The four-year-old Juddmonte homebred **Passage of Time (GB)** (Dansili {GB}--Clepsydra {GB}, by Sadler's Wells) has been retired, connections announced yesterday. Khalid Abdullah's 2006 G1 Criterium de Saint-

Cloud heroine, who was placed three times at the top level, disappointed on her latest start when only fifth in the Aug. 22 G1 Yorkshire Oaks staged at Newmarket. Trainer Henry Cecil told the Racing Post, "Passage of Time retires as a Group 1 winner,

and I'm sure she will prove a valuable addition to her owners' broodmare band. She was very consistent and was a winner in each of the past three seasons." Following her defeat of Soldier of Fortune (Ire) in the Saint-Cloud feature as a juvenile, Passage of Time was also successful in the G3 Musidora S. at York last May before suffering from a cyst on her epiglottis. After recovering from that problem, the filly, from the family of All at Sea, was third in both the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp and GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Monmouth Park. Highlights this term were a win in the Listed Steventon S. at Newbury July 19 and another third in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood Aug. 2. Passage of Time retires as the winner of five of her 13 starts and with earnings of £335,947.

#### NEW APPROACH TO CHAMPION; NO ARC, BC

Princess Haya of Jordan's **New Approach (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) will tackle the Oct. 18 G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. at Newmarket, trainer Jim Bolger announced yesterday. While tilts at the G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and GI Breeders' Cup Classic had been under consideration, connections have decided to round off the G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Irish Champion S. winner's sophomore season with an outing in the 10-furlong contest. "It has been decided that New Approach will bypass Longchamp and run instead in the Champion S. at Newmarket," Bolger told the *Racing Post*. "It was decided that running in the Arc would be problematical because of the draw factor, and it is probably the case that the mile-and-a-quarter trip at Newmarket should suit him better than a mile and a half at Longchamp."

#### INDIAN BLESSING FINE AFTER BLOOM SCORE

Hal and Patti Earnhardt's **Indian Blessing** (Indian Charlie) exited her dominating score in Saturday's GII Gallant Bloom H. in fine fettle, reports Tonja Terranova, who

oversees trainer Bob Baffert's horses in New York. "Nothing fazes her," said Terranova. The three-year-old filly won the 6 1/2-furlong event at Belmont by 6 1/4 lengths. Last year's champion juvenile filly is slated to leave for California tomorrow to prepare for the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Santa Anita Park on Friday, Oct. 24. "It will be hard seeing that empty

The local star entered this off four straight wins, including three in stakes company: the Chris Loseth H. July 6, the restricted B.C. Cup Stellar Jay Aug. 4 and the Richmond Derby Trial H. Aug. 31--all at 1 1/16 miles. Making his first start at nine furlongs as the crowd's second choice, Krazy Koffee was farther back than usual as he rated seventh of eight. Asked for his run on the far turn, Krazy Koffee circled five wide, hit the front in upper stretch and kept on under a drive to best longshot Wink at the Girls. Favored Texas Wildcatter, who ran for different connections when he was beaten just a nose by Visionaire in the GIII Gotham S. at Aqueduct this past March, completed the trifecta at 6-5 odds. #### GRAEME HALL COLT TOPS KEESEP SUNDAY

A Florida-bred colt by Graeme Hall topped Sunday's action at Keeneland September on Leighton Brooke Racing's \$95,000 bid. The Jan. 27-foaled chestnut, a \$55,000 Keeneland November weanling purchase, was consigned by Gainesway as hip 4748. Andrew Cant bred the colt, a son of the nine-year-old Is It True mare Divine Rockette who hails from the family of E Z Warrior (Exploit). River Dyna went to \$57,000 for a filly by Mizzen Mast, the top-priced miss and the third-highest price on the day. Hip 4525, consigned by Beau Lane Bloodstock as agent for Honeysuckle Farm, was produced by the Silver Deputy mare Oops. Janeen Oliver bred the filly. Session figures were again down significantly. The average of \$11,253 took a 23.5 percent hit; the median of \$9,000 was down 11.1 percent. The sale concludes Tuesday. Sessions begin at 10:00 a.m.

FIRES CALLS IT A CAREER The 61-year-old Earlie Fires, long a fan favorite on the Chicago circuit, rode his final race yesterday at Arlington Park. The Hall of Fame jockey was fifth aboard favored Manchu Prince in a claiming race on the grass. Born Mar. 19, 1947, in Rivervale, Arkansas, Fires booted home his first winner, Carnation Kid, at Oaklawn on Mar. 6, 1965, the same year he led all apprentice jockeys in the nation with 224 wins. During four decades, Fires captured riding titles at Hawthorne, Arlington, Calder, Keeneland, Churchill, Gulfstream, and the Miles Park. Fires competed in five renewals of the Kentucky Derby, his best finish a third (promoted to second) on Francie's Hat in 1968, the year Dancer's Image was taken down after a medication positive. Fires twice won seven races on a card at Arlington, first on Aug. 16, 1983, and again May 25, 1987. Fires had two Breeders' Cup mounts, both in '87. He came home fifth on 39-1 shot Explosive Darling in the Mile and was fifth again in the Distaff on 17-1 shot Ms. Margi. Fires, who has called In Reality his bestknown mount, was inducted into racing's Hall of Fame in 2001. Fires was recognized vesterday with a winner's circle celebration. He thanked friends and family, and offered a special thanks to his late wife Kathy, who passed away in 2005 from a rare form of cancer.

Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin's assistant, Artie Magnusson, reported Lucky Island is "doing better than ever" since the race. Lucky Island is two-for-two at Belmont, having won the GIII Bold Ruler H. May 10 and GII Tom Fool H. July 4.

#### Ginger Punch Works For Beldame:

Hall of Fame trainer Bobby Frankel sent out Adena Springs homebred **Ginger Punch** (Awesome Again) to a five-furlong workout Sunday morning at Belmont Park. The five-year-old stopped the clock in 1:01.26 on the fast main track. Ginger Punch, who comes off a nose victory in the GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga Aug. 22, goes in search of her fifth straight win in and fourth consecutive Grade I triumph in Saturday's GI Beldame S. at Belmont. Frankel's Aug. 30 GI Forego H. winner **First Defence** (Unbridled's Song) also worked Sunday, breezing a half mile in :48.26, while **Out of Control** (**Brz**) (Vettori {Ire}), completed five panels in 1:01.67.
