by a full sister to A.P. Indy, Mambo in Seattle came alive with three straight victories in May, June and July. The bay came up an improbable nostril short in the Aug. 23 GI Travers S. last time, and is bidding to become the third straight sophomore to triumph here following Bernardini in 2006 and, well,

Curlin last year. "It gives you a little bit of a comfort zone knowing it has been and can be done again, but Curlin's in good form," trainer Neil Howard told Daily Racing Form. "One of the biggest things that closed the deal for [his owners is that] he has uncharacteristically improved with every race, including the Travers, and he's kept on moving forward."

Giant Killer Jr?

Nick Zito may cede the offical "Giant Killer" title to Hall of Famer Allen Jerkens, but he's knocked off several major prizes with relatively unconsidered runners. Zito's Birdstone charged past Smarty Jones to thwart the 2004 Triple Crown bid, and Da' Tara posted this year's stunning upset of Big Brown in the Belmont. Can he do it again with veteran Wanderin Boy (Seeking the Gold)? "Curlin's a great horse. I'm only hoping we catch him on an off day when he's not one-million percent," Zito told DRF. The seven-year-old ran third to Curlin in his latest, the GI Woodward S. at Saratoga Aug. 30.

Aidan O'Brien boasts a sole win here provided by the highly talented George Washington (Ire) two years ago and will be buoyed by the return to lively conditions for **Henrythenavigator**. He is unbeaten over surfaces without soft or heavy in the description and came unstuck for the third time on easy ground when only fifth as

favorite in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp last time Sept. 7. His previous defeats of New Approach (Ire) in both the G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas at Newmarket and The Curragh in May and of Raven's Pass in both the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 17 and Sussex stamped him as one of the best colts to have been trained at Ballydoyle in recent years. Between him and Tamayuz, they have annexed the majority of the season's top

miling contests and the latter looked to be developing into a stellar performer with a 2 1/2-length defeat of Natagora (Fr) in the Jacques le Marois. "Tamayuz is very well and I couldn't be happier with him at the moment," the homebred's trainer Freddy Head told PA Sport. "I think the horse is still progressing and I don't have any worries. It is fast ground at Ascot which should be perfect, so everything is good." Raven's Pass has suffered defeat at the hands of both, with 1 1/2 lengths separating him and Tamayuz in the G1 Prix Jean Prat and 3/4 of a length and a head the margins between him and Henrythenavigator at the Royal meeting and in the Sussex, respectively. His subsequent easy win in that track's Aug. 23 G2 Celebration Mile sets him up for another shot, and jockey Jimmy Fortune harbors hopes he can turn the tables. "We have met Henrythenavigator three times and he has beaten us three times--albeit we have got closer every time we have met him--and if he wasn't around, we would have the champion," he said. "His main aim is the Breeders' Cup, so he is probably a little bit heavier than he normally is, but I rode him work the other morning and he is in great form. I'm quietly confident he will run a very big race--he gets the mile well and I wouldn't be surprised if he got further in time, as he is nice and relaxed now."

This prize has seen some high-class fillies enter and exit unbeaten in recent times, with Gossamer (GB) and Soviet Song (Ire) the most notable to do so in 2001 and

2002. Rainbow View (right), who has won her three starts by a total of 14 lengths without a hint of stress, hails from the John Gosden stable responsible for the trio of winners Crystal Music, Playful Act (Ire) and Nannina (GB) since the millennium year. Her facile wins in the G3 Sweet Solera S. at Newmarket Aug. 9 and G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster last time Sept. 11 came against rivals over their head, but she may need to engage an extra gear to deal with this assembly. "She has been impressive in all her starts and I tried to be as easy on her as I could at Doncaster last time, thinking

that the Fillies' Mile is just around the corner," jockey Jimmy Fortune commented. "She did it very well and while she hasn't met anything spectacular yet, she couldn't have done it any easier so you would have to be impressed by her." Fantasia heads the opposition and follows the Gossamer route here after wins in the same Newmarket maiden July 11 and G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood Aug. 23. Sir Michael Stoute saddles The who like Red Bloom comes off the back of a sevenfurlong maiden success at Newmarket Aug. 22, where she broke the juvenile track record. "We have decided to dip our toes in the water against the two top fillies," her owner-breeder's Racing Manager John Warren told PA Sport. "Sir Michael says she did a very nice piece of work at the weekend, which justified her declaration for the race. She is on a learning curve, but we are hoping for a decent showing."

Lemon Drop Mom by a flared nostril in the GI Personal Ensign H. Aug. 22 at the Spa. 'She's got the heart of a champion," said trainer Bobby Frankel. "In the Go for Wand, if she wasn't a champion, she wouldn't have won. She wants to win." Trainer Saeed bin Suroor will be on hand to saddle Cocoa Beach, who steps up in class following a facile win in her U.S. bow. Unbeaten in her native Chile, the dark bay won a pair of listed events at Nad al Sheba before running third in the G2 UAE Derby Mar. 29. She needed some time to get going in an overnight stakes at Saratoga Aug. 29, but was confi-

dently ridden to a five-length success that afternoon. "Cocoa Beach is a classy filly who won well last time," bin Suroor said on Godolphin's website. "She had a good long break after running in Dubai and she looks to have improved." He added, "Her last piece of work was very good. She is good enough to run in such a race, and I am happy with her."

Mauralakana has risen to new heights as a 5-year-old this season, securing her spot at the head of the division with sharp score in the GI Beverly D. S. last out Aug. 9 at Arlington. That was her fourth straight trip to the winner's circle, and fifth out of six 2008 starts. Her

only loss was a second to **Hostess** in the GIII Orchid H. Mar. 30 at Gulfstream, but that rival may not reoppose here if the rain continues to fall in the Big Apple area. The precipitation is also a concern to Mauralakana's conditioner, Christophe Clement. "With the weather, maybe I should have gone to California [for the GI Yellow Ribbon at Oak Tree,"

Clement told *Daily Racing Form*. "But at the moment, she is running here. She's doing well. She's training well. Everything is a go." **Dynaforce**, who performed with credit on soft ground in France, split Mauralakana and Hostess in the blanket finish of the GII New York H. June 21 in her U.S. bow. A close second in the GI Diana S. at Saratoga July 26, the bay was forced to steady when fifth in the 11-furlong GIII Glens Falls H. over the same course Sept. 1 in her most recent effort. Last year's surprise Flower Bowl heroine, Lahudood (GB), went on to take the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf and Eclipse Award honors.

Nearly all of the entrants for today's test have been confronted by easy ground, but it is something of a crapshoot to predict who might handle these conditions, which could approximate the bog of the 1995 GI Breeders' Cup Turf at this venue. **Proudinsky** is the lone member of the field to have competed over soft European turf, having won his maiden by 15 lengths prior to a narrow defeat by Saddex (GB) in a German listed stakes in his second career start. The latter has since registered multiple Group 1 scores overseas and was a half-length runner-up to Duke of Marmalade (Ire) in this year's G1 Prix Ganay. Proudinsky, winner of the GII Mervin Muniz Memorial H. this past March, makes his third start in 35 days and comes off a second to Big Brown in the Monmouth S. two weeks back. Dancing Forever has rounded into top form this season and loves this surface, over which he took the GI Manhattan H. on the Belmont S. undercard in June. His fifth to Grand Couturier as the 3-2 favorite in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. Aug. 16 was below par, but he is just one for five at the Spa and that effort is best forgiven. Summer Patriot could be the wild card off a 7 3/4length victory in the 13-furlong John's Call S. at Saratoga Aug. 17.

Fabulous Strike has faced the starter only once since his dominating win in last year's Vosburgh, but still merits plenty of respect here. The dark bay, who missed last year's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint due to a respiratory illness, wired Delaware's Vincent A. Moscarelli Memorial S. in his lone start this term June 21. He was forced to sit out Saratoga's GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt July 26 due to a foot injury. The Walter Downey colorbearer has recently fired two straight bullets at Presque Isle Downs, including a five-furlong move in :59 3/5 Sept. 21. "From the time I had to cancel that Breeders' Cup trip last year I never quit thinking about trying to get back in that spot again," trainer Todd Beattie told Daily Racing Form. "I'm sure we haven't seen the best out of this horse. I think we're in a position where we could see quite a bit [today]." Shadwell's Lucky Island looked primed to take control of the sprint division following the retirement of Benny the Bull (Lucky Lionel), but a eventful beginning in the Aug. 30 GI Forego S. led to a disappointing sixth-place finish behind First Defence. The GII Tom Fool H. victor posted a best-of-53 four-furlong workout in a snappy :47 over the Belmont training track Sept. 14. "The Forego was a disappointment," said Artie Magnusson, assistant trainer to Kiaran McLaughlin. "He lost all chance at the start. He was caught flat-footed, which was okay, but then a few steps out there was checking. He's been training very well since then and we expect a good performance." Rockerfeller, a good third behind Benny the Bull in the GII Smile Sprint H. July 12, earned a gaudy 112 Beyer Speed Figure when annexing Monmouth's Teddy Drone S. last time Aug. 3.

For the first time in three years, the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf will be contested at its intended 10-furlong trip, and Wait a While is back in this course-and-distance prep looking to add her 2006 Yellow Ribbon success. Fourth to Ouija Board (GB) in that year's F/M Turf when run over 11 panels at Churchill, the gray passed last year's race when the Monmouth turf came up soft. Fabulous Strike Smart Strike Dominguez 5-2 Is very fast--and not very sound. As we said last week, that kind of horse usually runs best when fresh, and this guy has fired big the last three times he has come off layoffs. On his best he's the fastest horse in the field, and that best came over an off track, which he figures to get here. With speed and the rail, Fabulous Strike is the most likely winner.

2 J Be K 8-1 Silver Deputy Bejarano

Was very fast early, and got even faster over the summer. But he bounced pretty badly in his last despite good rest, which makes it unlikely he's ready to run the new top he needs here.

Lucky Island (Arg) Lucky Roberto A Garcia

Is Southern Hemisphere-bred, which means he's really just turning four. He ran well in the spring and exploded in the mud with a huge effort in July before bouncing with trouble last time out. If he runs his best, he has a big shot here, and he'll probably catch an off track again. But he's only run fast enough once to win this, which makes him tough to take as the favorite, and it's probably too soon for him to run that well again.

First Defence Unbridled's Song Hill 4-1

Got good at three, but wasn't quite as good this year until he exploded last time at Saratoga. This guy has reacted badly to top efforts before, and those weren't nearly as big as his last. A bounce is very likely.

Kodiak Kowboy Posse

Is another that exploded at Saratoga, in his first start for Larry Jones, and was getting some very big figures over the summer. After adjusting for ground loss (4w) that figure came up one of the best ever run by a 3year-old, and if he does it again, getting a little weight, he'll probably win this. But he bounced badly from that effort, and we think it's going to be quite a while before he runs that well again, if ever.

Rockerfeller 6-1 Maria's Mon Castro

Wasn't much as a 3-year-old, but moved up dramatically when he went to the barn of Marty Wolfson, who is winning at a modest 48-percent clip recently (see profile). Two of this gelding's last four put him right in this and with eight weeks rest, he's likely to run another big one, although the off track is a question.

Black Seventeen Is It True **Potts** 12-1

Ran a lifetime top last year when he went from synthetic to dirt, as many do, and then disappeared, as also seems to happen often. He's making the synthetic/dirt move again here, and will probably run a top, but he's too slow to contend with these.

Bottom Line: Fabulous Strike is a likely winner. Rockerfeller can be used in exotics.



Tampa Bay Downs Announces Record Stakes Schedule:

Tampa Bay Downs will offer a record \$2.7 million in stakes money, pending the Breeders' Cup approval of supplemental funds, during its 94-day 2008-2009 race meet, which is scheduled to begin Dec. 13. The Sam F. Davis S., a 1 1/16-mile prep for the GIII Tampa Bay Derby, will carry a purse of \$225,000, up \$25,000 from 2008. "Each year, where it's warranted, we try to increase the value of key stakes races to help us maintain or receive graded status on deserving races," Tampa's Vice President and General Manager Peter Berube said. "This year, we are cautiously optimistic that the Sam F. Davis will be favorably evaluated." The Davis will be contested Feb. 14 on Festival Preview Day. The Tampa Bay Derby, the meet's signature event, is one of three graded stakes on the Festival Day card Mar. 14. Also scheduled that day are the GIII Florida Oaks and the GIII Hillsborough S.

RMTC Board Approves Testing Initiative:

The Board of Directors of the Racing Medication and Testing Consortium (RMTC) have announced a a fivepart drug testing initiative aimed at developing laboratory and testing standards comparable to the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) model. The Board met Sept. 24 in Lexington, Kentucky. These recommendations are the result of The Jockey Club Thoroughbred Safety Committee-sponsored drug testing meeting in Chicago Sept. 22-23, and are a direct response to Thoroughbred Horsemen's Associations President Alan Foreman's call for a major reorganization of drug testing in U.S. racing at The Jockey Club Round Table.

The initiative will include the following action points:

- Development of laboratory standards and accreditation criteria to ISO standards
- Expansion of current quality assurance and laboratory proficiency programs
- Development of a business plan for the U.S. drug testing infrastructure including industry-sponsored research and reference equine drug testing laborato-
- Establishment of a post doctoral and grad student recruitment program for drug testing research and laboratory staff development
- Review of current sample collection strategies including long-term storage of frozen samples

Dr. Rick Arthur, equine medical director of the California Horse Racing Board, said, "This is an opportunity to move equine drug testing in this country to a new level. Dr. Don Catlin, founder and former director of the UCLA Olympic Analytical Laboratory, recommended the WADA model for equine drug testing at the Grayson-Jockey Club Welfare and Safety Summit this spring, and he was absolutely correct. 

KINGSGATE NATIVE RETIRED John Mayne's Kingsgate Native (Ire) (Mujadil--Native Force {Ire}, by Indian Ridge (Ire)) has been retired and will stand at Cheveley Park Stud in Newmarket. Trained by John Best throughout his career, the colt, who cost €28,000 as a weanling at Goffs November 2005 and 20,000 guineas as a yearling at the following year's Doncaster Sales, registered a rare juvenile success in last year's G1 Nunthorpe S. at York before capturing the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot this June. He suffered a setback following a third in this year's renewal of the Nunthorpe last month, and his conditioner has been unable to prepare him for Longchamp's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye, in which he was runner-up 12 months ago. "I have been very lucky to be associated with Kingsgate Native," Best said of the colt, who started out with a second in Royal Ascot's Listed Windsor Castle S. last year and raced exclusively in stakes company throughout his career. "Right from an early stage, he showed us tremendous speed at home, and he has a temperament to match. To think that we had our first run at Royal Ascot and nearly pulled it off, and to end up as a dual Group 1 winner, is a dream come true. Both John Mayne and Cheveley Park have been so supportive during his career, and I am excited that he will now stand at such a prestigious stud. Myself and my owners will hopefully support him for many years to come. I just hope I can find one to replace him--it will be tough." Cheveley Park Stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson added, "It is very exciting to be in a position to offer British breeders the opportunity to use such an exciting commercial dual Group 1-winning sprinter as Kingsgate Native...not many stallions can boast having raced solely in stakes/group company throughout their career." A fee has yet to be announced for the three-year-old, who retires as the winner of two of his eight races and £438,787 in prize money.


