was still six lengths adrift as they raced into the turn, but jockey Robby Albarado had him in gear. He closed ground on the bend and into the lane, got on even terms at the eighth pole and was edging away at the wire. "With all the superstition and the 'Graveyard of Champions,' I was glad the horse showed what he is and we won," majority owner Jess Jackson said. "It was very important. Good horses like Man o'War and Secretariat had problems here. That's an honor roll of some of the famous and the greatest. I'm glad he showed he was up to it." Cont. p2

"She was impressive the last day when she won a group race and I'm looking forward to the ride," jockey Seamus Heffernan, who replaces the suspended Johnny Murtagh, told PA Sport. First Defence showed an affinity for the Saratoga main track when second to Hard Spun in last year's GI King's Bishop S. The Juddmonte homebred headed next to the Sept. 30 GI Vosburgh S., but faded after getting bumped at the break and ran seventh. Sidelined after that outing, he returned to take an optional claimer at Churchill May 3. First Defence was fifth after pressing the pace in the May 26 GI Met Mile H., and was coming off a second in the July 26 GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. Channing Hill sent the colt up the rail to join Eternal Star (Five Star Day) through a rapid opening half. He shook clear at the top of the lane and cruised home as much the best. It was the first Grade I win for Hill, and the fourth Forego score in six years for Bobby Frankel. Odds-on Lucky Island (Lucky Roberto) trailed after getting taken up sharply at the start. He made a bold move as they came around the bend, but flattened out to be sixth in a blanket finish for second. Jon and Sarah Kelly bought Vacare for \$2.8 million at the 2006 FTKNOV sale, just after her win in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. Adriano caught Roman Tiger in the final strides for his first win since taking the Mar. 22 GII Lane's End S. at Turfway for trainer Graham Motion. The chestnut beat just one home after a rough trip in the GI Kentucky Derby, then was transferred to trainer Bill Mott. Switched to the grass, he tired to be fifth in the June 21 GIII Colonial Turf Cup. The colt was bet down to even-money in the Aug. 4 GII Hall of Fame S. and came into the stretch with a solid chance, but found himself behind a wall of horses and had to settle for fourth. There wasn't a straw in his path this time. Rated in midpack through six panels in 1:13.61, Adriano rallied on the outside and was along in time. Deal Making (Empire Maker), the 19-10 chalk after running third in the Hall of Fame, was well back early and offered only a mild rally, finishing sixth. Buffalo Man kicked off the season with a game score in the Jan. 27 GIII Arthur I. Appleton H. on the grass at Gulfstream, but finished off the board when taking on Grade II company in his next three starts. The bay improved to be second in the June 7 Friskmenow S. on the main track at Monmouth, then returned to the lawn and captured the July 9 Inside the Beltway S. at Belmont by a nose. Fifth in the Aug. 3 GIII Oceanport S. at Monmouth in his latest, he was a 5-1 chance to return to the winner's circle here. Unhurried through six panels in a swift 1:08.82, Buffalo Man angled outside in the stretch and finished with good energy to get the job done. "The game plan was to just save as much ground as possible and wait as long as I can to ask the horse," winning jockey Carlos Marquez Jr. said. "We did just that. We sat off the early pace and waited. I knew this horse has a good turn of foot, so as soon as we saw daylight in the lane he turned it on and outkicked everyone." While Sri Putra entered this competitive affair off a 79-day break since his debut success over six furlongs at Newbury June 12, he belied his inexperience to deny The Cheka in the final strides. Settled close to the strong early fractions by Philip Robinson, the bay took time to reach top gear in the straight, but responded gamely to pressure to inhale that rival, who had looked to have settled the result when taking over at the quarter pole. "He worked very well in the spring, but was sick after Newbury with a virus so we had to give him the time," trainer Michael Jarvis commented. "Since we had brought him back, he had worked very nicely and, as he had some pretty smart entries, we felt we had to find out about him and threw him in the deep end. I thought he would run well and be in the frame, but probably not win. I always thought he was a horse with scope and so his layoff may have been a blessing in disguise, as it was amazing how much he had grown over the summer. I would quite like to go for the [Oct. 4] Tattersalls Million, as it's a richly endowed race, and a stiff mile would be his optimum next year. He probably wouldn't want the ground too fast." [Beyond Our Reach] has been working well since [her debut], so we decided to throw her in and see how she gets on."


