Mar. While Gomez was beating a son of Tiznow on Sunday, it was another son of the WinStar stallion--Colonel John--who provided him Saturday's GI Travers S. Gomez said his ride aboard Go Between was straightforward. "The only time I had to make a decision was at the [9/16th] pole," he said. "I had to decide whether to wait, and make that late run, or go around and go for it right then. I decided to go for it and it worked. It sure helps when you have a horse like him. Second last as they turned the corner, Intangaroo (Orientate) was wheeled six wide into the Saratoga stretch and closed like rocket to capture yesterday's GI Ballerina S. by 2 3/4 lengths over fellow closer Miraculous Miss (Mr. Greeley). The four-year-old Intangaroo was registering her third Grade I sprint victory on the year. "She relaxes pretty good when she is behind horses; when she's not, she wants to go," said winning rider Alonso Quinonez. "So, I just

Finding the sanctuary of cover through the early fractions, the G3 Anglesey S. winner found his rhythm inside the final quarter mile and had too many guns for **Gallagher (GB)** (Bahamian Bounty {GB}) in the closing stages, denying that rival by a half length at odds of 43-10. "The ground and trip suited him today," Murtagh commented. "He travelled well, he's got plenty of speed and I think he's a high-class horse." **Cont. p3**

#### A Horse For the Classics...

Following his win in the Sunshine Millions Classic Jan. 26, Go Between suffered a run of three straight runner-up finishes. He ran Heatseeker (Ire) (Giant's Causeway) to 3/4 lengths in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar.

1, then was upset by Sterwins (Runaway Groom) as the oddson pick in the GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland Apr. 20.

He returned from a freshening in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup June 28, where he was compromised by a slow pace and ran second to loose-on-the-lead Mast Track. Bettors forgave the effort, sending him favored here at 5-2 odds, and the bettors had it right. Barcola (Old Trieste) and Surf Cat (Sir Cat) ensured solid enough :23.40 and :47.36 splits as Go Between sat about eight lengths off. The latter moved four wide rounding the far turn and set his sights on Well Armed, who had spurted clear leaving the quarter pole. The two hooked up for a stirring duel, with Go Between proving gamest. "That was our plan going into it," said Kenny Mccarthy, assistant to trainer Bill Mott. "He has a running style that is good for this distance, and Garrett fits him so well. They're a great team." Trainer Eoin Harty, who sent out Colonel John to victory in the Travers, was happy with the runner-up's effort. "We're proud of the horse," he said. "He ran very well. He just got beat a head. He ran huge. He ran just the way we thought it would come up. He just got outrun."

# Go Go, Speed Racer...

It was Garrett Gomez's eighth stakes win of the Del Mar meet--and his second graded victory on the card-and marked the fourth time he's won the Pacific Classic, more than any other rider. His other wins were on Skimming (Nureyev) in 2000 and 2001 and with Borrego (El Prado {Ire}) in 2005. He also has two seconds in a total of eight mounts in the race. The victory also presents the sort of dilemma every jockey hopes for. Gomez will now have to chose between Colonel John and Go Between as both horses progress toward the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Oct. 25.

It was first Pacific Classic win for trainer Bill Mott, His only other starter was in 1996, when Cigar saw his 16-race winning streak snapped.



Successful in a Tipperary maiden on debut June 5, Bushranger was unable to justify favoritism or cope with the 100-1 shocker Flashmans Papers (GB) when second in the June 17 Listed Windsor Catle S. at Royal Ascot. He bounced back with a stylish win over Westphalia (GB) in the July 13 Anglesey S. at The Curragh and was a creditable third to Mastercraftsman (GB) in the G1 Phoenix S. back at the Co. Kildare venue last time July 27. Positioned under cover in midfield, Bushranger was given the hurry up by jockey Johnny Murtagh approaching the final quarter mile. Sent in pursuit of Gallagher once that rival had grabbed the lead with 300 meters to go, he devoured the ground late to override that rival's effort nearing the line. "He ran very well in the Phoenix S. last time and is a versatile horse who has run well in all his races no matter what conditions he has faced," said trainer David Wachman, "He was given a brilliant ride by Johnny [Murtagh] and stayed on very well at the end. On what he's shown today, he looks as though he might stay further, but we'll take him home and see how he comes out of the race before deciding. An option is to go to Newmarket [for the Oct. 3 G1 Middle Park S.], but the owners may have other horses for that, so we'll see what they want to do first. There are no definite plans at the moment." Brian Meehan, trainer of the runner-up, was not too downhearted. "Every time you have a Group 1 second, you always feel a little frustrated because you'd obviously have liked to have won," Meehan said. 

Handicappers who have taken a flyer on Intangaroo in her Grade I efforts have done just fine over the past seven months. She was a 26-1 bomb when she got her nose down on the wire in the GI Santa Monica H. at Santa Anita in February and, following a close-up third in the GIII Las Flores H. at that track in April, she was a 14-1 outsider when taking the GI Humana Distaff S. at Churchill May 3. Back in California for her latest, Intangaroo could do no better than fourth in the sevenfurlong GII A Gleam H. at Hollywood June 28, but was back to her best form shipping east for another go at the highest level. The dark bay--off at, for her, relatively short 5-1 odds--had just one beaten in the eight-horse field as Mistical Plan (Game Plan) and favored Sugar Swirl set quick splits of :22 1/5 and :44 4/5.

Tipped out six wide under regular rider Alonso Quinonez, Intangaroo came with a rush down the center of the track and won going away. Miraculous Miss, who caboosed the field early, also came flying, earning place honors. "You just saw why we came to Saratoga," said winning trainer Gary Sherlock, who was saddling his first starter at the Spa. "This was a national stage; if we could win this, it was three Grade I wins, and she would be looking good for the Eclipse Award. The next race will be the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint [at Santa Anita Oct. 24], and I'm happy about this because I don't have to worry about a Breeders' Cup prep [the Ballerina was a "Win and You're In" Event for the F&M Sprint]." It was also the first Saratoga winner for Quinonez. "It was my first time here and my first win, so I am excited," he said.

Trainer Steve Klesaris found no fault with the effort of Miraculous Miss, who earlier had been fourth to Intangaroo in the Humana Distaff. "She beat us at Churchill; she's tough," said Klesaris. "Regardless, 'Miss' always shows up. This was another Grade I race and everyone came with their running shoes."

It hadn't been a very pleasant week for trainer John Sadler. Last Monday, his barn was raided by investigators from the California Horse Racing Board as allegations of improper steroid use swirled, and there was talk of a possible lawsuit by Sadler, who was angered by the accusations. The week ended on a high note for Del Mar's leading trainer, however. Sadler sent out a pair of graded winners on yesterday's card, including Dearest Trickski in the GIII Rancho Bernardo H. and this colt. Whatsthescript, who shipped from Ireland to take the GIII Generous S. as a juvenile in 2006, made just three starts last term, his best efforts being a win in the Pasadena S. at Santa Anita in March and a second in the GIII American Turf S. at Churchill in May for trainer Doug O'Neill. He was well-beaten as the favorite in the GIII Sir Beaufort S. in his seasonal finale in December and subsequently was moved to Sadler's care. Whatsthescript was a big 29-1 shot taking the GII American H. for Sadler at Hollywood June 28, but was favored when beaten just a half-length by Monzante in the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar July 20. Confidently ridden here by the red-hot Garrett Gomez, who would add his own stakes double later in the card with Go Between, Whatsthescript settled in seventh through three quarters in 1:09 flat. Given the green light turning into the lane, he rallied wide and outfinished a hardtrying Bold Chieftain. "This is really a great horse," said Sadler. "He's one of the true horses that I've ever had that I think is a Grade I horse. When they went :22 [2/5] and :46, I knew we were in good shape." Though the crowd made Midnight Lute the over-whelming 4-5 favorite, the five-year-old Lewis Michael had the full confidence of trainer Wayne Catalano just prior to this race. Catalano told TVG in the paddock that he wouldn't trade places with anyone--a brazen statement, considering the race marked the return of

last year's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hero. A few minutes later, fans saw the reason for Catalano's confidence. Lewis Michael, a stalking presence early, powered

up to take control from pacesetting Barbecue Eddie in upper stretch and bounded away to win by 2 3/4 lengths. Stewards took a look at the stretch run, as Lewis Michael looked to have come in a bit on Barbecue Eddie, but made no change. Rebellion rallied for place honors; Barbecue Eddie held for third. The final time for the seven-furlong race, 1:21.17, established a new track record.

"Oh, no, no, it wasn't my horse," said winning jockey Rene Douglas when asked about the possible interference. "My horse wasn't swerving; that other horse was coming out. At one point he was right on my hip. He hit me. My horse ran good. Other than that bit of business, we had a perfect trip. He ran great."

A full-brother to champion Dreaming of Anna and produced by a stakes-winning half to champion Kitten's Joy, Lewis Michael has always been a solid sort. Second in the GII Peter Pan S. at three, he captured last year's 1 3/16th-mile GII Washington Park H. two starts before running up the track in the slop in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile in late October. He was off for eight months, returning to be a close-up fourth as the favorite in the grassy Sea O Erin BC S. at Arlington July 26. With this win, Lewis Michael earned a spot in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint through the "Win and You're In" program, thought Catalano indicted a trip to the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile is more likely.

Midnight Lute, meanwhile, raced in midpack going into the turn and was caught behind a wall of horses as they neared the quarter pole. Jockey Garrett Gomez was still unable to find a seam at the furlong grounds and the jockey didn't persevere. The pair finished 10th in the 12-horse field. "I had nowhere to go," said Gomez. At 1-10 you'd expect a glorified workout, and that in essence is what the top-class Hystericalady needed in order to register her third straight Grade II success. The five-year-old mare, runner-up in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, won the GII Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill June 14 and the GII Delaware H. in a dominant display July 13 and was looking to defend her title in the Molly Pitcher. Jockey Robby Albarado, fresh off his tough beat in Saturday's GI Travers S. aboard Mambo in Seattle, allowed Hystericalady to track off Rolling Sea's slow opening fractions of :24 1/5 and :48 2/5 before asking her to join that rival going into the far turn. Hysterical adv cruised past with ease and, from there, it was just a matter of by how much. "We'll probably go to the GI Lady's Secret BC H. at Santa Anita [Sept. 27], or we may skip it and go right to the GI Breeders' Cup [Ladies' Classic]," said trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. ## COLONEL JOHN FINE AFTER TRAVERS WIN



## HEAD EYEING FUTURE FOR DEAUVILLE

STARS Freddy Head failed in his attempt to sweep all four of the summer's Group 1 events at Deauville after the eclipse of Naaqoos (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the G1 Prix Morny at the Normandy track vesterday, but the trainer was looking forward rather than back after relaying plans for his three stable stars. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Tamayuz (GB) (Nayef), winner of the July 13 G1 Prix Jean Prat and Aug. 17 G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois in his last two starts, is set to cross Le Manche to tackle the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Sept. 27 in his next outing. "Tamayuz is going for the Queen Elizabeth at Ascot," said Head. "He's a real star, he's got the speed, he can stay and he's a champion. We'll have to discuss it with Sheikh Hamdan, but he could also go for the [Oct. 25 GI Breeders' Cup] Mile." Diverting his attention to recent G1 Prix Rothschild victress Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa), Head continued, "I think Goldikova is going to go for the [Sept. 7] G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp and from there she'll maybe go for the Breeders' Cup Mile later on." Ruling out tilts at both the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp and the Breeders' Cup meet, Head also revealed plans for Carla Giral's G1 July Cup and G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest hero Marchand d'Or (Fr) (Marchand de Sable). "He has run in the Foret twice and he was very unlucky both times, so this year I think we are going to choose the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye [at Longchamp Oct. 5]," he said. "The horse is well now, we had a little setback with him and that's why he can't go to Haydock [for the Sept. 6 G1 Sprint Cup], but he'll be okay. I doubt he'll go for the Breeders' Cup Sprint, there is a new [Sprint] race on turf now, but he is not in the race and we'd have to pay big money to enter him, so I think we'll maybe go to Dubai early next year."

I think the price comes from the fact that he was average sized, maybe a little below average size, and was out of a Rahy mare, and I think that scared some people off, thinking that he wouldn't grow that much more. But he wound up growing a lot--he's a good-sized, strong colt. Plus, Action This Day, being a first-year sire, probably had people on the fence. He was a really good individual, though. We thought he had all the tools."

As Majormotionpicture began training with Machowsky, their impressions seemed to be confirmed.

"About a week ago, Mike asked me after watching one of his five-eighths works, 'Have you ever seen a two-year-old work that good?' I said, 'Mike I don't think I've ever seen any horse work that good.' He really is special; he does things so effortlessly. He's got great action and a great mind, and Mike didn't really get a chance to crank him up. He's a really, really good horse. I think he'll move up a ton in his next start."

According to Feld, that start may come in the GI Norfolk BC S. at Santa Anita Sept. 28. "After that, we might take a shot at the Breeders' Cup [Juvenile, Oct. 25] if everything goes well."
