the front runners late to eke out the victory. The Del Mar Futurity winner was slowly closing the gap on the leader in the final strides, but could not find enough to get the job done this time. Believe in Hope (Thunder Gulch), who was off to a slow start, closed late to be third. "I can hardly talk, I'm so excited," said owner-breeder Myung Cho, who was also collecting his first Grade I score as a trainer. "I'm really happy. This is the best day of my life. Down the stretch, my heart was pumping. This is my biggest win, and I've been training around 17 years." HYPERBARIC POWERS HOME AT OAK TREE

Prestonwood Racing's **Hyperbaric** (Sky Classic) took command from frontrunner **Tropic Storm** (Stormy Atlan-

tic) entering the stretch and withstood the fast-closing **Tybalt** (Storm Cat) to record his first graded stakes win in yesterday's GII Oak Tree Mile at Santa Anita Park. Settled just behind an even early pace, the five-year-old poked his head in front turning for home and was all out to

withstand 6-1 chance Tybalt. "The pace surprised me," said winning rider Garrett Gomez, who reached a milestone of 3000 victories Sunday at Santa Anita. "We went a lot slower early than I thought we would. On paper, it didn't look like it would shape up that way. Out of the gate it looked like everybody was taking back, and [Tropic Storm] was going to be on his own, so I gunned my horse up in there to keep him honest." Part of the Breeders' Cup's 'Win and You're In' series, a score in yesterday's Oak Tree Mile guarantees Hyperbaric a berth in the Breeders' Cup, held at Santa Anita Oct. 24 & 25. Asked if the chestnut would run in the Breeders' Cup Mile next, trainer Julio Canani said, "We'll play it by ear. We'll decide later." cont. p8

Content to stalk the early pace through early spilts of :22.96, :47.02 and 1:11.11, the bay, who was equipped with blinkers for the first time, was in tight behind foes turning for home, but once he found a sliver of space, he forged to the front late to record his first career win. "I was in a tough position from the 5/16 [pole] to the top of the stretch," explained winning rider Alex Solis. "Finally, I had enough horse to get out. He's still a little green. He's still learning." Solis added, "I really liked him at Del Mar. Right away I noticed this horse could use blinkers. He was much better today and he's just learning how to run." Third first time out at Hollywood June 29, the homebred hit the board in a pair of maiden tests at Del Mar, including a runner-up finish to Midshipman going 5 1/2 furlongs Aug. 17.

With regard to whether the defending Horse of the Year will contest the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 25, Asmussen said, "What we decide will only matter according to how he is on that race track [Santa Anital." The chestnut, who arrived at the Arcadia-area oval vesterday afternoon, is stabled in Barn 27. Assistant Scott Blasi said that the

decision to ship yesterday morning came with short notice. "Mr. [Jess] Jackson [majority owner] instructed us to fly out [Sunday] morning about 30 minutes after the race," Blasi said, adding, "He shipped very well. He ate a lot and drank a lot of water." As for the colt's schedule, Blasi offered, "He'll walk here at the barn for two days, and then he'll resume training. The Classic is what we showed up for, but he's got to train well to run. If he's going to run, we want Santa Anita to be his home for the next 30 days."

GOSDEN EYES CUP FOR WEEKEND STARS

Trainer John Gosden vesterday revealed that George Strawbridge's unbeaten **O** "TDN Rising Star" **O** Rainbow View (Dynaformer) could join Raven's Pass (Elusive Quality) on the plane to Santa Anita next month. While Saturday's G1 Fillies' Mile heroine is guaranteed a slot in the Juvenile Fillies' Turf, a tilt at the Juvenile Fillies is the preferred option according to her conditioner. "Why not?" he told the Racing Post. "She has never been off the bridle at home or in her races, so it was a good education for her yesterday. She was confused when she first started to come off the bridle, but then she got the idea of it and was back on it again coming to the finishing line." Gosden also suggested that the Classic could be on the cards for Princess Hava of Jordan's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. hero Raven's Pass. "The plan is to go there with him and I wouldn't be frightened at this stage of going for the Classic," he told the trade daily.

DUO SUPPLEMENTED FOR MIDDLE PARK TDN Rising Star" Huntdown (Elusive Quality) and Sayif (Ire) (Kheleyf) were yesterday added to Friday's G1 Shadwell Middle Park S. at Newmarket. The former scored by seven lengths for the Princess Haya of Jordan-John Gosden axis in a Newbury maiden Sept. 19, while Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's Sayif will attempt to better a latest third in that track's G2 Mill Reef S. last Saturday for the Peter Chapple-Hyam stable. Their owners Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor are more likely to be represented by the David Wachman-trained G1 Prix Morny hero Bushranger (Ire) (Danetime {Ire}), while Brian Meehan could saddle the Morny runner-up Gallagher (GB) (Bahamian Bounty {GB}) and Marcus Tregoning is looking at running Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's G3 Molecomb S. winner Finjaan (GB) (Royal Applause {GB}). Five fillies were supplemented for the same card's G1 Cheveley Park S. yesterday, headed by Geoff Howard-Spink and Peter Marshall's G2 Lowther S. winner Infamous Angel (GB) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) from the Richard Hannon stable. 

Successful in a newcomers' event at Chantilly May 23, Baila Me proved an instant hit at pattern level when taking out the G2 Diana-Trial at this track next time June 15 before running third in the main event--the G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks)--at Dusseldorf Aug. 3. She dropped off the board for the first time when a last-out ninth in the Sept. 14 G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp, but bounced back from that defeat to upset the boys and claim a career high in this meeting feature. Settled in mid division for most of the contest. Baila Me was coaxed forward once into the stretch run. She guickened to the front approaching the final guarter mile and stayed on in tenacious fashion once joined by Poseidon Adventure soon after to deny that rival in a thrilling bobber. The win capped a memorable day for Gestut Karlshof's homebred sire Samum who was responsible for three winners on the card. "I was glad to see that Baila Me was much more alive today because she was very quiet in the Vermeille where she was in season," revealed trainer Werner Baltromei. "She really fought bravely and maybe we will call it a day for this year. I shall have to talk it over with the owner so there is a small chance she might run again." Jockey Dominique Boeuf added, "I wasn't guite sure whether we had won, but she fought like a lion and that was fantastic."

Tam Lin accounted for a trio of stakes victories in England at three, including the G3 Winter Hill S. at Windsor. With only a couple of stakes placings from four starts the following season, the attractive bay failed to fire and came home sixth in his U.S. debut going 1 1/16 miles in allowance company over a yielding turf course at Tampa Mar. 15. On the board in his next three starts, including a nose score in the one-mile Scottish Monk S. at Belmont June 14 followed by a runner-up finish behind Kip Deville in that track's GIII Poker H. July 13, the five-year-old failed to fire and had to settle for ninth in his latest in the seven-panel GII Play the King S. at Woodbine Aug. 23. Content to stalk the early pace as the second choice here, the English-bred forged to the front in the final furlong, and displaying his customary swish of his tail to his rivals, rolled home an easy winner. "This horse isn't easy to ride, but I get along with him," said winning rider Javier Castellano. "The key to the race today was that he was so relaxed. When we were right behind the leaders, I didn't want fight with him. I guess he really liked the course." Rick Mettee, assistant trainer to Saeed bin Suroor, echoed the sentiment. "He really likes it here at Belmont Park. He really doesn't corner that well. We thought the one-turn, seven-eighths [Play the King] would be good for him, but he never settled. He's a tough horse to ride because he runs with his head up and pulls hard. Saeed and I did not discuss what is next for him. Obviously, a two-turn race at Santa Anita with a full field would be completely different and I don't know if that would really suit him."

His owner has horses in Singapore and was going to take him there last year, but we thought he was capable of some black type so we kept him here. WEATHERING THE STORM

At a time of upheaval in the world economy and the now widely recognised problem of over-production in the breeding industry, consigning bloodstock could be viewed as one of the most precarious businesses to be in. Of course, it helps if you keep producing the goods by offering top-class potential, and that is the case with Bill Dwan's Castlebridge Consignment. Having topped the Tattersalls Ireland Sale with a son of Sahm last week, the County Meath-based operation have cause for optimism ahead of the Million extravaganza. "I'd be encouraged by the Tattersalls Ireland September Sale, because we thankfully topped that and it proved there is money for nice horses, but I'd be concerned about the lesser-bred horses," Dwan says. "I think this sale will be in a similar vein--it is a strong catalogue and I'm sure all the major players will be there and although it sounds like an old line now, the nice horses will still sell well."

Despite the general economic environment, the signs are that the Euroepan yearling sales are largely unaffected. While Doncaster and Baden-Baden were slightly down, Deauville was up, and while being realistic, Dwan is more optimistic than negative about the immediate future. "There is certainly a correction happening, but I'd be more inclined to point to the effects of overproduction hitting home rather than the economic downturn and market forces," he continues. "I wouldn't be a total doom-and-gloom merchant and, to be honest, I would blame the standard of some of the horses being offered as the reason why we are down 10 percent at the moment. When you see how much the world markets are down, that doesn't look too bad."

Among his draft, Dwan points to hip 157, a son of Royal Applause (GB) whose dam is a half to Cheveley Park's top-class sprinter Danehurst (GB) and smart Pivotal (GB) duo Humouresque (GB) and Mighty (GB). "He is an early, fast type and a very nice colt who I'm hoping will sell well," he says. "He would very nearly be our top one." Also among the dozen is hip 49, a daughter of Green Desert from the extended family of Hector Protector, Bosra Sham and Saturday's GI Clement Hirsch Memorial Turf Championship hero Red Giant. "She is exciting and a typical Green Desert," he adds.



"Evening Attire was one of a kind," said co-owner and retired Hall of Fame trainer Tom Kelly, who bred and raced the gelding in partnership with Joe & Mary Grant. "He rates up at the top of all the good horses I've trained, and that's saying something." The dappled gray had been entered in the Point Given S. at Monmouth Sept. 2, but was scratched on race day. "Last weekend at Monmouth, we saw some swelling in his leg," said his trainer Pat Kelly. "During the week, after discussions with the vet and his owners, we decided, considering his age and all he has done, it was in everyone's best interest to retire Evening Attire and find a good home for him." Where the 10-time graded stakes winner will retire has not been decided by his connections, who are considering all options and suggestions. "We are amazed at his popularity, said Mary Grant. "For years he has received birthday cards from fans in this country as well as from New Zealand and Europe. One fan has even built a website dedicated to him,

www.eveningattire.net." Besides his color, Evening Attire's popularity was partially attributable to his running style. He would usually hesitate at the start, then lag behind the field, a habit that became more pronounced with age. Evening Attire broke his maiden in his second start at two at Saratoga, but went winless in his next six races. "She won the Matron last year, but I want to see who's running and the weights of the races before I decide where she'll run." Owned by Senji Nishimura, Romance Is Diane was fourth in the GII Clement L. Hirsch Handicap at Del Mar last out Aug. 2. In 15 career starts, she has never raced against males, but has five wins, three at Santa Anita. "She's training great, and if she can handle this track the way it's playing now, the way speed is holding up on it, she'll like it even more," said Mitchell, who won the recent Fairplex Park training title for his 17th overall in Southern California. "It doesn't look like anybody's coming from out of it on this track. It seems like you've got to be laying up close to win on it, so with her speed, that alone should help her."

Veterinarian to the Stars Jock Jocov Dies:

Dr. Jock Jocoy, veterinarian to several of the greatest horses in Thoroughbred racing history, including champions Swaps, Ack Ack, Cougar II and Buckpasser, died Saturday afternoon at his home in Del Mar after a lengthy illness. The native of New London, Connecticut, was 82. Earning his degree as a veterinarian at the University of California at Davis in 1954, "Doc" Jocoy had a successful private practice on Southern California racetracks from 1955 until 1983. Serving as the resident vet for owner-breeder Rex Ellsworth early in his career, Jocoy, who was the track veterinarian at Del Mar for several years, was employed by numerous Hall of Famers, including Charlie Whittingham, Hirsch Jacobs, Meshach "Mesh" Tenney, Eddie Neloy, Horatio Luro and D. Wayne Lukas. A successful breeder in California, he bred stakes winners D'Artagnan, Windy Kate, Queen Janine, Jan Jessie, Sheila Jan and Kirrary. Survivors include wife Katie, daughters Jan and Sheila, sons Kelly and Jock Sterling, plus five grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Funeral arrangements are pending.


