In what turned out to be a slog in the mud following persistent rain at The Curragh, **Mastercraftsman (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) had to dig into his reserves to

Mastercraftsman's potential backers, but the chestnut showed gritty determination to prevail in a bobber. Keen early under restraint tracking the strong pace set by the established stable rabbit Sea of Marmara (Johannesburg), he was guided over to the stands rail by Johnny Murtagh, who allowed Shaweel first run passing halfway. Joining that rival at the furlong pole as O "TDN Rising Star" O Arazan (Ire) (Anabaa) floundered out wide, he inched ahead and maintained the slim advantage in the photo. Murtagh, fresh from a 17th Group 1, said, "He's got everything that a good horse needs--a lot of ability and a great heart to go with it--so with that he's hard to beat. I thought that seven would suit him, but on that ground, it is tough going and he battled well and his class carried him through. He feels like a very high-class horse to me." Cont. p2

ZARKAVA RETURNS WITH A VENGEANCE

Despite fears over a flat midweek workout, Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) returned from her summer break at her brilliant best to remain unbeaten in yesterday's 1 1/2mile G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp. As she had done over a mile in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches here May 11 and over the 1 5/16-mile trip of Chantilly's G1 Prix de Diane on her latest start June 8, His Highness the Aga Khan's sensation delivered a devastating rattle from rear to inhale her rivals and record an ultimately comfortable success. Slowly away from the gates and soon trailing in last under Christophe Soumillon, she still had every rival to pass as the field turned into the straight. Switched to the centre of the track, she unleashed her customary killer kick and was in full swing as her rider stopped pushing when alongside the final victim Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) with 50 yards remaining. Equaling the 2002 race-record time of Pearly Shells (GB) and passing the million-euro mark in the process, Longchamp's darling made a certainty of favoritism in the course-and-distance G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in three weeks' time. Mastercraftsman (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) showed he could dig in on debut May 5 and when doubling up in the June 29 G2 Railway S., but had not needed to employ that side of his nature when dominating Art Connoisseur (Ire) and Bushranger (Ire) in the July 27 G1 Phoenix S. "Johnny [Murtagh] gave him a masterful ride and held him together even though he was tired in the final furlong," Aidan O'Brien said of the winner, who was emulating his sire and the stable's One Cool Cat and George Washington (Ire) in completing the Phoenix/National double. "We were worried about the ground, as he's such a good, slick mover, so it was a very good performance. GREAT DATE FOR THE DUKE Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill) is set to make a diversion to Great Leighs ahead of a tilt at the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, trainer Aidan O'Brien revealed yesterday. While the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe remains a possibility for the five-time Group 1 winner, the Ballydoyle conditioner announced that the Essex venue's Sept. 27 Breeders' Cup Trials day is now on the agenda. "I am not ruling him out of the Arc, but we want to run him at the Breeders' Cup with possibly another run in between," he told PA Sport. "There is a possibility he might run at Great Leighs on the evening of the QEII S. at Ascot. They have a nine-and-a-half-furlong race there [the £40,000 Thoroughbred Open Classic], where Duke of Marmalade would carry a small penalty for his victories on Polytrack, but that is only a possibility at the moment." O'Brien also revealed that the G1 Irish Derby hero Frozen Fire (Ger) (Montjeu {Ire}), who was seventh in Saturday's G1 St Leger, could run in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf and confirmed Saturday's G1 Irish St Leger hero Septimus (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) on course for the Nov. 4 G1 Melbourne Cup.

Zarkava became the first filly since the great Allez France in 1973 to complete the treble of Pouliches-Diane-Vermeille. "She is truly exceptional," her ownerbreeder commented. "It was the plan to stay behind, but not to miss the break like that, so she showed today that she is outstanding." Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre added, "I think the noise of the filly's stalls blanket next to her upset her and that's why she pulled back slightly. We will now wait for the big day." Dar Re Mi's conditioner John Gosden said, "She has run to her second in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks and win in the G3 Prix Minerve to the pound, so we have no excuses--we were beaten by an exceptional one." Treat Gently's owner-breeder Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe revealed that she might be aimed at the Oct. 5 G1 Prix de l'Opera de Longchamp. Vision d'Etat had a tough act in Zarkava (Ire) to follow in this all-important Arc trial, but the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club hero earned a hard-fought win. Like the Vermeille winner, he will enter the course-and-distance showpiece in three weeks' time a millionaire unbeaten in six starts and with Classic-winning form to his name. The bay toughed it out when grinding his way past Ideal World in the final strides under loritz Mendizabal's drive. The list of French Derby winners to have won this race includes recent Arc heroes Montjeu (Ire) and Dalakhani (Ire). "I am thrilled with the result and loritz rode a beautiful race," his part-owner and trainer Eric Libaud commented. "They guickened twice and he gave him every chance to breath and come on his own. He was far from 100 percent today and so we will take it easy on our way to the Arc and be ready for the big day." Teddy Grimthorpe, Racing Manager to Ideal World's owner/breeder Khalid Abdullah, said of the runner-up, "He has never stopped improving and this was by far his best performance today. Favorite for the Arc before his eclipse in this card's G2 Prix Niel 12 months ago, Zambezi Sun had not tasted success since the G1 Grand Prix de Paris last July, but chose the right time to regain the winning thread here. Disappointing again when trailing in this track's G1 Prix Ganay on his four-year-old bow Apr. 27, the bay recovered with a second in the June 1 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly and fourth in the June 29 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud last time. Returning from a subsequent break, he tracked Schiaparelli before edging ahead of that rival at the quarter pole. Made to dig deep by the long-time leader, Zambezi Sun was equal to the task and settled the fight with a final thrust near the line. "He didn't have the ideal preparation for the Arc and it took me a while to get him back to his best," trainer Pascal Bary explained. "He has real talent and, although he is in the Arc, he is not certain to run as there are other options in the world such as Canada, Hong Kong and Japan." 

Better known as a high-class staying hurdler, Kasbah Bliss had done battle with the mighty Inglis Drever (GB) and come off second best in the Mar.13 World Hurdle at the Cheltenham Festival. Switched back to the flat this summer, the bay had finished second in an amateur riders' race on Deauville's Polytrack Aug. 3 before capturing a valuable two-mile handicap on the turf there a fortnight later. Held up in rear early by Thierry Thulliez, he quickened decisively in the stretch to lead passing the quarter pole as Incanto Dream (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) was badly hampered against the rail which led to the demotion of Harbore (Fr) (Raintrap {GB}). Soon clear, he was eased near the line when no dangers appeared. "Hurdling has done him a lot of good, as he has learnt to relax and can produce on the flat now," trainer Francois Doumen said. "After the big handicap last time, we decided it was worth taking a chance here and I am not surprised he won like that. Lady Gloria showed she was at home in this company when wiring the G3 Princess Elizabeth S. at Epsom June 7, but could manage only seventh when upped in class in the Sept. 7 G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown last time. She secured the lead after the opening exchanges here and set sedate early fractions. Shaken up 2 1/2 furlongs from home, she clung on grimly throughout the final eighth as the smooth-traveling Bankable made his challenge in vain. "Her two latest wins have come seven days after a run and there wasn't much wrong with her effort in the Matron when beaten only three and a half lengths by one of the best fillies in Europe [Lush Lashes]," trainer James Given told *Racing Post*. "We may well step up to the G1 Sun Chariot S. [at Newmarket Oct. 4] or go for the [Oct. 5] G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp. I don't know whether she'll remain in training next year." A MACHO MUCHACHO AT KEESEP

A colt by Macho Uno topped yesterday's sixth session of the Keeneland September Sale, closing out Book 3 with a \$400,000 exclamation mark courtesy of Paula C Racing Stable's winning bid. Despite the nice result for consignor Hidden Brook and breeder Adena Springs, both average and median were down for the session. Sitting toward the left side of the sales pavilion, Joe Appelbaum and Carlos Morales, who operate the juvenile pinhooking operation Off the Hook, were steadfast in their bidding and finally won the war for hip 1897. Appelbaum signed the ticket for Paula C Racing, the operation of Jose Castro. Castro is a Venezuelan businessman who campaigned that country's 2007 Triple Crown winner Taconeo (Ven). After going 12 for 14 in Venezuela, Castro moved Taconeo to Kiaran McLaughlin's care earlier this year. The four-year-old son of Water Poet (Ire) was second in the John's Call S. at Saratoga in August.

"Mr. Castro's been getting a taste for the American game, and he's going to pinhook two or three horses this year--a very select group," explained Appelbaum, who said the men became acquainted with each other through the contacts of Morales, a seven-time leading trainer in Venezuela before coming to the States. Appelbaum added, "We've been here all week trying to buy this sort of horse for Mr. Castro, but they kept going for \$3 million and \$1 million, but we were finally able to do it. We're excited for him."

Off the Hook also acquired <u>hip 1489</u> for Castro. The Lion Heart--Bloomin Thunder colt brought \$100,000 on Saturday. "We were really excited to get him for that, because we both really liked him a lot," Appelbaum said.

Yesterday's topper was produced by Bag Lady Jane (Devil's Bag), a MSW & GSP earner of over \$230,000. Bag Lady Jane is daughter of dual Canadian champion Deputy Jane West (Silver Deputy) and a sister to SW & MGSP Deputy Storm (Forestry). Frank Stronach's Adena Springs purchased Bag Lady Jane for \$90,000 at the 1996 Keeneland November Sale and sold her, in foal to Holy Bull, for \$50,000 last year at November. When asked about hip 1897's appeal, Morales commented, "He's a big, good-looking horse, Macho Uno is doing so well, and he's out of a very nice mare. Plus we know that he was bred and raised by a very nice farm."

As a pinhooking operation, Off the Hook is coming off a good spring. Off the Hook sold Break Water Edison (Lemon Drop Kid) to trainer John Kimmel for \$525,000 at the OBS March Sale. That colt earned **O "TDN Rising Star" O** status after breaking his maiden impressively at Belmont in July and went on to be second in the GII Saratoga Special S. -LM

Average, Median Down; RNA Rate Remains Solid...

Numbers were down during the sixth session of Keeneland's marathon September Sale, but sale officials were generally pleased with the level of trading on Sunday. The session average slumped 6.6 percent, to \$91,802, while the median took a 12.5-percent hit, to \$70,000. The cumulative average is now down 13.7 percent, to \$185,876, and the median is down 10.7 percent, to \$125,000. The good news once again was a drop in the RNA rate, which was down 5.2 percent to 21.8 percent for the session. The cumulative RNA rate is down 2.7 percent to 25.5 percent. "It was a good session, with good representation from both the domestic and different international markets," said Keeneland's Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "Europe is still here, Latin American countries are starting to pop up, and the pinhookers have been very busy." Russell said he's optimistic as Book 4 begins this morning at 10:00. "I think we're looking pretty good," he said. "I think this middle market carries over from Book 3 to Book 4. I think we've got some really nice horses [today], and I hope we have a few breakouts." Power to the People...

Trainer Aidan Ô'Brien gave his bosses at Coolmore one order before they left for Keeneland September: "Don't come home without a Powerscourt (GB)." It was mission accomplished yesterday when the operation's Demi O'Byrne outlasted Tom Gentry for hip 1902, a colt from the first crop of the Sadler's Wells son.

O'Brien's affection for Powerscourt is understandable. While wearing the colors of Mrs. John Magnier, Powerscourt won the GI Arlington Million S. and G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup for the Ballydoyle conditioner, banking over \$1.8 million in the process. Powerscourt now stands at Coolmore's Kentucky base, Ashford Stud. He covered at a \$7,500 fee in 2008.

Bred by La Jolla Thoroughbred Stables, hip 1902 was consigned by Padraig Campion's Blandford Stud. La Jolla also bred the colt's dam, the solid grass mare Beefeater Baby (Thunder Gulch), who earned \$190,000 and placed in the GII Honeymoon Breeders' Cup Invitational H. for trainer Bobby Frankel. Beefeater Baby is a half-sister to GSW & GISP The Seven Seas (El Gran Senor) and GSW & GISP Boyal Gem (Boyal Academy).

Good Results for Historic Audley...

Sunday saw some solid sales for Audley Farm, the Berryville, Virgina-based operation which consigns through Brookdale Sales. Audley bred the first horse through the ring yesterday, <u>hip 1708</u>, a gray filly by



Forestry--Never Fail (Holy Bull), who was knocked down to Pegg Thoroughbred Consultants, Inc. for \$150,000.

An hour later, another Audley-bred yearling, <u>hip 1758</u>, elicited a bid of \$330,000 from bloodstock agent Bob Feld, who was acting on behalf of Sagamore Farm. A filly by Dixie Union, hip 1758 was produced by the 10-year-old MGSP Rosthern (Broad Brush), herself a daughter of MGSW Groovy Feeling (Groovy).

Audley purchased Rosthern, in foal to Mt. Livermore, for \$275,000 out

of the 2003 Keeneland November Sale. Two years ago, Audley sold Rostebaran (Aldebaran), a colt out of Rosthern, for \$120,000 at this sale. The mare foaled a Rockport Harbor filly this spring and is back in foal to First Samurai.

The history of Audley Farm stretches back to Colonial America. The farm was founded in 1749, when Lord Fairfax granted a 3,000-acre estate to Colonel George William Fairfax, according to Audley's website. George Washington's cousin bought half the estate 15 years later, and later Audley was home to Eleanor "Nellie" Custis Lewis, Martha Washington's granddaughter and the adopted daughter of George Washington. In the 1920s, the farm was sold to the brothers Monfort and B. B. Jones, the latter of whom owned Sir Barton. The Triple Crown winner stood stud at Audley for 10 years.

Audley came under its current ownership in 1979, when the German Hubertus Liebrecht, on a visit to America to acquire broodmares, took a shine to the property and purchased the farm. Liebrecht died in 1991, but his family, in addition to retaining control of the pharmaceutical company Liebrecht headed, has carried on Audley under the direction of Erich von Baumbach Jr.

"It's a great farm with a lot of history, and the family just loves it," said Jens von Lepel, DVM, who manages Audley for the family, which is still based in Germany. "We're getting ready to celebrate 30 years, and we actually just had a lot of family members over last week. With the children and cousins and everyone, I think there were 19 in all." When Liebrecht first purchased Audley, one of his aims was to mix Germany's stout bloodlines with America's speed-influenced pedigrees. Audley's current broodmare band of 25 still contains a few members which trace to Germany, including the 10-year-old Monabella (Lando {Ger}), whose yearling son by More Than Ready completed Audley's Book 3 selling last night.

All of Audley's offerings are Virginia-breds, something Dr. von Lepel likes to stress to potential buyers.

"I don't think people realize that at Colonial Downs, owners with Virginia-breds are eligible for 100 percent purse incentives," he said. "If you've got a Virginia-bred, you get twice the winner's share of the purse."

Among Audley's biggest accomplishments was selling its first seven-figure horse, The Visualiser (Giant's Causeway), for \$1 million at the 2005 September Sale. Audley also bred, raised and sold Mandy's Gold (Gilded Time), a Grade I winner and million-dollar earner. And yesterday, an Audley-bred and -sold horse, Sixthirteen (Dixie Union), won by three lengths in an allowance/optional claimer at Belmont. Sixthirteen was produced by a sister to Mandy's Gold, Mandy's Classic (Sky Classic).

While primarily a commercial operation, Audley does keep and race a few fillies. "If they do well on the track, hopefully they can come back and join the broodmare band," von Lepel explained.

Helluva Run...

Timing is everything in this business, and yesterday's sale of <u>hip 1995</u>, a colt by Cherokee Run who Centennial Farm purchased for \$350,000, offers a sterling example. Nine years ago, Jody and Michelle Huckabay's Elm Tree Farm offered the colt's dam, Falun Dafa (Editor's Note), as a weanling at the Keeneland November Sale. Elm Tree was acting on behalf of longtime client Robert Wilensky, an Atlanta-based businessman who typically keeps between three and five mares at Elm Tree. Bidding for Falun Dafa stalled out at \$30,000, and Elm Tree bought her back. That proved the right move when, 10 months later at September, Falun Dafa sold to trainer Ken McPeek as a yearling for \$100,000.

Falun Dafa started only twice and got hurt before she was able to win a race, and was subsequently put through the 2003 Keeneland January Sale. The Huckabays and Wilensky took notice, and figured they didn't have much to lose after reacquiring the filly for next to nothing. The cost? Just \$3,000. *Cont. p12*

One month after Falun Dafa was welcomed back into the fold, her half-brother During (Cherokee Run) broke his maiden at Santa Anita for trainer Bob Baffert. During went on to become a rock-solid performer, winning the GII Swaps S., GII Jerome S. and GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. while earning \$820,000. He now stands at Claiborne Farm. During's exploits added quite a sheen to Falun Dafa's page, and surely didn't hurt the price of her first three yearlings through the ring. The Last Mohican (Yonaguska) brought \$100,000 in 2005, Lady of Jackson (Kafwain) made \$50,000 in '06, and Jacks Again (Johannesburg), a \$65,000 weanling RNA, made \$250,000 last year.

Falun Dafa's first two yearlings were bred similarly to During, being by stallion sons of Cherokee Run, but sent to Darley's star himself in 2006, Falun Dafa would produce her most profitable sale horse yet in yesterday's \$350,000 colt.

Since Wilensky paid \$3,000 to repurchase Falun Dafa, the now nine-year-old has produced \$750,000 worth of sales yearlings.

"The family's been very, very good to us," Elm Tree's Huckabay confirmed shortly after yesterday's transaction. "Ben Glass [bloodstock agent for Gary and Mary West] was the underbidder today, and they bought the yearling out of the mare last year for \$250,000--so obviously they think a lot of him."

The Kentucky-based Elm Tree and Wilensky, who breeds under the name Gulf States Racing, had teamed to sell During as a yearling for \$350,000, and had high hopes that he'd turn out to be a top-class colt when they bought Falun Dafa as a broodmare prospect.

"We knew Baffert had the horse, and they had come back and bought the yearling half-brother to During, so we figured he had a chance to be a good racehorse," explained Huckabay.

Speaking of vesterday's success, Huckabay offered, "We knew he was a nice colt, and he just kept getting better and better. We had reserved him at \$120,000, so we're real happy. You just never know in this business."

Young Hall Operation on the Rise...

Anyone who paid attention to Monmouth this summer got familiar with the pink and orange silks of George and Lori Hall. The Halls, a New York City-based couple, have teamed with up-and-coming trainer Kelly Breen to win at a 27-percent clip at the shore. On Saturday, Coffee in Bed (Toccet) became the Halls' latest winner when she broke her maiden in her route debut at Monmouth.

George Hall is only transposing the success he's had on Wall Street. Hall, a graduate of the prestigious Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania, is the founder of the Clinton Group, a hedge fund which handles some \$1.1 billion in investments.

The Halls began buying horses in 2004 and enjoyed immediate success with the likes of 2005 Sorority S. heroine and GI Frizette S. third Keeneland Kat (Hennessy) and Pilgrim S. winner Fagan's Legacy (Monarchos). But last year, the Halls decided to take it to the next level, and it was announced that Breen would become their private trainer.

"That was a big step," Breen said yesterday during a lull in the action at Keeneland. "We were both committing to each other. He is looking to keep me busy with a barnful of horses, and one way to do that is to come down to Keeneland and buy some nice young babies."

Last year, the Halls purchased 12 yearlings at the September Sale for \$1,132,000, an average of \$94,333. Included in that group is their most successful horse to date, the Dixie Union filly Bold Union. Tabbed a 🗘 "TDN Rising Star" 🖸 after romping by 10 3/4 lengths in a Monmouth maiden in June, Bold Union came back to take Belmont's Astoria S. by a similar margin, but failed as the favorite when fourth in the GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga in mid-August. Also included was Rapid Redux (Pleasantly Perfect), an \$85,000 KEESEP purchase last year who ran third in the Tyro S. at Monmouth in July.

The Halls and Breen have been just as busy at this year's Keeneland Sale. Thus far, the Halls have purchased 11 yearlings for \$1,350,000, an average of \$122,727. Among their get is a Giant's Causeway--Aishah colt that went for \$270,000; and a Tiznow--St. Helens Shadow half-sister to successful young sire Officer who was acquired for \$210,000. Yesterday, Breen signed for two, including an Awesome Again--Chit Chatter filly for \$105,000; and a Hennessy--Tipsy Girl filly for \$85,000. Cont. p13

"We're generally looking for fast horses," said Breen. "I like sprinters. If you can get a sprinter to go a mile, that's great. But I do like horses that are going to start and win before the middle of their three-year-old year. I don't need a mile-and-a-half horse. But we look for a lot of value in our horses. That's how George runs his hedge fund, and it's how we run the stable."

One horse the Halls surely found value in is the twoyear-old West Side Bernie, a son of Bernstein who was knocked down here for \$50,000 last year. The colt was an impressive debut winner at Monmouth Aug. 28 and is slated to make his next start in Turfway's GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile S. Sept. 27.

As for their selection process, the Halls acquired West Side Bernie the old-fashioned way: they let George's 12-year-old niece pick a horse out of the rear walking ring at Keeneland and let her bid on the horse.

"Last year, George brought his niece with him to the sale," explained Breen. "At one point, we had an hour break between bidding on horses, and I told them that I was going to sit down [on the benches that ring the pavilion] and just relax. So I'm sitting there, and I see George and the whole crew come in and sit in the pavilion. Then the niece starts raising her hand to bid -- raising her hand like she was in school. Thirty seconds later, George called me on my cell and asked me to come in and the sign the ticket on the horse. It was crazy. At the time, I had been locking myself in my bedroom at home, the bed covered with catalogues and buyers guides, with two kids knocking on the door and a dog ready to have a litter of puppies, and she picks a horse that just gallops first time out. We got a lot of value there--you can find horses in strange places."

While the Hall family had left by Sunday, they were on hand Saturday to enjoy the action. George and Lori's young children Kathryn and George Jr., ages six and five, did some bidding, too, but sadly weren't able to land any prospects.

"Maybe if we bring them back for Book 4 or 5," laughed Breen.

Whistling Dixiana...

On Saturday, the yearling manager at Dixiana Farm, Romain Malhouitre, was part of the group that scored the huge pinhooking coup via the \$500,000 Medaglia d'Oro session topper. Yesterday, it was Dixiana's turn. William Shively, who owns Dixiana Farm, was on hand to watch a Tiznow colt bred by his operation sell to RLD Bloodstock for \$290,000.

"He's a really nice colt, but we didn't think he'd bring that much," said Shively, an insurance executive in Florida. "We're really happy."

The colt, catalogued through Four Star Sales as <u>hip</u> <u>1985</u>, is the first foal from the winning Souvenir Copy mare Elora, who hails from the family of Grade I stakes winner Collect the Cash.

Dixiana bought Elora, with this colt in utero, for only \$30,000 at the 2006 Keeneland November Sale.

"She was a well-balanced little mare who ran decently on the track," explained Shively. "And I love Tiznow, both as a race horse and a sire. We always have a Tiznow or two around; we've got a Tiznow broodmare.

Shively also has a small farm outside of Gainesville which was named Tomoka Hills Farms before Shively renamed it Dixiana Farm South. The operation was still called Tomoka Hills when Shively bred a small but wellbuilt son of Lucky Lionel from Comet Cat, a Birdonthewire mare he'd purchased for \$19,000. That colt went on to become the top-class sprinter Benny the Bull.

Shively purchased historic Dixiana Farm back in 1999, and in 2006 added the nearby 325-acre Woodlynn Farm. Shively currently owns about 75 broodmares. He keeps roughly 50 at Dixiana and the rest in Florida.




