ROCK SOLID

It was Group 1 win number five at Newmarket yesterday as Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Duke of Marmalade (Ire)** (Danehill) ground out a 3/4-length success in the rerouted G1 Juddmonte International S. Following a gruelling fight in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 26 and two flights from Ireland due to York's abandonment Tuesday, Ballydoyle's juggernaut would have been excused for not wanting to roll up his sleeves again here, but that was not the case. Jockey Johnny Murtagh asked him to stretch when he hit the front three furlongs out, and the "Duke" had too many guns for **Phoenix Tower** (Chester House) at the finish. **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) failed to provide the much-anticipated match, and was a further 2 1/2 lengths back as he stayed on for third after racing too keenly in rear early. WHO'LL BE THE PAC MAN?

A well-matched field of 11 older horses go postward in this afternoon's \$1-million GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar and never, arguably, has the race carried such significance, with this year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic to be contested for the first time over a synthetic surface. The tepid 3-1 morning-line favorite is Peter Vegso's **Go Between** (Point Given), who has turned into something of an all-weather specialist as he's grown older. The Rodney Dangerfield of the Crop...

Despite just one off-the-board finish from his first eight trips to the post, **Colonel John** just never seems to garner the respect he merits. A maiden winner and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ over seven furlongs at the Oak Tree meeting in October, the bay figured to improve with distance and did just that in his next start, coming from off the pace to win the Nov. 18 Real Quiet S. at Hollywood Park. That effort earned him a spot in the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 22, and although the attractive colt finished second that afternoon, anyone watching the way he was striding out in the final furlong and past the wire knew he would become a serious three-year-old. Brought back to action in the GIII Sham S. at Santa Anita Mar. 1, Colonel John was forced to race unusually close to a dawdling pace and caught a race-fit El Gato Malo, but came calling for the lead at the eighth pole and held on for a half-length victory. The second choice to the West Point runner in the GI Santa Anita Derby, Colonel John was shuffled back on the turn and had nine of his 11 rivals ahead of him with a quarter mile to run, but found his best stride just in time to post a half-length success. The 9-2 second choice to Big Brown in the GI Kentucky Derby May 3, he was steadied early, made a strong middle move into contention, but flattened in the lane to finish sixth. He was rested off that effort, with the Travers squarely in the crosshairs, and the WinStar colorbearer faced just three of his peers in the July 12 GII Swaps S., and, in a near repeat of the Sham, raced outside his comfort zone on the pace and lost second on the wire.

Looking for Validation...

Well drawn for the "Midsummer Derby," Colonel John leapt in the air at the start, but recovered and secured a cozy ground-saving position as GI Belmont S. hero **Da' Tara** (Tiznow) cut out reasonable fractions of :23.91 and :48.06. Patiently handled by Garrett Gomez, he bided his time on the turn, but was bothered a bit and was checked as heads were turned for home. "The Colonel" went after a weakening Da' Tara at the eighth pole, but was joined soon after by **Mambo In Seattle**, who

rallied stoutly on the turn and six wide into the stretch and looked as if he had the momentum as they raced into the final furlong. The two exchanged leads bob by bob as the winning post loomed, and Colonel John got there when it mattered most.

Winning jockey Garrett Gomez rode Colonel John to a runner-up effort on debut, picked up the mount from an injured Corey Nakatani for the Sham, and was back aboard for the Swaps. He was full of praise for his mount. "The way he ran today was a heck of a performance," said the jockey, winning his first Travers. "I've always liked him, I was fortunate enough to be the first one to ride him in a race. [Trainer] Eoin [Harty] was high on him then. It took me a while to get back on him, and I got to watch him kind of develop. It's been a real trip for me, to have him is unbelievable. The kind of trip and what he did today, it takes a special horse to do what he did because he got left a little bit. He was inside and then I got bounced around a little on the turn and then I had to jump over heels. To do that after going a mile, he still jumped up on his feet and started to quicken it and lengthen his stride. It shows that he is right up there with the top of them." Added winning trainer Eoin Harty, "When you've been around horses for a long time, the really good ones do things very differently than the usual ones. This one, from Day 1, had shown that. It was an unfortunate thing in Kentucky. In hindsight, the race he had in the Swaps was a very good race. He's a beautiful horse to be around. Go Between has never finished outside of the exacta in five starts on synthetic surfaces but will compete on Del Mar's Polytrack for the first time. After a successful career on turf, trainer Bill Mott decided to try the chestnut over all-weather tracks upon the advice of exercise rider Keith Allen, who said the horse "seemed to feel really good" during a workout over Arlington's Polytrack. In five subsequent starts over synthetics, Go Between won the 2007 GIII Fayette H. at Keeneland and the 2008 Sunshine Millions Classic at Santa Anita and finished second in this year's GI Santa Anita H., GIII Ben Ali S. and GI Hollywood Gold Cup. In the Gold Cup June 28, his latest start, he was unable to chase down a free-running **Mast Track**, who set comfortable fractions of :48 4/5 and 1:12 4/5 to win his first stakes.

The pace should be much faster this time, which will likely benefit Go Between and fellow closers **Awesome Gem** and **Student Council**. Awesome Gem hasn't won a stakes since taking the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. in January 2007, but has had several close calls. He lost by a nose in his most recent race, the restricted Wickerr H. on turf, but last year at Del Mar, he was second to Sun Boat in the GII San Diego H. and to Student Council in the GI Pacific Classic before losing by a nose in the GII Goodwood S. and finishing third in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. Student Council subsequently won the 2007 GII Hawthorne Gold Cup and this year's GI Pimlico Special. He followed his Pimlico win with a third in the Hollywood Gold Cup, and most recently was second to Commentator in the GI Whitney H. July 26.

Whether Duke of Marmalade would have handled the desperate conditions on York's Knavesmire remains an unknown, but his iron constitution helped him cope with the sporting decision of connections to run yesterday. He refused to buckle when threatened by the talented Saddex (GB) on soft ground in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp Apr. 27, but his subsequent exploits in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 25, G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 18 and the King George last time out had been carried out on his favored fast surface. Aidan O'Brien demonstrated all of his training prowess when keeping the four-year-old on an even keel during the week's turn of events; it was soon evident that the imposing bay had lost no edge as he traveled strongly in behind his regular lead Red Rock Canyon (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}).

Left in front to turn the screw as his barnmate tired at the three-furlong marker, the "Duke" dug in to ward off the significant threat of Phoenix Tower inside the final eighth and continue his unprecedented winning sequence. "He's an amazing horse to do what he does week after week," O'Brien said after his 18th top-level win in 2008. "He came here after a messy week and we weren't sure what to expect, but the way he traveled through the race today is what was most impressive. When he gets to the front, he doesn't do much, which is probably to his advantage, and he has a super temperament--he relaxes, takes everything in and responds when you want him to. This horse loves racing and, if everything is well, we'll go to Leopardstown for the [Sept. 6] G1 Irish Champion S. All races are open to him, and I don't think he'd mind dropping back to a mile, judged by the way he traveled today." **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#), the [brisnet.com PPs](#) or the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree.](#)**

Phoenix Will Rise One Day...

Henry Cecil took defeat on the chin as he reflected on a career-best performance from Phoenix Tower. "It was a wonderful run and he's an improving horse, but the other horse just got the better of him up the hill," Cecil said. "He's done really well and improved nearly four lengths on his last run, but he's just unlucky. He's been second in three Group 1 races, but his day will come. I'm very pleased with him." Trainer Jim Bolger was not downcast about the comeback run of New Approach off an injury-enforced layoff. "We are beaten, but definitely not battered," Bolger said. "He ran a very good race and obviously he is on the way back. It would have been better if he had been a little bit sharper. We will regroup and I would imagine that you will see a different horse in a couple of weeks' time in the Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown."

20-20 VISION

After watching GIII Gotham S. winner **Visionaire** (Grand Slam) finish off the board for the only times in his life in the nine-furlong GI Blue Grass S. and 10-panel GI Kentucky Derby, it was clear to his owners that the colt would be better off at shorter distances. The chestnut colt dropped back to a mile and a sixteenth for the June 14 GIII Northern Dancer S. at Churchill Downs and

finished third, then went back to one turn for a 6 1/2-furlong optional claimer at Saratoga July 24. Last early, Visionaire charged down the lane to get up for a one-length score. "The main thing with this horse is that he is very, very explosive off the turn,"

Team Valor International principal Barry Irwin explained. "He showed that in the Northern Dancer, but the race was just too far. We knew if he could put in that kind of run going short, it would be very effective. That was the gamble, and it paid off." It did indeed. Let go at 6-1 in the seven-furlong King's Bishop, Visionaire trailed the field as 17-10 chalk **J Be K** (Silver Deputy) led them through an opening half in :44.71. The crowd's choice still had the advantage at the eighth pole, but jockey Alan Garcia had Visionaire in the clear on the far outside, and the colt stormed past the field to win going away. **Desert Key** (E Dubai) closed through the crowd on the inside in deep stretch, but couldn't match strides with the winner late. "My horse, he came flying!" said Garcia, celebrating his fifth winner on the card. "This is great." Added trainer Michael Matz, "The horse just has that one style of running; it can be a little nerve-wracking. When I saw him that far behind after the first quarter, I said, 'Oh, my goodness!' But he is an honest horse and he tries real hard." Matz also conceded, "Maybe he doesn't want to go far. It looks like seven furlongs to a mile is his distance." J Be K faded late to be sixth. His jockey, Garrett Gomez, remarked, "I did not have a good trip. My horse just did not respond like normal. I tried to get him to move down the stretch, but I never got the response I was looking for." SHAKIS DEFENDS IN THE BARUCH

In the last 10 years, the Bernard Baruch has been won a total of seven times by Kieran McLaughlin (twice) and Bill Mott. The two veteran horsemen were responsible for the exacta in yesterday's running, and it was McLaughlin and Shadwell Stable's defending champion **Shakis (Ire)** (Machiavellian) who pulled the minor upset. A respectable third in last year's GI Shadwell Turf Mile S. at Keeneland Oct. 6, Shakis was put away for the year and returned with a sixth to champion Kip Deville in the GI Maker's Mark Mile back in Lexington Apr. 11. The 11-10 chalk in the GII Dixie S. on the Preakness undercard May 17, he caught a yielding turf and never took to the course, finishing a midpack ninth. Steadied early during the running of the GI Manhattan H. June 7, Shakis was never really involved, finishing a well-beaten ninth.

Shak Daddy...

Thorn Song (Unbridled's Song) took advantage of what appeared to be a paceless field and towed the field along through moderate splits of :48.17 for the half and 1:11.67 for three-quarters, as Shakis and the in-form Alan Garcia bided their time from eighth. **War Monger** (War Chant), a tugging second beneath Kent

Desormeaux for most of the running, had the first crack at the weakening pacesetter at the eighth pole, but Garcia steered Shakis out into the middle of the track and the duo stormed home a clear winner. **Operation Red Dawn** (Miswaki), last of 10

after six furlongs, weaved his way between rivals down the lane and outfinished Thorn Song to complete the trifecta. "He's really been unlucky," McLaughlin commented. "His first race back, he was 10 wide at Keeneland. Then, we went to Pimlico and he had a rough trip. He ran back in three weeks on short rest going 10 furlongs. [But] this is what he wants to do. Alan did a great job. We just wish they ran the Bernard Baruch twice a year." War Monger, the Sunshine Millions Turf winner earlier this year, raced atypically close to the pace from a high draw and did very well to hold for second. "I thought he ran an incredible race from the outside post," Mott said. "I was worried about him breaking from the 10 post. He was in good position throughout. Reigning champion sprinter **Midnight Lute** returns to the races for the first time since finishing second in the GI Cigar Mile H. last November. Winner of the GIII Perryville S. at three, Midnight Lute lost his first three starts of his four-year-old campaign before returning to the winner's circle in the GI Forego S. at Saratoga with a 2 1/4-length victory. That score was impressive enough to make him the 5-2 favorite in his next race, the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Racing in eighth up the backstretch, he made a sweeping rally to prevail by 4 3/4 lengths in the slop. Midnight Lute has been working blazingly fast for his 2008 debut, including a 1:21 3/5 seven-furlong move Aug. 7, which tops the Del Mar Polytrack record. **Rebellion** began his career routing on turf in England, but before posting consecutive wins sprinting over Lingfield's Polytrack. After being shipped to the United States, the expatriate first found success in his new country sprinting on turf, posting three consecutive wins, including the Steinlen S in September. at Belmont last fall. Switched back to Polytrack, he was second in the GIII Phoenix S. in October before finishing eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile later that month. The bay won his first two starts of 2008, taking the GII Commonwealth H. and the GIII Ack Ack H. He shortens up off a fifth in the GII San Diego H. at 1 1/16 miles July 19 in his most recent start. **Barbecue Eddie** got caught in a speed duel in the GI Bing Crosby July 27 most recently, fading in the stretch to finish eighth, but could be tough to track down if he can clear the field up the backstretch. He seeks his first stakes win, but has placed in three stakes, including last year's GI Ancient Title S.

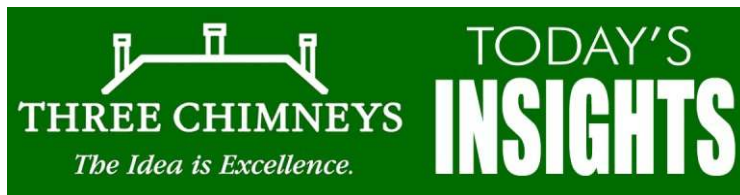
