





BETTER THAN HONOUR TO BE SOLD

The 2007 Broodmare of the Year **Better Than Honour** (Deputy Minister--Blush With Pride, by Blushing Groom {Fr}), the only mare of the modern era to produce two consecutive Classic winners, will be offered for sale at



the Fasig-Tipton November Sale as part of a dispersal of the joint holdings of Southern Equine and Hill 'n' Dale Farms. "We have each recognized our own differing goals within the Thoroughbred business," John G. Sikura, president of Hill 'n' Dale, cited of the reason for the dispersal.

The 12-year-old Better Than

Honour is the dam of 2006 GI Belmont S. hero **Jazil** (Seeking Thomas the Gold) and last year's

Better Than Honour L Thomas

Belmont heroine and subsequent champion three-year- old filly **Rags to Riches** (A.P. Indy), in addition to being the dam of this year's GII Peter Pan S. winner, the three-year-old **Casino Drive** (Mineshaft). The latter was the morning-line second choice in the Belmont, but was withdrawn on the eve of the race with a foot bruise. A graded stakes winner, Better Than Honour is a daughter of GI Kentucky Oaks winner Blush With Pride, who in turn is a daughter of Broodmare of the Year Best in Show. Better Than Honour's 2006 foal, the Giant's Causeway colt Man of Iron, has made one start in Ireland. She produced a Giant's Causeway colt last year and, after losing an A.P. Indy foal late in her term this spring, was not bred back.

The split between Southern Equine and Hill 'n' Dale represents the end of a prominent buying force in recent years. At the 2007 Keeneland January Sale, they teamed to purchase the sale-topping Grade I winner **Point Ashley** (Point Given) for \$1.8 million. Two months before that, at Keeneland November, they acquired Grade I winner **Madcap Escapade** (Hennessy) for \$6 million. Both mares will be offered in November. In all, eight mares and five weanlings will be sold. The other mares include: **Crystal Current** (A.P. Indy), **Last Song** (Unbridled's Song), **Promenade Colony** (Pleasant Colony), **Sensation** (Dixie Union), and **Surprises Welcome** (Storm Cat). TEAM ASMUSSEN HIT TRACK AT SPA

Trainer Steve Asmussen sent out several of his stable stars yesterday at Saratoga, including Horse of the Year **Curlin** (Smart Strike). Asmussen intended to work the big chestnut on the main track, but called an audible



after overnight rains and instead opted for the Oklahoma training track. Curlin breezed an easy six furlongs in 1:14.67 in company with stablemate Hawaii Calls. Sitting chilly just

set splits of :13.04, :25.47, :37.82, and :49.75 and was well in hand late. He galloped out seven panels in 1:28.68 under exercise rider Carmen Rosas.

"I think he's a lot more relaxed earlier in a work when he's in company," Asmussen said of Curlin, ranked by *Timeform* of England as the world's best Thoroughbred last week. "In company, he gets smoother works. They went a little quicker than I was expecting them to, but they did it really easily. We were hoping to get a work on the main track, and this morning would have been good because we would have gotten that done and over with. Now, we will really have to watch the weather, but if the main track is muddy [next week], we'll work him here."

Curlin is targeting the \$500,000 GI Woodward S. at Saratoga Aug. 30.

Asmussen also sent out GII Jim Dandy S. runner-up **Pyro** (Pulpit) and GI Whitney H. second **Student Council** (Kingmambo) to six-furlong works yesterday. The former, who goes next in the Aug. 23 GI Travers S.-Presented by Shadwell Farm, got the distance in 1:16.01, while Student Council, who is set to defend his title in the Aug. 24 GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar, stopped the clock in 1:14.46.

"Pyro had a solid race last time, and his work this morning was nice and steady," Asmussen said. "He galloped out real big and came back good."

Tanta Honra posted her first Group 1 tally as she pounced on the pacesetter at the top of the stretch and prevailed over third choice Square Dance in the opening leg of Sao Paulo's Triple Crown series for sophomore fillies on turf. Favorite and champion two-year-old female Cores do Brasil (Brz) (First American) placed seventh in the 11-horse field. The winner survived a jockey's claim of foul. Tanta Honra entered off a 2 3/4-length victory in the G3 GP Adhemar e Nelson de Almeida Prado July 13. At two, she captured the G2 Grande Premio Francisco Vilella de Paula Machado over 7 1/2 furlongs on turf May 25. The series continues with the G1 Grande Premio Henrique de Toledo Lara over 2000 meters on the turf on Sept. 6.

AZUL LEON, 'BARON' TO FUTURITY?

Though trainer Doug O'Neill indicated following Sunday's GII Best Pal S. that the winner by disqualification, Joseph Lacombe Stables' **Azul Leon** (Lion Heart), might bypass the upcoming Sept. 3 GI Del Mar Futurity, he was a little less definitive about that Monday morning.

"The original game plan was to skip the Futurity," O'Neill said, "but maybe now we'll play it by ear. The decision belongs to the LaCombe family and Joe, here, will be talking to his dad about what to do next."

O'Neill was referring to San Diego County resident Joseph LaCombe Jr., who keeps track of his father's horses in Southern California.

Azul Leon was awarded the Best Pal victory when **Kelly Leak** (Runaway Groom), first across the wire, was disqualified to fourth for causing interference in the stretch. His disappointed trainer, Mike Machowsky, said the chances of running in the Futurity are slim, but he would give the matter a week to shake out and then make a final decision.

"I would love it if the Best Pal was two weeks ago, then the timing would be right, in my view," Machowsky said.

Darley's **Coronet of a Baron** (Pure Prize), who was moved up to second in the Best Pal, is likely for the Futurity, said trainer Eoin Harty. Harty also indicated that the colt's East Coast-based stablemate, GII Sanford S. winner **Desert Party** (Street Cry {Ire}), is also possible for the Futurity. Harty said weather and track conditions at Saratoga would play the deciding factor. Darley's Desert Party is currently at the Spa, where he could instead contest the GI Hopeful S. Sept. 1.

day's Shergar Cup meeting, has had an application to alter the dates of his suspension accepted by the British Horseracing Authority. Baze was handed a four-day ban for using his whip with excessive frequency and for not allowing his mount **Mac Gille Eoin (GB)** (Bertolini) sufficient time to respond in the Shergar Cup Dash. He was originally slated to be out of action Aug. 23 through Aug. 26, but the BHA have agreed to switching those dates so Baze can ride at Saratoga Aug. 23 and Del Mar

ning at 2 p.m. A total of 80 head has been cataloged. Included are members of the first crops of **Eurosilver** (Unbridled's Song), **Fantasticat** (Storm Cat), **Here's Zealous** (Dehere), **Oratory** (Pulpit) and **Unforgettable Max** (Northern Afleet). In 2007, this sale saw 73 horses sell for \$523,600 and an average of \$7,173. The median was \$4,500. Fifty-four horses failed to sell, equating to a RNA rate of 42.5 percent.



Tyler Baze Chooses Awesome Gem for Pacific Classic: Tyler Baze, second in the rider standings at Del Mar, will partner with West Point Thoroughbreds' Awesome Gem (Awesome Again) in the Aug. 24 GI Pacific Classic, choosing last year's runner-up over recent GI Hollywood Gold Cup winner Mast Track (Mizzen Mast). "It was a tough decision [getting off of Mast Track], but Tyler has a good chance to stay with the horse," Ron Ebanks, Baze's agent, said yesterday morning. "The horse has great credentials--second in last year's Pacific Classic, third in the [GI] Breeders' Cup Classic and a terrific race last time out." Baze was aboard the gelding in his first start since the Breeders' Cup, the July 25 Wickerr H. over Del Mar's lawn, when the pair just missed by a nose to One Union. In addition to Awesome Gem and Mast Track, the Pacific Classic field could include: Go Between (Point Given), McCann's Mojave (Memo {Chi}), Mostacolli Mort (Hold for Gold), defending champion Student Council (Kingmambo), Surf Cat (Sir Cat), Zappa (Afternoon Deelites), **Delosvientos** (Siphon {Brz}), **Barcola** (Old Triest), **Tres** Borrachos (Ecton Park) and Well Armed (Tiznow).
