Sir Michael Stoute finally ended his hoodoo in the G1 St Leger as Frankie Dettori steered the 8-1 shot Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}) to a three-length success in the Doncaster Classic. With a elongated list of nearly horses and also-rans in the race to sit alongside his many achievements, the Newmarket-based trainer had few worries this time as Ballymacoll Stud's chestnut hit the front over two furlongs out and maintained the gallop all the way to the line. KEESEP THURSDAY TOPPER RESOLD

The Medaglia d'Oro filly who topped Thursday's session at Keeneland September at \$1.1 million has been resold privately to Bobby Flay. The purchase price was not revealed. On Thursday, the filly was knocked

down to Dr. Karen Sanderson, an oral surgeon based near London who was largely unknown on the American auction scene. The sale was notable in that Sanderson outbid Darley's John Ferguson and Coolmore representatives to land hip 1084 for \$1.1 million; her trainer, the Newmarket-based Paul d'Arcy, signed the ticked. But shortly thereafter, it was revealed that Keeneland officials hadn't completed their credit check of San-

derson, and the sale was declared void. The filly was consigned by Tom Evans's Trackside Farm for her breeders, Stonewall Farm and Liberation Farm.

Conduit was allowed the typical low-profile start to his career that many of Ballymacoll's slower-maturing types have enjoyed under Stoute's care over the years. Off the mark on Wolverhampton's Polytrack last September, he was third on his sophomore debut in a Sandown handicap Apr. 25 before making amends with a dramatic spell of acceleration to win an equivalent contest on Epsom Derby day June 7. Runner-up to Campanologist in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot June 20, he was 1-2 for Goodwood's G3 Gordon S. on his latest start July 29, but only just scraped the win. Ballymacoll looked to have a better prospect for Leger glory in Patkai (Ire), and Conduit was in the shadows until that colt disappointed in the Voltigeur as well as in a recent workout. There was another twist to come, as Ryan Moore opted for Doctor Fremantle (GB) (Sadler's Wells), leaving the four-time winning Frankie Dettori to deputise. Dettori's ride was a simple one. After moving the homebred from rear to the fore early in the straight, his only worry came as the colt jinked to the right when alone in front, but he was always beyond the reach of Unsung Heroine. "The race worked out perfectly, as they went very fast and I knew I was on a stayer," Dettori explained. "He got lost a bit on his own, but it was a great effort." Stoute revealed that Conduit will remain in training at four. "I thought he ran below-par at Goodwood, having shown progression in the King Edward, where he was unlucky as he met interference on the bend," Stoute said. "Ryan was very concerned about the ground and made a late switch, so I'm sorry for him as he has brought him through. We will keep him in training, and look forward to having him around next year." A Genuine Heroine...

Fillies filled the next two places and, for trainer Tommy Stack's son and assistant Fozzy, there was much to take out of Unsung Heroine's effort. "She has been a very good filly and I am delighted with the way she has run," Stack told PA Sport. "She had an Oaks winner and a Derby winner behind, and it's only her third start. We might look at the Breeders' Cup Marathon next [at Santa Anita Oct. 25], and perhaps the G1 Melbourne Cup next year." Jockey Eddie Ahern said of Look Here, "I was very confident, as I had a lovely position, and even though six out I got a bump, she is tough and got back into her stride. Going to the four pole, I was just holding on to her and when I let her down, she couldn't quicken out of the ground. She stayed all the way to the line, and Mr Beckett had her spot-on today." As for the 9-4 favorite Frozen Fire (Montjeu {Ire}), who raced keenly throughout the early stages before failing to pick up and finishing seventh, trainer Aidan O'Brien offered, "He was a little bit fresh and keen, and maybe a mile and six on tacky ground was stretching him as well. Hopefully, there will be another day for him."

Things got eventful in the Gazelle before the gates were ever sprung. Music Note, who was loaded last of the five sophomore fillies, got eager and punched the front of the gates open, but the worst was yet to come. Two stalls to her inside was GISW Country Star (Empire Maker), who flipped in the gate and threw jockey John Velazquez off her back. Luckily, horse and rider emerged unscathed, and a quartet faced the

starter. Sent off at the minimum odds, Music Note laid third for the opening half-mile as Mega (Horse Chestnut {SAf}) and Awesome I Am alternated through moderate fractions on the front end. Javier Castellano gave Music Note her cue approaching the half-mile pole and she strode effortlessly to the

front with three furlongs to race. Merely cantering as she widened into the stretch, the Godolphin filly hopped off leads while being shut down five jumps before the wire, knowing the job was more than complete. "I had a great post on the outside," Castellano commented. "She did it the right way today. She was comfortable and relaxed. At the three-eighths pole, she grabbed the bit and she wanted to go. I took care of her today for her next race." That should come in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Santa Anita Oct. 24, where she will shoot for a championship and her fourth Grade I of the year. The bay bested Proud Spell in the GI Mother Goose S. June 28 and stablemate Little Belle in the GI CCA Oaks July 19. She suffered her lone defeat within the division last time out, finishing a head behind Proud Spell in the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga Aug. 16. With history at stake, Septimus produced a powerpacked performance here which will be remembered for a long time by the purists. It was an imperious success, one that completed trainer Aidan O'Brien's clean sweep of the country's Irish 1000 and 2000 Guineas, Derby, Oaks and Leger; the feat was last accomplished in 1935. Unbeaten over extended trips, the bay was always well placed in third by Seamus Heffernan and drew away from stable companion New Zealand early in the straight to lead home a one-two for Ballydoyle. Runner-up in Epsom's G1 Coronation Cup last June, Septimus emerged in late summer as a formidable stayer with wins in York's G2 Lonsdale Cup in August and the G2 Doncaster Cup the following month. Returning to take the June 28 G3 Curragh Cup, he had been forced to wait on the sidelines while the Ebor meeting fell foul to the weather, but simply exploded under Heffernan here. His rider, who had partnered Halfway to Heaven (Ire) to win the Irish 1000 and Frozen Fire (Ger) in the Irish Derby, paid tribute afterwards. "He wants to win and keep responding and is only five, which is young for a stayer, so he should be around for a while yet," Heffernan said. He added about the Classic quintet for Ballydoyle, "When you are working every day, you don't really see the big picture, but when you step back it's unreal." O'Brien, who is now on Group 1 winner number 19, added, "He's a great horse with a lot of class, and I feel privileged to be involved with so many special people and horses. He is a possible for the [G1] Melbourne Cup [Nov. 4], and there is also the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 5], so we'll sit down and talk next week."

African Rose overcame the disadvantage of having to stay away from home for over a week when capturing this rescheduled heat. Flown over Sept. 4 before the Haydock race, which was lost to the rain two days later, the homebred was diverted to Newmarket to train up to this contest, but showed no negative effects of that unorthodox preparation with a battling success. In the midst of the group racing towards the stands side early, she quickened to lead passing the eighth pole and dug in to prevail as Assertive closed in late. African Rose was third in both the G3 Prix d'Aumale at Chantilly in September and G3 Prix des Reservoirs at Deauville the following month as a two-year-old before returning to take the seven-furlong Listed Prix du Pont-Neuf at Longchamp May 22. Only fourth in the June 24 G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot over that same track and trip, she came within 3/4 of a length of beating Marchand d'Or (Fr) in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest Aug. 10 at Deauville, and that form line entitled her to favoritism. For trainer Criquette Head-Maarek, her justification of that tag came as a relief. "To do what she has done today proves that she is a very good filly," the French conditioner commented. "She is very tough and can go anywhere now." Teddy Grimthorpe, racing manager to owner/breeder Khalid Abdullah, added, "Criquette has done a very good job with her, and it was her idea to go for the Maurice de Gheest. After she ran so well in that, it was the natural thing to come here, but it hasn't been straightforward, with her having to come down to Side Hill in Newmarket and work on the Heath. She looked well today and was shining, but with the trip and race that she has had, I think we'll have to give her the time she needs and deserves now. She is in the [Oct. 5] G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, but also has a couple of options at the Breeders' Cup to mull over." The G1 King's Stand S. winner Equiano (Fr) (Acclamation {GB}), sent off at 9-2, refused to load and was withdrawn.

Charitable Man solidified as the market favorite in the minutes before post time and made his backers happy with a promising score to remain unbeaten. The dark bay had just one previous appearance to his credit, but could not have looked better, making all the running en route to an 11 1/2-length debut victory at Saratoga Aug. 10. He hadn't missed a beat in three subsequent works and was bet into 7-5 to take this graded-stakes debut. Unhurried while four wide down the backstretch. Charitable Man allowed High Mesa (Sky Mesa) and Kensei (Mr. Greeley) to duke it out on the front end, then commenced his rally five deep on the turn. He loomed boldly at the quarter pole, overtook Flying Pegasus at the furlong grounds and stayed on nicely for the win. Victorious trainer Kiaran McLaughlin, who also sent out fourth-place Girolamo (A.P. Indy), indicated the winner would go next in the GI Champagne S. at the one-turn mile Oct. 4.

Doremifasollatido kicked off her career with a pair of starts against state-bred competition, finishing a neck second on debut at this track June 12, then had Tom Durkin literally singing her praises when she graduated by six lengths on Independence Day. The dark bay broke slowly in the Aug. 13 GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga and held on for second, seven lengths adrift of subsequent GISW Mani Bhavan. 



Ridden away from the gate by Kent Desormeaux, Big Brown had to work hard to get the lead from longshot Get Serious (City Zip). He covered the opening quarter-mile in :23.46 and a half in a testing: 46.83 over a course soaked by overnight rains. Big Brown raced freely and with mouth wide open down the Monmouth backstretch and got six furlongs in 1:11.21. Desormeaux had the left rein taut, giving the appearance that Big Brown may have wanted to lay out on the tight-turning track as they cornered for home and, by that time, Proudinsky, prominent throughout; and Shakis, who did it tougher while wide, were launching their respective bids. Big Brown looked in deep water entering the final furlong, but Desormeaux gave his mount a few cracks of his turned-down whip on his right shoulder and Big Brown dug deep, earning arguably his most impressive victory to this point in time. Perhaps the greatest tribute came from Joe Bravo, who rode GII Bernard Baruch H. repeater Shakis. "I underestimated Big Brown," he said. "Until today, when he showed what kind of horse he is."



Overlooked in pre-race discussions despite being a proven Group 1-winning sprinter, indefatigable chestnut Typhoon Zed (Aus) proved his narrow victory in the G1 Galaxy over 1100 meters at Randwick Mar. 22 was no fluke when he repeated the dose here. Jockey Nash Rawiller opted to go forward promptly from barrier 11, and the natural on-pace gelding settled one off the lead behind Kaphero. He fought to edge ahead of the favorite, then fended off a challenge from Absolut Glam despite conceding the filly two kilograms to score by a short half-head. "It's no fluke," trainer Tim Martin said of the gelding, whose A\$213,000 first prize purse boosted his earnings to A\$798,410 overall. "He's a terrific horse. He's pretty honest. When the barrier draw came out, I was really worried. But he traveled down well and I was quite happy with him. He had to do a bit of work early, but there was no pressure mid-race, which helped him." Typhoon Zed was a halflength second in the G3 Missile S. Aug. 2 before notching a last start half-head win in the G3 Concorde S. at Rosehill Aug. 30. He will now point to the G2 Thai Airways International Sprint at Caulfield Oct. 18, ahead of the G2 Salinger S. at Flemington Nov. 1.

Sanderson purchased two other horses Thursday. The first was hip 942, an Afleet Alex--Real Cat colt for \$75,000. The colt was consigned by Paramount Sales, agent for Swordlestown Stud. Sanderson also acquired hip 1132, an Indian Charlie--Christmas Affair filly for \$120,000. Hip 1132 was consigned by Warrendale

Sales, agent for Hargus and Sandra Sexton. Both horses were re-offered yesterday afternoon during a quick break in the action at 4 p.m. The Afleet Alex colt elicited a bid of \$70,000; The Indian Charlie filly was purchased for \$125,000. The combined prices of those two horses means that--for the pair, at least--it was a wash for Keeneland. Sales officials had earlier pledged that, re-

gardless the amount the horses resold for, the connections would be paid the original hammer price. That included the seven-figure price tag for the Medaglia d'Oro filly. Sanderson made a splash at Keeneland when she outlasted Darley's John Ferguson to land hip 1084. Her trainer, the Newmarket-based Paul d'Arcy, signed the ticket for the lone seven-figure horse in Book 2. But Keeneland officials hadn't completed their credit check of Sanderson, and the sale was declared void, pursuant to the company's conditions of sale. "We were in the process of completing the credit check and were waiting for some information from a bank to be faxed to us, and it never came," explained Keeneland Vice President Harvie Wilkinson. "As a result, under our conditions, if you don't have approved credit, you have to pay shortly after the session. This wasn't done, and so we met with her and she agreed that we could put the horses back through the sale." The filly was consigned by Tom Evans's Trackside Farm for her breeders, Stonewall Farm and Liberation Farm. -LM

Sequoia Stands Tall at September...

Sequoia Racing, the new racing partnership begun by bloodstock agent Reynolds Bell, has been making an impact at Keeneland September. Yesterday, Bell, sitting in the back row of the sales pavilion, saw off WinStar

Vice President Elliot Walden to land hip 1371, a handsome Maria's Mon colt from the family of last year's top sophomore filly Octave (Unbridled's Song) for \$390,000. It was the secondhigest price paid for a yearling during September's fifth session. The colt, bred by Kidder, Cole and J & J Mamakos, was offered by Gainesway and was produced by She Nuit All (Lost Soldier), a half-sister to MGISW Octave. The nine-year-old She Nuit All is also a half to MGSW and stakes producer Belle Cherie

(Belong to Me) and two other stakes winners.

The colt marked the 12th purchase overall at September for Sequoia, which has been busy since the sale's start. Among Sequoia's other purchases, all colts, are an Unbridled's Song--Puxa Saco yearling who was knocked down for \$500,000 on Day 1, and a Distorted Humor--Storm Minstrel colt who went for \$450,000 on

"Basically, we buy only colts with the physicals and pedigrees who, if they go on and become top race horses, they can become stallion prospects. That's the idea," Bell explained. "We bought 15 last year, and we'll buy 15 this year. We spread them out between four trainers. Right now, it's Barclay Tagg, Shug McGaughey, Kiaran McLaughlin and Michael Matz. We're based mostly on the East Coast right now."

Just like last year, the entire 15-horse group will be split into 40 units, Bell said. The Seguoia partnership is comprised mostly of owner/breeders.

"With a lot of owner/breeders in there, they can stay in and breed to the horse if he becomes successful," explained Bell. "But if someone comes along and offers us a lot of money, we'll be in a position to take a look at that, too."

Bell said that his focus was horses with distanceoriented pedigrees capable of running two turns. That's borne out when examining his purchases. Last year, Bell secured horses by sires like Giant's Causeway, Lemon Drop Kid, Mineshaft and Awesome Again, and this year has added horses by A.P. Indy, Rock Hard Ten and Ghostzapper. Asked if the Maria's Mon colt fit that mold, too, Bell responded, "Absolutely. I'm primarily going with proven sires who have the pedigree to go two turns."

Thus far, five runners from Sequoia's first group have made the races, including Wickaninnish (Giant's Causeway), a \$450,000 Keeneland September purchase who ran a good second as the chalk in his debut going five furlongs at Delaware Sept. 9.

"And it looks like we've got a real nice Empire Maker colt Named Imperial Council, who ran a nice second to Hello Broadway [at Saratoga Aug. 30], who's coming back in the GI Champagne S. [at Belmont Oct 4]," Bell added. "So that's the type of horse we're looking for, a horse you can maybe go to the Classics with." Imperial Counsel, a \$130,000 September acquisition, is trained by Shug McGaughey.

So what was the impetus behind launching Sequoia Racing?

"I just think it's a good time to be developing stallion prospects in our business," said Bell. "It's a way to spread the risk through a lot of people--plus the racing's exciting." -LM

A Golden Pinhook...

A group of friends who teamed to buy a **Medaglia** d'Oro weanling last year for \$40,000 knocked one out of the proverbial park yesterday at Keeneland September, reselling the handsome colt for \$500,000. Sohby Sonbol signed the winning ticket for Zayat Stables. Catalogued as hip-1592 through the consignment of Eaton Sales, the colt is a half to the stakes-placed Twenty Eight Hours and was produced by Game Trick (Clever Trick), a half-sister to the dam of leading sire Langfuhr.

As a weanling at last year's Keeneland November Sale, the Medaglia d'Oro colt was knocked down to Falguieres Bloodstock, which Romain Malhouitre started two years ago with some friends. Falguieres is a small village in the south of Franc. Malhouitre is the yearling manager at Dixiana Farm, and had selected the colt along with Martin Keogh, himself a broodmare manager at Woods Edge Farm. Falguieres was acting on behalf of a partnership that included both Malhouitre and Keogh, as well as Nick Drion, Rey Ford, Scott Gaddis and Robert Tillier. Drion is also a manager at Woods Edge, while Tillier is a manager at Needham-Betz. The other two aren't involved in the horse business.

Malhouitre and Keogh were on hand to watch the colt sell, and were all smiles afterwards as they accepted congratulations from friends.

"We thought he was a real nice horse, but a half a million from \$40,000 is just dreams," said Keogh. "But he was the talk of the sales grounds today, and we knew we had something special."

Malhouitre commended the folks at Dixiana who prepped the colt for sale. Cont. p19

"They did a really great job with him," said Malhouitre, who added of the dark bay, "We loved him as a weanling--he was a beautiful, big horse. He was always very athletic, with a big walk, and was very correct. He had everything a horse needs to be."

Together or in partnerships with others, Malhouitre and Keogh typically pinhook from between four and eight weanlings each year. Though they typically buy yearlings around the \$20,000 to \$50,000 range, "We may have to upgrade a bit after this one," Keogh smiled. It was easily the biggest pinhook for either man; Keogh had previously resold a \$50,000 weanling for \$230,000, while Malhouitre last year sold an Officer colt he'd bought for \$45,000 for \$115,000.

The partnership sold two other horses yesterday. <u>Hip 1451</u>, a filly by **El Corredor**--Zephyr (His Majesty), was bought for \$65,000 as a weanling and sold to Southern Equine Stables for \$125,000; <u>Hip 1627</u>, a colt by **Grand Reward**--Ionian Bride (Icecapade), was purchased for \$15,000 and resold to H.C. and T.O. Meyerhoff LLC for \$80,000.

For his part, Sonbol is confident Zayat has a top prospect on its hands in the Medaglia d'Oro colt. "He is very well-balanced horse a good walk, and the stallion couldn't be any hotter," said Sonbol. "It looks like he could be the real deal. The horse had a good pedigree and a good physical. We've been trying to add some colts, and I thought he was the best on the day--colt or filly."

The breeders of the colt, Rob Whiteley's Liberation Farm and Stonewall Farm, are enjoying a sensational September. They co-bred an **El Prado (Ire)** colt who brought \$1 million during Book 1 and on Thursday were responsible for the \$1.1-million Medaglia d'Oro filly which wound up selling privately to Bobby Flay yesterday. Despite no longer owning yesterday's topper, Whiteley was genuinely happy for the group that purchased the horse from him and Stonewall.

"When somebody does well with a horse I've sold, either as a yearling or a two-year-old, it makes me happy," he said.

Dilger Hooks 'Em...

Dromoland Farm's Gerry Dilger is the type who doesn't feel entirely comfortable in the spotlight. If the sharp-witted Irishman keeps on racking up big pinhooking scores, though, he may have to get used to it. Yesterday, Dromoland was represented by a pair of rock-solid weanling-to-yearling pinhooks.

The second horse through the ring Saturday morning was <a href="https://hien.com/hie

A few hours later, the Dromoland-offered hip 1472, a colt from the first crop of Eurosilver (Unbridled's Song), was knocked down to Jay Em Ess Stable for \$270,000. The colt, whose dam Attitude (Capote) is a daughter of GSW Good Mood (Devi's Bag), was a \$150,000 weanling purchase by Dilger. The result was doubly good for Dromoland, which also stands Eurosilver.

Dilger purchased a number of Eurosilver weanlings last term, and said this colt looked a lot like pop.

"Very much so--he's getting them like himself," Dilger said. "They're good-looking, rangy, clean-legged, solid horses. I bought five or six weanlings to support Eurosilver. I couldn't buy every one, but I wanted to support those who bred to the horse."

Dilger has a few more Eurosilver pinhooks to sell at Keeneland September, and hopes those horses will further stoke the buzz around the seven-year-old Grade II winner.

"People were very excited about him in July [at the Fasig-Tipton Sale], and people I've talked to said they've seen some very good individuals here," said Dilger.

Though both of his pinhooks yesterday were purchased as weanlings under the Dromoland banner, Dilger said he did have partners on the colts. Dilger declined to name the partners. Asked about how he typically arranges the partnerships, Dilger laughed and said, "It all depends on whose in the back walking ring and who wants a piece of him. There's no planning in it, though I do have some people who I often work with."

To the Wests, Young Man...

Ben Glass, acting on behalf of Gary and Mary West, went to \$350,000 for hip 1653, a colt by Grand Slam from the consignment of Eaton Sales, agent. The colt, bred in Virginia by Edward P. Evans, hails from a family that's been good to Evans. The colt's unraced dam is the five-year-old Last Fever (Storm Cat), a full-sibling to MGISW Raging Fever, GSW Stormin Fever and SW Roaring Fever, all of whom raced in Evans's colors. Hip 1653 was Last Fever's first foal. "What could you not like about him?" said Glass, who did his bidding from the back of the sales pavilion. "He was a typical first foal. In my experience, those foals typically, between their two- and three-year-old years, really grow up and blossom. I think he's going to grow up and be a really good-looking horse. He's good-looking now, so there's a really a lot to like about him. If he was in Book 1, he would have brought tons more money, so we were actually willing to go higher." Glass said the colt would get some R&R at Dell Ridge Farm before joining Jeff Kirk in Ocala. Kirk breaks and trains all of the Wests' youngsters.

More of the Same In Book 3 Opener...

Following Friday's dark day, Keeneland September resumed yesterday in Lexington. Much like the first four days of trading, session five witnessed declines in average and median. Session average was down 8.5 percent to \$109,561, while median was down 10 percent to \$90,000. The cumulative average for September is down 14.2 percent to \$210,721, and the median is down 6.3 percent to \$160,000. One bit of good news for Keeneland is that the session RNA dipped to 21.2 percent, a 19.5-percent drop from last year's corresponding figure of 26.2 percent. "As I said on Thursday, I think consignors have done a spectacular job adjusting their reserves," said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "To have a not-sold rate today of around 21 percent is excellent. Looking at the average from the first page to the last, the average didn't change much--it stayed around \$110,000 range all day. It was consistent from start to finish. It was great to see some breakout horses, like today's session topper. The exercise of this Book 3, with the dark day yesterday, is working very well--there's no mistake. The buyers are out there looking at these horses in the environment we want them to, which is at the barns and not the back walking ring." MGSW Tiz Wonderful (Tiznow--Evil, by Hennessy), undefeated as a juvenile in 2006; and MGSW Notional (In Excess {Ire}--Truly Blessed, by French Deputy) will also join the Spendthrift team. Tiz Wonderful, a \$475,000 FTFFEB purchase by Stonestreet Stable, won three of his five starts for trainer Steve Asmussen, including the GIII Iroquois S. and GII Kentucky Jockey Club S., both at Churchill, He earned \$254,672, J. Paul Reddam's Notional, acquired for \$235,000 as a BESMAR two-year-old, accounted for the GII San Rafael S. and GIII Risen Star S. last year at three, and added a victory in the GIII Salvator Mile S. this season.
