Spirit One (Fr) (Anabaa Blue {Fr}) made all the pace in yesterday's GI Arlington Million and held off a late rally from a troubled **Archipenko** (Kingmambo) to take it by

3/4 of a length. The bay, who posted a sharp four-furlong workout over the Polytrack in :49 Thursday, was keyed up through an opening quarter of :24.66, but began to settle through fractions of :48.57 and 1:12.40 beneath loritz Mendizabal. Spirit One turned back a challenge from G1 Eclipse S. hero Mount Nelson (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) in the stretch and was

able to hold off the globe-trotting Archipenko, who raced in tight quarters for most of the stretch. "I took the lead because I wanted to run my race and he responded very well for me," Mendizabal said. "He quickened when I asked him to, so I never saw what was happening behind me. 

She won well here on fast ground; I didn't know about the soft, but her mother won on it in France and she handled it well. She got left and pulled very hard in behind, so to me that makes it all the more impressive--she likes to get on with life, but is a very sweet, honest filly. What did you see in Get Lucky when you bought her in 2002? She was my number one pick in the sale. She had everything I look for in a mare: She had good conformation, she had a top female family and she was by a sensational broodmare sire, Mr. Prospector.

Were you involved with horses before you got your start in racing? I've always been around horses. I used to show five-gaited Saddlebreds when I was a kid. As an adult, I played polo for 10 years. I recently quit that because I herniated a few discs in my neck. You see some of the same people interested in both [racing and polo].

Who inspires you the most? My father. He was a great man. He was very smart and very successful. I always wanted to do well and please him. What is your favorite vacation spot? Where I live. I love Palm Beach. The only time I really travel is for the horses.

What do you think of the idea of bringing racing back to Hialeah?
I think it's great. I went to watch a horse work in the morning, but never went for the races. I think it will be beautiful if it's restored.

Favorite food or meal? Broiled lobsters from Joe's Stone Crab. Favorite film? "Ghost and the Darkness." It's a true story and I like movies that are based on real-life situations.

Favorite book? "Tesio." I've read a lot of the old, out-of-print books from Lyrical Ballad bookstore in Saratoga. Allen Jerkens advised me on what books to buy and which ones would be good to read.

Perfect day? Winning a Grade I race at Saratoga.

Childhood ambition? I was always planning to go into [the printing] business with my father and be successful. We sold the company [Copy-Mor Inc] awhile back and it worked out pretty well.

What Aidan O'Brien is doing in Britain and Ireland, Freddy Head has been copying on a smaller scale in France of late, and the former top jockey has another big gun to fire in Marchand d'Or here. The Head stable is on a roll, with domestic Group 1 wins in the Prix Jean Prat and Prix Rothschild in the last month, and also collected the G1 July Cup courtesy of Carla Giral's Marchand d'Or. The five-year-old is chasing a piece of history as he bids to become the first to win this race three times, and is arguably in the form of his life. He managed a success in the June 1 G1 Prix du Gros-Chene over an inadequate five furlongs at Chantilly and added Newmarket's premier speed test July 11. "He's in very good form," Head commented. "I think he will run very well and will be hard to beat. He won't care about the ground, he goes on any, and soft going won't stop him." The Ballydoyle stable is currently exercising an iron grip on the major summer prizes, and the operation is represented here by Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Joseph Allen's US Ranger and Smith, Tabor and Magnier's 2007 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner Astronomer Royal. The former was fifth, with Marchand d'Or and Astronomer Royal two places behind, in Royal Ascot's G1 Golden Jubilee S. June 21. He went under by a head to the French raider in the July Cup last time, where his stable companion finished well to hit the line less than a length back in fourth. Godolphin put forward last year's GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. winner Diabolical, who returned to grass last time when a respectable sixth in the July Cup. "Diabolical is working well and is in good form," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "He was staying on strongly at the end of the July Cup and we were happy with his run on that occasion."



RETIRED RIDERS TO COMPETE IN 'LIVING

LEGENDS' RACE Eight retired Hall of Fame jockeys will compete in the Living Legends Race at Oak Tree Oct. 18, a week before the Breeders' Cup. Scheduled to ride in the allowance sprint are Angel Cordero Jr. (65), Jacinto Vasquez (64), Sandy Hawley (59), Pat Day (55), Chris McCarron (53), Jerry Bailey (51), Gary Stevens (45) and Julie Krone (45). The eight riders have combined for 49,163 wins and over \$1.5 billion in earnings. "I'd be surprised if we see the likes of this gathering again," said Bailey, who retired in January of 2006, most recent of the riders. Cordero is the longest retired of the group, having called it a career in 1992. It will be his first race since finishing fifth aboard Indian Vale in the 2005 GII Cotillion H. at Philadelphia Park. 

TEAM EUROPE VICTORIOUS

Gerald Mosse led a resounding success for Team Europe during yesterday's rain-soaked Shergar Cup meeting at Ascot, which saw a record crowd and an extended sponsorship deal by Dubai Duty Free. Mosse's team, which included Italian Mirco Demuro and Turkishborn Halis Karatas, was in control; Mosse, now a Hong Kong resident, collected the Silver Saddle as the meeting's top rider. "It was a great day, a lot of competition," Mosse said. "It is a real pleasure to be here and to participate in this kind of challenge." The rider added, "I believe next season that I will be in Europe for six months, and I hope that I will get some strong support. I will be a European freelance, and I hope to get some good rides worldwide." The Rest of the World Team's Captain Yutaka Take also recorded a double. Dubai Duty Free has announced that they will extend their sponsorship of the event for another five years, until 2013. Managing Director Colm McLoughlin remarked, "A ground-breaking concept, [the Shergar Cup] has exceeded the aims of its originators, the gladiatorial element of competing teams in one of racing's greatest theatres having captured the imagination of a wider audience and helped introduce many new faces to the sport." First-time participant Russell Baze, second with Al Muheer (Ire) in the Shergar Cup Sprint H., received a four-day ban Aug. 25-28 for using his whip with excessive frequency in the opening Shergar Cup Dash. Still, Baze commented, "I've had a blast. I have to admit it's been quite a challenge, because it's different to what I'm used to. But I've enjoyed it immensely. I was just getting the hang of it at the end, but sadly it's all over. I can't wait to come back here." The attendance was a record 33,115. Ascot's Chief Executive Charles Barnett said, "To get over 30,000 people for Dubai Duty Free Shergar Cup day is obviously tremendous. The weather wasn't kind to us, but people have been resilient, and it's been a noticeably different crowd to a normal raceday, which of course is what this event is all about. It's great to get such a fantastic line-up of international jockeys to take on the two home teams, and people have clearly enjoyed watching their very different styles." The final team standings were: Europe, 94 points; Rest Of The World, 57; Great Britain, 53; and Ireland, 44. Mosse accumulated 50 points to earn the Silver Saddle, 13 more than Take.



CELEBRATION TARGET FOR RAVEN

Stonerside Stable's Raven's Pass (Elusive Quality) is likely to contest the Aug. 23 G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood, trainer John Gosden announced yesterday. 
