FRESHMAN SIRE PLEASANTLY PERFECT HIS WINNER RAPID REDUX IS 3RD IN TYRO S. AT MONMOUTH

BROWN PLUS SIX IN HASKELL

A field of seven sophomores, largely overshadowed by the return of GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. winner **Big Brown** (Boundary), was entered yesterday for Sunday's 41st running of the GI Haskell Invitational



at Monmouth Park. Big Brown, looking to rebound from a disappointing effort in the GI Belmont S., will break from post four and was installed the 1-2 morning-line favorite. "We're eagerly anticipating this race," said Michael lavarone, head of the colt's co-

Cool Coal Man Equi-Photo owner IEAH Stables. "If it's possible, he's training better than he did before he won the Kentucky Derby." Nick Zito, who saddled Da' Tara to an upset win in the June 7 Belmont, will look to upset the Derby winner again, this time with the duo of **Cool Coal Man** (Mineshaft) and **Coal Play** (Mineshaft). Cool Coal

Man, the 4-1 second choice in the Haskell, is coming off a narrow victory over Atoned (Repent) in Monmouth's June 14 Spend A Buck S. Of Cool Coal Man's two post, Zito said, "I like the inside post for him. I'm hoping he can save ground and run a nice race." Todd Pletcher will be looking for an unprecedented third straight Haskell win when he saddles Atoned Sunday. The colt has only won twice in 12 lifetime starts, but has been runner-up seven times. Both career wins have come at Monmouth. "I

don't know whether he's been unlucky or underachieving or overachieving," Pletcher said. "We're trying to figure that out. We're putting blinkers on him for this race to see if we can get him more focused. He's performed so well every time we've run him that we feel he deserves a chance in a race as prestigious as the Haskell." *Full Field p7*

ANOTHER CUP FOR YEATS

Yeats (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), fresh off a record-tying third G1 Gold Cup win at Royal Ascot, made light work of a five-pound penalty and eight foes to win a second G2 Goodwood Cup S. yesterday at Goodwood. The



seven-year-old met with a rare defeat in last October's G1 Prix du Cadran at Longchamp, but opened this campaign with a second victory in the Listed Vintage Crop S. at Navan Apr. 27. The sixvear-old added the Roval feature last time June 19, and was a class above yesterday's overmatched rivals to add to his 2006 score. Johnny Murtagh ideally positioned his mount in second from the bell, allowing Tungsten Strike (Smart Strike) to build a six-length advantage by halfway, but coaxed Yeats closer once into the stretch run. The champion smothered the brave pacesetter at the two pole and opened up daylight with the minimum of fuss from there to

break the £1-million barrier, enhancing

his impressive portfolio with a 12th stakes win. "He's a great horse, a true warrior and fair dues to the owners for keeping him in training," said Murtagh. "The crowds turned out to see him, and he did not let them down, although he's often done more on the gallops. He was fresh at Ascot, but today was much better as it was a more even pace. He has a very high cruising gear and when he gets into it, he can maintain it constantly. He truly is a great stayer." APPROACH NEARING RETURN Trainer Jim Bolger is looking to run New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) twice more in 2008, according to *Racing Post*. Revealing that Princess Haya of Jordan's G1 Epsom Derby hero was well on the road to recovery from a recent setback, the Coolcullen conditioner outlined a quartet of targets which are under consideration. "New Approach is coming along well," Bolger told the trade daily. "I'm not sure where his next race will be, but we are looking at the possibility of him having another couple of races this year. He's in the G1 Juddmonte International S. [at York Aug. 19], the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 6], the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 5] and the Breeders' Cup, and he may run in two of those races."

Terry Cooper's **Sergeant Cecil (GB)** (King's Signet--Jadidh {GB}, by Touching Wood) trailed in last of the

eight Goodwood Cup runners and was immediately retired. Now nine, the chestnut was France's highweighted stayer in 2006, when his victories included the G1 Prix du Cadran, G2 Doncaster Cup and G2 Lonsdale Cup, and he also ran third in the G1 Prix Royal-Oak that season. "He has been wonderful and has taken us to places we never dreamed of going," trainer

Rod Millman told *Racing Post*. "Him winning the Cadran on Arc weekend was probablythe most memorable day, along with his win in the 2005 Cesarewitch." Millman added, "He has been a credit to the girls who have looked after him but he is now nine, isn't getting any quicker and is racing against the best group of stayers there has been." Sergeant Cecil retires with a record of 53-10-14-6 and earnings of £828,127.

Runner-up in this contest last term, Enticing closed her sophomore campaign with another second in the G3 World Trophy at Newbury in September, and came back to run third in the May 4 G3 Palace House S. at Newmarket. Fifth in the May 24 G2 Temple S. at Haydock next time, she was beaten seven lengths when 12th in the G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot last time June 17, and hit the right note here to bag a third stakes success in impressive fashion. Enticing missed a beat at the break and raced in mid division through the furious early fractions. Easing into contention at halfway, the bay was set alight approaching the final furlong and found an irresistible surge inside the last 100 yards to prevail a shade cozily. "She's got two speeds; very slow and very fast," winning jockey Johnny Murtagh offered. "She's keen in five-furlong races, and she really does have a lot of speed, so [trainer William Haggas's wife] Maureen told me to get some cover today. I knew they wouldn't be going fast enough to lead her, and at halfway she came on the bridle. I got a lovely split and she quickened up well. It suited her today." 

Prolific brings proven group form to the party here, having finished third in both the G2 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 19 and G2 July S. at Newmarket last time July 10. He gets another shot at this trip over more suitably fast conditions. Godolphin are represented by Khor Dubai, who followed a Yarmouth maiden score July 3 with a conditions success at Lingfield 16 days later. "Khor Dubai pleased me with his performance at Lingfield and he has come out of the race really well," said trainer Saeed bin Suroor. Brian Meehan, who took this with Easycall (GB) in 1996 and Carrizo Creek (Ire) five years ago, looks to the impressive July 2 Chepstow maiden scorer **Gallagher** to continue the trend. Jeremy Noseda saddled Strike the Deal to win 12 months ago; he puts forward the Apr. 26 Leicester maiden winner Waffle. "Waffle has been working well, but it is a long time since his first start," said Noseda. "I hope he has enough experience for a race such as this." Mick Channon lines up another potential improving runner in Rileyskeepingfaith, who was soundly beaten when second on debut at Ascot July 11 before impressing with his attitude when getting the better of the smart Crackdown (Ire) in a decent Newmarket maiden 13 days ago. "He's always shown plenty in his work, but he was a bit green on his first run at Ascot," Channon told Racing Post. "But, like a lot of mine he learned plenty that day and did the job well at Newmarket."


Miss Macy Sue, third in last year's inaugural Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint, is looking to improve on a fourth-place effort in this race in 2007. The five-year-old mare was sixth in the May 3 GI Humana Distaff before a runnerup effort in the May 26 GIII Winning Colors S. at Churchill. She is coming off a six-length victory in the June 27 Saylorville S. at Prairie Meadows. "We gave her that layoff [after the Breeders' Cup] just to give her a rest," explained trainer Kelly Von Hemel, who is based at Prairie Meadows. "She didn't have any surgeries or anything like that. We brought her back in April and we probably rushed her a little bit to get her to the Humana Distaff. Her next race was the Winning Colors and she broke really slow. She couldn't overcome that, but she still managed to run second and got beat less than two lengths by Graeme Six." Graeme Six won stakes at Fair Grounds and Oaklawn this winter before running eighth in the Humana Distaff.

She has been off since winning the Winning Colors by 1 1/2 lengths. Godolphin's lightly raced **Zada Belle** has won three of four starts. Sidelined for 16 months after a nine-length maiden win at Santa Anita, the bay filly returned to take an optional claimer in Arcadia in February before suffering her lone loss when ninth in the Apr. 9 GII Madison S. She rebounded with a 6 3/4length win in a short four-horse field at Monmouth in a June 1 optional claimer.

TRUCK DRIVER'S FILLY TO GET 'TEST'

In November, breeders will spend six and seven figures on broodmare prospects at Keeneland's Breeding Stock sale in the hopes of producing a Grade I winner. But price isn't everything. Just ask owner/breeder Dean Hayes, whose Tequilas Dayjur (Dayjur) will be starting in Saturday's GI Test S. at Saratoga. Hayes, a truck driver who has worked for Sallee Van Lines for over 30 years, owns just one broodmare, a daughter of Astro named Tequilas First. The price tag on Tequilas First? Zero. She was a giveaway from the late Jere Smith Sr., who died in 2004. Hayes met Smith by hauling his horses between Arlington and Hawthorne. Tequilas Dayjur, the second foal out of Tequilas First, caught the eye of Hayes' cousin, who had been an exercise rider. "Two to three days after she was born, my cousin Tom Embry--who is 77-years-old--said, 'You got something there young man' when he saw her conformation," Hayes recalled. Tequilas Dayjur broke her maiden at 30-1 in her first start, despite breaking slow and losing six lengths. She boasts a record of 6-4-1-0 and has earned \$140,516. The dark bay was second in the GIII Chicago H. against older fillies and mares June 28 at Arlington in her last start. Tequilas Dayjur led approaching the final sixteenth but was collared by the five-yearold Leah's Secret, who was already a Grade II winner. "I was pleased with it," Hayes said of Tequilas Dayjur's effort. "She ran a nice race against older horses. [Leah's Secret] was just more seasoned.

There's no shame getting beat by her." Hayes is hopeful his filly will show "what she's made of" in the Test. "We'll see if she belongs with horses like Indian Blessing and the rest of the three-year-old fillies," he added. "We're going to crawl before we're going to walk and we're going to walk before we're going to run." Tequilas Dayjur races under the name of her owner, but in the future she'll race for Uddentown Stables. Hayes decided to name his racing operation after the African American community where he grew up, which is about eight miles outside of Lexington. -Jon Forbes


