#### MONZANTE MOTORS TO EDDIE READ SCORE

His late run came up a neck short in the June 7 GI Charlie Whittingham H. at Hollywood, but **Monzante**

(Maria's Mon) had just enough real estate to work with in Sunday's GI Eddie Read H. Content to trail the tightly bunched field through a half in :48.21 and six panels in 1:11.79, the grey gelding unleashed a furious late run as they raced down the lane. Whatsthescript (Ire) (Royal Applause {GB}), the 17-10 chalk, had taken over from pacesetter Storm Military (Arg) (Bernstein) inside the eighth pole, but he couldn't hold off the charge of Monzante,

who surged past to take it by a half-length. "I had the perfect trip," jockey Rafael Bejarano said. "When I saw the one and the six [Lava Man and Storm Military] asking early on, I knew I was in good shape. I was down inside and saving and I felt real good. I know what kind of kick this horse has and I was ready with it." Lava Man (Slew City Slew), third in a three-way photo in the Whittingham, faded after pressing the pace to be sixth. Cont. p2

#### ADLERFLUG TAKES FLIGHT

Gestut Schlenderhan's homebred Adlerflug (Ger) (In the Wings {GB}), winner of last year's G1 Deutsches

Derby, posted the mild upset over **Quijano (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}) in a driving rain in yesterday's G1 Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf. The colt, whose name means 'Flight of the Eagle,' made all over the rain-soaked conditions and left no doubt as to who was best on the day, defeating the favorite by a resounding seven-length margin. "Today he finally had a suitable going, so we had to be lucky once," said winning trainer Jens Hirschberger. "It was not planned for



#### **BELMONT CANCELS SUNDAY CARD**

Sunday's live card at Belmont Park was called off due to electrical problems. A transformer fire in the basement of the track Saturday morning forced a temporary evacuation and the closure of the grandstand area. Saturday's program went off as planned, but the disruption in power from the fire continued to cause problems Sunday, particularly with the air conditioning system, and the card was scrapped. Sunday was to be closing day of the Belmont spring/summer meet. The 2008 season at Saratoga opens Wednesday.





#### Eddie Read H. cont. Making the Grade...

Monzante started his career in Britain, but managed just one win in six starts. He was shipped to the U.S. after finishing sixth in the Listed Fairway S. at Newmarket in May of 2007. The four-year-old put in one stateside appearance last year and made it count, taking a Hollywood allowance on the Cushion Track Nov. 25. He was kept to synthetic surfaces for his first four starts of 2008, missing the board twice, but running third in the GII Strub S. Feb. 2 and winning the Santana Mile H. Mar. 8. Connections opted to switch him to the grass after a sixth in the Apr. 26 GII Mervyn Leroy H. at Hollywood, and Monzante responded with that rallying second in the Whittingham. The Kentuckybred was shortening up from that 10-panel test yesterday, but sat a little closer early, and came with a perfectly timed late run that got the job done. "We're going to stay on the turf and we'll probably run here or at Oak Tree," trainer Mike Mitchell said. "We're going to aim for the [GI] Breeders' Cup Mile. That's his best distance." Jockey Tyler Baze said of last-placed Lava Man, "I had a perfect trip. He's sound; he's happy. They just might be a little too tough for him right now." The most expensive sales two-year-old of 2008, Darley Stable's Desert Party (Street Cry {Ire}) looked worth every penny of his \$2.1 million purchase price when breaking his maiden by a handy 3 3/4 lengths at

Arlington June 22 (video). Drawn on the outside in the 4 1/2furlong test, he was floated wide on the turn, but needed only mild encouragement to catch the leaders at the top of the lane, and was taken in hand late to earn

Trainer Eoin Harty is hopeful the colt will handle the jump in class. "He broke his maiden very impressively. Granted, the competition will be considerably stiffer at Saratoga, but breaking your maiden from the 10 hole at Arlington is pretty tough to do," Harty said yesterday. "You break right on the turn. But he showed a good turn of foot, a good burst of speed, and we're hoping he replicates that performance at Saratoga." Desert Party had an easy work at Keeneland last Monday, going five-eighths in 1:03 2/5, then shipped to Saratoga. He stretched his legs over the main track at the Spa Saturday, getting five furlongs in 1:00 flat, second-fastest of 27 moves at the distance. "He had a very good work over the track [Saturday] morning, and he seems to be in top shape," Harty said.

Adlerflug bagged a career high when taking out the 138th renewal of the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg last year, but had his colors lowered by Quijano when tackling older opposition in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden in September, his final sophomore outing. Coming back to finish seventh under a penalty in the Apr. 27 G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne, he ran third with a similar burden in the June 29 G2 Hansa-Preis back at Hamburg last time, and exacted revenge on Quijano with a stunning performance in the deep mud here. Seizing the initiative, Adlerflug cut through the driving rain to set the pace from the outset. He was pushed along by Fredrik Johansson off the home turn, quickened clear of toiling rivals approaching the final furlong and maintained a relentless gallop in the closing stages to open up daylight on a quality cast. "He could now run in the [Sept. 7 G1] Grosser Preis von Baden, and he is also entered in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 5]," said trainer Jens Hirschberger. 

J J the Jet Plane registered a first top-level success in the May 3 G1 Computaform Sprint at Turrfontein, and doubled that tally with an easy score in the May 31 G1 Golden Horse Casino Sprint at Scottsville. Setting the seal on his position as the nation's leading sprinter in this, he tore up the field to complete the hat-trick in track-record time. Handily placed in the early stages, J J the Jet Plane seized the contest by the scruff of the neck when taking the lead with a half mile to run. Traveling smoothly in front, he was not for catching once surging clear of the pack approaching the final furlong and coasted to the wire in hand for another easy win. He will now transfer to the Mike de Kock stable and will prepare for an international campaign, including a tilt at the Dec. 14 G1 Hong Kong Sprint at Sha Tin.

Saturday's GII San Diego H. was a "Win and You're In" event for the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile,

but trainer Eoin Harty said yesterday that the winner of the 1 1/16-mile test, Well Armed (Tiznow), will stretch out for his next start, the Aug. 24 GI Pacific Classic going 10 panels at Del Mar. "We will probably keep him out here on the West Coast, on the

synthetic track," Harty said, adding, "Right now, the plan is to aim for the Breeders' Cup

Classic--the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile is Plan B." Making his first start since a solid third-place finish in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai World Cup, Well Armed wired the field in the San Diego, and was none the worse for the wear yesterday. "It looks like he came out of the race in good order," Harty added. "He ate up, and he seems guite happy this morning." The five-year-old gelding, bred and raced by WinStar, became a millionaire with Saturday's victory; his bankroll now stands at \$1,030,830.

#### Smooth Air Back Home and at Work at Calder:

Mount Joy Stable's Smooth Air (Smooth Jazz) breezed an easy five furlongs in 1:02 2/5 Sunday morning at Calder Race Course for trainer Bennie Stutts Jr.,



posting his first workout since romping to a four-length victory in the GII Ohio Derby at Thistledown May 31. "We got back here about 10 days ago," said the veteran horsemen, who took Smooth Air and three-year-old Horsephotos filly stablemate Cubs Fan to Arlington Park to train after the

Ohio Derby victory. Mount Joy owner Brian Burns and his family live in Chicago. Smooth Air was originally being considered for the \$250,000 lowa Derby at Prairie Meadows in late June, but he was forced to miss that spot. "It was a great run going to the Kentucky Derby [where he finished 11th after a rough start behind Big Brown], and then winning the Ohio Derby, but things just didn't work out for him after that," said Stutts. "He had some little foot problems and one thing and another, but he seems to be happy to be back home on the track that he was developed over, and his trainer is, too." Stutts added, "If all goes well, there is enough time to get ready for the [\$1-million GII] Pennsylvania Derby [Sept. 1 at Philadelphia Park], although there is no rush if he isn't ready for that."






