FRENCH FILLIES VISIT TRAINING TRACK

The Rothschild Family's **Cicerole (Fr)** (Barathea {Ire}) and the Marguesa de Moratalla's Toque de Queda (GB) (Dansili {GB}), a pair of French-based four-year-old fillies making their respective U.S. debuts in Saturday's Beverly D., visited Arlington's training track vesterday morning for brief exercise after clearing guarantine following a Tuesday flight from Paris. Cicerole, trained by Jean Claude Rouget, captured her seasonal debut, the Listed Prix de Montretout at Longchamp in May, and comes into this off a good runner-up effort in the G3 Princess Elizabeth S. at Epsom July 7. Toque de Queda, conditioned by Mikel Delzangles, is still looking for her first stakes success. Third in last year's G3 Prix Chloe, she was most recently fourth in the G3 Prix Messidor at Maisons-Laffitte July 19.


TEN DRAWN FOR BEST PAL

A total of 10 two-year-olds have been entered in Sunday's GII Best Pal S. at Del Mar, included pro tem West Coast divisional leader Azul Leon (Lion Heart). Joseph Lacombe's homebred, who improved to two-fortwo with a four-length tally in the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship S., will likely go favored in the Best Pal, but trainer Mike Machowsky is confident he's holding a good hand. Machowsky's Kelly Leak (Runaway Groom), purchased for \$110,000 as an OBSMAR juvenile, rallied to capture his five-furlong debut at Hollywood June 5 in :57 3/5. He's unraced since, but is thriving at Del Mar, reports his conditioner. "He loves the track here," Machowsky said. "Victor [jockey Espinoza] has worked him several times and says he's doing better here than he ever did at Santa Anita." Machowsky added that he opted to skip the Hollywood Juvenile Championship and wait for this spot. "I wasn't interested in just getting a lot of races into him," he said. "I really was hoping to run him in an allowance race early in the meet, not in a race as tough as the Best Pal is going to be, but nothing filled."

IEAH ACQUIRES SECRETARIAT ENTRANT

PLAN IEAH Stables has acquired a controlling interest in GSW Plan (Storm Cat) -- a three-year-old son of GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Spain (Thunder Gulch)-who is slated to make his U.S. bow in Saturday's GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Park. Owned by Michael Tabor and trained by Aidan O'Brien, he was last seen defeating older horses in the G3 Keeneland International S. at the Curragh July 12. "Plan is a colt we were very excited to add to the stable," IEAH's Vice President of Investor Relations Mike Sherack told the TDN. "We'd seen video on him, and he looked like a colt who will never have a problem staying a distance of ground, as he kept coming in the stretch to beat older horses in his latest. [IEAH Senior Advisor] Gary Stevens also went overseas to get on him for us and everything added up. He indicated to us that American racing and firmer surfaces may also help his development, and that should be a plus. The Secretariat won't come easy, but it does look like a nice spot for him, and we're looking forward to seeing him run." Following the Secretariat, Plan will join trainer Richard Dutrow Jr's string at Saratoga. He will be trained by O'Brien for the Secretariat.

MIDNIGHT LUTE WORKS IN TRACK-RECORD

TIME They don't run for purse money in the morning, but if Midnight Lute (Real Quiet) continues to train like this, maybe that will change. Last year's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hero and division champion sailed through seven furlongs yesterday morning at Del Mar in 1:21.60, faster than the track record of 1:22.46 for the distance set by the filly Lethal Heat in Del Mar's Fleet Treat S. July 20. Jockey Martin Pedroza was aboard Midnight Lute, who is unraced since running second in last year's GI Cigar Mile. Trainer Bob Baffert, who was at Saratoga, has not yet said where Midnight Lute will return, but the Aug. 24 GII Pat O'Brien H. at Del Mar is reportedly a possibility. The trainer also has as an option the GI Forego H. at Saratoga Aug. 30. Two other sprinters who could wind up in the O'Brien -- Barbecue Eddie (Stormy Atlantic) and Johnny Eves (Skimming)--also worked Thursday morning at Del Mar. Barbecue Eddie, eighth in the GI Bing Crosby H. July 27, went a half-mile in :49.60, and Johnny Eves, seventh in the Crosby, was clocked in :57.80 for five furlongs, the best of 63 at the distance.

GIII Sham S., returns from an eight-month absence in today's third race at Saratoga, a thirdlevel allowance/ \$75,000 optional claimer going nine furlongs on the main track. Owned by Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith and trained by Todd Pletcher, Ravel was an early presence on the Triple Crown trail last


spring, but developed what appeared to be the beginnings of a fracture in his left fore and went to the sidelines. He returned late in the season to romp by five lengths in a Keeneland allowance in October, but could do no better than fourth, beaten 4 3/4 lengths by Heatseeker (Ire) as the favorite in the GIII Native Diver S. in December. He was fourth again, to Air Commander, in the Jan. 12 GII San Fernando S. Daily Racing Form reports the colt was again sidelined, this time with a serious eye injury. Ravel returned to the worktab in June and comes into this off a five-furlong breeze in 1:00 3/5 (5/42) at Saratoga Aug. 3.

SEEKING THE DIA TO STAND AT HILL 'N' DALE Hill 'n' Dale announced yesterday that sevenyear-old Seeking the Dia (Storm Cat--Seeking the Pearl, by Seeking the Gold) will join the stallion roster at the Lexington nursery for the 2009 season. A six-time stakes winner and four-time Japanese group winner, Seeking the Dia is Storm Cat's leading money earner with a bankroll of over \$5 million. He won the G2-Jpn New Zealand Trophy, where he ran the mile in 1:33 2/5 on turf, and G3-Jpn Arlington Cup, also on turf. Switched to dirt for his four-year-old year, he was second in consecutive runnings of the Japan Cup Dirt and captured the Nihon TV Hai S. and last year's Urawa Kinen S. He was named co-highweight on dirt in Japan. Bred by Jayeff 'B' Stables, Seeking the Dia is a son of G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest heroine and European champion Seeking the Pearl. "We are extremely pleased to be able to offer a horse like Seeking the Dia to American breeders," said Hill 'n' Dale's John G. Sikura. "We live in an ever-shrinking world, and this horse is the complete package who, similar to Heatseeker (Ire), should garner a true international audience. He was an elite performer from a great female family. He's by Storm Cat and really looks the part." A stud fee has not yet been determined.

Keeneland Partners with HOK Sport to Develop Site:

Officials at Keeneland announced vesterday that it has contracted with HOK Sport, a leading sports architecture firm, to develop a master plan for the current and future use of its facility. As part of the process, HOK will undertake a review and assessment of Keeneland's existing facilities and operations. A release said the goal of the project is to enhance the "Keeneland experience" for racing, sales and simulcast guests and the community. Nicholson acknowledged that he is frequently asked about the possibility of Keeneland hosting a Breeders' Cup World Championship, and that accommodating the event is an ancillary aspect of the master plan project. "We would be honored to host the Breeders' Cup at Keeneland, and we have asked HOK Sport to build that consideration into their development plans," he said. "It would be very exciting to have the championship in Central Kentucky, and we would be remiss if we didn't explore the opportunity. The facility review will provide guidance as to its feasibility."


