole and was not for catching thereafter to secure a personal best win. "The trip was too far for her in the Diane and, with her performance here, I'm now certain one mile is her best distance," said winning trainer Freddy Head. "We'll keep her going and will bring her back in what was the Prix d'Astarte, now renamed the G1 Prix Rothschild, at Deauville Aug. 3." Following up a first win at Lingfield Mar. 31, Percolator doubled up in a Longchamp conditions May 5 before tearing open the June 14 Listed Prix La Fleche in a new track record back over the Bois de Boulogne strip last time. She made a third English Channel crossing for this pattern-race bow and justified the collective Gallic faith to bag a career high in this speed test. Out sharply to lead as per usual, she maintained control throughout and coasted to the wire in hand inside the final furlong to win unchallenged. "She's very tough, extremely fast and easy to train," said winning trainer Paul Cole. "I can't believe she was led out unsold for 2,000gns at Tattersalls' October Sale last year, but her breeder kept her and it's just another one of those nice stories in racing. I'd be tempted to come back here for the [July 27] G2 Prix Robert Papin, but she's already done a lot of travelling so we'll see. I might also consider the [Aug. 22 G1] Nunthorpe S. at York as she'd carry just 110 pounds in that and, with a filly so fast, I'm quite tempted." Click for the Racing Post chart.

"She worked good and we're all set to get her on the plane for the trip Tuesday morning," said trainer Rick Violette, Jr. The highweight at 120 pounds and probable favorite for the Princess Rooney, Dream Rush was second as the favorite in her 2008 unveiling in the GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont

May 25. "She ran well enough in that race off the layoff, and it gets her to this race," said Violette. "She's pretty much on schedule this year, except for one little blip, when she wrenched an ankle and missed a race at Aqueduct that she could have run in before the Vagrancy. Now, if all goes well in the Princess Rooney, then it will be on to the Ballerina at Saratoga. The objective will be to get her back for another try in the Breeders' Cup [Filly & Mare Sprint at Santa Anita], but we'll want to try her on a synthetic track before then somewhere. She didn't handle the slop at Monmouth." Eibar Coa has ridden Dream Rush in her last four starts and gets the mount Saturday.




