TWO-HEADED MONSTER IN CCA OAKS

It's hard to look past the Godolphin coupled entry of Music Note (A.P. Indy) and Little Belle (A.P. Indy) in

today's GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont Park. Music Note was tabbed as a C "TDN Rising Star" after posting a sharp maiden tally at the Big A for Tom Albertrani and Darley Nov. 7. The bay finally resurfaced at Belmont in May for the boys in blue, and picked up right where she left off, beating up on allowance foes by seven lengths. Stepping up to the big leagues for the GI Mother Goose S. June 28, she overcame a stumbling start to hand Proud Spell a 3 1/2length defeat. "The Mother Goose was a strangely run race," said Rick Mettee, trainer Saeed bin Suroor's

assistant. "Three of the four fillies in the race broke bad. We were lucky that Music Note was able to re-

cover quickly after she stumbled and pull a good trip outside of all the trouble. There is no guarantee of that happening again. In a short field, strange things can happen, like I said." Little Belle enjoyed the winter in New York for Kiaran McLaughlin, graduating over the inner track Feb. 1 and adding the Busher S. Feb. 24. She pulled off a 16-1

upset in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 5 and finished second in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 2, which marked her final start for McLaughlin. "Kiaran had [Little Belle] before me and he told me that he thought she would be able to get a mile and a quarter," Mettee said. "I think both Little Belle and Music Note can get the distance. Both are training very well." Cont. p2

Acoma (Empire Maker) graduated in her second start at Keeneland Apr. 18 and hasn't tasted defeat since. She splashed her way home to a Churchill allowance tally May 11, and was last seen annexing the one-mile GIII Dogwood S. May 31 over 🗘 "TDN Rising **Stars"** Steep the Peace and Secret Gypsy. The bay has posted five workouts beneath the Twin Spires in the interim, including an easy half mile in :50 1/5 July 14. While Kiaran McLaughlin no longer trains GISW Little Belle, he will be represented by a nice filly in her own right, Never Retreat (Smart Strike). The Jeff Singer colorbearer won her first two starts at Aqueduct and Belmont this spring, then placed third in Delaware's Susan's Girl S. June 14. She takes another crack at Music Note after crossing the wire third--she was placed second via DQ--in the Mother Goose.



The last was over a soft course he may not have liked, and the barn is much better third time off a layoff (see trainer profile), so we expect improvement. With the rail, this is a live longshot.

- 2 Old Man Buck Hold That Tiger McPeek 5-1
 Marched down to some good figures as a two-yearold, and came right back to that level in a concealed
 effort in a fast race. This is a strong pattern (see ThoroPattern), and Ken McPeek has been doing well recently
 (see "Last 90 days"), so this colt is a strong contender.
- 3 El Sultry Sun Eltish Kimmel 10-1
 Ran two big ones, then a stinker over very soft grass.
 We're inclined to throw that one out, and his good ones make him a contender here.
- 4 Court Vision Gulch Mott 10-1

 Has generally been overrated off his slow Remsen win last year, and his big effort in the Wood took a lot out of him. We don't like stakes horses who are running that far off their tops.
- 5 Baltimore Bob Malibu Moon Garcia 30-1 Too slow to contend here.
- 6 Budge Man Fusaichi Pegasus Gorder 20-1
 Got down to a good figure in March, but took four months to get back to it, and now comes back again on only 16 days' rest. He needs a forward move to compete here, and that's unlikely.
- 7 Gio Ponti

 Showed moderate ability last year, then jumped way forward in his seasonal debut. That much development makes a bounce possible, and another immediate forward move unlikely. He's also going to be going much further than he ever has before, so at a short price, this one is a bet-against.
- 8 Sailor's Cap <u>Distant View</u> Toner 8-5
 Didn't show much last year, got good this spring, and moved forward last time with a big effort to win the local Colonial Cup. He could pair-up that figure, but he spots weight and drew outside all the contenders here, which evens things up. Still, he's a contender, and this one has a big future.


9 Southwest <u>Cozzene</u> Jenkins 20-1
Returned to his top last time out, and has a decent pattern. But he would need a jump on less than three weeks' rest to contend, and the post hurts.

Bottom Line: Gio Ponti is a bet-against, and the right approach is to play exotics using Old Man Buck, El Sultry Sun, Sailor's Cap, and even Your Round for a little.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

July 20, 1951...Six-year-old Citation, the first Thoroughbred to earn \$1 million, was retired to stud.

July 20, 1974...Carl Rosen's **Chris Evert** trounced **Miss Musket** by 50 lengths in the world's richest match race, a \$350,000 winner-take-all contest at Hollywood Park.

July 20, 1988...John Galbreath, founder of Darby Dan Farm, died at age 90. He was the first person to have owned and bred winners of the Kentucky Derby (Proud Clarion) and the Epsom Derby (Roberto).

July 21, 1989...Jockey **Chris McCarron** notched his 5,000th career win aboard I Sure Hope So in the fifth race at Hollywood Park.

July 23, 1985...A bay colt, **Seattle Dancer**, by Nijinsky II out of the mare My Charmer, sold to Robert Sangster for \$13.1 million at the Keeneland July Yearling Sale. It was the record price for a Thoroughbred at public auction.

TOMISUE'S DELIGHT EUTHANIZED

Multiple Grade I winner Tomisue's Delight (A.P. Indy--

Prospectors Delite, by Mr. Prospector) was euthanized July 16 following complications from colic surgery, Lane's End Farm announced yesterday. The 14-year-old mare was owned by Hilbert Thoroughbreds Inc. and Menard Thoroughbreds Inc. A \$575,000 KEEJUL yearling, the chestnut was the first foal out of multiple Grade I winner and 2003 Broodmare of the Year Prospectors Delite, and hailed from the first crop of 1992 Horse of the Year A.P. Indy. Campaigned by Steve and Tomisue Hilbert, Tomisue's Delight won the GI Ruffian H. at three and captured the GI Personal Ensign H. at four, and retired with a lifetime record of 20-7-5-4 and \$1,207,536 in earnings. She was a full sister to 2003 Horse of



B.E.S.T. Receives NY State Agency Grant:

The Backstretch Employee Service Team, which serves as the health and human services agency for backstretch workers in New York, has received a \$350,000 grant from the Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers Division of the New York State Department of Health. B.E.S.T. will receive \$70,000 a year over the next five years to use for improvement of the backstretch healthcare programs. The organization operates a year-round clinic at Belmont Park, as well as a clinic that is open for six months at Saratoga. The money from the grant will be used to extends the hours of operation at the clinics, and to hire two community health workers, who will run outreach programs on the backstretch. In related news, B.E.S.T. announced yesterday that it will open New York's first on-site dental clinic for backstretch workers at Saratoga Race Course. The Solomon Dental Clinic, funded by grants from the Alfred Z. Solomon Charitable Trust and the New York Department of Health, opens Sunday, July 20, and will offer cleanings and exams. More extensive treatment will be scheduled through the clinic with local dentists. The dental unit is portable and, if funding can be found, it is the goal of B.E.S.T. to bring it downstate when the Saratoga backstretch closes in October. Sunday also marks the opening of the Global Communication Center in Saratoga. The Center will provide backstretch workers with supervised access to computers and to wireless Internet, free of charge. It was made possible by donations from Fasig-Tipton, West Point Thoroughbreds and Marchfore Thoroughbred Enterprises. B.E.S.T. is working toward opening a similar center at Belmont, where AXA Finacial Services will contribute computers.

Tougher Penalties for Steroid Positives in California:

The California Horse Racing Board voted Thursday to implement tougher penalties for anabolic steroid positives. The CHRB officially reclassified the anabolic steroids boldenone, nandrolone, stanozolol and testosterone as Class 3 substances. Positives for the four medications will result in the loss of purse money. Trainers could also be fined or suspended. Testing for anabolic steroids began July 1, with trainers receiving warnings for positives. According to published reports, 347 horses have been tested, with 27 coming up positive for stanozolol, marketed as Winstrol. The recommended withdrawal period for anabolis steroids is a minimum of 30 days.


