Now (Tiznow) (BC Ladies' Classic), Dynaforce (Dynaformer) (BC F/M Turf), Stardom Bound (Tapit) (BC Juvenile Fillies), West Side Bernie (Bernstein) (BC Juvenile) and **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) (BC Ladies' Classic) were all handy in victory. It was a little tighter for Curlin (Smart Strike) (BC Classic) and Wait A While (Maria's Mon) (BC F/M Turf), but both were comfortably on top at the finish. Then you had the dogfights: Black Seventeen (Is It True) and Fabulous Strike (Smart Strike) in the GI Vosburgh; Cocoa Beach (Chi) (Doneraile Court) and Ginger Punch (Awesome Again) in the GI Beldane S.; and Red Giant (Giant's Causeway) and Out of Control (Brz) (Vettori {Ire}) in the world-record-setting GI Clement L. Hirsch S. Fingers crossed, they will all be back in four weeks for the main event.

ALL THAT GLITTERS

Cigar has been dethroned as North America's richest racehorse. Reigning Horse of the Year Curlin (Smart



Strike) wrested that title with his determined win in vesterday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park, bringing his career bankroll to a cool \$10,246,800. He is the first North American-based horse to break the eight-figure mark in earnings. "It's amazing," jockey Robby Albarado said. "I'm sure this record will be broken one day, but it will take a helluva horse." According

You start to run out of superlatives. Except for a slight hiccup when trying the turf, Curlin has been



unbeatable since taking the 2007 edition of the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. That was his closest call--a neck tally over Lawyer Ron--and he has done whatever he needs to do to get the job done in six of his seven starts since. The superstar took a short break after his tour de

force in the Mar 29 G1 Dubai World Cup, then made light work of the competition in the June 14 GI Stephen Foster H. Looking for new worlds to conquer, his connections decided it was time to try the grass, and Curlin was the 2-5 favorite in the GI Man o'War S. at Belmont July 12. He lacked his usual strong late kick, running second, and has been far from overpowering in his two starts since, but the four-year-old has been the consummate professional every time. He caught loose-on-thelead Past the Point (Indian Charlie) in the Sept. 1 GI Woodward S. and edged away to a 1 1/4 length score, and it was the same story yesterday. Wanderin Boy went to the front on the sloppy track and took them as far as he could, but Curlin came after him in the stretch, seized control and never felt the whip as he powered to the wire. As to whether he will ultimately defend his title in the Breeders' Cup Classic, owner Jess Jackson said by phone, "It's up to Curlin whether or not he likes the track and the surface. But we'll consider it. We'll consider it now that we're past this hurdle. It's the next prospect for us and we'll give every bit of attention that we can." Gaining his revenge on Henrythenavigator after three defeats, Raven's Pass finally garnered the top-level victory his consistency demanded. The chestnut stamped himself a genuine top-class runner with an easy success in the G3 Solario S. at Sandown last September, but had to wait almost a year for his next win. Despite a sequence of reverses--five of which came at Group 1 level--he maintained a progressive profile, and had been steadily inching closer to this ultimate goal. The sophomore was on his favored fast ground when runner-up to Henrythenavigator in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 17 and in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood July 30, sandwiching a second to Tamayuz (Nayef) on an easier surface in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly July 13. On all three occasions, he had to make up ground from behind. Buoyed by a straightforward score in Goodwood's Aug. 23 G2 Celebration Mile and a more positive ride here, he put to bed all of the hard-luck stories.

O'Brien and Freddy Head rabbits, Raven's Pass pounced on Tamayuz approaching the furlong marker. He battled gamely for Jimmy Fortune to withstand the advances of Henrythenavigator and Johnny Murtagh in the drive to the line. "He's been at the top of the tree and was a bit hot earlier in the year, so we had to relax him," Fortune commented. "I probably got it wrong in the Sussex, which was a messy race, and I should have kicked earlier, so I knew it was time to go when Johnny [Murtagh] came to my quarters. He's an out-and-out miler and he'll probably get farther, so I knew the pace would suit us." Trainer John Gosden added, "Horse, trainer and jockey finally got it right. Last year, he was pretty outstanding, but it all went wrong in the Guineas from the draw. He ran a blinder in the St James's Palace, and then we let Tamayuz have 12 lengths in the Jean Prat and Henry first run in a slowly run Sussex, so the only plan was to be handier. He sees his races out well now and, physically, he's done very well and looks great. The plan is now to go to the Breeders' Cup; whether that is for the Mile or the Classic, we will have to see." Aidan O'Brien said of the runner-up, "He ran a stormer, but the ground was quite loose and he's better on a fast surface. I'm not putting that up as an excuse and hopefully we'll have a look at Santa Anita--although I'm not sure which race yet."

The Bright 'Side' of Things...

A share of Raven's Pass, who was bred by Bob McNair's Stonerside Stable and initially raced solely by that operation, was purchased by Sheikh Mohammed's Darley last October. Darley subsequently acquired Stonerside in its entirety in early September, and yesterday Raven's Pass raced in the colors of Sheikh Mohammed's wife Princess Haya. Remarkably, it was the second Stonerside-bred Grade I/Group 1 winner to emerge since the deal was announced, following the success of Midshipman (Unbridled's Song) in America's GI Del Mar Futurity. The ugly duckling has truly become the swan queen. Picked up for just \$60,000 at the 2005 Keeneland September Sale due to an unsightly skin rash, Zenyatta saw her value rise before she ever saw a racetrack due to the Grade I-winning exploits of her older half-sister Balance. But just 10 months after kicking off her career with a 🛇 "TDN Rising Star" 🛇 performance on Thanksgiving at Hollywood, the filly with the Amazonian physique might be the rare racehorse that can only be measured against the champions of the past. "I rode a mare [Azeri in 2002] who became Horse of the Year," Smith offered. "Honestly, in their own right, she was a champion, as is this one. No one beat either one of them. But this one, I wouldn't necessarily even compare her to fillies. I'm really starting to think she might be the best horse l've ever ridden."

David Flores rode Zenyatta in her first three triumphs, capped by the GII El Encino S. Jan. 13 at Santa Anita, but Smith climbed aboard for the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Apr. 5. She swept by the likes of Ginger Punch that day, and returned home to add trophies in the GII Milady H. May 31, the GI Vanity H. July 5 and the GII Clement L. Hirsch H. Aug. 2 to her collection.

Second-choice Hystericalady cruised along through splits of :24.26, :48.32 and 1:11.45 while stalked by Santa Teresita here. Zenyatta took her usual spot at the back, albeit never further than three lengths from the front. She ranged up three wide, hit the front and midstretch and came under the wire with her ears pricked forward.

"I would say her best two races probably are this and the Apple Blossom at Oaklawn," Smith said. "But this one, she really was within herself. She went by them like...well, the last quarter-mile, she was just galloping."

John Shirreffs indicated that Zenvatta would prepare at Hollywood for the GI Ladies Classic nee Distaff (credit to DRF's Steve Crist) Oct. 24 over this surface. Hystericalady will take another crack at her there.

"I thought she got the fractions that she wanted," said trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. "We got away at the top of the lane like we thought we would, and then we just couldn't hold off Zenyatta. We're going to run in the Breeders' Cup. Garrett [Gomez] said he would ride."

It took her the length of the stretch, but Cocoa Beach was able to gun down champion Ginger Punch and earn her first Grade I score. The filly started her career in her native Chile, going a perfect four-for-four with three Group 3 victories, and catching the eye of Godolphin. Purchased privately, she shipped to Dubai and, after running second in a Jan. 17 conditions race, reeled off wins in the Feb. 8 UAE 1000 Guineas and Feb. 28 UAE Oaks. Third in the Mar. 29 G2 UAE Derby, Cocoa Beach made her U.S. bow in the Aug. 29 Love Sign S. at Saratoga and cruised by five as the 3-5 chalk. She was the second choice to try to end Ginger Punch's winning streak at four. Rated in third as the reigning Eclipse winner led them along through a half in :48.18 and six panels in 1:12.26, the winner angled outside at the top of the lane. Ginger Punch had kicked clear and looked to have the race safely in hand, but Cocoa Beach put her head down and kept coming, finally getting on top in the final strides. "She looked stronger than ever and she has learned a lot from her last race at Saratoga," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. Cocoa Beach will now target the Oct. 24 GI Breeders' Cup Ladies Classic. Sidelined after an impressive triumph in this event last year, Fabulous Strike made his return in an overnight stakes at Delaware June 21, winning by 3 1/4 lengths as the 1-20 chalk. The gelding missed a start in the GII A. G. Vanderbilt S. at Saratoga due to a torn frog, and may have been just a bit short of his best yesterday. Black Seventeen was also on the shelf for an extended period, disappearing for more than 11 months after taking the GII Carry Back S. last July. Second in the June 14 Oakland S. at Golden Gate and fifth in the Vanderbilt, he was caught at the wire in the Sept. 3 Pirate's Bounty H. for Cal-breds at Del Mar, running second. Content to stalk the pace as Fabulous Strike motored through a half in :44.31, Black Seventeen was put to the test at the top of the lane. Fabulous Strike kept finding more and still had a narrow lead inside the sixteenth pole, but Black Seventeen stuck his head out when it counted to get the nod. WinStar Farm and trainer Eoin Harty already had a GI Breeders' Cup Classic hopeful by Tiznow in the form of Colonel John, and yesterday another son of the WinStar stallion, Well Armed, confirmed his status as a legitimate threat for America's richest race.

Well Armed's emergence as arguably the best horse on the West Coast has been long in coming. As a promising three-year-old, he suffered a hip fracture in a stall mishap and was nursed back to health in a long and laborious process by co-owner Bill Casner. Given a break, Well Armed wired the GII San Diego H. on return July 19, then showed a new dimension coming from just off the pace to nearly beat Go Between in the GI Pacific Classic H. Aug. 24. The previously headstrong colt was once again taken back here by regular rider Aaron Gryder, stalking in third off honest splits. Under a ride nearing the quarter pole, he forged to the lead in upper stretch as a host of challengers fanned wide, and it looked unlikely that he'd be able to withstand the heat. But the big colt dug in and posted his first Grade I win. "Aaron has done a hellacious job with him," Harty enthused afterwards. "Every time I work [Well Armed], it's always Aaron, and the fact that he's relaxing so much is a credit to Aaron Gryder more than to my training. He was under a ride at the 3/8th pole, but he just showed me so much heart from the top of stretch." 

Looking ahead, he added, "The G1 1000 Guineas is a good place to start and, as for the Oaks, I think when a filly has won this race as a two-year-old, they should stay that trip...and she is a Dynaformer." 

Wait a While's victory in this race in 2006 sealed Eclipse Award honors as the nation's champion threeyear-old filly. The grey went 6-2-2-1 at four, with victories coming in the GIII Honey Fox H. at Gulfstream and the GII Ballston Spa H. at Saratoga, and she concluded 2007 with a second to Precious Kitten in the GI Matriarch S. Nov. 25. She kicked off this year with a GII San Gorgonio H. win Jan. 14 over the Santa Anita lawn, but was sidelined with a minor injury. After a rusty seventh as the favorite in her return, the GI Diana S. July 26 at the Spa, Wait a While successfully defended her title in the Ballston Spa Aug. 21. The even-money chalk sat in third here as Live Life (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) led through the opening furlongs, and was perfectly positioned to get first run on her main rivals. Wait a While led as they straightened into the lane and kicked on for home as Vacare gave chase. "She got a little bit aggressive with me when we started down the backside," acknowledged winning rider John Velazquez. "But she does everything easy, and I was able to bide my time. On the far turn she was really running comfortably, and when we made the lead turning for home I thought she was going to just open up, but instead she waited on those horses. When Vacare came to her outside, though, she dug in and got it done. She's going to be real tough [in the Breeders' Cup] on this course." Plans are more fluid for the runner-up. 

The top-class dirt performer represents the Godolphin team successful with Diffident (Fr) in 1996 and Sampower Star (GB) in 2000. "I have been slightly disappointed with Diabolical this season, but he has the ability to win a race like this," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "He's been working well lately and has been a healthy and sound horse all season. I don't think he will have a problem with the forecast ground." James Fanshawe saddles a duo in Sir Gerry and Zidane, but both put in rare disappointing efforts when unplaced in the July Cup on their latest start. Sir Gerry previously ran to a career-best over this track and trip when third in the June 21 G1 Golden Jubilee S., and Zidane would have claims on his earlier win in Newmarket's Apr. 17 Listed Abernant S. at Newmarket Apr.17. "Zidane had a break since the July Cup, but he seems in good form now, although he has got a bit to find," Fanshawe told PA Sport. "Sir Gerry has not been able to run with the soft ground around. He is the first in the yard to have got a winter coat, but he's going well at home." Dark Missile was denied in the final stride by Haatef 12 months ago, but is another who needs to improve on recent efforts, which include a latest fourth in the Aug. 9 Shergar Cup Dash.

The third renewal of this bonanza features the Sept. 7 G3 Prix la Rochette and Aug. 17 Listed Prix Francois Boutin winner Soul City, who represents the Richard Hannon stable so lethally effective in these contests. "He'd have a great chance, and has done nothing wrong," his trainer said. Luck Money (Ire) carried this prize off to Britain 12 months ago, and trainer Jeremy Noseda puts weight behind the assault with Awinnersgame, who bids for a rare sales-race double following his success in the £300,000 St Leger Yearling S. at Doncaster Sept. 11. "He has won on all types of surface, but the soft side of good would be ideal," Noseda said. "He is a tough, honest horse with lots of experience, which makes him fit perfectly into a race like this. He is very professional, and his form is as good as anything else in the race...he must has a good live chance." In their way stand a formidable home team headed by the Naas maiden scorer Gan Amhras, who beat today's G2 Beresford S. favorite Masterofthehorse (Ire) by three lengths in that contest last time July 16. His trainer Jim Bolger is also represented by the June 17 G2 Coventry S. runner-up Intense Focus, who is closely tied with Alhaban on the form of their third and second placings, respectively, behind Mastercraftsman (Ire) in the G2 Railway S. over six furlongs here June 29. He encounters livelier conditions than when sixth in the course-and-distance G1 National S. a fortnight ago, where Ballydoyle's main hope Drumbeat was fifth. "Intense Focus ran a very good race at Ascot when he was second in the Coventry, but he didn't particularity like the heavy ground last time out in the National S. at The Curragh," Bolger told PA Sport.

PURSE REDUCTION FOR FLORIDA DERBY The 2009 GI Florida Derby will be contested Mar. 28 at Gulfstream Park with a purse of \$750,000, down from \$1 million. "We felt the \$250,000 we're reducing the purse of the Florida Derby would be better served going into overnight purses," the track's new racing secretary, Doug Bredar, told Daily Racing Form. "After looking at what else is out there for 3-year-olds in the division, we doubt the reduction will affect us much." Two of the last three Florida Derby winners--Barbaro in 2006 and Big Brown this year--returned five weeks later to claim the GI Kentucky Derby. Bredar also confirmed that the distance of the GII Fountain of Youth S., which will be run Feb. 28, has been shortened to a flat mile. Once offered as a 8 1/2-furlong prep for the meet's marquee event, the Fountain of Youth had been conducted at nine panels since Gulfstream's reconfiguration in 2005. "Obviously, I'd prefer to run the Fountain of Youth at a mile and a sixteenth, but that's not possible because of the configuration of the racetrack," Bredar continued. "And I don't believe having back to back mile-and-one-eighth races, the Fountain of Youth and then the Florida Derby, for 3-year-olds at that time of the year does us much good. By shortening the Fountain of Youth to a mile, I felt it could help us maximize the size and quality of the field while also giving those horsemen who might be a little behind developing their Derby prospects a better opportunity to run in the race." The \$300,000 GII Gulfstream Park H. for older horses, which will be offered Mar. 14, has also been shortened to a mile. "In the past, there really hasn't been a natural progression of both distances and purses in many of the categories, and I think we've done a good job accomplishing that with our program for 2009," Bredar continued. In all, the Hallandale oval will host 31graded events, including the \$500,000 GI Donn H. Jan. 31 and the \$250,000 GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. Feb. 1. Click here for the complete stakes schedule.


