#### VINEYARD HAVEN SURPRISES HOPEFUL

Purchased privately by a group including trainer Bobby Frankel following a sharp debut at Calder, **Vineyard Haven** (Lido Palace {Chi}) took advantage of **Cribnote** (Read the Footnotes) blowing the turn in the

GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. at Saratoga. The grey colt scampered home a 2 1/4-length winner over the troubled Cribnote. Vineyard Haven's front-running task was made easier when 2-1 choice **Munnings** (Speightstown) stumbled at the start before winding up third. "Obviously, everything counts," said Frankel. "I was worried about a lot of

horses." Vineyard Haven got out of the blocks quickly under meet-leading rider Alan Garcia, showing the way by a half-length over Break Water Edison (Lemon Drop Kid) through splits of :22.68 and :44.17. In third early, Cribnote loomed boldly on the turn as rider Rajiv Maragh was trying to keep him straight, but the chestnut wound up bearing out badly. He passed his rivals in the lane to finish a clear runner-up. "I think he was tons the best today," said trainer Rick Violette Jr. "All the way down the backside, it looked like he was afraid of horses inside of him--I thought maybe when he turned the corner coming for home, he might finally cooperate and straighten out. He was still looking at them like they were ghosts inside of him and he wanted to get away from them. For him to be second is pretty miraculous." Cont. p2

#### DARLEY ACQUIRES STONERSIDE OPERATION

Owner Bob McNair announced yesterday that Sheikh Mohammed's Darley has purchased nearly all of the holdings of McNair's Stonerside Stable. Included in the transaction are approximately 80 horses in training and

approximately 170 broodmares, yearlings and weanlings, as well as the 2,000-acre farm near Paris, Kentucky, and the training center in Aiken, South Carolina. The Texas native, who founded the Thoroughbred operation with his

wife Janice in 1994, cited his NFL commitments as the reason behind the decision to sell. "Janice and I have loved every minute of owning Stonerside," McNair said, "but I have a duty to the Houston Texans now, and it has become increasingly difficult to focus on both ventures. We decided to sell to Darley, and an important aspect of the deal to us is that the Stonerside staff, who have worked so hard for the family and contributed so much to our success, have been assured that their futures are secure." The McNairs will keep just one of their racehorses, the three-year-old GSW Cowboy Cal (Giant's Causeway), and will retain their homebred stallions Congaree (Arazi), Bob and John (Seeking the Gold) and Stonesider (Giant's Causeway), as well as their other stallion interests. "Stonerside and the McNair family have a record to be proud of," Darley representative John Ferguson said. "John Adger, Bobby Spalding, David Sorrell and Tim Jones, along with the entire Stonerside team, have done a great job, and Darley looks forward to working with them. We have no plans to change anything at the present time, and it will be business as usual at Stonerside. Sheikh Mohammed is delighted to have been given this opportunity. Stonerside have bred some great horses in the past, and we are confident it will continue to do so." Cont. p10-12

Vineyard Haven was saddled by owner, breeder and trainer Lynne Scace in his career opener at Calder June 28, when he drew off to score by 4 1/4 lengths.

That caught the attention of trainer Bobby Frankel, who had saddled the colt's sire, Chilean champion Lido Palace, to victory in the GI Whitney H. and GI Woodward S. in 2001; Frankel, along with partners Louis Lazzinnaro and Diamond Pride LLC acquired the colt in a private transaction.

Shipped up to Saratoga, the grey colt got third in the four-horse GII Sanford S. won by Desert Party (Street Cry {Ire}) in the slop July 24.

With his wire-to-window victory in the seaon's first Grade I race for juveniles, Vineyard Haven may be on the market once more. "I know we'll be getting some good offers, because he won like a really nice horse," Frankel added. "I think we'll keep him, but it depends. We'll play it by ear and enjoy this race. Maybe, we'll look at the [GI] Champagne [at Belmont Oct. 4]."

Stardom Bound was the highest-priced juvenile from Tapit's first crop at this year's in-training sales, and had a host of good works heading into her career bow over this surface July 20. Her connections' hopes were

dashed when she broke in the air, but the grey filly closed powerfully to miss by just a nose in that 5 1/2-furlong affair (video). Trainer Chris Paasch took a pass on maidens thereafter and entered her in the 6 1/2-panel GIII Sorrento S. Aug. 6, but her late charge came up a length shy

of Evita Argentina (Candy Ride {Arg}) (video). The third time was indeed the charm, however, as Stardom Bound did her best impression of Zenyatta. Content to caboose the field as longshot Palacio de Amor showed the way, the Cono colorbearer began to rev her engine heading into the turn. She came sweeping up on the outside whilst on her left lead, collared the pacesetter and shifted gears nicely once on her right lead. Stardom Bound was the first maiden to capture the Debutante since Cindy's Hero in 2000. "She was a little bit better coming out of the gate today," said jockey Mike Smith. "A little. And I didn't mind at all sitting back there--with her it's like being on the lead." He added, "She was picking those horses up in the stretch without even trying. She was on her wrong lead, but it didn't matter. The most amazing thing was, as we were pulling up, she started playing." Paasch added that her next start would likely be the GI Oak Leaf S. Sept. 27. 
It wasn't quite Da' Tara in the Belmont, but it wasn't bad. Trainer Nick Zito, who plundered that million-dollar race at big 38-1 odds, was back to his tricks for this seven-figure purse, sending out Anak Nakal to a 16-1

upset. Anak Nakal looked to be a promising juvenile last year after taking the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. in November, but he failed to hit the board in his next four, including a fifth in the Apr. 5 GI Wood Memorial and a seventh in the May 3 GI Kentucky Derby. He was eight lengths adrift of his stablemate

when third in the Belmont June 7, but could do no better than fifth, beaten 13 lengths, in the GII Jim Dandy S. July 27. Disregarded here, Anak Nakal settled near the back of the 12-horse field as Two Step Salsa (Petionville) prompted Wishful Tomcat (Tactical Cat)'s pace. Those two packed it in as Acai forged to the front, but Anak Nakal was just getting going and came charging wide to be up in the dying strides. "We'd worked with this horse at Palm Meadows all winter long, and he always showed a lot of talent," said winning jockey Joe Bravo. "He's a big stud colt. He never really concentrates much, but he was concentrating today. When it comes to big races, Nick Zito gets 'em ready." Smooth Air, the tepid chalk at 4-1, loomed a threat in upper stretch before flattening out.

Hostess handed Mauralakana (Fr) (Muhtathir {GB}) a 1 1/4-length defeat in the GIII Orchid H. Mar. 30 at Gulfstream, but wound up third behind that divisional leader in her next two outings. Third by 3 1/2 lengths in the GII Sheepshead Bay H. May 24 at Belmont, the bay came up a half-length short to Mauralakana and Dynaforce (Dynaformer) in the GII New York H. at the New York oval June 21. Trainer Jim Bond considered running her in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational Aug. 16, but held her out due to Saratoga's copious rainfall. Jockey Rajiv Maragh allowed his mount to settle into stride in here fourth as Tejida (Rahy) showed the way in the early stages. With 1-2 Dynaforce coming up empty turning for home, Hostess hit the lead in front of the stands and held Palmilla at bay in record time for the inner turf. "I know we would have liked to take a shot against the colts, but this was a smart conservative way," said Bond. "Now, we'll probably go onto the [GI] Flower Bowl [at Belmont] or the [GI] Yellow Ribbon [at Oak Tree; both Sept. 27]--we'll have to see what the turf is like." 

Jim Bolger is preparing Princess Haya of Jordan's G1 Epsom Derby hero **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), third in last Saturday's G1 Juddmonte

International at Newmarket, for a rematch with the "Duke," and Henry Cecil could saddle the Niarchos Family's G3 Rose of Lancaster S. winner Multidimensional (Ire) (Danehill). The Niarchos family's Racing Manager Alan Cooper told PA Sport vesterday, "At the moment, it is quite possible he will run--the ground won't be firm in Ireland. A final decision will be made on Thursday, but I think Henry Cecil would like to run if conditions are suitable." Kevin Prendergast has left in the Iona Equine Syndicate's G3 Ballyroan S. scorer Mores Wells (GB) (Sadler's Wells). He told PA Sport, "We left him in the race and I will have a look at it later in the week and see how it looks. Obviously, it looks very hot, and I was planning to run him in the Irish St Leger a week later, but the owner pays the bills. He won nicely at Leopardstown last time over a mile and a half and was always travelling well. He has won over a mile and quarter a couple of times, though, and has plenty of pace, so the trip is not really a concern."

The race for the title of leading freshman sire heated up nicely two days ago. Firstly we saw Congaree become the first of this year's newcomers to sire three stakes winners, thanks to the G3 success of the Irish debutante Maoineach. Then Lion Heart matched Congaree's feat when Silent Valor took the GIII Sapling S., looking every inch a colt who will thrive as the distances lengthen.

Assessing new stallions has never been easy, the only certainty being that the vast majority of them will fail in the long-term. If pushed to make predictions about Congaree and Lion Heart at the end of 2005, I must admit I would have been more optimistic about Lion Heart.

Not that there was much fault to be found with Congaree's racing career. As a three-year-old he had limbered up for the Kentucky Derby with a trio of victories, the last gained at the main expense of Monarchos

in the GII Wood Memorial. He made a bold bid at Churchill Downs, holding a clear lead at the top of the stretch which he didn't relinquish until the final eighth. His third in the Derby was followed by another in the Preakness and a decisive victory in the GI Swaps S. No wonder the compilers of the



Congaree at Del Mar Benoit Photo

International Classifications awarded him an official rating of 123, just seven pounds below Point Given.

Congaree maintained a similarly high level of form for the next two years, winning two editions of the GI Cigar Mile H. in addition to collecting other Grade I successes in the Carter H. over seven furlongs and the Hollywood Gold Cup over 1½ miles. His second victory in the Cigar came on his 20th consecutive appearance in a graded stake, a statistic which paid ample testimony to Congaree's talent and toughness. He was also admirably versatile and boasted an imposing physique.

What more could one wish for? Well, for a start, one could have wished that he was NOT a son of Arazi, even though this brilliant performer had proved himself the best two-year-old in Europe by a margin of no less than eight pounds in 1991. Nothing proved capable of finishing closer than three lengths to Arazi in three Group 1 races in France, and the son of Blushing Groom was even more dazzling in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Churchill Downs, where he handed out a five-length beating to Bertrando. Unfortunately, brilliant racehorses don't always develop into brilliant stallions and Arazi fell squarely into this category. He made such a slow start with his first runners in 1996 that he left Dalham Hall in England (his home for four years) for Three Chimneys in Kentucky. Then, when his stock generally continued to disappoint in 1997, he was sold to Japan.

As so often happens, Arazi's fortunes quickly took a turn for the better. Having failed to sire a group winner in his first two crops, Arazi came up with two in his third crop and three in his fourth. However, it wasn't until Congaree won the 2001 Swaps S. that he was finally represented by a Grade I winner.

Arazi's woes continued in Japan, to the extent that he topped up his frequent flyer points with a trip to Switzerland to stand at Gestut Sohrenhof in 2003. He then shuttled between Switzerland and Australia for two years before settling permanently in Australia, where, as a 19-year-old, he is standing the 2008 season at only A\$7,700. Remarkably, Congaree remains his only Grade I winner.

The limited success that Arazi did enjoy owed a lot to inbreeding to the great Northern Dancer. Arazi's first Group 2 winner, First Magnitude, was inbred 3x3, and so was Prairie Runner, his other group winner from his 1996 crop. Shibl, a Group 3 winner from his 1997 crop, was also inbred 3x3, while America, the Group 2 winner from this crop, was inbred 3x4. Congaree too is inbred 3x3, his dam Mari's Sheba being a daughter of Northern Dancer's son Mari's Book.

Mari's Book's racing record stood at three ordinary wins from 17 starts, but the Northern Dancer magic worked again to some extent, with several of his daughters shining as broodmares. Cont. p9

In addition to Congaree, daughters of Mari's Book have produced the siblings Ashado, Sunriver and Saint Stephen as well as Behrens and Palladio.

Congaree's dam Mari's Sheba was good enough to

finish third in the GI Santa Anita Oaks and she had the distinction of being inbred 4x4 to the brilliant Ribot, her third dam being Ribot's Oaks winner Long Look.

Even so, a horse by Arazi out of a Mari's Book mare surely represented a potentially hard sell as a stallion, and Congaree's prospects weren't helped by the fact that he showed little of his usual fire in two starts early in 2004. Stonerside quickly retired their old favorite, with his

earnings standing in excess of \$3.2 million, but it was too late for the 2004 season.

When Congaree finally made his debut at Adena Springs in 2005, his connections compensated for the Arazi factor by setting his fee no higher than \$15,000, in a year when the highest-priced newcomers were Smarty Jones (\$100,000), Speightstown (\$40,000), Pleasantly Perfect (\$40,000), Medaglia d'Oro (\$35,000), Lion Heart (\$30,000) and Strong Hope (\$30,000).

The interesting link between Congaree's stakes winners is that all three have more Northern Dancer blood in the bottom half of their pedigree, supplied on each occasion partly by Danzig. Maoineach has a second dam by Storm Cat and a third dam by Danzig. Zigaree, winner of the Minstrel S. on turf at Louisiana Downs, is out of an unraced Danzig mare. And the third stakes winner, Congo Kaye, has an unraced Danzig mare as her second dam.


It is interesting that two of Congaree's stakes winners have scored on turf, as he finished only seventh on his single appearance on turf. Chances are that he is going to sire winners on all surfaces.

Maoineach, who cost \$225,000 at Fasig-Tipton in Florida in February, has unraced mares as her first two dams, but her third dam, Dispute, proved herself one of Danzig's best daughters by winning four Grade I events, including the Kentucky Oaks. Dispute's brother Adjudicating was also very talented, collecting a pair of Grade I successes at two. This female line traces back to Misty Morn and Grey Flight, so it would be no surprise to see Jim Bolger's filly develop into another potential champion for the Irish maestro.

Are there any Stonerside yearlings slated to sell at Keeneland September, and how will they be affected? We have some partnership yearlings that will sell--there are a couple of foal shares, and a couple we co-owned, having co-owned the dams, too. I think there are four or five, and they are still in the sale. But our interest will become Darley's interest. There's a colt by Tale of the Cat that's co-owned by Dr. Walter Zent and Tony Holmes who's a half-brother to (GISW) Dixie Chatter. There's also a Storm Cat colt out of Gossamer (Seattle Slew), which was a foal share we did.

Will all of the horses in training be Darley's as of Tuesday? They're going to be soon, but the deal's not actually closed yet. It's completely agreed to, but the lawyers have to work out their stuff--we expect the deal to be closed in the next 10 days to two weeks. We've got a horse running Wednesday in the GI Del Mar Futurity, Midshipman (Unbridled's Song), and he'll run in Stonerside's name and Stonerside's colors. As soon as we get everything buttoned up, we'll switch over to the Darley colors.

The number of graded stakes winners bred or cobred by Stonerside, according to its website. That includes Grade I winners Fusaichi Pegasus, Congaree, Country Star, No Matter What, The Cliff's Edge and Bob and John.

Will Stonerside's current horses in training be moved to Darley's trainers? No, they'll stay with their current trainers. It was part of the deal that they stay with their trainers for at least a year--we've got about 10 different trainers.

And that includes the unraced two-year-olds? Yes. The only ones that might not be included are those that Sheikh Mohammed thinks are good enough to go to Dubai next winter. There also might be some two-year-olds that are at the training center that haven't yet gone to a trainer that they might want to send somewhere else, to one of their trainers.

Do you see Mr. McNair becoming involved in the racing side of the business again? Yeah, I think there's a chance, if we see a promising filly who's racing and we like her pedigree and record, that we'd buy one or two like that. We've had luck with that in the past. It's not a question of whether they love their horses--they love their horses, their beautiful farm, but Mr. McNair's children have other interests, and no one's really in tune with the Thoroughbred interests. We never thought it was going to become the large operation it is. But we're all proud of the fact that it's been an economic success and an artistic success. I hope the first Kentucky Derby winner Sheikh Mohammed has comes off Stonerside.

Personally, what's it mean to you? Will you stay on? I don't know for sure. John Ferguson and I have talked about possibly staying on as a consultant, but we haven't finalized anything yet. Frankly, I'm just happy the entire operation is going to stay together, and the people that have worked so hard in Kentucky and down in South Carolina will be taken care of. Obviously, the McNairs are going to take care of everybody. I think the main thing is it's going to stay as one entity. It's my understanding it will be called Darley at Stonerside.



"I'm real tickled," trainer John Kimmel admitted after Premium Gold (Mineshaft) yesterday gave him his seventh consecutive win at Saratoga. #### WEEKEND REVIEW, by Christa Riebel

It is the most coveted prize in German racing. The 'Golden Whip,' which has the names of all the previous winners engraved on it, was in the grip of the Hungarian connections of **Overdose (GB)** (Starborough {GB}) after the G2 Golden Pietsche at Baden-Baden Sunday (see Monday's TDN). Returning to Germany after winning the G3 Holsten Trophy at Hamburg last month, the three-year-old colt is now the unbeaten winner of 10 races, and his jockey Andreas Suborics later paid tribute. "I've not sat on such a fast horse before--he is amazing," Suborics said. The plan now is to run at Longchamp in either the Oct. 4 G1 Prix de la Foret or Oct. 5 G1 Prix de l'Abbaye, with next year's G1 July Cup on the agenda.

Baden-Baden's Summer Racing Festival began on Saturday with the G3 Preis der Badischen Sparkassen Finanzgruppe as the main event on the card, and it was garnered by Stall Reni's **Prince Flori (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}) (see Sunday's TDN). Gestut Schlenderhan's sire Tertullian sired his second stakes winner this month when his three-year-old son **Idolino (Ger)** landed the Listed Preis des Casino Baden-Baden on Sunday (see Monday's TDN). Tertullian won five group races over sprinting distances, and shares Miswaki as a sire with his close relative Urban Sea. Interestingly, his other stakes winner, the two-year-old filly **Illiana (Ger)**, is trained in Hungary like Overdose.

Saturday's big auction race for two-year-olds may have witnessed a potentially smart filly in the making as Stall Salzburg's **Night Magic (Ger)** (Sholokhov {Ire}) recorded a second success in the valuable prize *(see Monday's TDN)*. Out of Night Woman (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}), she had to defy top weight and could now be aimed at the Oct. 26 G3 Preis der Winterkonigin, also at Baden-Baden.
