Invincible Since Debut...

Music Note kicked off her career in Darley maroon and white for trainer Tom Albertrani with a respectable fourth over 6 1/2 furlongs at Belmont Park Oct. 14, but got it right the next time, posting a 7 1/4-length maiden victory going Aqueduct's one-turn mile. Accorded status as a □"TDN Rising Star" □ off that effort, she made a successful debut in Godolphin blue, strolling home a seven-length winner of a mile allowance May 22, then completed her ascent through the ranks, posting an easy 3 1/2-length success in this track's GI Mother Goose S. June 28.

Another Noteworthy Performance...

Never Retreat (Smart Strike), the promoted runner-up in the Mother Goose, set a moderate pace from Flaming Slew (Slew City Slew), while Music Note and Javier Castellano raced three wide from last, but always in touch. Given her cue after six panels in 1:13.01, the bay filly cruised up to the leaders with little encouragement whatsoever and promptly opened up on the field under a few superfluous cracks of her rider's whip. Little Belle was rank early on and never looked com-

pletely comfortable, but ran on well enough to capture second money in a finish reminiscent of stablemates Inside Information and Heavenly Prize in the 1995 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Belmont.

long, beautiful stride," commented Castellano. "She sat just where I wanted her. At the quarter-pole, when I asked her, she just took off. I know it was a small field and looked impressive, but she did it the right way. She does everything the right way." Added trainer Saeed bin Suroor, "She has really improved from her last race. She showed a different class than the rest of them. I told the jockey to keep her nice and relaxed. She looked like she was stronger than her last race. The plan is to take her to the Alabama." That is also the objective for the runner-up. "Little Belle had not run since May," bin Suroor stated. "This race will set her up for her next race." Gio Ponti made a successful debut in a seven-furlong turf maiden at Belmont Park Sept. 7, then took his show on the road and defeated Nownownow in the Oct. 7 Bourbon County S. at Keeneland. A troubled eighth to that rival over the boggy Monmouth turf in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Oct. 26, the bay was brought back in a seemingly ambitious spot, but made relatively light work of the field in Belmont's GIII Hill Prince S. June 6. Gio Ponti was offered at auction as a yearling and as a two-year-old, but was led out unsold on both occasions.

Eleventh in Discreet Cat's G2 UAE Derby win in 2006, Well Armed was off 16 months, returning to be fourth in a Satna Anita allowance Oct. 4. Victorious in a Nov. 11 event at Hollywood, the homebred was second in the Jan. 12 GII San Pasqual H. in Arcadia, but bounced back to defeat Heatseeker (Ire) in the GII San Antonio H. Feb. 9. Connections passed the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 1 in favor of the G1 Dubai World Cup, and he gave a good account of himself, losing second on the wire while eight lengths behind Curlin. Quickly in front in this comebacker, Well Armed galloped along happily on the front end and was never seriously menaced. The final time over a much-faster Del Mar strip took nearly four seconds off the stakes and track record set last year by Sun Boat (GB).

I Lost My Choo broke her maiden and ripped through her allowance conditions in a three-race winning streak at Gulfstream earlier this year. Third in both the GIII Appalachian S. at Keeneland Apr. 16 and GII Sands Point S. at Belmont May 31, she registered her first stakes win facing fellow New York-breds in the Elmont S. June 28. Looking to add a graded tally to her resume, I Lost My Choo settled into stride in sixth as Julia Tuttle bounded out to establish a commanding lead. The latter was up by as much as 15 lengths on the backstretch, but began to sputter in upper stretch as the field closed in rapidly. Moving best of all was I Lost My Choo, who flew down the center of the track under the urging of jockey Edgar Prado. Namaste's Wish rallied for second, while the pacesetter dug in to save third.

Racinger took the G3 Prix Edmond Blanc at Saint-Cloud last April before adding that track's G2 Prix du Muguet to his tally the following month. Off the board in both Ascot's G1 Queen Anne S. in June and G2 Summer Mile S. in July, the bay was on the shelf until returning to finish second to Spirito del Vento in the G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein at Longchamp in October. He had raced only once since, trailing in the Mar. 6 G2 Jebel Hatta at Nad Al Sheba. Taken to the lead in the early stages by Davy Bonilla here, he was perfectly poised by the quarter pole and, after kicking there, had first run on his arch-rival, and that was enough to ensure the victory.

Kept to handicap company throughout his career, the bay had finished runner-up in the Listed Achilles S. at Kempton before filling the same spot in Ascot's Wokingham H. last June. Only 10th when favorite for the latest renewal of that prestigious prize at the Royal meeting June 21, he was seventh on his latest start in the July 5 G3 Sandown Sprint S. Settled towards the rear throughout the early stages by George Baker, he quickened impressively inside the final quarter to rush by Corrybrough before surging to a convincing success. "We've had some pretty good sprinters over the last few years, and when he gets things right, he is pretty good," trainer Hughie Morrison said. Click for the Racing Post chart.

The seven-year-old veteran Lava Man proved he still had some life in those old legs in his latest when he was beaten just a neck when third in the 10-furlong GI Charlie Whittingham H. at Hollywood June 7. Still, he hasn't won in five starts since taking last summer's GI Hollywood Gold Cup, and connections hope he can reacquaint himself with the winner's circle scaling back to a flat mile. Storm Military hasn't quite lived up to expectations for the Bobby Frankel barn. The Argentine import seems to be rounding into form, however, running second in the GIII Dallas Turf Cup at Lone Star May 25 and again in the nine-furlong GII American H. at Hollywood June 28. He's one-for-four at today's distance. Ferneley is an interesting addition to the race. The four-year-old grandson of Danzig has been campaigned in Europe, and makes his stateside debut for trainer Frank Ennis. He was a two-length winner of the G3 Amethyst S. at Leopardstown in May, then ran third and fifth in listed stakes at the Irish track.

Quijano returns to his native land after annexing the June 15 G1 Gran Premio di Milano on his European return. Since his breakthrough win in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden in September, the six-year-old has held his own in the top international events, and can lay claim to being his country's leading performer. Third in the G1 Canadian International last October, he was runner-up in the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December before returning to Nad Al Sheba.

Fifth in the Mar. 6 G3 Dubai City of Gold and fourth in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, he was fifth again back in Hong Kong for the Apr. 27 G1 QEII Cup before his San Siro success. Last year's G1 Deutsches Derby hero **Adlerflug** has taken time to come to himself this term, and steps back into the highest level for the first time since finishing runner-up in the Grosser Preis von Baden. Carrying a penalty when seventh in the G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne Apr. 27 and third in Hamburg's G2 Hansa-Preis last time June 29, he is weighted to reverse placings from that latter contest with the first and second, respectively, **Egerton** and **It's Gino**.

Darkley Flying Start

DARLEY FLYING START DEBATES Wednesday, July 16, 2008 Keeneland Race Course

by Alan Carasso

The 12 individuals--10 men and two women--which comprise the 2007 class of Darley "Flying Starters," paid a visit to Keeneland Race Course the afternoon of July 16 to engage in lively debate on an eclectic selection of topics. Each student had 12 minutes to build their case and a two-minute rebuttal at the conclusion. To follow is a brief capsule of each presentation.



Topic 1: Dosage Proposing--Kyle Wilson, USA; Opposing--lan Tapp Winner--lan Tapp

Wilson spoke in favor of the use of Dr. Steven Roman's dosage index and his center of distribution computation, suggesting that its application could extend into breeding decisions, to assess the precocity of young horses and even in handicapping. Tapp refuted the notion, claiming that the idea that a mathematical equation can shed any light on the distance limitations or abilities of the Thoroughbred is ludicrous. Dosage, Tapp asserts, considers so little and overlooks too much and is of little use.



Topic 2: Horse Management "By the Sign" Proposing--Darren Fox, Ireland; Opposing--Liam Howley, Australia Winner--Liam Howley

As curious as it may sound, Fox proposed that there is a small segment of horsepeople who use the Farmer's Almanac and zodiacal constructs in arriving at decisions about their horses. That a zodiacal chart is printed even today in trade publications is evidence. Fox explained that there are specified times to undertake certain procedures, i.e. castration should take place while the moon is waning (the period between a full and new moon), adding that there is reputed to be less bleeding and less stress on the animal. He reported that if gelding takes place while the moon is waxing (new moon to full moon), that horses can "bleed like a stuck pig."

Howley summed up his argument in his first line--"Are you kidding me, ladies and gentlemen?" Howley questioned how and why the 200-year-old almanac, available for \$7, should or could be trusted in any matter, much less the management of valuable Thoroughbreds.



Topic 3: May/June Foals Proposing--Mick Flanagan, Ireland; Opposing--James McHale, United Kingdom Winner--Mick Flanagan

Flanagan floated the idea that the breeding season in this hemisphere be pushed back to April 1, and that foals born during the months of May and June are "the way Mother Nature intended it to be." He suggested that by pushing back foaling dates, the current trend of overproduction could be reversed or corrected, given that only the best mares would be bred. Only one January foal, Flanagan said, has won the Epsom Derby since 1962, and "late" foals have won six of the last 15 Belmont S., including Touch Gold and Lemon Drop Kid. McHale argued strongly in opposition, stating that foals produced this late are at risk developing poorly and are considerably less able to handle stressful activity or situations. They are far less likely to have success at the track, he claims, and are less appealing, commercially and otherwise.

Topic 4: Astrology/Horse Horoscopes Proposing--Leif Aaron, USA Opposing--Jordyn Brand, USA; Winner--J Brand

Aaron took a very tongue-in-cheek approach, saying that the moon, the sun, the planets and the starts exact some sort of influence on horses as well as humans. Each horse, Aaron states, has characteristics based on the signs of the zodiac, and presented examples of contemporary horses born under each sign. Though he admits it is not a true science and does not offer definitive answers, Aaron encourages horsepeople to check out the horoscopes to see what is happening with their horses. Brand counter-argued that just 0.00002 percent of people in the Western world have attempted to study horoscopes on a scientific level. Book after book is available filled with page after page of horoscopes, all of which is useless. The "insights" offered are so broad and vague as to render them completely meaningless.

Topic 5: Kiniesiology: Stride Analysis and Biomechanics Proposing--Jana Kroutilikova, Czech Rep.; Opposing--Jason Walsh, Australia Winner-Jason Walsh

Kroutilikova took the lead on this interesting subject, saying that the firms that specialize in this type of information are able to quantify characteristics such as the size of a horse's heart and the size and scope of a horse's stride. After all, Kroutilikova offers, a longer and more powerful stride is consistent with success at the races. This is an especially beneficial tool as it applies to two-year-old sales and helps prospective buyers pick out promising individuals. Walsh was a little more skeptical and explained that these measurements are inaccurate to begin with, given that it takes an average of 12 seconds to get a full stride analysis. Given that the vast majoritiy of works at under-tack shows are faster than that mark, it is mathematically impossible get a perfect analysis. Just because a horse has a good stride doesn't necessarily mean he's a great horse, i.e. just because he has a stride like Secretariat does not make him Secretariat. It is also what's in their heart and their brain that also contributes to making a great horse.

Topic 6: Nicks Proposing--Cathal Beale, Ireland; Opposing--Andrew Williiams, New Zealand Winner--Cathal Beale

Nicks are increasingly available through products such as eNicks and True Nicks, and Cathal believes it to be a useful tool. It is helpful to owers and breeders to know which sires have worked well with mares by a certain sire and to what extent the matings have proven successful. For example, to know that A.P. Indy has crossed 'x' well with mares by Quiet American is beneficial when compared to other broodmare sires. Williams is diametrically opposed to the product and is against it as a tool. The nicks are just "commercial" products used by "novice" breeders are relied upon far

too heavily. One of the products, Williams explains, creates a grade for stakes horses only and the percentages are based solely on that, not the whole pool of winners.

While technically there was a declared winner and loser in each debate, each of the "Flying Starters" demonstrated


