GOING OUT IN STYLE

After a slow start due to inclement weather, the Saratoga meeting picked up plenty of steam with a

thrilling renewal of the GI Travers S. last weekend, and promises to close with some fireworks with a little help from Horse of the Year Curlin (Smart Strike) in today's GI Woodward S. The G1 Dubai World Cup hero, pegged as the 3-5 morningline favorite, returns to dirt after suffering his first defeat this season when secondbest in his grass debut in the GI Man o'War S. July 12. "We had many options, but we decided this was the best place for him to show his talent," owner Jess Jackson said. "We felt it was best for him to race on a surface where he is already a cham-

pion and at a place where he can add to his legend. He is very fit here and is a very happy horse here." Trainer Nick Zito has already worked some magic with a sevenyear-old this meeting, saddling Commentator (Distorted Humor) to his second victory in the GI Whitney H., and will be represented by veteran Wanderin Boy (Seeking the Gold). The speedy chestnut was a sharp allowance winner at the Spa July 28. "It would be like bookends," Zito said. "There's been other trainers who have won the Whitney and the Woodward the same year, but not with two different horses, both of them seven years old." Divine Park (Chester House), a winner of three straight, including the GI Met Mile H. last time May 26, has been training smartly for his return. "I have a lot of respect for Curlin," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said. "If both of us have a perfect day, he's better than us. But I am confident we have the best chance to beat him."

"His breakout race was when he won the Bold Ruler at Belmont," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said. "He had won two in a row going into that race, but that was a big step going from a `two other than' into a graded stakes. The Tom Fool just showed that he is a very versatile horse and he has continued to train as well up here as he has trained all year." Eternal Star has enjoyed a breakthrough season for trainer Mike Trombetta winning five of six starts, including triple-digit Beyers in each of his last three outings. He followed a nose victory in Philly Park's Donald LeVine Memorial H. June 28 with a neck decision over **Bold Start** in Saratoga's James Marvin S. Aug. 9. First Defence, second in last year's GI King's Bishop S. over this strip, most recently completed the exacta in the GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. July 26.

Her first defeat was a third in the 2007 GI Gamely S. at Hollywood Park on Memorial Day, where she finished a nonthreatening 5 1/4 lengths behind the winner Citronnade. Vacare finished second in her next start. the GII Ballston Spa H. at Saratoga in August after steady-

ing in traffic and completed her 2007 campaign with a win in the GII First Lady S. at Keeneland in October. She has raced twice this year, finishing eighth in the GI Just A Game S. June 7 after getting caught four wide, and was fourth in the GI Diana S. July 26. Kris' Sis has placed in five graded stakes but still seeks her first graded victory. This year, she was second in the GIII Wilshire H. in April and third in the GII Buena Vista H. in February and the GII Milady H. on Cushion Track in May. She was the victim of a soft pace in her last start, the restricted Osunitas H. at Del Mar July 19, and was unable to defend her 2007 title in that race.



following a sharp maiden win at Churchill Apr. 30, looks to get back on track in Monday's GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. following a second-place finish as the 1-10 chalk in Monmouth's Tyro S. July 26. The Ken and Sarah Ramsey homebred skipped the GII Sanford S. July 24 due to a fever, but recovered quickly enough to make the trip to the Jersey Shore. He will race in the Hopeful for the first time without blinkers. "In the Sanford I wanted to put him on the lead with blinkers," trainer Wesley Ward told Daily Racing Form. "In the Tyro, he just blasted out of there and basically he just got outrun." CHURCHILL CUTS STAKES PURSES BY \$975K

Churchill Downs has cut \$975,000 from its fall stakes program, blaming an ongoing dispute between track management and the Kentucky horsemen over allocation of revenue derived from Internet and phone wagers. Eleven of Churchill's 12 graded stakes had their purses reduced. The meet's marquee race, the GII Clark H., was unaffected, and will once again offer a purse of \$500,000. Five races were trimmed by \$100,000: the GIII Ack Ack H., the GIII River City H., the GIII Falls City H., the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S., and the GII Golden Rod S. Two ungraded turf sprints worth \$100,000, the Mariah's Storm S. and the Cherokee Run S., have been canceled. The season will begin Oct. 26 and will conclude Nov. 29. Churchill has been unable accept wagers from ADW companies starting with this year's spring meet, as the Kentucky Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association and the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association have blocked distribution using their powers under the 1978 Interstate Horseracing Act.


