### MEDAILLE D'OR

No horse had ever won the same French Group 1 race three times, but that statistic was consigned to history as Carla Giral's Marchand d'Or (Fr) (Marchand de

Sable) broke through the €1-million barrier and claimed a hat trick of victories in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville yesterday. Continuing a dream run for trainer Freddy Head and jockey Davy Bonilla, the homebred five-year-old outclassed his rivals and justified favorite's odds of 8-5 by defeating Juddmonte Farms' African Rose (GB) (Observatory) by 3/4 of a length at the Normandy track. "It is a privelege to train and be around such a horse," claimed Head. "He's a gelding and is very sound, so

hopefully we can run him again for a few more seasons yet. My ambition is to try and win the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye [at Longchamp Oct. 5] with him, but, in the meantime, we might go back to England for the [Sept. 6] G1 Haydock Sprint Cup." *Cont. p2* Click for the <u>Racing Post chart</u> or the <u>free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree</u>.



### AZUL LEON INHERITS BEST PAL WIN

Azul Leon (Lion Heart) overcame a troubled trip to finish just a nose behind Kelly Leak (Runaway Groom) in yesterday's GII Best Pal S. at Del Mar, but inherited the victory in the steward's room when Kelly Leak was demoted to fourth. Azul Leon, coming off a win in the July 5 GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship, tarried near the back of the pack through the opening half-mile of the 6 1/2-furlong contest. He loomed a threat with a three-wide move on the turn and was forced out five wide into the stretch. Jockey Rafael Bejarano moved the bay colt inside of Kelly Leak, who was taking the lead at midstretch, only to have that foe drift back into his path, "IVictor Espinoza on Kelly Leakl was coming in on me," Bejarano said. "He cost me the race. He was watching me and first I tried to go out, then I had to go in. My horse deserved to win. [Azul Leon] showed me something today. He gave me two great runs. He made a big move for me from the back on the turn, then when I got stopped he came back and made another move for me. He's a nice horse and he's going to be a good one." Espinoza had a different version of events. "I can't agree [with the stewards' decision]," Espinoza said. "It's not my fault if the other jockey can't ride his horse. He just happened to be in the wrong place. I was riding my horse and riding my race. That's all." Winning trainer Doug O'Neill said, "We love to win, but I hate to win under these circumstances. There were four gutsy two-year-olds going for the wire. I feel if Azul Leon had





### Marchand D'Or Takes Maurice de Gheest (cont. from p1)

It was a lost opportunity for others when Marchand d'Or remained in the ownership of breeder Carla Giral after running seventh in a claiming event at Chantilly in 2005 and that debut effort was a distant memory when he registered a first renewal of this contest the following year. He bagged a fifth stakes score when repeating the dose last semester and came back this term to plunder a vintage edition of the G2 Prix du Gros-Chene at Chantilly June 1. The grey endured a troubled trip when sixth in the June 21 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot, recorded a third top-level win with a late dash in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket last time July 11 and extended connections' dream sequence with a landmark score here. Marchand d'Or was anchored at the back of the pack as Jumbajukiba (GB) (Barathea {Ire}) set fierce early fractions and moved to within range with a quarter mile remaining. Slicing through the pack to be sent in pursuit of African Rose, he challenged that rival with 100 meters to go and was comfortably on top at the line to register a fourth Group 1 success. "He's an amazing individual who is always there when you need him and now, with age, we can do much more with him than we could in the past," said Freddy Head. Criquette Head-Maarek was delighted with the performance of runner-up African Rose and commented, "My filly was very unlucky in her last run at Longchamp, and I knew she could run such a race at the highest level. She ran a blinder and might come back in the G3 Prix du Pin [at Longchamp Sept. 7] before a tilt at the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 4]."



### GODOLPHIN FILLIES WORK FOR ALABAMA

Godolphin Stables' Music Note (A.P. Indy) and Little Belle (A.P. Indy) both worked five furlongs Sunday morning over the Polytrack surface at the Greentree Training Center adjacent to Saratoga Race Course. Music Note, coming off an 11-length romp in the July 19 GI Coaching Club American Oaks went the distance in 1:02 2/5, while her stablemate and CCA Oaks runner-up Little Belle completed the drill in 1:00 4/5. Both fillies are being pointed towards Saturday's GI Alabama S., but Music Note is also under consideration for the Aug. 23 GI Travers S. "I spoke with [trainer Saeed bin Surror] right after they worked," said Rick Mettee, Godolphin's North American racing manager. "He said to prepare as if both fillies were to run in the Alabama. The final decision (as to where Music Note runs] will be made by Sheikh Mohammed and the Maktoums." Mettee said the fillies had been galloping over the Polytrack all week because of the wet weather in Saratoga. "Music Note went off a bit slow, she got the first eighth in :14, but finished up strong, getting the last quarter in :22 4/5," he said. "She galloped out real well. It was a pretty good work for Little Belle, who is not much of a work filly."

"It depends how she come out of this race, but she could come back here at the end of the month for the [Aug. 31] G2 Grand Prix de Deauville." 

### RAIN FORCES CURRAGH TO CANCEL SUNDAY

CARD Following torrential rains on Saturday, officials at The Curragh in Ireland decided to cancel yesterday's card, which featured three group races: the G2 Royal Whip S., G2 Debutante S. and G3 Phoenix Sprint S. Course officials made the determination after inspecting the track at 7:30 a.m. "The course is waterlogged in places and there is nothing they can do about it," said Cliff Noone, press officer for the Irish Turf Club. "We had a lot of rain; it was a deluge yesterday and there have been more showers overnight. [It's] a real shame, because it was a cracking card." Racing Post reports that officials will discuss the rescheduling of the group races sometime today. "I'm not sure what will happen with the races," Curragh manager Paul Hensey told the publication. "The G2 Debutante S. is a trial for the [G1] Moyglare Stud S., which will be run at our meeting on Aug. 31. Our next meeting is on Aug. 23, and that might be a bit too close to the Moyglare, so we will have to discuss things and wait and see what Horse Racing Ireland decides to do."

Over the past week, there has been a lot of talk about who's better, Big Brown or Curlin. Much of the debate originated in the former's camp, when trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. wondered aloud what all the fuss over Curlin was about.

"Curlin couldn't win the Derby, we could," said Dutrow. "Curlin couldn't win the Haskell. We could. Curlin got beat by a filly. We haven't. Our horse is undefeated on grass. Curlin isn't. I don't know why people think Curlin is such a good horse. We're way better than Curlin."

Curlin's majority owner, Jess Jackson, weighed in a few days later during a national teleconference.

"I'd like to meet Big Brown, preferably on the dirt, which is each one's best surface, but I think they're considering retiring Big Brown before we have a chance to meet him," said Jackson.

Fans, naturally, are hoping beyond hope that the two actually meet up on the track. At this point, the prospects of that, I'd guess, are reasonably good. For all of Dutrow's braggadocio, it's hard for me to imagine that Jackson would declined a chance to take on Big Brown should both horses make it to the Breeders' Cup Classic. (Though Jackson has said of the Classic, 'Been there, done that.') *Cont. p6*

The problem with the Classic is that it's being run this year over Santa Anita's Pro-Ride surface. Neither Curlin nor Big Brown has competed on a synthetic track, and that means that the connections have a built-in excuse should their runners not fire in the Classic.

Jackson has clearly shown he's willing to think outside the box with his horse and genuinely seems to want to do what's best for racing. The brass at IEAH, for all the slack they've taken in the last few months, I think probably want the same.

So here's a novel idea--let's really figure out who the better horse is, not through the words of owners, but through the exertions of the horses. Let's not pit Big Brown and Curlin against each other just once this year, let's send 'em out against each other three times. And let's do it over each surface--dirt, turf and synthetic--so there can be no excuses, no debate.

Let's put together a three-race series, comprised of races already on the calendar, in the hopes of getting these superstars to face off. The first could be on conventional dirt. The second on turf. And the Breeders' Cup Classic could decide it all. A \$5-million bonus should be awarded to either horse capable of winning all three, providing both Curlin and Big Brown compete in all three legs. A \$3-million bonus should be awarded if either horse was able to take two.

We already know where Curlin's heading next--the nine-furlong GI Woodward S. on the dirt at Saratoga Aug. 30. Perfect. That's gives us four weeks for Big Brown to rebound after his hard-fought win in the Haskell, and leaves four weeks before the 1 1/2-mile GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational on the lawn at Belmont Sept. 27. And then it's another four weeks for the Breeders' Cup Classic.

The obstacles of establishing such a series are many--Would both camps agree to race? Who would put up the bonus money? etc.--but really, this isn't rocket science. It would take some hard work and finessing from NYRA and the Breeders' Cup and maybe the NTRA. But it could be done. Let's show some ingenuity and capitalize on the fact that we've got two brilliant runners on our hands.

And let the best horse win. No excuses. No debate.

**SALE OPENER** A colt by Exchange Rate attracted the top price during Saturday's opening session of the twoday Fasig-Tipton New York-Bred Preferred Yearlings Sale in Saratoga. Consigned by McMahon of Saratoga Thoroughbreds LLC, agent, the bay yearling sold for \$250,000 to Buzz Chace, agent for West Point Thoroughbreds. The session topper is out of Star One One (Caller I.D.) and is a half brother to stakes winner North Beach Condo (Out of Place). The top-priced filly during Saturday night's session was a daughter of Songandaprayer out of Naughty Natisha (Known Fact). Debbie Easter, bidding on behalf of Carter and Wick McNeely's Morrowdale, signed the ticket at \$200,000 for the bay yearling. 


