#### 'SMOOTH' UPSETS 'SPELL' IN COTILLION

She's a dirty girl. **Seattle Smooth** (Quiet American) continued to shine on conventional dirt surfaces, upsetting 2-5 chalk **Proud Spell** (Proud Citizen) to take the \$750,000 GII Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. at Philadelphia Park

yesterday. Guided to the rail by Jose Lezcano, the big filly secured a ground-saving trip as longshot Color Me Up (Aptitude) cut out the early fractions. Proud Spell never looked comfortable racing be-

tween rivals. Seattle Smooth shifted out and loomed boldly on the turn, but found herself carried further out when the pacesetter drifted off the rail, and Proud Spell was forced into the center of the track. The second choice kept on going, hit the front in midstretch and strode home smoothly for her first graded trophy. Proud Spell rallied belatedly to claim second. "I didn't want to get into a dogfight with Proud Spell," said winning trainer Tony Dutrow, who took over the filly's care this summer. "We've been watching her win those all year." He added, "I'm overwhelmed. Larry [Jones] and my brother Rick both came here with great fillies in Proud Spell and By the Light, and we beat them. This is a tremendous win." Cont. p2

A maiden winner in an off-the-turf contest at Hollywood--her third career start--Seattle Smooth romped by six lengths Apr. 12 over an old-fashioned main track in the Bay Meadows Oaks. She travelled to Pimlico for the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. and finished third in the mud in that May 16 test; sent back to California, she came home ninth on the grass in the GII San Clemente H. at Del Mar July 26, her final outing for trainer Julio Canani. Transferred to Dutrow, the rangy miss reported home an authoritative 7 1/4-length winner of Delaware's Go for Wand S. Aug. 30, and loomed the main danger to Proud Spell here.

The GI Kentucky Oaks and GI Alabama S. heroine carried 124 pounds in the Cotillion, five more than the winner, and nine to 10 pounds more than the others. It remains uncertain as to whether she'll run again this season. "Everybody wants to beat her," said trainer Larry Jones. "We came here with a big bull's eye on our back, and got beat by a little race riding. We were packing a good bit more weight than the others and, in that scenario, you look to get yourself a nice clean trip. Today, we got anything but." Proud Spell is the second straight odds-on choice to falter in the Cotillion; Octave ran second at 1-5 a year ago.

#### Gallant Bloom H. cont.

Indian Blessing was crowned the nation's champion juvenile filly following her score on Breeders' Cup Day at Monmouth, and kept up the good work in her first two outings this year. A game winner of the GII Santa Ynez S. in her seasonal opener Jan. 13, the dark bay defeated Proud Spell for the third time in the GIII Silverbulletday S. Feb. 9 before succumbing to that rival in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 8. She proved second best to Zaftig in the GI Acorn S. going a flat mile at Belmont June 7, but, shortened up since, has gone on a three-race tear. A 5 1/4-length tally in the GI Prioress S. July 5 preceded a seven-length score in the GI Test S. Aug. 2 at Saratoga, and she added another trophy here. Trainer Bob Baffert scratched her out of the GI Ruffian H. Sept. 6 and flirted with both the \$400,000 Presque Isle Downs Masters last Saturday and the GI Vosburgh S. against the boys a week hence before ultimately deciding on this safe spot. "The day started horrible, but at least the champion came through," Baffert told Daily Racing Form, referring to Ruffian winner Tough Tiz's Sis sustaining a career-ending injury (see p9). "We were low, then went all the way down, and now came all the way back again." Indian Blessing will now rejoin Baffert's California string for a tilt at another Breeders' Cup title. My Pal Charlie has made quite a name for himself in the Pelican State. Earlier this year, the bay colt attempted to wire the GII Louisiana Derby at Fair Grounds before settling for second at 60-1 to Pyro, but he made good on that promise by proving a sharp winner of this \$500,000 contest.

A full brother to the good sprinter Bwana Charlie, My Pal Charlie disappointed in his first three tries for owner B. Wayne Hughes and trainer Al Stall Jr. He turned things around when dropped in for a \$50,000 tag to graduate Jan. 26 and promptly added an entry-level allowance score on Valentine's Day at Fair Grounds. Following his runner-up effort to Pyro in the Louisiana Derby, he finished fifth in the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 12 at Oaklawn before filling the same spot in the GIII Lone Star Derby May 10. The Kentucky-bred found Pyro too good once more in the GIII Northern Dancer S. at Churchill June 14, and weakened to be fifth again after a wide trip in the GIII West Virginia Derby at Mountaineer Aug. 2.

My Pal Charlie took advantage of post two, breaking alertly to secure a rail trip as Stungbythestorm (Vindication) cut out fractions of :23.14, :47.65 and 1:11.81. Moving eagerly under Curt Bourque, the third choice cut the corner smartly and quickly put daylight between himself and his rivals, striding home impressively in the final furlong. Favored Macho Again, forced to steady on the turn for home, outfinished Forest Command to take second.

Consistency proved its own reward here as Lord Shanakill finally garnered a first stakes success. Third in Royal Ascot's six-furlong G2 Coventry S. June 17, the bay stepped up a panel and saw out the trip when second to Orizaba (Ire) in Goodwood's G2 Vintage S. July 30. Reverting back to six for Deauville's G1 Prix Morny Aug. 24, he was third behind Bushranger (Ire) and Gallagher on that occasion, but seemed unsuited by the drop back to five furlongs when fifth in Doncaster's G2 Flying Childers S. last Friday. Showing early pace to race behind the leading duo in this contest, Lord Shanakill overhauled the speedy Sayif at the furlong marker and battled gamely between that rival and Gallagher in the run to the line. "The pace wasn't very strong, but he traveled beautifully and everything went right for him," jockey Jim Crowley said. "He had a bit to find with Gallagher, but he's a hardened horse now. Eighth on debut at Deauville July 12, Calvados Blues was a last-out second at Chantilly Sept. 1 and justified connections' decision to pay a €4,800 supplementary fee with victory in this black-type bow. Restrained in third until pushed along to challenged with 350 meters remaining, he took a slender advantage into the final eighth and was ridden out to safely hold the late charge of Naval Officer. "I think he has great potential and, although he's still immature, there is more improvement to come," said trainer Philippe Demercastel. "He was originally entered in the maiden [earlier on the card], but the owner insisted we go for this after he did some good work at home. We will take our time to decide where to go next, but the G1 Criterium International [at Saint-Cloud Nov. 2] will be under consideration." Explaining on how he came to acquire the winner, coowner Malcolm Parrish added, "I fell in love with him when I first saw him as a foal on the farm, and watched him grow until he was offered for sale at Deauville last year. I was keen to buy him, which I eventually did, and I think he is very good. Hopefully, the best is yet to come."

Never on Sunday, successful in a June 16 Chantilly conditions event, returned there to garner the July 31 Listed Prix Ridgway in his stakes debut and maintained the winning streak with this patient victory. Settled last of the eight runners from the bell, he made headway in the straight to challenge with 250 meters remaining and was ridden out late to assert superiority. "He was supposed to run in blinkers, but it proved impossible to fit them during the saddling process as he was going crazy and would have killed somebody if we had persisted with our efforts," explained trainer Jean-Claude Rouget. "We had no choice but to run him without them, and the victory was probably his way of telling us he didn't need them. He hasn't stopped improving and is entered in the [Oct. 18] G1 Champion S. at Newmarket, but is also in the Argana Arc Sale at Saint-Cloud Oct. 4, so we have to make a decision whether he is to be retained or sold." Edouard de Rothschild, owner of Russian Cross, outlined future plans for the runner-up. "He ran a very good race, considering he was giving weight to the winner," de Rothschild said. "He most definitely showed that he will not stay a mile and a half, so he will not run in the [Oct. 5] G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. However, we are keen to go for the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket, but he will have to be supplemented for that race." A sad postscript to the event was the demise of early leader River Proud (Proud Citizen), who set the pace, but faded in the straight, where he ultimately collapsed and died (see p10). 

Reigning Horse of the Year Weekend Hussler racked up his seventh Group 1 win at his first attempt beyond a mile when he snatched the Caulfield feature Saturday. The win was not handed to the athletic bay on a plate, however, and at the 200-meter pole, bookmakers had reason to think they would get a reprieve from the sensationally backed gelding. Seeking a chink in the champion's armour, Michael Rodd aboard Maldivian skipped away to a two-length lead rounding the home turn, while Weekend Hussler was caught wide after racing in third throughout. Then Pompeii Ruler challenged on the outside as jockey Brad Rawiller asked the bay for a supreme effort to collar Maldivian. The former was able to shake off Maldivian, but despite a gallant effort, was unable to hold off 'The Hussler,' who laid his ears flat back and applied himself to the task for a narrow win. "He was three wide all the way; Maldivian got a kick on him, and [Weekend Hussler] ran Maldivian down," marvelled trainer Ross McDonald. Jockey Brad Rawiller said his worst fears were realized when Maldivian scooted forward. "I wasn't that confident, I thought if that happened we might be in trouble, but I was happy to get him into the clear, and I know what he can do when he gets into rhythm," the rider explained. "I did ask him for a bit more, but I trusted him-he has always found more when I have asked for it." Rawiller added, "This field today was full of champion horses and once again he's out on top, because he is the best." One punter had A\$1 million on Weekend Hussler at A\$1.65, and bookmakers reported heavy losses on the gelding, who is outright favourite for the G1 Cox Plate. TAB Sportsbet and Betstar have Weekend Hussler at A\$3 for the Caulfield Cup and at A\$2.80 for the Cox Plate. McDonald said Weekend Hussler would likely target the G1 Yalumba S. over 2000 meters Oct. 11 ahead of the Caulfield Cup a week later, and a decision on the Cox Plate would be made after that.

#### TOUGH TIZ'S SIS INJURED, RETIRED

Multiple Grade I winner **Tough Tiz's Sis** (Tiznow--Lease-holder, by Taylor's Falls) has been retired after pulling

up from a five-furlong workout with an injury Saturday morning at Belmont. Trainer Bob Baffert told Daily Racing Form that an exam revealed "the beginning of a condylar fracture" in the fouryear-old filly's right foreleg. Tough Tiz's Sis was coming off the best performance of her career, a 12 1/4-length victory in the GI Ruffian H. in the slop at Belmont Sept. 6. "It makes you sick to your stomach; she was peaking at the right time," Baffert told *DRF*. He added that while the injury was not necessarily career-ending, the filly had

"done enough." She is scheduled for surgery today, where a screw will be inserted in the fracture. Tough Tiz's Sis began her career at Hawthorne in December 2006 at two before she was privately sold to owners Karl Watson and Paul Weitman after a 6 1/4-length maiden triumph in her third start. She won her first stakes three starts later when she prevailed in the WinStar/Sunland Park Oaks in March 2007 before she finished seventh in the GI Kentucky Oaks. She rebounded to capture the GII Hollywood Breeders' Cup Oaks in her subsequent outing and added a victory in the GI Lady's Secret S. in October of that year. She was then seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, but would never again finish worse than third. From seven starts at four, Tough Tiz's Sis added wins in the Harry W. Henson Breeders' Cup H. at Sunland in March and GIII Hawthorne H. at Hollywood Park in May, in addition to her Ruffian romp. She retires with a lifetime record of 20-8-5-3 and \$903,791 in earnings.

RIVER PROUD DIES Mrs Michael Spencer's River **Proud** (Proud Citizen--Da River Hoss, by Irish River {Fr}) collapsed and died after attempting to wire the field in yesterday's G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange at Longchamp. Leading at a solid pace from flagfall, the sophomore appeared to falter along the rail when still in front halfway up the straight and never recovered after collapsing in front of the stands. "The vet told me that his aortic valve burst, and it's so tragic as he was a really great horse," trainer Paul Cole told Racing Post. Jockey Olivier Peslier added, "Coming out of the last turn he lost his action, and I knew something was wrong. He began wandering before I realised exactly what had happened." River Proud earned "TDN Rising Star" status with a five-length debut score at Newbury in June last year, and the highlight of his juvenile campaign came with victory in the G3 Somerville Tattersall S. at Newmarket in October. Fourth on seasonal return in the Apr. 17 G3 Craven S. back at Newmarket, he became upset at the gate in the May 11 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp and registered a career high in that event when finishing third after being reloaded in a disadvantageous wide box. River Proud regained the winning thread in the Aug. 2 Listed Thoroughbred S. at Goodwood and ran second to Russian Cross (Ire) (Cape Cross (Ire)) in the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville last time Aug. 23. He won three of his 10 starts and garnered earnings of £140,678.

Mambo in Seattle (Kingmambo), beaten a nostril in the GI Travers S. Aug. 23, will face Curlin (Smart Strike) in next Saturday's \$750,000 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. Trainer Neil Howard had considered keeping the colt among his peers in the GII Super Derby, but opted to

"We have nothing but the utmost respect for him, like everybody else does. We agree he ran a good race; we didn't see any blemishes anywhere." Robby Albarado, who piloted Mambo in Seattle in the Travers, will be aboard Curlin in the Gold Cup; Edgar Prado will take over the reins on the Farish/Kilroy homebred. Also expected in the 10-furlong contest are Angliana (Giant's Causeway), Frost Giant (Giant's Causeway), Timber Reserve (Forest Camp) and Wanderin Boy (Seeking the Gold), and possibly A.P. Arrow (A.P. Indy) or Ravel (Fusaichi Pegasus).



Dandy Nicholls excels at turning the cast-offs of the high-profile establishments into top sprinters and applied the magic again here as Regal Parade led home a one-two for the stable, celebrating a fifth winner from the last nine runnings. Formerly trained by Mark Johnston for Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Regal Parade had failed to build on his three wins from his first three starts and left that Middleham base for his new connections at the end of last year. Trying seven furlongs for the first time in almost a year in Royal Ascot's Buckingham Palace S. June 20, he registered a 25-1 surprise there before finishing third in the Bunbury Cup at Newmarket July 11. Back to a mile for a prestigious prize at Goodwood last time Aug. 1, the chestnut formed one of a five-strong Nicholls squad tackling the shortest trip of his career so far. In rear of the stands-side group as the strong early pace caught him out, he was last approaching halfway, but worked his way through the crowd from there under jockey William Carson, grandson of the legendary Willie Carson who went through his entire career without a win in this prestigious race. With his momentum carrying him to the front with 100 yards remaining, Regal Parade's stamina kicked in and he surged clear of the Shadwell reject Tajneed for the notable exacta. "I watched his races over seven furlongs and a mile last night and he wasn't traveling as well here because of the pace over six furlongs, but I knew they'd come back to me on this ground," Carson commented. "He traveled to the front and I did the easy job of keeping him going." The winning trainer added, "It's a hard race to win and you need the rub of the green, but they are both nice horses and he'll be going to Dubai, I would imagine."
