MANI BEING MANI IN THE SPINAWAY

Mani Bhavan (Storm Boot) made it a perfect three-forthree with a front-running 1 1/4-length victory in yesterday's GI Spinaway S. at Saratoga. The filly, unchallenged in two previous starts, jumped out to the early lead and set fractions of :22.18, :45.46 and 1:11.03 while alone on a loose lead. GIII Schuylerville S. winner



Jardin (Montbrook) moved to challenge Mani Bhavan at midstretch, but couldn't get by the determined dark bay. "It was a gutsy performance," said winning trainer Steve Klesaris. "The runner-up ran a great race, and Mani Bhavan dug in to fight her off. Midway down the stretch, I A Coglianese was concerned. Jardin was com-

ing relentlessly. My filly was dig-

ging down and had enough to hold her off." Despite Klesaris's concern, jockey Alan Garcia was not worried about the runner-up. "I wasn't nervous when I saw Jardin coming at us," Garcia said. "I knew I still had a lot of horse to keep going. When she was coming closer to us, my filly was trying hard. I didn't want to be too hard on her because I wanted to save her for the next race." 

GLORY AGAIN

Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's Again (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) justified 6-4 favoritism in yesterday's G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh to maintain a clean sweep of Europe's top-level juvenile contests in 2008. Adding to her success in the course-and-distance G2 Debutante S. last time Aug. 17, the imposing bay tracked the fast early fractions under jockey Seamus Heffernan. She took over inside the final furlong and held Shimah (Storm Cat) at bay by a half-length. "She's a big, tall weak filly that's really a three-year-old, so she's done well to win a Group 1 and Group 2 at two," trainer David Wachman said. Cont. p2

A QUICK GETAWAY

TDN Rising Star" Getaway (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) had failed to hit the board in two starts since bagging Newmarket's G2 Jockey Club S. in May, but righted those wrongs with a determined effort in yesterday's G2 Grand Prix de Deauville. Bouncing back under a confident Frankie Dettori, Baron Georg von Ullmann's 12-5 second favorite booked his ticket to the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 5 by defeating globetrotter Doctor Dino (Fr) (Muhtathir {GB}) by a length. "His ability has never been in doubt, and he again showed just how good he is with that victory today," said winning trainer Andre Fabre. Cont. p3

Mani Bhavan earned "TDN Rising Star" status with a dominating 9 1/4-length debut win at July 12 Delaware Park. She justified the hype with a front-running seven-length win in the Aug. 13 GII Adirondack S. "I don't know what's next," said Steve Klesaris. "Today was a good test. We'll go back to the drawing board and evaluate and see what's next." Trainer Steve Asmussen was anything but disappointed with Jardin's runner-up effort. "I thought she ran a beautiful race," Asmussen said. "Robby [Albarado] gave her a dream trip and finished second. It looked like Robby had a shot to get [Mani Bhavan], but she was getting tired."



Again started out with an inauspicious eighth at Roscommon July 7, but took a leap forward next time when winning a mile maiden here 20 days later. Dropped back a furlong for the Debutante, she showed she was still making progress with a three-length defeat of Oui Say Oui (Ire), and employed her inherent stamina against a serious opponent in Shimah here. Settled in mid-division off the generous tempo, she loomed alongside the maiden Beyond Our Reach at the eighth pole and, after mastering that rival, was made to dig in by the Shadwell homebred. Again drifted right across that foe's path in the closing stages and was the subject of an inquiry, but the stewards judged that no interference had been caused and allowed the result to stand. "She has no real preference for ground, but works well on good ground at home and handled the testing conditions a fortnight ago," David Wachman remarked. "She's in the G1 Fillies' Mile [at Ascot Sept. 27] and G1 Prix Marcel Boussac [Oct. 5]--wherever her owners would like her to go, if she's fit and well, she'll take her place. Madeo, a back-to-back winner at Hollywood and Santa Anita this spring, was second by a neck in Hollywood's May 24 Alydar S. and was fourth in the July 12 GII Swaps S. before switching to the turf for a good late-running fourth-place finish in the Aug. 9 GII La Jolla S. at this course. The Moss homebred stalked pacesetting Tangled Tango from fourth, moved to the outside for the stretch run and overtook the leader with a strong move passing midstretch. He held off the lateclosing favorite Gio Ponti for the break-out win, while Tangled Tango just held third over the even later closing Nownownow (Whywhywhy). "He's a little bit of a funny horse to ride," Mike Smith admitted of the winner. "I wanted to keep him down inside and covered up. He does better there. But then I had to get him out and going, but not get him going too soon. We found out if we let him out too soon, he gets to playing around and doing all sorts of things. 
Getaway was a close fourth in last term's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and returned for this campaign with a victory in the G2 Jockey Club S. Enduring late traffic problems when fifth in the June 6 G1 Coronation Cup, he was unable to land a blow in the June 29 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. The bay homebred was settled in third going by the judge the first time as Sommertag (Ger) (Tiger Hill {Ire}) enjoyed a clear lead, and inched into a remote second as the field moved onto the backstraight. Edging closer once turning for home, he was ridden to the front with 350 meters remaining and refused to buckle in the closing stages. Trainer Andre Fabre, looking to the immediate future, said, "The plan

has always been to run in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe,



Overdose retained his unbeaten record when going nine-for-nine with victory in the G3 Lotto Trophy at Hamburg July 5, and he made it a perfect 10 with a dominant success in this most prestigious of all German sprints. The bay sophomore is unmatched in Austria, Hungary and Slovakia--where he achieved champion status as a juvenile--and provided the German audience with a first look when winning the Listed Lanson-Cup over course and distance May 18. Stopping off in Bratislava to continue his streak June 1, he overcame setbacks while preparing for the Hamburg event and succeeded in that pattern-race bow despite losing a shoe during the six-furlong contest. The bargain buy burst from the gate to seize instant control in this and was never seriously threatened, coasting to the wire with the minimum of fuss in the straight to easily outclass his five rivals. Hungarian trainer Sandor Ribarszki said, "That was the real Overdose again today, quite different from Hamburg, and I am really very proud of him." A spokesperson for the sophomore's owner, SCH Racing Team, added, "There are two options for him now; the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 4] or the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye [at Longchamp Oct. 5], but the tendency is towards the latter." Peter Rau, trainer of the runner-up Abbadjinn, was not downcast in defeat, and commented, "Abbadjinn is clearly the best domestic horse over such a trip, but to lose to such an outstanding horse is definitely no disgrace."



Fifth in the Buckingham Palace H. at Royal Ascot June 20, Laa Rayb landed the valuable International H. back there July 26 and improved on a last-out second in the Aug. 14 G3 Sovereign S. at Salisbury to claim a career high in this. Mark Johnston's horses are very tough and even though it may have looked as though I went for home too soon, I knew I had plenty left in the tank and that he'd keep going." 

ARGENTINE STAR LADY SPRINTER POINTING TO BREEDERS' CUP F/M SPRINT Argentine sensa-



had her third official workout since returning to the U.S. at Fairplex Park Saturday, going three furlongs in :38.20. The four-year-old is being handled by Argentine-born trainer Juan Reviriego. "She has really blossomed since arriving here after exiting quarantine in Florida [in July]," said Reviriego from

Fairplex Sunday. "Her coat looks good, she's had three 3/8 breezes, and we have been working at Fairplex to get her accommodated to the tight turns. We will be relocating her to Oak Tree at Santa Anita [Sunday morning] and she will have her first half-mile breeze there next week." Lady Sprinter is unbeaten in both of her starts this year, most recently capturing the five-furlong G1 Gran Premio Ciudad de Buenos Aires against males May 3 at Palermo, a convincing victory that stamped her as the top sprinter in Argentina. In her only other start this year, she defeated fellow distaffers by five lengths in the G3 Clasico General Arenales Mar. 24 at Palermo. Campaigned in Argentina by leading owner Ricardo Benedicto's Stud Rubio B., the dark bay has won eight of nine starts in her adopted nation, including the G1 Gran Premio Maipu against her elders on the Argentine Derby card last November. Lady Sprinter's lone career defeat came last year when she was eighth on the turf at San Isidro in the G1 Gran Premio Felix de Alzaga Unzue on the G1 Carlos Pellegrini undercard. The four-year-old filly, bred by Gainesway Thoroughbreds Ltd, is out of the Dixieland Band mare Passionate Player.







CLOSING DAY PARTY AT SARATOGA

Trainer Eoin Harty will look to cap a successful Saratoga meet with a win in today's GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. "I thought we had a great meet; it has been a fantastic summer," Harty admitted. "We won two graded stake races and finished third in two others." Hopeful contender **Desert Party** (Street Cry {Ire}) provided one of those graded victories with his win in the July 24 GII Sanford S., and Harty is confident the colt

will continue to justify his \$2.1-million FTFFEB price tag. "He's by a hot sire and he has been working well," Harty said. "Right now, it looks like he is capable of winning these types of races. Stonestreet Stables's Cognito (Langfuhr), a \$700,000 KEEAPR two-year-old, reported home a determined half-length victor over the slop at Saratoga July 23. The gray colt is a half brother to GII Fountain of Youth S. winner Cool Coal Man (Mineshaft).



September 3, 1956...Del Mar...Jockey **Johnny Longden** surpassed Sir Gordon Richards' then-record number of wins, riding Arrogate to take the Del Mar H. for his 4,871st career victory.
