FOREVER TOGETHER TAKES DIANA

Three starts after being switched to the turf, Forever

Together (Belong to Me) took down a top-class field to land the GI Diana S. at Saratoga yesterday afternoon. "As far as depth goes, this race was solid," said winning trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "I picked up the paper, and she had beaten four of the horses picked over her in her last start." Champion Wait a While (Maria's Mon),

sent off as the 3-1 favorite in her first start since January, loomed in the stretch, but flattened out to finish seventh. "She didn't run like we thought she was going to," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "We're going to take her back to the barn and make sure everything is okay." Cont. p2

THE YEAR OF THE DUKE

Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Duke of Marma-lade (Ire)** (Danehill) made it four Group 1s in a row yesterday when getting the better of **Papal Bull (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) after a thrilling tussle in Ascot's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S.

Attempting the mile and a half for the first time, the 4-6 favorite looked set to surrender his winning sequence as Olivier Peslier swooped on the 14-1 shot inside the final furlong, but Duke of Marmalade rallied under Johnny

Murtagh to prove his stamina and provide Ballydoyle with a 14th success at this level in 2008. Passing the £1-million mark in the process, he dragged the runner-up a huge nine lengths clear of the next best **Youmzain** (Ire) (Sinndar {Ire}). "It's another huge win for me and a huge win for the team," Murtagh said. "I would rate this horse as good as Dylan Thomas (Ire), if not better, and he doesn't lack for anything. He probably won't get the plaudits, as he doesn't look spectacular, but he's always got loads in hand. He's a true champion and one of the best I've ridden." **Cont. p3**

A \$27,000 KEESEP yearling who matured into a \$240,000 OBSMAR juvenile, Forever Together kicked off her career with three straight victories, including the GII Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream. Her perfect record came to an end when she missed by a neck in the GII Stonerside Beaumont S. at Keeneland. The grey hit the board just once in her next four outings, all on the main track, and trainer Jonathan Sheppard opted to freshen her up following a fourth in a seven-furlong optional claimer at Gulfstream Feb. 15. Forever Together resurfaced on the lawn at Arlington to annex the one-mile Reluctant Guest S. May 17, and gave a very good account of herself when third at 44-1 in the GI Just a Game S. on the Belmont undercard June 7. She arrived in Saratoga earlier this month and signaled her readiness for this contest with a bullet five-furlong breeze in 1:01 2/5 over the Oklahoma track July 23.

Longshot Bayou's Lassie (Outflanker) opened a lonely lead as 9-1 Forever Together caboosed the field along with Rutherienne. The field began to gather on the far turn, with Dynaforce getting first run on the tiring pacesetter. Forever Together moved to the center of the course in the lane, set her sights on second-choice Dynaforce and forged past her in the final strides. "I was last [early], but it was nothing spectacular," said winning rider Julien Leparoux. "I mean, she was last, relaxed, and around the stretch I thought to make a move and come inside. When I got her out, she just took off. So, that was very good." The Diana winner earns an automatic berth in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf Oct. 24 at Santa Anita, and that looks to be the path for Forever Together. "Going from a mile and an eighth to 11 furlongs, you would like a mile and a quarter race somewhere in between," Sheppard added. "The [GI] Flower Bowl [at Belmont Sept. 27] might be such a race." As for his charge's newfound stardom on grass, Sheppard offered, "We seemed to have a preponderance of turf horses in the barn, and if we find one that seems to be doing okay on the dirt, it gives us some diversity. Mr. [George] Strawbridge jokes, 'Why do we have nothing but turf horses?' and now we have another one. Whatever we do, we seem to wind up in the same spot." It was the second Diana trophy for Strawbridge and Sheppard, who teamed up with Ratings to take the 1993 renewal as part of jockey Julie Krone's historic five-win day. Dr. John Chandler's homebred Dynaforce stayed on for second following a similar effort in her U.S. bow in the GII New York H. She was bidding to give trainer Bill Mott his fourth consecutive Diana, following My Typhoon (Ire), Angara (GB) and Sand Springs. "She ran her heart out," said Mott. "She was in great position. She was where we wanted her, right behind the pace. She just got caught in the end."

While nobody questioned the ability of Duke of Marmalade following his four-length score in the June 18 G1 Prince of Wales's S. at the Royal meeting on his latest start, his staying power for this stiff test remained an unknown. For much of last year, the strapping bay had tackled the top mile events, and he had only raced beyond 10 furlongs on one occasion, when annexing the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup over an extra 110 yards at The Curragh May 25. The pace factor had become the main issue leading up to this showpiece, but that was settled when the stable's third-string Red Rock Canyon (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) was sent on by Colm O'Donoghue. Restrained in fifth off the solid tempo, Duke of Marmalade was unleashed widest of all at the top of the stretch and appeared to have settled the result with a dramatic turn of acceleration. Papal Bull matched that burst and, by the time they had reached the furlong marker, the mercurial character held a definite advantage, but the Duke dug in against the fence to get back in front in the final 50 yards.

"We knew we had the best horse, so we wanted no hard-luck stories," winning jockey Johnny Murtagh said. "He settled well and that gave him every chance of staying. When I went to the front very easily and quickened up very well, I was surprised to see a horse come with me. He got a neck up on me, but my horse has all the qualities of a great horse and soon had the measure of him. He's a great battler with a will to win, and I love the way he gets his head down and eats the ground. The race worked out very well for me, and to go nine lengths clear of the third tells you what the first two are capable of." Aidan O'Brien, now looking to return the winner to a mile and a quarter, added, "We weren't sure he would stay a mile and a half, but we wanted a strong, evenly run race to find out. It is very unusual to get a horse to show the class he has over a mile and a mile and a half. Johnny hadn't really gone for everything when the runner-up came at him and, when he picked him up, he really answered and won snug in the end." Looking head, O'Brien remarked, "Everything is an option, but I'd love to drop him back to a mile and a quarter and train him positively, rather than keeping him asleep. The G1 Juddmonte International S. [at York Aug. 19] and G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 6] are there for him." The Bull Run...

So far in 2008, Papal Bull is the only horse to have given Duke of Marmalade a serious worry, but jockey Olivier Peslier was left ruing having taken that rival on as early as the furlong pole. Peslier suggested that the result may have been different had he not committed so soon, but added, "The owners have asked me to ride him in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [Oct. 5] and I have agreed. I also feel he could do well in the Japan Cup." Trainer Mick Channon confirmed that last year's Arc runner-up Youmzain will be back at Longchamp in a bid to go one better. "He's run another solid race, but he didn't get the best of luck and it cost us momentum," Channon said. "He got turned round sideways a furlong and a half out, but he will be back for the Arc and will have a little break beforehand."

Left alone on the lead, Commentator made every pole a winning one to add another Whitney trophy following his memorable success in 2005, when he defeated eventual Horse of the Year Saint Liam by a neck. In doing so, he became the first runner to win two renewals of this marquee affair since the venerable Kelso, who won in 1961, 1963 and 1965. "This is a special win for me," exclaimed winning trainer Nick Zito. "This has to be up there with the greatest of them all. I am thankful to have a horse of this caliber." Zito added, "He gets in that league with Kelso and Forego, which I wanted him to be in so they couldn't take him out." At age seven, Commentator is second only to Kelso, who was eight when he won his third Whitney.

Commentator was limited to just two starts at five in 2006, dusting New York-breds in the Mugatea S. before faltering to 10th as the 4-5 chalk in the GI Forego S. After another triumph against state-breds to kick off 2007, the chestnut came up short against the nation's best sprinters, finishing sixth in the GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. and seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 27. But he seems to have discovered the fountain of youth this season. The New York-bred set a track record at Gulfstream in a one-mile optional claimer in his Jan. 17 return; his 119 Beyer Speed Figure remains the highest achieved to date in 2008. A 13 3/4length winner of the GII Richter Scale H. at 1-5 Mar. 8, he battled through a :44 2/5 half in the GI Met Mile before succumbing late to Divine Park, and settled for second. Commentator continued to train smartly on the Oklahoma track, and went postward as the 4-1 second choice to Solar Flare (Salt Lake). The 120-pound highweight scampered away from his rail post and was allowed a cushion through splits of :24.16 and :47.73. Solar Flare tried to cut into that margin on the far turn, but began to fade in the lane, and Commentator opened

up once more under a few unnecessary taps from John Velazquez. "He got to the front, and that was it," said Velazquez. "He ran just as big as he did three years ago." Zito added, "He's an amazing horse. I think the theme should be, 'If you get old, don't give up.' This is a seven-year-old gelding winning this kind of race against this kind of field-there were 11 horses in this

field. This was no easy race, and he was carrying the top weight." Student Council, well back early, put in a solid five-wide rally to finish second best. "We ran a very good race," said trainer Steve Asmussen. "Commentator, as usual at Saratoga, was very effective. Everybody made a run at him, but when he cut the corner, he was just gone."

Beaten just once in her last five starts, Eclipse Award and GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Ginger Punch bounced back from a third-place finished behind unbeaten Zenyatta in the Apr. 5 GI Apple Blossom H. with a 3 3/4-length victory in the May 2 GII Louisville H. The chestnut romped by 7 3/4 lengths in the June 14 GI Ogden Phipps H., and was a deserving 1-5 favorite to successfully defend her Go for Wand title yesterday. Jockey Rafael Bejarano tucked the champ in at the rail as she tracked Moon Catcher (Malibu Moon) through a leisurely six panels in 1:14.04. It looked like the groundsaving tactics might prove costly, as Ginger Punch found herself boxed in on the far turn, but she shouldered her way between horses after they turned into the lane and spurted clear to assert her authority when it counted. "My filly showed me a big kick because she was a little mad, you know?" Bejarano said. The mare goes next in the Sept. 27 GI Beldame S. Storm Mesa needed five tries to finally get her picture taken, but has been unstoppable in five subsequent outings. Her first stakes success came courtesy of a 13 1/2-length romp in the Cinemine S. at Lone Star May 26--earning a 108 Beyer Speed Figure--and she added a wire-to-wire score in the GIII lowa Oaks June 27 at Prairie Meadows in her latest. Sent to California and trying turf for the first time, the dark bay had a good spot early from post two, but lost ground on the backstretch. She shifted to the outside turning for home and rallied smartly up the center of the course to keep her winning streak alive. "There's a good chance she'll stay [for the GI Del Mar Oaks Aug. 16]," said winning trainer Bret Calhoun. "There's a plane leaving here on July 30, so we'll make a decision by then on whether we'll take her back or leave her here. Off this race, I don't know why we wouldn't run in the Oaks." Abraai made his stakes debut in last year's renewal of this contest, but bobbled at the start, then was bumped en route to an eighth-place effort, and found himself on the sidelines. The bay returned to action with a towering six-length score over Stormin Normandy and Bishop Court Hill in an optional claimer May 2, and came up just a half-length short when third to Benny the Bull in the GII True North H. June 7 at Belmont. The lightly raced Sammarco (Johannesburg) outbroke the field and hustled through a :22.06 opening quarter while chased by Black Seventeen (Is It True) and, further back, First Defence. Abraaj raced in fourth, but looked to be under a ride on the turn. While First Defence had first run on the pacesetter when Black Seventeen began to tire, he looked reluctant to take over. Abraai shifted into gear, rallying past the leaders in midstretch for his first stakes success. He joins Shadwell's Lucky Island (Arg) as another sharp sprinter in the Kiaran McLaughlin barn. On the face of his short-head defeat of Alhaban in that course-and-distance June 29 contest, which has thrown up two of the last four winners of this, he needs to improve to trouble the British raider Art Connoisseur. Also unbeaten, he used his electric acceleration to win the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 17, and that marks him as the one to beat. Trainer Michael Bell believes he has the right credentials to loosen the domestic stronghold. He's a very smart horse who looked the real deal at Ascot and he's done nothing but please us at home since, so we've got no reason not to be confident. He's won on soft, but will be suited by fast ground." David Wachman, who stopped the Aidan O'Brien run of success with the filly Damson (Ire) four years ago, relies on Bushranger. Second when running away from the stands-rail bias in the Listed Windsor Castle S. at Royal Ascot June 17, he beat Mastercraftsman's well-touted stable companion Westphalia (Ire) by 2 1/2 lengths in the July 12 G3 Anglesey S. here last time. "He seems to be in really good form, so we decided we would let him take his chance," his conditioner told PA Sport. "He was really impressive last time, but it was only a fortnight ago and we haven't done an awful lot with him since. This does look a seriously hot race, and time will tell if he is up to this class."
