### **CURLIN TO GOLD CUP**

Stonestreet Farms announced today that Curlin (Smart Strike) will defend his title in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park on Saturday, Sept. 27. "The Jockey Club Gold Cup was selected for Curlin in order



to continue his legacy as one of America's greatest Thoroughbreds," Jess Jackson, majority owner of Curlin, said in a press release. "We are steering Curlin toward all the renowned competitions, and certainly the Jockey Club Gold Cup is one of America's most prestigious races. In the past, many of America's top Horsephotos Thoroughbreds sealed their honors by competing in this race.

Also, this contest is in New York State, where Curlin has seen much success and received an outpouring of support. Both factors weighed heavily in favor of our decision to compete again at Belmont." Curlin beat Lawyer Ron (Langfuhr) in a thrilling renewal of last year's Gold Cup. Last Saturday, Curlin notched his sixth Grade I tally in the Woodward S. at Saratoga, which moved him into second place behind two-time Horse of the Year Cigar as racing's all-time leading earner in North America. Cigar's career earnings totaled \$9,999,815. Curlin's current earnings total is \$9,796,800.

### **DUKE PARTICIPATION HINGES ON GROUND**

Tomorrow's G1 Tattersalls Millions Irish Champion S. could be without Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill) if Leopardstown gets a drenching in the preceding hours. While Clerk of the Course Joe Collins reported "perfect" good ground at the Dublin venue yesterday, he is aware that there is a threat of significant rain. "We've had no rain of any consequence in the last couple of days, but tomorrow there is about 20-25 millimetres of rain forecast to Saturday morning," he said. "I walked the track yesterday morning and it was beautiful, perfectly good ground, so I see no reason why the track wouldn't be able to handle that amount of rain." Aidan O'Brien is keen to avoid a slog for Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's five-time Group 1 winner and told the Independent newspaper, "Everything is fine with the Duke and the plan at the moment is to run at Leopardstown. The situation is exactly as it has been all week. The things we have to consider are the ground and his recovery time since his last run. The ground will come into it; if it is too soft, it might be too much of a test so soon after Newmarket. We'll hope to clear him tomorrow morning. But with the weather as it is, we'll be playing everything by ear."

### STREET BOSS TO DARLEY

Bruce Headley, Marsha Naify and Simon Yu's multiple Grade I winner Street Boss (Street Cry {Ire}--Blushing Ogygian, by Ogygian) will retire to Darley in Lexington upon the conclusion of his racing career. The four-year-old has won six of seven starts this term, including the GI Bing Crosby H. and GI Triple Bend Invitational H. Street Boss set the six-furlong track record of 1:07.55 at Del Mar in the Bing Crosby and also set the six-furlong mark at Hollywood, winning the GIII Los Angeles H. in 1:08.67. "Street Boss is a multiple record-breaking, multiple Group 1-winning son of the most exciting young stallion in America," commented Charlie Boden, head of nominations at Darley America. "We're obviously partial to [Darley stallion] Street Cry, and Street Boss truly shows the diversity of his sire's progeny. What's more, he's a gorgeouslooking horse. Mr. Headley has done a great job with him and we're very excited that Street Boss will be joining the roster at Darley." On the board in nine of 11 starts to date, Street Boss has seven wins and earnings of \$581,800.

# SAMUM DUO LIGHT UP BADEN-BADEN

Gestut Karlshof's Samum (Ger) has enjoyed a successful season so far thanks to the exploits of flagbearers Kamsin (Ger) and Baila Me (Ger), and it was a full brother and full sister to that high-class pair who dominated proceedings at the BBAG Yearling Sale yesterday. The full-sibling to the G2 Diana-Trial scorer and G1 Preis der Diana third-place finisher Baila Me provided the main focus when selling to the active agency Blandford Bloodstock for €250,000. Consigned by Karlshof as hip 161, the March-foaled filly named Be Fabulous (Ger) is also a half to the dual listed scorer and multiple Group-placed performer Bailamos (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}). Cont. p2

### KIP DEVILLE MORNING LINE FAVORITE FOR

MILE Kip Deville (Kipling), winner of last year's GI Breeders' Cup Mile, was assigned post four when the field was drawn yesterday for Sunday's GI Woodbine Mile S. The gray was installed the 6-5 morning-line favorite to improve on his runner-up effort in last year's Woodbine Mile and has been unbeaten in three starts since. "He's been doing great since [the Woodbine Mile] last year," said trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. "He's just been in a zone of his own. He's incredible. He's doing unbelievable. I'm just really excited about being able to watch him run again." Juddmonte Farms' Ventura (Chester House) is the 4-1 second choice in her attempt to become the first female to win the Woodbine Mile. "I've had five Eclipse Award-winning fillies, but I'd rate [Ventura] pretty good," trainer Bobby Frankel said of the four-year-old who has already won this year's GI Just a Game S. and GII Vinery Madison S. "We'll see how she does in this race [before planning her next start]," he added. The local contingent is headed by Just Rushing (Wild Rush) at 5-1 on the morning line. The seven-year-old gelding is coming off a win in the Aug. 23 GII Play the King S. "It's a good draw...number three, close to the rail," said trainer Sid Attard. "It looks like he's the only speed, so we'll see."

Jurgen Albrecht prevailed with a bid of €220,000 for Blandford Bloodstock's hip 204, a full brother to this year's G1 Deutsches Derby hero Kamsin (Ger), who has also been awarded last month's G1 Rheinland-Pokal due to the disqualification of Oriental Tiger (Ger). Named Kings Messenger (Ger), he will race in the colors of Russian owner Rashit Shaykhutdinov and is likely to be trained by Andreas Wohler.

### Blandford Blitz...

Tom Goff and Richard Brown's Blandford Bloodstock have become a regular force at this sale and yesterday's session saw the operation strike for a number of highprofile yearlings. Following their purchase of the Samum filly, they swooped for Ronald Rauscher's hip 221, a daughter of Darley's red-hot Dubawi (Ire) who is a half to the listed-placed Goblet of Fire (Green Desert). Her dam, who was also listed-placed, is a half to the 2000 G1 Epsom Oaks heroine Love Divine (GB), later the dam of the 2006 G1 St Leger hero Sixties Icon (GB). She provided Rauscher with a profit on the 90,000 guineas he paid for her at Tattersalls December. Blandford also signed the docket for Gestut Brummerhof's hip 254, a son of Monsun (Ger) whose half-sister Quila (Ire) (Unfuwain) is the dam of Quijano (Ger). The international exploits of that gelding ensured that the May-foaled colt named Quitao (Ger) would be hot property and it took a bid of €150,000 to see off the opposition. Twenty lots earlier, the agency had paid €100,000 for Gestut Auenquelle's hip 234, a Marchfoaled son of Big Shuffle named Molly Mambo (Ger). He is a full brother to the 2006 G3 Alice-Cup winner Molly Art (Ger) and that year's G3 Preis der Winterfavoriten scorer Molly Max (Ger). Goff revealed that his purchases may be offered for re-sale. ### Just One for Shadwell...

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's operation was responsible for a single purchase 12 months ago and it was the same story again yesterday as Tom Goff signed for the sole offering by stallion Nayef on their behalf. Consigned by Brummerhof as hip 338, the March-foaled colt named Kayef (Ger) hails from an Aga Khan family and his group-winning second dam Kassana (Ire) was responsible for the 2006 G1 Irish St Leger heroine and G1 Hong Kong Vase runner-up Kastoria (Ire). From the extended family of Kahyasi (Ire), he fetched €200,000. Jurgen Albrecht, who bought the session topper, also paid €180,000 for a daughter of Monsun consigned by Gestut Fahrhof Stiftung. Hip 212 is out of the 2004 G1 Preis der Diana fourth La Hermana (GB) (Hernando {Fr}), whose page includes Lomitas (GB). IVA's Roger Alles later paid €100,000 for the von Stauffenberg's hip 269, a filly by Soviet Star named She is Madonna (Ger). Her second dam is the GIII Pucker Up S. winner Sum, whose progeny include the smart Add the Gold and the dams of the 2006 G3 Chairmans Trophy winner and last year's G1 Hong Kong Cup fourth Art Trader and this year's G3 Grand Prix de Vichy scorer Hapsburg (Fr).

# Bad Timing...

With the average of €28,469 and median of €30,229 down by 22 percent and 24 percent respectively on the record-breaking year of 2007, the hierarchy at BBAG were taking a downbeat stance on the two days of trading. Managing Director Carola Ortlieb commented, "The structural reform [of German racing] has been proposed, but sadly too late for this sale. Vendors at the top level were pleased and very pleasing also was the strong foreign interest, with England and Russia being very active this year. 


