CHANGES FOR GRADED STAKES ELIGIBILITY

The Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association (TOBA) American Graded Stakes Committee announced two new eligibility requirements for U.S. graded races. Beginning in 2009, states or racetracks must adopt the Association of Racing Commissioners International (ARCI) model rule on androgenic anabolic steroids by Jan. 1, or the state/racetrack's first graded race in 2009. Similarly, states/racetracks must abide by the ARCI model rule for toe grabs on front shoes. In both cases, if the model rules are not adopted, then the races in question will lose their graded status. However, they will be eligible for grading once the rules are in place. "There has been much discussion recently about how any recommendations put forth by various groups could be implemented given Thoroughbred racing's fractured organizational structure," said TOBA President Dan Metzger. "The Committee members feel strongly about these two issues and determined that they should be implemented in graded stakes by expanding the conditions of eligibility." The AGSC also announced that, beginning Jan. 1, the drug testing protocol has been expanded to include alkalinizing agents in graded races. All racehorses entered in graded events will have blood samples drawn prior to the race in accordance with the Racing and Medication Testing Consortium. Jurisdictions will determine the testing method. Races will lose graded status if this testing is not done.






STORM KO'S SARATOGA RACING A severe summer thunderstorm, complete with heavy rain, hail and lightning, washed out part of the main track at Saratoga Race Course, forcing the cancellation of racing after Friday's second race. The final eight races of the day were cancelled, including the \$80,000 Waya for older fillies and mares at a mile and a half on the turf. "Even after an hour, there was no guarantee that the track would be up to standard," NYRA President Charles E. Hayward said after track maintenance crews had to work on wash-out spots between the quarter-pole and the five-sixteenths pole. "The threat of more storms was real, and we decided to cancel for the safety of the horses, the jockeys and the fans." Patrons were given a two-part rain check for admission and program upon exiting the facility, which remained open for simulcasting. Exchange of reserved seats will be granted for future dates, based on availability. NYRA will also honor exchange of Daily Racing Form and/or program on any day within the next two weeks. The last time racing was cancelled at the Spa was Aug. 2, 2006, when severe heat and humidity forced the cancellation of Saratoga's entire nine-race card. That decision to cancel was also an historic one, marking the first time in memory that an entire Spa card was cancelled.

"We are very excited about the partnership we have with the KHBPA," said Ron Geary, owner of Ellis Park. "We hope our agreement with the KHBPA will positively impact the entire Thoroughbred industry."

CHRB Amends Steroid Classification:

The California office of Administrative Law granted final state approval for a new regulatory amendment passed by the California Horse Racing Board, upgrading stanozolol, boldenone, nandrolone and testosterone from Class 4 to Class 3 drugs and increasing the severity of related penalties from Catgory D to a Catgeory B. Adopted July 17, the amended changes will be enacted Sept. 4. The presence of any one of these drugs above authorized levels of 1844c (10-14) will results in the automatic disqualification of the horse and purse redistribution. Category B penalties call for a minimum 30-day suspension and a fine up to \$10,000. All other anabolic steroids have been Class 2 or Class 3 violations, carrying Category B penalties since July 1, 2008.


