ONE-HORSE PARTY IN THE SANFORD

Desert Party (Street Cry {Ire}), who fetched \$2.1 million from Darley earlier this year at Fasig-Tipton Calder, splashed his way home to a decisive 3 1/4-length victory over **Officer Ipod** (Officer) in yesterday's GII Sanford S. at the Spa. Tabbed as a **"TDN Rising Star"** following his eye-catching unveiling at Arlington Park June 22, he lined up as the heavy favorite in this field of four. Ridden by Edgar Prado, the bay pressed the early leader Officer Ipod from the inside through an opening quarter of :22.78. Desert Party dropped back to trail the field approaching the turn for home after Prado slightly tapped on the breaks, but it didn't seem to make a difference, as he re-rallied along the fence in the stretch to report home a much-the-best winner.

Youngster Overcomes Adversity...

With only one start under his belt, Desert Party seemed to handle the trouble on the turn for home all in stride. "I was lucky a little bit on the far turn, but he's that kind of horse, you know," jockey Edgar Prado offered. "It was just a matter of time when I could find a hole--even if the rail didn't open up, I think he still would have won the race. He was very responsive. He came running out of the gate and relaxed beautifully. When I pressed the pedal again, he was there for me. I like this horse. I like the way he came back--he wasn't blowing too much. He really acted like an old pro. For only running one time, he handled everything very well." Trainer Eoin Harty confirmed that Desert Party would remain at Saratoga and start next in the GI Hopeful S. Sept. 1. "This colt's biggest asset is his turn of foot," Harty said. "I told Edgar not to hustle him away from there; to give him a chance [so when] you call on him, he can run for you. I had a pretty anxious moment on the turn--I thought I'd lost all chance there. I was very concerned about the wet track. My wife [Kathleen] told me to run. I have to give her full credit. She told me not to weaken. [But] we came over for the first couple of races and the track was surprisingly good."

A single-digit taskforce lines up for Europe's midsummer championship for the third straight year--coinciding with the absence of the Classic generation during the same period--after a field of eight was declared yesterday. Aidan O'Brien's Ballydoyle base sends out a team of three seeking to improve on a record of 13 Group 1 successes this term. It consists of ante-post favorite **Duke of Marmalade**, a three-time Group 1 winner in 2008; fellow Royal Ascot winner **Macarthur**; and likely pacesetter **Red Rock Canyon**. Connections of multiple Group 1 winner **Youmzain**--who tackles top-level company for the 11th time in succession--will be hoping the latter does adopt the rabbit's role. "In France last time [in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud], they went fast and, if you have that pace, he never runs a bad race," jockey Richard Hughes told *Attheraces*. "He ran a blinder in a true-run race in the Arc and was just beaten by Dylan Thomas, one of the best horses of the last 10 years. We went to Dubai and got no pace and, when I rode him third or fourth in an ordinary Group 1 in Germany, he didn't finish. When they go slow, you have to ride him out of his ground and if there is no pace then we have to try and find another way of getting him going. Usually when he passes two or three tailers it gives him something to run at and he finishes really strong. If they go fast, I'll have no worries at all. I enjoy riding him and get a real kick out of it."

Pass was confirmed in the race this morning and is an intended runner at this stage," Gosden said. "We will take a look at the shape of the field, but I would be hopeful of another good run. The ground shouldn't be an issue--good, good to firm, good to soft, they all suit him." Aidan O'Brien has five engaged and, alongside Henrythenavigator, he could run the G1 July Cup second and fourth **US Ranger** (Danzig) and **Astronomer Royal** (Danzig). Peter Chapple-Hyam has left in a duo headed by the Comic Strip Heroes's **Winker Watson (GB)** (Piccolo {GB}), and Mark Johnston is responsible for Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed Al Maktoum's G1 Falmouth S. heroine **Nahoodh (Ire)** (Clodovil {Ire}). One who will not be lining up is Godolphin's multiple Group 1 hero

Ramonti (Fr) (Martino Alonso {Ire}), who was reported to be suffering from the hind leg infection that had kept him off the track until this month.

Ballydoyle continue to fly high and enjoyed further pattern success here with King of Rome, who had been the choice of Johnny Murtagh for the G1 Epsom Derby. However, he was only 12th in that June 7 Classic, and got going too late when third in the Listed Hampton Court S. at Royal Ascot 12 days later. Tackling heavy ground in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 6, he failed to land a blow in sixth, but had all in his favor in this return to his native country. The bay tracked the tempo set by his barnmate King of Westphalia (Kingmambo), took over at the quarter pole and safely held the veterans Lord Admiral and Mustameet in the closing stages.
